CARDINALS NOTES

- **Miles Mikolas** made his sixth start of the season, first against the Cubs in 2018 and first career start (3rd app.) vs. the Cubs (1-0)... made two relief appearances while with San Diego in 2012...is making his 6th straight start against an N.L. Central opponent...has not walked a batter over his last three starts (21.0 IP)...has made four straight starts of 7.0 innings or more, first Cardinals pitcher since **John Lackey** (9/6-27/2015).
- **Matt Carpenter** tied **Red Schoendienst** for 14th all-time in Cardinals history with 497 career walks.
- **Marcell Ozuna** tied his season-high tallying three-hits, his 4th such game of the season. His three hits tonight were his first hits against the Cubs as a member of the Cardinals after starting this season 0-for-8.
- **Tommy Pham** tallied three RBI vs. the Cubs, his highest total in any of his 35 career games vs. CHI.
- **José Martinez** snapped an 0-for-8 with a single in the 1st inning...produced his 8th multi-hit game of the season.
- **Luke Gregerson** has not allowed a run to the Cubs in his last nine appearances dating back to 2012 (8.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 9 K - 7 Holds).
- *Dominic Leone was removed from the game in the 8th inning with right bicep cramping.*
- **Bud Norris** is a perfect 7-for-7 in save opportunities this season.
- **The Cardinals** have won three straight one-run games and are 6-5 in them after beginning the season 0-3 in one-run games...committed two errors tonight against the Cubs, the 10th time they have had two or more errors vs. CHI since 2012...won their 4th game this season scoring three runs or less and three have been in their last three games.

CUBS NOTES

- **José Quintana** made his sixth start of the season, first against the Cardinals in 2018 and fifth career start vs. the Cardinals (3-1)... his team had won all four of his career starts against the Cardinals dating back to 2012 with two at Busch Stadium entering tonight... threw 4.0 innings, his shortest career outing vs. STL and his 2nd shortest outing of 2018 (2.1 IP vs. ATL on 4/14; 7 runs in 38 degree weather and rain).
- **Kyle Schwarber** recorded his first outfield assist of the season...had seven in 2017.
- **Ian Happ** is 4-for-6 as a pinch-hitter this season with two extra base hits (2B, HR) after his pinch-hit double in the 5th inning.
- **Steve Cishek** threw a season-high 2.0 innings. Was his longest outing since tossing 2.0 innings at KC (8/30/17).
- **Tommy La Stella** has six pinch-hits this season (6-15, .400, 6 RBI) and six pinch-hit RBI, leading MLB in both categories.
- **Javier Báez** tallied his team-leading 9th multi-hit game of the season.
- **Jason Heyward** had his streak broke of reaching base in each of his last 17 games vs. the Cardinals dating back to 9/25/2016 entering tonight with a .352 OBP during the stretch (hitting safely in 16-of-17)...also had an RBI in six straight games vs. STL, the longest active streak by any player in MLB (Freese, 2nd, 4) entering tonight.

- The **Cubs** lost three straight games for the first time this season...are 13-for-35 (.371) this season in pinch-hitting situations this season (4 extra base hits), their 13 pinch-hits rank 2nd in MLB behind Los Angeles-NL (19).
