RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals are 39-26 post All-Star Break and 40-26 under manager **Mike Shildt** since he took the post on July 15. The Cardinals own the most wins (39) in the National League since the All-Star Break, while St. Louis' .600 winning percentage ranks 7th in MLB over that period. Entering July 15, the Cardinals had 9th-most wins in the NL (47) and currently have the 6th-most wins (87) in the NL.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals, who were off yesterday, were swept in 3-games by the Brewers this week and concluded their final regular season homestand with a 3-3 mark...St. Louis enters play today in 3rd place in the N.L. Wild Card race, 5.0 games back of Milwaukee and 1.0 game back of the Dodgers...the Cardinals are currently in 3rd place in the NL Central, 6.0 games out of first place.

TIE-BREAKERS: In the event of postseason tie-breakers, the Cardinals have won their season series with both Los Angeles (4-3) & Colorado (5-2).

WINNING SEASONS: The Cardinals have posted their 11th consecutive winning season, something they'd done just once previously in franchise history, when they compiled 15 consecutive winning seasons from 1939-1953.

CATCH THIS: Yadier Molina hit his 20th homer on Tuesday, two shy of his career high 22 in 2012...Yadier joined **Ted Simmons** (1977 & 1979) as the lone Cardinals catchers with multiple 20+ homer seasons.

CARPENTER CHASING N.L. HR TITLE: Matt Carpenter hit his NL-leading 36th home run last Sunday and is trying to become just the 8th Cardinal (12th instance) to lead the league in round-trippers: **Albert Pujols** (2009-10); **Mark McGwire** (1998-99); **Johnny Mize** (1939-40); **Joe Medwick** (1937); **Rip Collins** (1934); **Jim Bottomley** (1928) and **Rogers Hornsby** (1922 & 1925).

A TASTE FOR CHICAGO: Matt Carpenter has hit eight home runs in 16 games against the Cubs this season, the most by any opposing player in 2018, and tied with **Jim Edmonds** (2004), **Albert Pujols** (2004), **Stan Musial** (1950) and **Rogers Hornsby** (1925) for most in a season among Cardinals. The most ever hit in a single season by a Cubs opposing player was **Ralph Kiner** (13, PIT, 1949). Carpenter's eight are the most since **Greg Vaughn** hit nine in 13 games vs. CHI with Cincinnati in 1999...**WRIGLEY WALLOPS: Carpenter** has hit six homers at Wrigley Field this season (all during July 19-22 five-game series), tying **Les Bell** (1925) for the most in a single-season by a Cardinal.

POWER PLAY: St. Louis has homered in 115 of 159 games this season, going 77-38 (.670 win pct.) in those games (10-34 when not homering)...their 77 wins lead the NL & rank 5th in MLB (Yankees, 1st-88)...St. Louis' 205 HR's are 3rd in NL behind the Dodgers (227) & Brewers (211)...**HOMERS AWAY FROM HOME:** St. Louis is an NL-best 41-20 (.672) when homering on the road, and trails only Oakland (132) in road homers (122) among all Major League teams.

TRIPLES TRIVIA: The Cardinals have hit a Major League low nine triples this season and finished with a record single-season low of four at Busch Stadium III...the Cardinals have never finished a season in single-digits in three-baggers.

GAMES THAT MATTER: The Cardinals today will play their 1,291st regular season game out of 1,293, dating back to Opening Day of 2011, during which they still maintain playoff aspirations and have yet to be eliminated. **"MO"- MENTUM:** In their 11 seasons under President of Baseball Operations **John "Mo" Mozeliak**, the Cardinals have won 984 regular season games, trailing only the Yankees (1,008) & Dodgers (988), while they & the Yankees are the only teams to have posted 11 consecutive winning (+.500) seasons in that time period.

FARM SYSTEM: The Cardinals 492-402 (.550) overall organizational record placed them 2nd behind Tampa Bay (539-345; .604) in total wins among all minor league systems this year...Memphis (AAA) won its 2nd-consecutive Pacific Coast League title and the Triple-A National Championship Game and Peoria (A) reached the Midwest League Championship Series.

TODAY'S GAME

- Makes his 8th start of the season (285th career start) and his 352nd career appearance.
- He and Yadier Molina have been a starting battery for 241 career games, the most in Cardinals history (surpassed Bob Gibson & Tim Lincecum's 198 on 6/15/16) and the most for any tandem since Tom Glavine and Javy Lopez had 248 games together for the Braves from 1994-2002 (*Elias*).
- Since 2016, St. Louis sports a 41-23 record in his games pitched.
- Has appeared in 177 career games home and 174 on the road.
- Has missed a total of 129 games this season with three stints on the DL: left hamstring strain (3/26-4/4) and right elbow inflammation (4/20-5/12 and 5/14-9/9).
- His 69 career road wins rank 5th all-time in franchise history (one shy of Bob Forsch) and trail only Clayton Kershaw (70) among active N.L. pitchers.
- Ranks 6th among Cardinals pitchers in franchise history in ERA (3.31), innings pitched (1,927.0) and win pct. (.638), while his 1,616 strikeouts trail only Bob Gibson (3,117).
- His 3.31 career ERA ranks 5th among active pitchers to Clayton Kershaw (2.38), Madison Bumgarner (3.03), Max Scherzer (3.22), and David Price (3.25).
- Among active MLB pitchers, ranks 6th in winning percentage (.638), 11th in wins (148), 17th in strikeouts (1,616), 7th in complete games (22) and 6th in shutouts (10).

LAST TIME OUT

- Came away with a no-decision in last Saturday's come-from-behind 5-4 win in 10 innings over the Giants at Busch Stadium.
- 104 pitches marked a season-high. Was his 2nd quality start since returning from the disabled list.

- Logged a season-high 10.0 inning scoreless streak from 9/1-9/22.
- Struck out season-high nine batters over 6.0 scoreless frames in 5-0 win over the Dodgers at Busch Stadium on ESPN Sunday Night Baseball (9/16).
- Has pitched 6.0 or more innings in 12 straight starts vs. the Dodgers (8/10/07-present), currently T3rd longest active vs. LAD and trailing Curt Schilling (19) and David Cone (16).
- Became the first pitcher to throw 1,000 career innings at Busch Stadium III, and the 5th Cardinal to throw 1,000 innings at home stadiums, joining Bill Sherdel (1,087.1 at Sportsman's Park), Jesse Haines (1,554.0 at Sportsman's Park), Bob Gibson (1,182.0 at Busch Stadium II) and Bob Forsch (1,402.1 at Busch Stadium II).
- Activated from the 60-day disabled list (right elbow inflammation) on 9/10 vs. PIT and made his first start for St. Louis in 121 days. Allowed four runs in 5.0 frames in the Cardinals' comeback 8-7 win.
- Surpassed Todd Worrell (1985-89, '92) with his 349th career game on 9/10, moving into 8th all-time in Cardinals history.
- Struck out Corey Dickerson (swinging) on 9/10 for his 1,600th career strikeout.
- Made his six rehab appearances across three levels (8/13-9/1) while recovering from right elbow inflammation. Scattered 12 hits with 23 strikeouts over 17.0 scoreless IP.
- Also missed 18 games with right elbow inflammation (4/20-5/12).
- Earned his only win of the season in a 5-3 victory at CHI (4/17) at Wrigley Field, allowing 1 UER with 5 strikeouts in 5.0 IP. Temperature at first pitch was 35°.
- Marked his 15th career win vs. the Cubs (T10th all-time in Cardinals history) and his 11th career win at Wrigley Field (3rd all-time in Cardinals history).
- Reached 1907.1 career innings in 4/17 start, passing Slim Sallee (1905.1) for 6th-most all-time in franchise history.
- Passed 1,900 innings pitched for career in his 4/11 start vs. MIL, becoming the 15th active pitcher to do so.

- Leads all active pitchers with 15 career wins vs. the Cubs. He ranks T-10th among all Cardinals (Mort Cooper); Harry Brecheen (1st, 31).
- His 11 career wins at Wrigley Field stand 3rd all-time among Cardinals: Bob Gibson (15), Harry Brecheen (13).
- Adam's .846 (11-2) win percentage at Wrigley Field is tops among all pitchers in MLB history (*minimum. 15 or more career starts at the Friendly Confines*).
- Limited the Cubs to one unearned run over 5.0 innings in the 2018 season series opener on April 17 at Wrigley, with a first pitch game temperature of 35°.

- Has a lifetime .156 average (12-77), three doubles, three RBI, and 7 sacrifices against the Cubs (.149, 7-for-43 at Wrigley Field).
- Won his first Louisville Silver Slugger award following 2017 season...led NL pitchers with a .262 average with 11 hits, 11 RBI (T1st) and two home runs.
- Leads active MLB pitchers in career hits (128), RBI (69), doubles (34), and extra-base hits (46), is 4th in homers (10), T4th in triples (2), 9th in sacrifice hits (53), T2nd in BA (.202), 5th in on-base pct. (.228) and slugging (.309) (*min. 200 AB*).
- Has driven in at least two runs in 15 career starts (St. Louis is 15-0), most among active pitchers (Madison Bumgarner is second with 13). Eight starts have come since the beginning of the 2016 season. The last pitcher with at least eight starts of this type over a two-season span was Bob Gibson in 1970-71 (St. Louis 8-0) (*Elias*).
- Is the only active MLB pitcher with multiple 10-plus RBI seasons (2016 & 2017).
- Collected 29 RBI over the 2016-17 seasons, including 27 in games in which he was pitching...RBI total marks the most by a pitcher over two consecutive seasons since Steve Carlton had 28 for the Phillies in 1977 and 1978, and the most by a Cardinals pitcher since Bob Gibson had 29 in 1970 and 1971 (*Elias*).
