RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals are 37-23 post All-Star Break and 38-23 under manager **Mike Shildt** since he took the post on July 15. The Cardinals have the most wins in the N.L. since the All-Star Break (37), while St. Louis .617 winning percentage ranks 4th in MLB over that period. Entering July 15, the Cardinals had T9th-most wins in the NL (47) and currently have the T4th-most wins (85) in the NL.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals opened their final regular season home stand (SF-3, MIL-3) last night with a 5-3 win in the opening game of their three-game weekend series against the Giants...St. Louis enters play today as the N.L.'s 2nd Wild Card, 3.0 games back of Milwaukee and 1.5 games in front of Colorado...the Cardinals are currently in 3rd place in the NL Central, 4.5 games out of first place...the Cardinals have six games (MIL-3, CHI-3) remaining against teams ahead of them in the standings.

EARLY BIRDS: The Cardinals are playing their 56th day game of the season this afternoon, and currently have 60 day games on their schedule...this year is the just the 2nd time since 1985 that the Cardinals will have played 60 or more day games (61 in 2003)...St. Louis is 29-26 in natural lighting this season.

BATTERY MATES: **Adam Wainwright** and **Yadier Molina** have been a starting battery for 240 career games, the most in Cardinals history (they surpassed **Bob Gibson** & **Tim Lincecum**'s 198 on 6/15/16) and the most for any tandem since **Tom Glavine** and **Javy Lopez** had 248 games together for the Braves from 1994-2002 (*Elias*).

COMEBACK CARDS: The Cardinals plated a pair of runs in the 8th last night via a **Matt Adams** pinch-hit double, as they improved to 7-5 when tied after seven innings...the Redbirds have 9 wins when trailing after 7 innings, 2nd only to Washington (10) amongst N.L. teams.

FAN-TASTIC: The Cardinals have surpassed the 3 million mark in season attendance for the 15th-straight season (2004-18) and the 22nd time overall...the Cardinals, Dodgers & Yankees as the only MLB teams to have reached the 3 million mark in attendance this season.

SERIES STUFF: The Cardinals are 13-5 in series since the All-Star break.

TIE-BREAKERS: In the event of postseason tie-breakers, the Cardinals have won their season series with Los Angeles (4-3) & Colorado (5-2), lead their series with the Cubs (9-7) and are even with Milwaukee (8-8).

WINNING SEASONS: The Cardinals have posted their 11th consecutive winning season, something they'd done just once previously in franchise history, when they compiled 15 consecutive winning seasons from 1939-1953.

THE HUNT FOR A RED OCTOBER: Six of the Cardinals eight remaining games (MIL-3, at CHI-3) are against teams currently in contention for playoff positions...the SF Giants are the only remaining team on the Cardinals slate that is under .500...the Cardinals are home for five more (SF, MIL), then finish out the regular season next weekend at Wrigley Field.

BASH BROTHERS: **Yadier Molina** belted his 144th career HR on Mon. at Atlanta to tie his older brother **Bengie** for the family lead...**José Molina** had 39 career round-trippers...**Yadier's** 18 HR's this season match his total from 2017 and are four shy of his career high 22 in 2012.

POWER PLAY: St. Louis has homered in 111 of 154 games this season, going 75-36 (.676 win pct.) in those games (10-33 when not homering)...their 75 wins lead the NL & rank 5th in MLB (Yankees, 1st-84)...St. Louis' 199 HR's are 3rd in NL behind the Dodgers (219) & Brewers (203)...**HOMERS AWAY FROM HOME:** St. Louis is an NL-best 41-20 (.672) when homering on the road, and trails only Oakland (123) in road homers (122) among all Major League teams.

Willie McGee played four seasons (1991-95) with the Giants...was born in San Francisco...graduated from Harry Ells High School in Richmond, Calif...played college baseball at Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Hill, Calif...resides in Hercules, Calif...worked as an assistant coach for Contra Costa College in San Pablo, Calif. **Harrison Bader** hit his first MLB home run on Sept. 1, 2017 at San Francisco, a two-run blast off **Johnny Cueto**.

Tyson Ross was born in Berkeley, Calif...graduated from Bishop O'Dowd High School in Oakland in 2005...attended the University of California (2006-08), earning All-Pac-10 honors in 2007-08...left Cal ranked third on the Bears' career strikeout list (271)...resides in Oakland, Calif.

Bud Norris was born in Greenbrae, Calif...graduated from San Marin High School in Novato, Calif...played college baseball at Cal Poly, San Luis Obispo.

Adam Wainwright homered on the first pitch of his first career at-bat (May 24, 2006) at AT&T Park, a solo homer off **Noah Lowry**.

Jack Flaherty made his MLB debut (Sept. 1, 2017) at San Francisco...became the 15th youngest Cardinal to make MLB debut in a start at 21 years and 321 days old.

Giants catcher/infielder **Aramis Garcia** was originally selected by the Cardinals in the 20th round of the 2011 MLB Draft out of Pembroke Pines (Fla.) High School, but did not sign.

Giants pitcher **Pierce Johnson** pitched three seasons at Missouri State University (2010-12).

Giants VP of Player Development **David Bell** previously served as a Cardinals assistant hitting coach (2014) and bench coach (2015-17)...played parts of four seasons with St. Louis (1995-98)...traded by Cleveland with catcher **Pepe McNeal** and pitcher **Rick Heiser** to the Cardinals for pitcher **Ken Hill** (July 27, 1995).

Giants Coach & Video Replay Analyst **Shawon Dunston** played parts of two seasons with St. Louis (1999-2000)...signed with the Cardinals as a free agent twice, sandwiched around being traded by St. Louis to the Mets for utilityman **Craig Paquette** (July 31, 1999).

Cardinals Hall of Famer and Giants Outfielder & Baserunning Coordinator **Vince Coleman** played six seasons with St. Louis (1985-90)...was a two-time NL All-Star (1988-89) and the 1985 Rookie of the Year...led the NL in stolen bases in all six seasons...selected by St. Louis in the 10th round of the 1982 MLB Draft.

Giants Community Ambassador and Hall of Famer **Orlando Cepeda** played parts of three seasons with St. Louis (1966-68)...in 1967 with St. Louis, started at first base for the NL in the All-Star Game, recognized as the NL MVP and won the World Series...later traded by the Cardinals to Atlanta for catcher/infielder **Joe Torre** (March 17, 1969).

Giants Special Assistant **Will Clark** played part of his final professional season with St. Louis in 2000...slashed .345/.441/.621 in eight Postseason games with St. Louis...became a Cardinal via trade with Baltimore with cash in exchange for infielder **José León** (July 31, 2000).

Arizona Giants #1 Pitching Coach **Lee Smith** pitched for the Cardinals for parts of four seasons (1990-93)...was two-time NL All-Star (1991-92)...became all-time career saves leader with St. Louis (April 13, 1993)...became a Cardinal via trade with the Red Sox for outfielder **Tom Brunansky** (May 4, 1990)...later traded to the Yankees for pitcher **Rich Batchelor** (August 31, 1993).

Cardinals broadcaster **Bengie Molina** played parts of four seasons with the Giants (2007-10).

TODAY'S GAME

- Makes his 7th start of the season (284th career start) and his 351st career appearance.
- He and Yadier Molina have been a starting battery for 240 career games, the most in Cardinals history (surpassed Bob Gibson & Tim Lincecum's 198 on 6/15/16) and the most for any tandem since Tom Glavine and Javy Lopez had 248 games together for the Braves from 1994-2002 (*Elias*).
- Owns the most career wins at Busch Stadium III at 79 and has 3rd-lowest ERA at 2.86 (min. 200 IP). A win today would pass LHP Bill Sherdel (1918-30, '32) for 4th-most all-time at home in Cardinals history.
- Since 2016, St. Louis sports a 40-22 record in his starts.
- His 8.0 active scoreless streak is a season-high and currently T12th-longest in the NL.
- Has appeared in 176 career games home and 174 on the road.
- Has missed a total of 129 games this season with three stints on the DL: left hamstring strain (3/26-4/4) and right elbow inflammation (4/20-5/12 and 5/14-9/9).

LAST TIME OUT

- Struck out season-high nine batters over 6.0 scoreless frames in 5-0 win over the Dodgers last Sunday (9/16) on ESPN Sunday Night Baseball.
- Has pitched 6.0 or more innings in 12 straight starts vs. the Dodgers (8/10/07-present), currently T3rd longest active vs. LAD and trailing Curt Schilling (19) and David Cone (16).
- Became the first pitcher to throw 1,000 career innings at Busch Stadium III, and the 5th Cardinal to throw 1,000 innings at home stadiums, joining Bill Sherdel (1,087.1 at Sportsman's Park), Jesse Haines (1,554.0 at Sportsman's Park), Bob Gibson (1,182.0 at Busch Stadium II) and Bob Forsch (1,402.1 at Busch Stadium II).

- Activated from the 60-day disabled list (right elbow inflammation) on 9/10 vs. PIT and made his first start for St. Louis in 121 days. Allowed four runs in 5.0 frames in the Cardinals' comeback 8-7 win.
- Surpassed Todd Worrell (1985-89, '92) with his 349th career game on 9/10, moving into 8th all-time in Cardinals history.
- Struck out Corey Dickerson (swinging) on 9/10 for his 1,600th career strikeout.
- Made his six rehab appearances across three levels (8/13-9/1) while recovering from right elbow inflammation. Scattered 12 hits with 23 strikeouts over 17.0 scoreless IP.
- Also missed 18 games with right elbow inflammation (4/20-5/12).
- Earned his only win of the season in a 5-3 victory at CHI (4/17) at Wrigley Field, allowing 1 UER with 5 strikeouts in 5.0 IP. Temperature at first pitch was 35°.
- Marked his 15th career win vs. the Cubs (T10th all-time in Cardinals history) and his 11th career win at Wrigley Field (3rd all-time in Cardinals history).
- Reached 1907.1 career innings in 4/17 start, passing Slim Sallee (1905.1) for 6th-most all-time in franchise history.
- Passed 1,900 innings pitched for career in his 4/11 start vs. MIL, becoming the 15th active pitcher to do so.
- Made his 5th career home opening start on 4/5 and took the loss against Arizona, tossing 3.2 innings, his second shortest home Opening Day start (2012, CHI).

CAREER

- Ranks 6th among Cardinals pitchers in franchise history in ERA (3.30), innings pitched (1,920.2) and win pct. (.638), while his 1,610 strikeouts trail only Bob Gibson (3,117).
- His 3.30 career ERA ranks 5th among active pitchers to Clayton Kershaw (2.37), Madison Bumgarner (3.03), Max Scherzer (3.22), and David Price (3.25).
- Among active MLB pitchers, ranks 6th in winning percentage (.638), 11th in wins (148), 17th in strikeouts (1,610), 7th in complete games (22) and 6th in shutouts (10).
- His 69 career road wins rank 5th all-time in franchise history (one shy of Bob Forsch)

- Makes his 16th career appearance and 14th start against the Giants.
- Allowed only 3 HR over 94.1 career innings vs. the Giants (0.29 HR/9 IP).
- Is lifetime 36-22 in 75 games (60 starts) against the NL West. His 36 wins rank 1st all-time among all active pitchers who have never pitched for an NL West team.
- Earned the win May 24, 2006 at SF and homered on the first pitch of his first career at-bat, joining Hoyt Wilhelm (NY Giants, 1952) and John Montefusco (SF Giants, 1974) as only relievers to hit their first home run and gain win in the same game.
- Two of his 22 career complete games have been against SF: July 1, 2009 in a 2-1 win in which he struck out 12 and June 1, 2013 in a 7-1 win when he fanned 10.
- Has faced the Giants three times in the Postseason: 1-1 with a 2.41 ERA in 3 starts.

- Won his first Louisville Silver Slugger award following 2017 season...led NL pitchers with a .262 average with 11 hits, 11 RBI (T1st) and two home runs.
- Leads active MLB pitchers in career hits (127), RBI (68), doubles (34), and extra-base hits (46), is 4th in homers (10), T4th in triples (2), 9th in sacrifice hits (53), T2nd in BA (.201), 5th in on-base pct. (.227) and slugging (.309) (*min. 200 AB*).
- Has driven in at least two runs in 15 career starts (St. Louis is 15-0), most among active pitchers (Madison Bumgarner is second with 13). Eight starts have come since the beginning of the 2016 season. The last pitcher with at least eight starts of this type over a two-season span was Bob Gibson in 1970-71 (St. Louis 8-0) (*Elias*).
- Is the only active MLB pitcher with multiple 10-plus RBI seasons (2016 & 2017).
- Collected 29 RBI over the 2016-17 seasons, including 27 in games in which he was pitching...RBI total marks the most by a pitcher over two consecutive seasons since Steve Carlton had 28 for the Phillies in 1977 and 1978, and the most by a Cardinals pitcher since Bob Gibson had 29 in 1970 and 1971 (*Elias*).
