FRIDAY NIGHT LIGHTS: The Padres toppled the Los Angeles Dodgers 5-3 last night to claim the 1st of the 3-game series in Chavez Ravine...starter **Eric Lauer** received the win (now 6-7), tossing 5.0 innings and allowing just 1 run (earned) on 4 hits on 2 walks and 5 strikeouts...after going 4-for-7 with RISP on Wednesday vs. SF, the Padres went just 1-for-11 in such situations, though home runs by **Hunter Renfroe** and **Freddy Galvis** propelled the Friars to their 2nd win @ Dodger Stadium this season...relievers **José Castillo**, **Matt Strahm**, **Robert Stock** and **Craig Stammen** each recorded a hold, and **Kirby Yates** worked a 1.1 inning save (his 10th of the season).

NIX AND MATCH: RHP **Jacob Nix** toes the rubber tonight for his 8th start of the season and his 1st against the Los Angeles Dodgers...the Padres have won the last 2 starts Nix has made and 3 of his last 4...Jacob has relied on 4 pitches this season: four-seamer (62.5%), curve (21%), changeup (13%) and slider (3.5%)...his 6.4 bb % is the lowest among Padre rookie starters this season (lowest by an SD rookie starter since **Luis Perdomo's** 5.9 bb % in 2016).

VS. LAD: The Friars win last night snapped a 5-game losing streak opposite LAD, and it was the first time the Padres had won the 1st game of a series against the Dodgers since August 11, 2017 @ Dodger Stadium...**Eric Lauer** was credited with the win in each of the Padres last 2 victories over the Dodgers and 3 of their last 4.

THE YOUNG AND THE RESTLESS: Padres rookies have combined to strike out 564 batters this season, the most of any rookies in the National League (behind TB's 595 for the most in the majors)...opposing batters have a 83.9 contact percentage on pitches that are inside the strike zone, which is tied with Dodgers rookie pitchers for the 5th-lowest contact percentage in the strike zone of any team.

HE'S NO FRAN OF THE DODGERS: **Franmil Reyes** is riding a career-high 12-game hitting streak since Sept. 7 @ CIN (.405, 17-for-42), and it also marks the longest hitting streak by a Padre since 2016 (in which **Yangervis Solarte** had a 14-game stretch from Sept. 6-29, 2016)...Reyes has a hit in 22 of his last 23 games since August 25, and his .387 clip in that time leads NL.

HE'S STEADY, HE'S READY, HE'S FREDDY: In the past week since Sept. 15, **Freddy Galvis** has tied with WSH's **Anthony Rendon** for the ML-lead in average, going 12-for-24 (.500) with 4 2b and 2 hr for a 1.437 OPS (.520 OBP + .917 SLG)...he's hit in a season-high-tying 6 consecutive games (.500), and he's also riding a 5-game extra-base hit streak, which is now the longest of his career...with his homer last night, Galvis joined **Khalil Greene** as the only two Padres shortstops to hit 13-or-more HR in a single season...Greene had 4 such campaigns with SD, topping at 27 HR in 2007 (also was the last season in which an SD shortstop hit 13-or-more HR).

KEEP YOUR EYE OUT: The Dodgers have stolen 3rd base 18 times this year, the 3rd-most of any NL club...they've accrued a Major League-leading 182 "bases taken," which are bases advanced on fly balls, passed balls, wild pitches, balks and defensive indifference.

HIT THEM FAR, HIT THEM OFTEN: Last night, **Hunter Renfroe** and **Freddy Galvis** homered for the Padres 43rd multi-homer game of the season...Galvis' shot in the 7th inning marked the 1,500th multi-home run game in Padres history.

THIS DATE IN PADRE HISTORY: On Sept. 22, 1996, the Padres defeated the Dodgers 3-2 behind a 2-run homer by CF **Steve Finley** to gain a split of a four-game series that drew a 4-game series record of 197,225 fans to Mission Valley.

- Became the first Padre to toss 6.0-or-more scoreless innings in his debut since **Odrisamer Despaigne** on June 23, 2014 @ SF (7.0 innings).

TEXAS LEAGUE GRADUATE: Has spent the bulwark of this season with San Antonio (AA), going 2-3 with a 2.05 ERA (12 ER, 52.2 IP) with 41 strikeouts against nine walks across his nine outings (all starts).

- Allowed three earned runs or less in all nine of his Double-A outings, including two earned runs or less in seven outings and one or less in six...also ranked second in the Texas League in ERA (2.05) and fifth in opponent average (.211), minimum nine games started.

QUICK STINT: Promoted to El Paso on August 4 vs. Round Rock, tossing 6.0-shutout IP of five-hit ball, striking out three and walking none...he lowered his ERA to 1.84 on the season across his 10 combined starts...the only time his ERA sat above 2.00 was prior to his final Double-A start, when it was 2.05.

A TASTE OF THE POSTSEASON: Made one start during the 2017 postseason for both San Antonio (AA) and El Paso (AAA)...made his first career postseason start and tossed 7.0 IP of three-run ball (two earned) in the Missions' 4-1 loss on Sept. 10 vs. Midland in Game 5 of the Texas League semifinals...was promoted to El Paso on Sept. 16 vs. Memphis and started Game 4 of the PCL championship series that same day, earning the win to force Game 5 behind 6.2 IP of one-run ball in El Paso's 5-1 victory.

YOU'RE ABOUT TO BE NIXED: 22-year-old RHP **Jacob Nix** is set to make his eighth career start and first against the Los Angeles Dodgers tonight.

LAST TIME OUT: In his last start on 9/16 vs. TEX, he tossed his third career quality start (6.0 IP, 7 H, 3 ER)...in his two starts vs. AL opponents, he is 1-0 with a 2.51 ERA (4 ER, 14.1 IP)...has not factored into the decision in both of his last two starts after going 2-3 through his first five outings.

THE TALE OF THE TAPE: In the first inning, he's surrendered a .367 (11-for-30 average)...in innings 2-4, he's limited the opposition to a .203 clip (13-for-64)...the third time through the lineup, opposing hitters are hitting .333 (11-for-33).

STATCASTED: Has relied on four pitches: four seamer (62.5%), curve (21%), changeup (13%) and slider (3.5%). his fastball averages at 92.9 mph, and opposing bats are hitting just .182 against his changeup.

BE SUPPORTIVE: Nix has received three runs of support or more on just two occasions (9/2 vs. COL and 9/9 at CIN)...among all ML rookies who have made at least seven starts, his 15 total runs of support are the third-fewest and his 3.75 run support average (runs scored while he's in the game) is the eighth-lowest.

SPLIT IT UP: In his seven starts, lefties are hitting .304 (24-for-79) and righties are hitting .270 (17-for-63).

PUT THE NAIL IN THE COFFIN: When Nix has two strikes on a batter, opposing hitters have a .203 clip (ML average in such scenarios is .173).

GET THE FIRST GUY: When facing the first batter of an inning, opposing batters are hitting .263 (10-for-38) with three doubles, a home run and eight strikeouts.

A LITTLE SOMETHING WE CALL EFFICIENCY: On Aug. 28 vs. SEA, Nix tossed 8.1 IP of one-run ball on eight hits with no strikeouts and no walks, tossing just 79 pitches.

- He became the second Padres pitcher in club history to work 8.1-or-more innings and not fan a single batter or allow a walk (first being **Randy Jones** on May 30, 1976 when he worked 10.0 innings in a complete game win vs. SF).
- Became the sixth pitcher since 2000 to work at least 8.0 innings without recording a strikeout or a walk (also: Porcello, Lohse, Hunter, Verlander and Pineiro).

HAVE A DEBUT: Nix had his contract selected from El Paso (AAA) on August 10 vs. PHI, becoming the 13th Padre to make their ML Debut this season and the fifth to do so as a starting pitcher.

TOMORROW'S STARTER — #37 LHP Joey Lucchesi (8-8, 3.74) — joeyfuego23

LET'S GET FUEGO: LHP **Joey Lucchesi** is set to make the 25th start of his career and third this season against the Dodgers... is 0-2 with a 5.00 ERA(5 ER, 9.0 IP) in his previous two outings.

- His last time out on 9.18 vs. SF, he tossed 5.0 IP of three-run ball on seven hits and one walk while striking out eight in the Padres' 5-4 loss, but did not factor into the decision.
- Along with LHP **Eric Lauer** this season, is one of just 20 rookies to have reached the 20-start plateau in Padres franchise history...prior to **Dinelson Lamet** (2017) and **Luis Perdomo** (2016), the most recent Friar rookie arm to do so was Justin Germano in 2007.

- Has allowed just one earned run in 13 games and 13.1 IP vs. the NL West (0.68 ERA), while he has yet to allow a run in 2.0 IP vs. LAD.
- Tuesday, struck out each of the three batters he faced, the fourth time this season he struck out each batter faced in at least 1.0 IP.
- Opponents are hitting just .161 (20-for-124) against him this season and .207 (6-for-29) with RISP.
- This season, he's relied on two primary pitches: four seamer (54.9%) and slider (44.7%).

last outing: 9/15 vs. TEX (1.0 ip, h, so) **vs. LHB:** .200 (5-25) • **vs. RHB:** .313 (10-32)
season-high ip: 2.0 (5x, last: 9/2 vs. COL) **current scoreless streak:** 1.0 IP (1 g)

- Has tossed 2.0 innings in five of his eight outings this year and has recorded three-or-more strikeouts in six of his eight games.
- Opponents are hitting .100 (1-for-10) with RISP/2 out.
- This year, he's relied on five pitches: four-seamer (52.8%), changeup (24%), sinker (2.4%) and slider (20.9%).

- Owns a 3.29 ERA (5 ER, 13.2 IP) in 10 games on the road this season...Dodgers hitters are just 1-for-12 (.083) against him at Dodger Stadium.
- Posted a 1-1 record and a 3.76 ERA in 24 games for El Paso this season.
- His average pitch velocity of 77.5 mph is the second-slowest among major league pitchers (min. 200 pitches).
- This year, he's relied on five pitches: four seamer (65.3%), slider (18.4%), sinker (10.7%), curve (3.5%) and changeup (2.2%).

#88 Phil Maton • RHP **0-2, 4.17 ERA, 0 SV, 1 SVO, 43 APP.**

last outing: 9/19 vs. SF (1.0 ip, bb) **vs. LHB:** .247 (21-85) • **vs. RHB:** .283 (26-92)
season-high ip: 2.2 (2x, 4/11 at COL) **current scoreless streak:** 1.0 IP (1 g)

- Has gone 1-1 in 14 career September outings with a 3.21 ERA (5 ER, 14.0 IP).
- Owns a 10.32 SO/9 and a 62.3 first-pitch strike percentage...has tallied a career high 45.1 IP, just passing his 43.0 IP in 2017.
- This year, has relied on two primary pitches this season: four seamer (62.8%) and slider (37.2%)...leads the Padres with an average spin rate of 2630 RPM (min. 200 pitches thrown).

#61 Luis Perdomo • RHP **1-6, 7.75 ERA, 0 SV, 0 SVO, 10 APP.**

last outing: 9/8 at CIN (1.0 ip, bb, so) **vs. LHB:** .361 (35-97) • **vs. RHB:** .321 (25-78)

- Is 1-1 in five games (four starts) on the road this season with a 2.70 ERA (6 ER, 20.0 IP) and 15 strikeouts.
- Tossed 5.0 innings-or-more in four of his nine starts this season...with RISP/2 out, opponents are hitting just .167 (3-for-18).
- Has relied on five pitches this season: Sinker (45.1%), Slider (26%), Four Seamer (17.1%), Split Finger (11.7%), Curve (0.1%).
