## NATIONALS NEWS

### MOVING ON

Following Friday night's 9-5 loss in the first game of this weekend set, the Nationals will meet the Giants in a 12:05 p.m. start today at Nationals Park...The 12:05 p.m. start is necessitated by the 13th annual Washington Nationals Dream Gala, held tonight at the Marriott Marquis in downtown Washington, D.C...See the "In The Community" section below for more details.

- The Nationals have won 11 of their last 16 games and since April 29, the Nationals (24-10, .706) boast the best record in the National League and the second-best mark in Major League Baseball behind the New York Yankees (24-9, .727).

### MILESTONE WATCH

With two more wins, Nationals President of Baseball Operations and General Manager **Mike Rizzo** will record his 800th win since taking over the club during Spring Training 2009...Since the start of the 2009 season, the Nationals are 798-720 (.526) and dating to the start of the 2012 season, the Nationals have the best record in Major League Baseball (590-443, .571).

### SUMMER OF SOTO

**Juan Soto** has reached base safely in 14 of 17 games played this season, hitting .339 (19-for-56) with a .431 on-base percentage (9 walks/10 strikeouts) and a .571 slugging percentage (4 2B, 3 HR).

- Since joining the Nationals on May 20, Soto leads Major League rookies in runs scored (12) and ranks among National League rookies in on-base percentage (1st, .431), walks (1st, 9), slugging percentage (2nd, .571), OPS (2nd, 1.002), doubles (4th, 4), and batting average (4th, .339).

### TAYLOR TIME

Over his last 16 games, **Michael A. Taylor** is hitting .310 (18-for-58) with seven doubles, two triples, two homers, 10 RBI, five walks, five stolen bases and seven runs scored...He has hit safely in 14 of the 16 games and has posted a .603 slugging percentage and a .969 OPS along the way.

With 99 in hand, **Trea Turner** is approaching 100 career stolen bases...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, here is the list of quickest active players in terms of games (Turner: 260 games) to reach 100 stolen bases:

### START ME UP

Washington's starting rotation leads the National League in ERA (2.95), strikeouts (414), opp. AVG (.214), opp. OBP (.275), hits per 9.0 IP (7.07), WHIP (1.06)...The staff ranks second in strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.02), strikeouts per 9.0 IP (9.92), opp. OPS (2nd, .637), and opp. SLG (.362), and third in home runs allowed per 9.0 IP (0.91).

- Since April 28, Nationals starters have allowed three earned runs or fewer in 34 of 36 starts.
- The Nationals boast four starters in the top 15 in the National League in ERA...No other team has more than two: **Max Scherzer** (2nd, 1.95), **Gio Gonzalez** (4th, 2.27), **Stephen Strasburg** (14th, 3.46) and **Tanner Roark** (17th, 3.56).

### BULLPENNING

Over the last 16 games, **Henry Blanco's** bullpen has tossed 53.0 innings of relief, striking out 49 batters, walking 10 and posting a 1.87 ERA (11 ER/53.0 IP)...Nationals relievers have inherited 21 runners during this stretch and have allowed just three to score.

- Washington's 1.87 bullpen ERA is the best in the National League and second-best in Major League Baseball since May 21...They trail the Boston Red Sox (1.70 ERA).
- On the season, Washington relievers rank among National League 'pens in inherited runners scored percent (2nd, 21.9%) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (2nd, 2.98).

### ALL HANDS ON DECK

The Nationals have used 42 players so far in 2018...That number does not include the players that have been on the active roster, but did not appear in a game (**Jhonatan Solano**, **Austin Voth**)...The 42 players used are tied for the second-most in Major League Baseball:

## DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

#47 - GIO GONZALEZ - LHP

Electric left-hander is in his seventh season with Washington...In seven years with the Nationals, is 85-56 with a 3.42 ERA in 198 starts...Ranks second on Washington's all-time (2005-pres.) wins list with 85...Is Washington's most prolific left-handed pitcher, leading Nationals southpaws in nearly every pitching category...Leads Nationals (2005-pres.) lefties in wins (85), innings pitched (1,179.0), and strikeouts (1,161), among other categories...Has made 30-or-more starts seven of the last eight seasons.

**AGAINST THE GIANTS:** Makes his 13th career start against the San Francisco Giants...Is 5-5 with a 3.21 ERA in 12 previous starts.

**LAST START:** Tossed 7.0 innings striking out a season-high nine batters in Washington's 5-3 win at Atlanta...He allowed three earned runs and for the first time this season he walked none...The nine strikeouts were his most since he struck out nine on July 1, 2017 at St. Louis.

2018 NOTES

- Has pitched to a 1.81 ERA (9 ER/44.2 IP) in his last seven starts, going 4-0 along the way...Has recorded 43 strikeouts and a .200 opp. AVG.
- Leads all MLB left-handed pitchers with a 2.27 ERA...Overall, ranks eighth among all MLB pitchers and fourth in the National League in ERA.
- Also ranks among NL lefties in strikeouts per 9.0 IP (4th, 9.08), opp. SLG (3rd, .337), opp. OPS (3rd, .632), opp. AVG (5th, .225), opp. OBP (5th, .295) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (6th, 2.57).
- Ranks fifth in MLB (4th in NL) in home runs allowed per 9.0 IP (0.50).
- Has held opposing batters to a .127 average with RISP (7-for-55), fourth-best in MLB and third-best in the NL.
- Has allowed two earned runs or fewer in 10 of his 12 starts this season...His 10 such starts are tied for third most among starting pitchers in Major League Baseball.
- Has not suffered a loss since April 23 at San Francisco.
- Allowed two earned runs on six hits in 5.0 innings of work on May 15 vs. New York...Struck out five batters...Allowed his first home run since April 12 vs. Colorado...The game was eventually suspended due to rain.
- In his sixth start, tossed a season-high on 7.0 innings and struck out a season-high eight batters en route to his third win of the season on April 29 vs. Arizona.
- Earned his 11th career win at Citi Field vs. NYM on April 17...Allowed two earned runs on eight hits with two walks and five strikeouts in 5.1 IP.
- Allowed two earned runs on five hits with three walks and seven strikeouts in 5.0 innings on April 12 vs. COL.
- Allowed one earned run on six hits in 5.1 innings on April 7 vs. NYM...Left the game with a chance to win, but the Nationals fell, 3-2.
- Opened the season with 6.0 strong innings as Washington completed the sweep of the Cincinnati Reds, 6-5...Allowed one earned run on five hits with one walk and seven strikeouts.

CAREER NOTES

- His 85 wins are fifth among left-handed pitchers since 2012...Ranks fifth among MLB left-handed starters in that span with a .234 opp. AVG.
- His 21 wins in 2012 are tied with Clayton Kershaw (21 in 2014) for the most in a single season by a lefty since 2012.
- Since 2012, is 75-5 with a 2.85 ERA in 100 starts when receiving more than two runs of offensive support...Is 86-1 with a 2.77 ERA in 108 starts when getting four or more runs of offensive support in his career.
- Since 2014, has allowed just five home runs in 670 AB vs. LHB, the fewest among left-handed starting pitchers (min. 600 AB vs. LHB).
- Since the start of the 2017 season, ranks seventh in Major League Baseball with a 2.78 ERA...Is 21-11 in 44 starts since the start of 2017.
