## BATS ALIVE | YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians set new season-highs with nine runs scored and 15 hits as they completed a four-game sweep of the Tigers with a 9-3 victory at Progressive Field last night.

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** sparked the Indians offense with a leadoff homer in the bottom of the 1st inning and went on to collect three RBI on the evening...**JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** added a two-run homer of his own, while **JASON KIPNIS** and **BRADLEY ZIMMER** notched three hits each.

» The Tribe received another strong start from **TREVOR BAUER**, who allowed two runs on seven hits over 7.0 strong innings to earn his first victory of the season.

» The sweep of the Tigers marked Cleveland's 11th consecutive victory over Detroit...it also gave the Tribe an MLB-record 14 consecutive series wins against A.L. Central opponents.

» Last night's win also extended the Tribe's winning streak to a season-best five games, as they reached a new high-water mark of three games over .500.

## OUR FRIENDS IN THE NORTH

» The Indians welcome Toronto to Cleveland as they conclude this 10-game homestand with a three-game set vs. the Blue Jays.

» Cleveland posted a record of 4-2 against the Blue Jays in 2017...the Tribe swept a three-game series at Progressive Field from July 21-23, punctuated by a **FRANCISCO LINDOR** walk-off homer in the bottom of the 10th inning as the Tribe won, 2-1, on July 22.

» Since the start of 2016 (including the 2016 Postseason), the Indians have gone 12-6 against Toronto, with a 7-1 mark at home.

» The two clubs have met 412 times in the regular season since the Blue Jays' inaugural season in 1977, dueling to an even 205-205-2 record...Cleveland has gone 9-4-1 in the season series vs. the Blue Jays since 2004...the Indians' 4-1 victory over Toronto in the 2016 ALCS was the first Postseason matchup between the clubs.

## EASTERN PROMISES

» The Tribe's series against Toronto this weekend marks the first contests of the Tribe's 33-game slate against the teams of the A.L. East, 16 of which are scheduled to come at Progressive Field.

» Cleveland posted a record of 22-12 (.647) against the A.L. East in 2017, going 11-6 at Progressive Field and 11-6 on the road...seven of the Tribe's wins during their 22-game winning streak last season came against A.L. East opponents (one vs. Boston, three at New York-AL, three vs. Baltimore).

» Since Tampa Bay joined the A.L. East in 1998, the Indians have gone 386-369 (.511) against the division...Cleveland has played at least one Postseason contest against all five teams, with matchups against A.L. East teams in 13 of their 15 all-time Postseason series at the American League level (including each of their last six).

## MOUND MASTERS

» Cleveland pitching has held opposing batters to just nine runs total over the first seven games of this homestand, good for a 1.29 team ERA (9ER/63.0IP) in that span.

» The Indians pitching staff ranks 2nd in the American League (4th in MLB) with a 2.84 ERA this season...their 2.77 starter ERA is 2nd in the A.L. and MLB, while their 3.00 relief ERA is 4th in the A.L.

» The Indians have allowed three runs or fewer in 10 of their 13 games this season, the most of any team in MLB...Cleveland has recorded 103 such games since the start of 2017, also the most in the Majors over that span.

» **COREY KLUBER** is currently the American League leader in innings pitched (23.0), complete games (1, T1st) and strikeouts (27), while he ranks 3rd in opponent batting average (.143)...**CARLOS CARRASCO** is tied for the A.L. lead in both wins (3) and complete games (1).

## STANDINGS CHECK

» After the Indians pulled even with Minnesota after their win on April 9 vs. Detroit, the two clubs have matched wins each of the last three days to maintain their tie atop the A.L. Central.

» The Tribe has set a new high-water mark for the season at three games above .500 and have spent each of the past four days tied for 1st place...the Tribe spent 132 days in 1st place last season, including every day from June 26 onward.

## THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

» **1921:** The defending World Series champion Cleveland Indians open their title defense with a 4-2 loss at St. Louis...Elmer Smith's 9th inning home run was the first ever by an Indians player on Opening Day...the 1921 Indians went on to finish second to the New York Yankees with a 94-60 record, 4.5 games shy of the A.L. pennant.

## HOME COOKING

» The Indians have opened their 2018 home slate with a 6-1 record on this 10-game homestand...last season, the Indians posted a 49-32 (.605) record at Progressive Field, the 2nd-best home record in the American League and 4th-best in the Majors.

» Since the 2017 All-Star Break, Cleveland has gone an MLB-best 34-9 (.791) at home, including wins in 23 of their past 26 regular-season games here.

» In addition, Cleveland currently leads MLB with a .181 opponent batting average at home, while they also rank 1st with a 1.29 home ERA...Tribe starters have posted a 1.25 ERA (7ER/50.1IP) on this homestand.

» This current 10-game homestand (vs. KC, DET & TOR) matches the longest the Tribe will play this season, along with another 10-gamer from July 6-15 (vs. OAK, CIN & NYY).

## LET THE SUNSHINE IN

» **MIKE CLEVINGER** is slated to make his third start of the 2018 campaign tonight, as well as his second start of this homestand...Clevinger did not factor into the decision on April 8 vs. Kansas City, scattering one run on 10 hits over a career-long 7.1 innings of work.

» Currently ranks 6th in the American League (min. 12.0 IP) with his 0.71 ERA this season.

» Clevinger has allowed one earned run or fewer in each of his last seven starts, dating back to August 26, 2017...marks the longest such streak of his career and the longest by any Indians pitcher since Bob Feller turned in a similar seven-start streak from July 24-August 17, 1946.

» Clevinger has faced the Blue Jays just twice in his Major League career...he earned the win in relief on August 21, 2016 at Progressive Field (1.1IP, 1H, OR, 1BB, 3K), while he also pitched the final 1.2 innings (1H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 1K) in the Tribe's ALCS Game 4 loss on October 18, 2016 at Rogers Centre.

## OFFENSIVE NOTES

» The Tribe recorded a season-high 15 hits last night, receiving multi-hit efforts from five different players...Cleveland has now collected double-digit hits in back-to-back contests, raising its team batting average over 30 points (from .158 to .189).

» **BRADLEY ZIMMER** batted .500 (5-10) in the Detroit series, hitting a two-run homer and recording his second outfield assist of the season...**MICHAEL BRANTLEY** went 4-10 in the series with a double and a pair of RBI.

» The Indians belted two home runs last night, bringing their season total to 14 through 13 games (T6th in the American League)...the Tribe also leads the A.L. in stolen bases (12, 2nd in MLB).

» Four Tribe batters own lifetime averages of .300-or-better against Toronto, most notably **EDWIN ENCARNACION** against his former club (.368, 7-19, 1 HR, 5 RBI)...**MICHAEL BRANTLEY** is batting .363 (49-135, 5 HR, 21 RBI) against the Blue Jays, while **FRANCISCO LINDOR** (.304, 21-69, 1 HR, 5 RBI) and **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** (.310, 22-71, 2 HR, 10 RBI).

## URSHELA UPDATE

» Tribe infielder **GIO URSHELA** is scheduled to make his first rehab start for the Columbus Clippers tonight vs. Durham.

» Urshela has been on the 10-day Disabled List since the start of the season with a right hamstring strain suffered during spring training on March 19.

» Urshela batted .500 (21-42) in 18 Cactus League games before his injury, collecting three homers, six doubles and seven RBI.

» Appeared in 67 games for the Tribe in 2017, batting .224 (35-156) with one homer, seven doubles and 15 RBI...played all four infield positions in his time with Cleveland.

## UNLUCKY FOR SOME

» Tonight's matchup against Toronto will mark the Tribe's first Friday the 13th game since a 7-6 win on May 13, 2016 vs. Minnesota.

» Dating back to 1901, Friday the 13th has overall been a lucky day for the Tribe...team holds a 44-39-1 (.530) record on Friday the 13th, including a 3-3-1 mark on Friday, April 13...tonight will also mark Tribe skipper Terry Francona's 13th Friday the 13th as a Major League manager...he has managed his teams to a 5-7 record in 12 previous games.

# 52 MIKE CLEVINGER

## (1-0, 0.71 ERA)

RHP

**TONIGHT'S START**

» The 27-year-old right-hander is scheduled to take the mound tonight in the opener of this three-game weekend series against the Toronto Blue Jays...will be pitching tonight on regular four days' rest after making his last start on April 8 vs. the Kansas City Royals.

» **LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision in the Tribe's 3-1 walk-off win, holding the Royals to one run on 10 hits across a career-high 7.1 innings pitched (2BB, 4K)...also set a new career high with 110 pitches thrown.

» **Has allowed one earned run or less in each of his last seven starts, a career-long streak that dates back to August 26, 2017...**...has compiled a 6-0 record and 0.64 ERA (3ER/42.1IP) over that span of time.

» Faces the Blue Jays for the second time in the regular season in his career, after making a relief appearance against them on August 21, 2016 in a 3-2 win at Progressive Field...earned the win after striking out three batters and allowing one hit in 1.1 scoreless innings (1BB).

» Also faced Toronto in Game 4 of the 2016 American League Championship Series at Rogers Centre...tossed 1.2 innings (1H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 1K) in the Tribe's 5-1 loss.

**ONE (OR LESS) AND DONE**

» **Clevinger's April 8 outing marked his 14th start since the beginning of 2017 with one-or-fewer runs allowed.**

» His total is the 2nd-most such starts on the team in that span, behind **Corey Kluber** and **Carlos Carrasco**, who have 15 such starts each...has allowed just five earned runs in those 14 starts, compiling a 0.53 EERA (5ER/84.1IP) and 10-0 record in that span.

» **Clevinger's 14 such starts also rank T5th in the American League in that time span, with Houston's Justin Verlander...**...Boston's Chris Sale & New York-AL's Luis Severino lead with 17, followed by Carrasco and Kluber (15).

» Has recorded 18 career starts with one-or-fewer runs allowed, which is T3rd on the Tribe since he made his Major League debut in 2016, trailing Kluber and Carrasco (25 each).

**VS. TORONTO | TAKING ON THE A.L. EAST**

» Tonight's start will represent Clevinger's first career start and second career regular season appearance against the Blue Jays.

» Faced the American League East division seven times in 2017, making five starts...went 3-1 with a 4.73 ERA (14ER/26.2IP) in those outings...

» Owns a career 4-1 and 5.06 ERA (18ER/32.0IP) in nine regular season outings (six starts) against the A.L. East.

**AT PROGRESSIVE FIELD**

» Clevinger went 5-3 with a 3.79 ERA (25ER/59.1IP) in 15 games (10 starts) at Progressive Field last season...owns a 7-4 record and 3.52 ERA (37ER/94.2IP) overall at home.

» Three of his last four outings at home have been in relief, including relief appearances on Sept. 26, Sept. 27 and Sept. 30 of last season and his start on April 8.

» **The Indians have won Clevinger's last seven starts at home, dating back to August 12, 2017...**Clevinger is 6-0 with a 0.41 ERA (2ER/43.2IP) at home in that span.

**SUNSHINE IN SPRING**

» Clevinger went 2-0 with a 3.79 ERA (8ER/19.0IP) in six Cactus League starts (12H, 4HR, 4BB, 25K).

» **His 25 strikeouts marked a new Spring Training career best, and ranked T2nd on the Tribe (with Corey Kluber) and T4th in the Cactus League, as well as T7th in MLB...**his six starts ranked T3rd among Arizona-based pitchers and T5th in MLB.

**2017 HIGHLIGHTS**

» Posted career-highs in nearly every pitching category in 2017, including wins (12), strikeouts (137), ERA (3.11), innings pitched (121.2), games (27) and games started (21)...overall, went 12-6 with a 3.11 ERA (42ER/121.2IP) in 27 games (21 starts) at the Major League level.

» His 3.11 ERA ranked 8th among American League starting pitchers with at least 100.0 innings, and his .211 average against ranked 5th...also finished 4th on the Tribe in wins.

» Tossed a career-high 7.0 innings on May 20 at Houston, a feat he went on to replicate on August 12 at Tampa Bay...**struck out nine batters on June 27 against Texas, a new career best...**...matched his strikeout feat again on Aug. 12 at Tampa Bay and Aug. 26 vs. Kansas City.

» Made four starts in the Tribe's historic 22-game win streak, allowing one earned run in those appearances and posting a 4-0 record and 0.38 ERA (1ER/23.2IP), while holding opposing hitters to a .186 (16-for-86) batting average...also became the first Indians pitcher since John Denny in 1981 to have three consecutive starts of 6.0-or-more scoreless innings.

» **Won his final five starts of the season, marking a new career-long streak, and compiled a 5-0 record with a 0.61 ERA (2ER/29.2IP) in that span.**

» Made three appearances out of the bullpen to end the season, from September 26-30 (3.2IP, 3H, 1ER, 4K).

» Began the season with Triple-A Columbus and spent three stints with the Indians (May 7-June 6, June 17, June 22-end)...ranked 5th in the International League in ERA at the time of his first recall on May 7...in seven starts with the Clippers, went 3-2 with a 2.65 ERA (10ER/34.0IP).

**CAREER SNAPSHOT**

» Clevinger is in his fourth season with the Indians organization...was selected in the 4th round (135th overall) by Los Angeles-AL in the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Seminole State College of Florida...**acquired by the Indians in exchange for reliever Vinnie Pestano on Aug. 7, 2014...**...was added to Cleveland's 40-man roster on November 20, 2015.

» Was ranked as the 7th-best prospect in the Indians organization entering the 2015 & 2016 seasons by **Baseball America**...split 2016 between Triple-A Columbus and Cleveland, going 11-1 with a 3.00 ERA in 17 starts for the Clippers and making 17 appearances for the Tribe throughout the season...began the year 9-0 in Columbus, did not lose a game until July 18 (15th start)...tossed a scoreless inning in the Triple-A All-Star Game on July 13 (2K).

» Made his Major League debut on May 18, 2016 against Cincinnati...did not factor into the decision, tossing 5.1 innings (5H, 4R/ER, 1HR, 1BB, 5K) in the Tribe's 8-7 win over the Reds...struck out Joey Votto in the first inning for his first career MLB punchout...went 3-3 with a 5.26 ERA (31ER/53.0IP) in 17 games (10 starts) across three stints with the Indians.

» **Named Tribe's organizational Pitcher of the Year in 2015...**...had a breakout season, going 9-8 with a 2.73 ERA in 27 games/26 starts with Akron, tallying the 3rd-most strikeouts, the second-lowest WHIP and the 4th-lowest average against in all of Double-A (.219).

**TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTER**

**RHP COREY KLUBER (1-1, 1.57 ERA)**

» The 32-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his fourth start of the season tomorrow afternoon in the second game of this series against the Toronto Blue Jays.

» Kluber will be pitching on regular four days' rest after his last start on April 9 vs. the Detroit Tigers...earned his first win of the season, tossing 8.0 innings and striking out 13 batters while holding Detroit to two hits (1BB) in the Tribe's 2-0 shutout win...marked his 40th career game with 10-or-more strikeouts.

» Has compiled a career 2-3 record and 4.46 ERA (18ER/36.1IP) in six career starts against the Blue Jays, with 41 strikeouts in those innings...faced Toronto once last season, earning the win on July 23 at Progressive Field, pitching into the 8th inning (7.2IP) and allowing one run on five hits, with 14 strikeouts...game was the second start in his second streak of five consecutive starts with 10-plus strikeouts.

» Kluber is coming off a dominant 2017 campaign that saw him become the first pitcher in Indians franchise history to win the American League Cy Young award twice (2014/2017), as well as the 19th multiple-winner in MLB since 1956...led the American League in wins (18, T1st), finished 2nd in strikeouts (265) and became the first Tribe pitcher to lead the Majors in ERA (2.25) since **Mike Garcia** in 1949.
