WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost three consecutive games and 10 of the last 13 as they conclude their penultimate trip of the season tonight with the finale at Cleveland.
- RHP James Shields, who is looking to win consecutive roads starts for the first time since 2015, takes the mound for the Sox.
- Chicago is 3-5 on this trip, losing the first two games to the Indians after winning two of three at Baltimore over the weekend and losing two of three at Kansas City to start the trip.
- Following tonight's finale at Progressive Field, the Sox will return to Guaranteed Rate Field for their final homestand of 2018 vs. the Cubs (9/21-23) and Indians (9/24-26) ... they will conclude the season with four games at Minnesota (9/28-30; DH on 9/28).
- The White Sox went 3-7 on their last homestand vs. Boston (2-2), Detroit (1-2) and the Angels (0-3) from 8/30-9/9 and 5-2 on their last trip to Detroit (3-1) and New York-AL (2-1) from 8/23-29.

TONIGHT'S STORYLINES

- The White Sox need to win four of their final 11 games to avoid the fourth 100-loss season in franchise history.
- Chicago is 0-8 at Progressive Field in 2018, and has lost nine straight dating back to 2017 ... the nine-game losing streak at the Indians is the second-longest in franchise history.
- The eight losses at Progressive Field are tied for the most in a season in club history (1-8 in 2013).
- The White Sox are 14-8 on the road since 8/3, the third-best record in the American League and fifth-best in MLB.
- Daniel Palka has homered in a career-high three straight games ... he is 13-44 (.295) with seven home runs, nine RBI, a .773 slugging percentage and 1.153 OPS over his last 13 games.
- Tim Anderson needs one home run to become the first White Sox shortstop to record a 20-HR/20-SB season.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

- Jason Kipnis hit a game-ending grand slam off Ian Hamilton in the bottom of the ninth inning to cap Cleveland's 4-1 win.
- Josh Donaldson (single) and pinch-hitter Yandy Diaz (single) started the rally in the ninth ... after Melky Cabrera popped out on a bunt attempt, Hamilton relieved Caleb Frare and hit Yan Gomes with his first pitch, setting up the homer by Kipnis.
- Daniel Palka drove in the Sox only run with a HR in the sixth.
- Dylan Covey received a ND despite allowing just two hits with five strikeouts over 6.0 IP ... Hamilton (2 ER/0.0 IP) suffered his first career blown save, and Frare (1 ER/0.1 IP) his first loss.
- Chicago struck out 15 times, walked just twice, went 0-6 with RISP and left nine runners on base.

TOUGH PROGRESSIVE RATES

- Chicago is 0-8 at Progressive Field in 2018, and has lost nine straight dating back to 2017, the second-longest losing streak at Cleveland in franchise history (11 in a row from 5/25/31-5/30/32).
- The Sox have been outscored, 61-20, scoring three runs or less eight times, and made just two QS during the losing streak.
- Chicago is trying to avoid going winless on the road vs. a single opponent in nine games or more for just the second time in franchise history ... the White Sox went 0-10 at the Boston Americans in 1901 (STATS LLC).

PALKA POWER

- Daniel Palka is tied with Matt Davidson (2017) in White Sox single-season history among rookies with 26 home runs in 2018, one shy of tying Zeke Bonura (1934) for third place ... the 25 homers are the most by a Sox left-handed hitting rookie.
- He ranks among MLB rookie leaders in homers (T1st, 26), RBI (4th, 62), extra-base hits (T5th, 43) and total bases (7th, 191).
- Palka owns seven homers and nine RBI in his last 13 games ... he is trying to become the first White Sox rookie to lead all MLB rookies in home runs since José Abreu (36) in 2014.

GUARANTEED HALF DOZEN

- RHP James Shields has worked at least 6.0 IP 24 times this season, the third-most in the American League and tied for fifth-most in MLB ... Max Scherzer leads MLB with 28 such starts.
- He has gone 7-10 with a 3.55 ERA (62 ER/157.1 IP), 118 strikeouts and a 1.13 WHIP in the 24 outings (18 QS).
- By comparison, made 23 starts of 6.0-plus IP over his first 43 outings with the White Sox from 6/8/16-9/25/17.

HOMER HAPPY

- The White Sox have hit 91 home runs since 7/2, the fourth-highest total in the American League and seventh-most in MLB.
- The Sox feature six players with 17-plus home runs this season, tied for the second-most in MLB behind the Dodgers (eight).
- Chicago has hit 97 homers on the road and is on pace for 103 in 2018, which would be its most since 1996 (119).

WHITE SOX VS. CLEVELAND

- Cleveland leads the season series, 12-3 ... Chicago is 0-8 at Progressive Field and 3-4 at Guaranteed Rate Field, and has been outscored, 82-41, in the season series.
- The White Sox are batting .189/.244/.334 with 15 home runs, and own a 5.02 ERA (71 ER/127.1 IP) with five quality starts.
- The Sox have lost eight of the last nine games overall, and nine straight and 11 of 12 at Progressive Field ... they are 5-21 in their last 26 games vs. the Indians dating back to 6/11/17.
- Chicago has lost five of the last six season series dating back to 2013 (10-9 in 2015), going 38-72 during that span.
- The White Sox lead the all-time series, 1,083-1,072 ... they are 572-503 at home (115-115 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 511-569 on the road (96-111 at Progressive Field).

LACK OF CENTRAL COMMAND

- Chicago is 28-40 against the American League Central in 2018, going 13-21 at Guaranteed Rate Field and 14-20 on the road.
- The Sox will record a losing record vs. the AL Central for the sixth consecutive season.
- The Sox have lost six of the last seven but won 11 of 20.
- Chicago is 4-4 in the last eight games and 7-5 in the last 12 on the road vs. the division.
- The White Sox are 318-418 vs. the AL Central since 2009, posting a losing record every season except 2012 (37-36).

POWER AND SPEED

- Tim Anderson (19 HR/26 SB) is one of five players in the major leagues with at least 19 home runs and 26 stolen bases this season, joining Boston's Mookie Betts, Pittsburgh's Starling Marte, Cleveland's José Ramírez and Colorado's Trevor Story.
- Anderson needs one homer to become the first White Sox SS to record a 20-HR/20-SB season ... he is one homer and four steals shy of joining Alex Ríos (2010) and Tommie Agee (1966) as the only Sox to post 20 homers and 30 steals in one season.

GRAB SOME BENCH

- The Sox have struck out 14-plus times in their last three games, tied for the longest streak in history ... Colorado (2015), Baltimore and Toronto (both 2016) also accomplished the feat.
- Chicago has struck out 1,473 times in 2018, the most in MLB and the most in a single season in franchise history.
- Yoán Moncada leads MLB with 205 strikeouts ... he is 17 shy of tying Adam Dunn (222 in 2012) for the club record.

QUALITY AND QUANTITY

- The White Sox have made 1,385 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, the second-highest total in the major leagues behind the New York Mets (1,386), and 55 more than Oakland (1,330), the next-closest American League team.
- The Sox rank third in the AL with 70 quality starts in 2018 ... RHP James Shields is tied for seventh in the AL with 18.

MEDICAL UPDATES

- José Abreu has been released from a Cleveland hospital after undergoing treatment for a right thigh infection ... the infection is unrelated to his stint on the disabled list from 8/22-9/10.
- Abreu is day-to-day, and is expected to miss tonight's game.
- RHP Michael Kopech underwent successful Tommy John surgery on his right elbow on Tuesday in Los Angeles, Calif.
- Kopech is expected to make a full recovery in time to fully participate at spring training prior to the 2020 season.

- Jason Benetti and Steve Stone will call seven of the final 11 White Sox games in 2018 ... please note the following changes:
 - ◆ 9/20 at Cleveland: Stone and Paciorek ... Benetti will miss the broadcast due to ESPN college football play-by-play duties on 9/21.
 - ◆ 9/21-23 vs. Cubs: Ken "Hawk" Harrelson and Stone ... Harrelson will call the final three games of his illustrious and iconic career.

ON DECK: VS. CHICAGO CUBS

- The White Sox open their final homestand with three games vs. the Cubs ... Reynaldo López (6-9, 4.05) faces former Sox All-Star José Quintana (13-10, 3.95) in tomorrow's opener.
- The Cubs won two of three from 5/11-13 at Wrigley Field, outscoring the White Sox by a 22-11 margin.
- The Sox have lost five of the last six and seven of nine in the series ... they are 5-9 in the last 14 at Guaranteed Rate Field.

SHIELDS AT A GLANCE

- Is scheduled to make his 33rd appearance (32nd start), 13th start on the road and third vs. the Cleveland Indians ... is looking to record his third win on the road, compared to five at home.
Tonight marks the 404th start of his career, one behind Camilo Pascual for 130th place in MLB history.

LAST START

- Recorded his second win on the road and seventh this season on 9/14 at Baltimore after allowing two runs on four hits with one walk and five strikeouts over 6.0 IP.
Marked his first road win since Opening Day (3/29) at Kansas City.

BITTEN BY THE BIG INNING

- Has allowed 30 of his 97 earned runs (30.9 percent) over the span of eight individual innings (7.0 IP) in eight starts in 2018 ... his season ERA would be 3.13 (61 ER/175.1 IP) without the below eight innings.

LOW AND SLOW

- Opponents are hitting just .238 (146-613) since 5/1, tied for the 10th-lowest mark in the American League (minimum 500 128.2 IP)... his .173 opponents average in May was the fourth-lowest in the AL.
Is limiting opponents to the following averages: .228 (84-369) at night, .209 (76-363) vs. left-handers, .216 (101-467) with nobody on base and .233 average (99-424) at Guaranteed Rate Field.

A TALE OF TWO STRETCHES

- Owns a 10-20 record in 42 appearances (41 starts) since 8/5/17 despite recording a 4.48 ERA (139 ER/253.0 IP), .241 opp. average and 23 quality starts ... has allowed three earned runs or less 29 times.
By comparison, went 6-15 with a 6.58 ERA (125 ER/171.0 IP), .290 opponents average and 46 home runs allowed in his first 33 starts with the White Sox ... made his Sox debut on 6/8/16 vs. Washington.

MISSING THE COMFORTS OF HOME

- Is 2-8 with a 5.67 ERA (53 ER/79.1 IP), .261 opp. average, 1.40 WHIP and 19 home runs allowed in 14 road appearances (13 starts) this season ... snapped a 12 game (11 start) winless streak in his last road start on 9/14 at Baltimore (2 ER/6.0 IP) ... five of his seven wins this season have come at home.
Owns a 6.04 ERA (36 ER/53.2 IP), 1.51 WHIP and 16 home runs allowed during over his last nine road starts ... has received a 4.99 run support average (44 RS) in 14 games (13 starts) on the road this season ... White Sox have scored three runs or less in eight of the 13 starts.

NOT DIGGING THE LONG BALL

- Has surrendered 31 home runs this season, including 24 in his last 19 starts ... allowed three homers in each outing on 6/2 vs. Milwaukee and 6/7 at Minnesota after going 14 consecutive appearances without allowing multiple homers from 9/20/17-5/27/18, the second-longest stretch of his career.
Has allowed 98 homers since 2016 and 131 since 2015 ... the 131 home runs allowed since 2015 are the most in MLB, and his 1.70 homers-per-9.0 IP mark since 2015 (693.2 IP) is the second-highest.

VS. CLEVELAND INDIANS

- Is 5-8 with a 3.79 ERA (57 ER/135.1 IP), 135 strikeouts, 1.25 WHIP, .253 opponents average and 13 quality starts over 22 career outings.
Has gone 1-3 with a 4.59 mark (17 ER/33.1 IP), 27 strikeouts and a .230 opponents average in his last six starts since 2016 ... has received two runs or less of support in five of the six outings.
Is 3-3 with a 4.47 mark (29 ER/58.1 IP) and .266 opp. average (63-237) in 10 career starts at Progressive Field (five quality).
Suffered the loss in his last start on 8/11 at Guaranteed Rate Field (2 ER/7.0 IP) ... is looking for his first win at Progressive Field since 4/22/14 with Kansas City (1 ER/6.0 IP).

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTER

- RHP Reynaldo López (6-9, 4.05) is scheduled to make his 31st start of the season, 16th on the road and first vs. the Cubs.
Is 2-1 with a 3.88 ERA (25 ER/58.0 IP), .220 opponents average, 1.16 WHIP, 10 home runs allowed and a 2.17 RSA (14 RS) in his last 10 starts, receiving 10 no decisions during that span.
Recorded the win in his last start on 9/15 at Baltimore, tossing 7.0 scoreless IP with six strikeouts.
Is 1-1 with a 4.91 ERA (8 ER/14.2 IP), .228 opponents average, 1.30 WHIP and 12 strikeouts in three career starts vs. the National League Central division ... suffered the loss in his last start on 5/15 at Pittsburgh, allowing six runs on seven hits over a season-low 2.0 IP.
