### GREETINGS FROM GOODYEAR

» The Cleveland Indians return to the Goodyear Development Complex for their 10th year of Spring Training in the Cactus League...after 16 seasons in Winter Haven, Florida from 1993-2008, the Tribe became the 14th organization to make its Spring Training home in Arizona beginning in 2009, while the Cincinnati Reds made it an even 15-15 split of teams between the Cactus and Grapefruit circuits after joining the Indians here in Goodyear for the 2010 campaign.  
» Cleveland is 145-138-24 (.512) all-time in the Cactus League.

### TODAY'S MATCHUP AT MILWAUKEE

» The Indians will square off with the Milwaukee Brewers this afternoon for the second of three spring contests between the clubs...the series wraps up on March 11, when the split-squad Tribe will host Milwaukee in Goodyear.  
» Milwaukee won the first game between the clubs this year on February 26 by a final score of 7-6...with the result the Tribe has lost seven of their last eight games overall vs. Milwaukee...the Indians own a 7-16 (.304) record in 23 all-time Cactus League matchups against the Brewers  
» The Indians and Brewers are scheduled to meet in the regular season for the first time since 2015 as the clubs will play a pair of two-game sets in 2018...the Tribe will travel to Miller Park May 8 & 9 and host Milwaukee at Progressive Field June 5 & 6...the Indians went 3-1 across their four games vs. Milwaukee in 2015, and own an all-time regular-season record of 204-206 (.498) against their former divisional rivals.

### ATHLETIC TRAINER'S TABLE

» **RHP CODY ANDERSON** (March 27 UCL reconstruction) threw a 25-pitch bullpen session on Saturday, as he continues his rehabilitation.  
» **OF MICHAEL BRANTLEY** (Oct. 18 right ankle surgery) is unrestricted offensively, as he has been a full participant in BP and cage-work; continues to progress toward full baseball activity, and began working on defensive lateral movements on Friday...he took Saturday off and will resume activity today.  
» **OF BRANDON GUYER** (Oct. 11 extensor tendon surgery) re-aggravated his left wrist injury; received an MRI on Feb. 22 and began his return to baseball activities on Tuesday...he continues to progress and hit off a tee on consecutive days Friday & Saturday, and has an off day today.  
» **RHP DANNY SALAZAR** (right shoulder inflammation) remains a few weeks behind in his throwing program; he has progressed to throwing 90 feet.

### YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians had their five-game winning streak snapped in a 13-4 loss to the split-squad San Francisco Giants in Goodyear yesterday afternoon.  
» Two of the Tribe's three hits in the game were home runs...Cleveland's defense also committed four errors.  
» **INF GIOVANNY URSHELA** got the Tribe on the board with a solo shot in the third inning, his first homer of Spring Training.  
» **DH EDWIN ENCARNACION** also hit his first long ball of the year, launching a two-run blast to dead center in the sixth inning, scoring **C ERIC HAASE**.  
» **OF ROB REFSNYDER** drove in the Indians' other run of the afternoon on a sacrifice fly in the fourth, scoring Encarnacion.  
» **1B YONDER ALONSO** notched Cleveland's other hit, a single in the fourth.  
» In his second spring start, **RHP JOSH TOMLIN** (2.0IP, 6H, 5R/ER, 1BB, 4K) was saddled with the loss.  
» Four Cleveland pitchers posted scoreless outings, including **RHP DAN OTERO** (1.0IP, 1H, 2K), **RHP MATT BELISLE** (1.0IP, 1H), **RHP CAMERON HILL** (2.0IP, 1H, 2K) and **RHP ALEXI OGANDO** (1.0IP, 2H, 2K).

### ROSTER BREAKDOWN

» The Indians currently have a total of 64 players in Major League camp; this includes 24 non-roster invitees in addition to players on the 40-man roster.  
» The club has 31 pitchers, including 24 right-handers (11 non-roster) and 7 lefties (3 non-roster), 6 catchers (2 non-roster), 17 infielders (5 non-roster) and 10 outfielders (3 non-roster).

**MEDIA INFORMATION:** The Press Room at the Goodyear Complex opens at 7:30AM on game days...The Indians clubhouse is open to members of the media with proper credentials for roughly 50 minutes prior to morning workouts and again from 11:15AM-Noon on game days...The clubhouse may close at certain times for team meetings, etc...For all games played at Goodyear Ballpark, a shuttle is available from the Indians Player Development Complex to Goodyear Ballpark beginning at NOON and will run for approximately 30 minutes after the final out...Goodyear Ballpark media dining room is located behind the press box and serves lunch for \$7 on game days...While the game is in progress, upon request, players that have been removed from the game can be made available near the Indians clubhouse located in the RF corner after exiting the game...Indians Manager Terry Francona will be available every morning around 9:10AM (subject to change) in the Press Room.

### ON THE MOUND: COREY KLUBER

» Reigning American League Cy Young winner **RHP COREY KLUBER** is due to make his second start of Spring Training this afternoon in Maryvale against the Milwaukee Brewers...Kluber held Oakland to one run over 2.0IP in his spring debut on February 27, striking out three.

» Kluber has made two career starts against Milwaukee in Spring Training, on March 6 & 28, 2017, posting a 0-1 record and 13.50 ERA (7.1IP, 14H, 11R/ER, 3HR, 4BB, 10K) in those starts...he has never faced the Brewers in the regular season.

» Kluber's 2017 season was one of the most dominant campaigns in club history, as he led MLB in ERA, won three American League Pitcher of the Month honors and started the All-Star Game for the A.L. en route to his second career Cy Young Award...overall on the season, Kluber went 18-4 with a 2.25 ERA and 265 strikeouts, sharing the A.L. lead in wins, complete games (5) and shutouts (3).  
» After spending the month of May on the Disabled List with lower back soreness, Kluber went 15-2 with a 1.62 ERA in his final 23 starts of the season...recorded his 1,000th career strikeouts on June 14, in a start which began a club-record streak of five consecutive starts with 10-or-more strikeouts...also recorded eight-or-more strikeouts in 14 consecutive starts (June 1-August 13), marking the third-longest such streak in MLB history...became the third pitcher in franchise history (Bob Feller, Sam McDowell) to record 200 strikeouts in four consecutive seasons, and currently sits 7th on the all-time Indians leaderboard (1,201)...Kluber made two starts for Cleveland in the 2017 ALDS vs. New York-AL, going 0-1 with a 12.79 ERA (9ER/6.1IP).

### TRIBE ON TOP

» **INF JASON KIPNIS** continues to impress in early Cactus League action, tying for the MLB lead with four home runs in just 11 spring at-bats (four games)...his eight RBI rank T3rd in MLB and 2nd on the team...he is hitting .636 (7-11) in four games this spring.

» **INF RICHIE SHAFFER** holds the team lead with nine RBI (T4th in MLB), and three of his four hits have gone for at least three bases (1 3B, 2 HR).

» **RHP TREVOR BAUER** leads the team with seven strikeouts (T4th in the Cactus League) and has thrown a team-high 5.0 innings (tied with **RHP STEPHEN FIFE**, **RHP LOUIS HEAD** and **RHP CAMERON HILL**)...HILL also paces the Tribe with 5.0 scoreless innings.

» The Tribe as a team lead MLB in RBI (78) and on-base percentage (.388)...the club also ranks near the top of the offensive leaderboard in batting average (.2nd, .319), runs (2nd, 79), hits (2nd, 118), doubles (3rd, 25), triples (T2nd, 5), home runs (T2nd, 19), slugging percentage (3rd, .568) and OPS (2nd, .956)...not to be outdone, the Tribe pitching staff's 4.65 ERA ranks 3rd in the Cactus League, while their 87 strikeouts are 4th.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

**#28 - RHP COREY KLUBER:** Became first Indians pitcher to win multiple Cy Young awards, and the 19th multiple-winner in MLB history...led MLB with a 2.25 ERA (51ER/203.2IP)...ranked T1st in A.L. in wins (18), 1st in WHIP (0.869) and 2nd in strikeouts (265)...third pitcher in club history with four straight 200+ strikeout seasons... set a new Tribe record with 10+ strikeouts in five consecutive starts (June 14-July 4)... recorded 8+ strikeouts in 14 consecutive starts (June 1-August 13), marking the 3rd-longest single-season streak in MLB history...named to his second All-Star team.

**#34 - RHP ZACH McALLISTER:** Put together another strong season in the Tribe bullpen in 2017, ranking fourth on the team in relief innings (62.0) and finishing 15th in the A.L. in ERA as a reliever (2.61)...ranked 14th among A.L. relievers with 10 outings of at least 2.0IP...39 of his 50 outings were scoreless, and struck out 9.6 batters per 9.0IP, the second-highest mark of his career.

**#49 - LHP TYLER OLSON:** Did not allow a run in 30G with Cleveland in 2017, spanning 20.0 innings...tied Paul Assenmacher for longest scoreless appearance streak in Indians history; longest such streak in MLB last season...set MLB records for innings pitched & appearances in a scoreless season...began year in Triple-A; had two stints with the Tribe (July 21-24 & July 31-end)... in 34G in Triple-A, was 2-0 with a 3.21 ERA.
