**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 7-2 through nine games on their 10-game, 11-day roadtrip, going 3-1 at Chicago-AL, 2-0 at St. Louis and 2-1 at Los Angeles-AL...today they will play the four-game series finale against the Angels...following today's series finale, the Twins will travel home to begin a nine-game, 10-game homestand with one make-up game vs. Seattle (May 14), two vs. St. Louis (May 15-16), an off-day on May 17, three vs. Milwaukee (May 18-20) and three vs. Detroit (May 21-23)...the Twins have won seven of their last eight overall.

**A LATE NIGHT VICTORY:** The Twins beat the Angels last night by a score of 5-3 in 12 innings, making them 2-3 in extra innings this season...Kyle Gibson was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on three hits in 6.0 innings pitched...the bullpen combined for 6.0 innings of relief...the offense recorded 10 hits, two from both Joe Mauer and Eddie Rosario...Mitch Garver, Byron Buxton and Eduardo Escobar each doubled.

**TWINS AND ANGELS:** The Twins and Angels are playing the fourth of seven games this season...the Angels will travel to Minnesota for three from June 8-10...the Twins are 11-5 against the Angels since 2016, going 3-1 in those series...their most wins against any non-divisional opponent in that span...the Twins went 2-12 vs. the Angels from 2014-15.

**MAUER AND THE ANGELS:** Joe Mauer is hitting .337 (111-for-329) with 16 doubles, 11 home runs, 57 RBI, 40 walks and a .409 on-base percentage...below are Mauer's all-time best batting average ranks vs. American League opponents:

\*Mauer's .337 batting average ranks second all-time against the Angels (minimum of 250 plate appearances)...the top seven are: Jose Altuve (.349), Mauer (.337), Wade Boggs (.335), Cookie Rojas (.333), Paul Molitor (.333) Derek Jeter (.333) and Kirby Puckett (.331).

**INSIDE THE ROADTRIP:** The Twins have gone 7-2 on their current roadtrip...out-scoring opponents 51-32 and out-hitting them 82-67...Twins hitters have a .375 (24-for-64) average with runners in scoring position...Twins pitchers have posted a 3.27 ERA (82.2 IP, 30 ER) with 28 walks, 81 strikeouts and a .226 opponent batting average.

**TAKING OVER THE BIGS:** In two starts to begin his big league career, Fernando Romero has yet to allow a run, extending his scoreless innings streak to 11.2 innings...this is the second longest scoreless innings streak to start a career in Twins history since 1974, following only Andrew Albers (17.1 IP)...Romero has also recorded wins in his first two outings, one of two Twins over the last 30 years to win their first two career starts: Albers (2013) and Eric Milton (1998).

• No Twins rookie has ever won each of their first three career starts.

**TWINS WEEKLY MINOR LEAGUE HONORS:** The Twins have named Double-A infielder Nick Gordon and Triple-A Rochester right-handed pitcher Zack Littell Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week...in seven games this week, Gordon hit .400 (10-for-25) with four doubles, one home run, four RBI, four runs scored, four walks and a .484 on-base percentage...Gordon was selected fifth overall by the Twins in the 2014 First-Year Player Draft and is the son of former major league pitcher Tom Gordon and younger brother of Mariners outfielder Dee Gordon...Littell, who was just recently promoted from Double-A Chattanooga, started two games for the Red Wings this week, going 1-0 with one run allowed on four hits in 12.0 innings, six walks and 14 strikeouts...he was acquired by the Twins via trade with New York-AL on July 30, 2017 along with left-handed pitcher Dietrich Enns, in exchange for left-handed pitcher Jaime Garcia.

**MAY REHAB UPDATE:** Right-handed pitcher Trevor May threw 3+ innings in Ft. Myers yesterday...he threw 58 pitches, 30 strikes, allowed one hit, no runs, three walks and five strikeouts.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1989, Kirby Puckett tied a major league record with four doubles against the Toronto Blue Jays...he became the 35th player to hit four doubles in a game, the first since Toronto's Damaso Garcia in 1986...16 players have accomplished the feat since, the most recent to do so being David Peralta with Arizona on April 22, 2017 against Los Angeles-NL.

**STORMING ST LOUIS:** In his second big league start, Romero shutout St. Louis over 6.0 innings and earned his second career win...allowed only three hits and three runs while striking out nine...worked with a runner on base in all six innings, but faced only three batters in the sixth inning after inducing a ground ball double play...struck out Paul DeJong to end his outing with nine strikeouts, third most by a Twins starter in 2018.

**TAKING OVER THE BIGS:** In two starts to begin his big league career, Romero has yet to allow a run, extending his scoreless innings streak to 11.2 innings...this is the second longest scoreless innings streak to start a career in Twins history since 1974, following only Andrew Albers (17.1 IP)...Romero has also recorded wins in his first two outings, one of two Twins over the last 30 years to win their first two career starts: Albers (2013) and Eric Milton (1998).

- No Twins rookie has ever won each of their first three career starts.

**DOMINANT DEBUT:** Romero shutout the Blue Jays over 5.2 innings in his major league debut on May 2, allowing four hits and three walks with five strikeouts, earning his first win...Romero retired the first three batters of the game, striking out the first batter he faced (Curtis Granderson)...he retired the first two batters he faced in the sixth inning but walked Kevin Pillar on a full count, ending his day...one of two pitchers to hold their opponent scoreless in their ML debut in 2018 (Nick Kingham, PIT)...he became the first Twins pitcher to win in his debut since Felix Jorge on July 1, 2017 at Kansas City.

**JOIN THE CAROUSEL:** By making his first career start on May 2, Romero became the sixth different starting pitcher and the 19th different pitcher the Twins have used in 2018 (including outfielder Ryan LaMarre)...Twins starters are 8-9 while the staff owns a 4.96 ERA, 12th in the AL.

**ELITE ENTRANCES:** Romero was the 63rd player and 40th pitcher to make his big league debut in 2018...he is also the seventh player on MLB.com's top-100 prospect's list to make his debut in 2018...Romero is one of five players in the Twins organization listed on the top-100 prospect list (Royce Lewis, 20; Stephen Gonsalves, 77; Nick Gordon, 79; Wander Javier, 100).

**SEVENS UP:** Romero is the second player in club history to ever appear in uniform number 77, joining third baseman Tony Batista, who wore it for 50 games in 2006...33 players in baseball history have ever worn 77, including current players: Toronto's John Axford, San Diego's Buddy Bauman, Miami's Merandy Gonzalez and Detroit's Joe Jimenez.

- Optioned from Twins spring training to Double-A Chattanooga March 13 where he spent the entire season.
- Named Southern League Midseason All-Star.

**TOP PROSPECT:** Since being signed in 2011, Romero has been touted as one of the top prospects in the Twins system...*Baseball America* named him the Twins 12th ranked prospect in 2013 and has been rated as a top-30 prospect in the Twins organization since...entered 2018 as the number 66 prospect in all of baseball and the second best prospect in the Twins system according to MLB.com, while *Baseball America* rated him as the sixth best prospect in the Twins organization.

**IN THE MINORS:** Romero was signed as an undrafted free agent November 4, 2011...started 2018 in Triple-A Rochester, 0-1, 2.57 ERA (21.0 IP, 6 ER) in four games (3 starts)...after missing half of 2014 and all of 2015 recovering from elbow surgery, split 2016 between Low-A Cedar Rapids and High-A Ft. Myers...in six minor league seasons, 23-17, 2.83 ERA (324.1 IP, 102 ER) with 102 walks and 314 strikeouts.

## TOMORROW'S STARTER - JAKE ODORIZZI, RHP [SEASON- 3-2 3.83 ERA // CAREER- 43-40, 3.83 ERA]

In seven starts in 2018, Odorizzi is 3-2, 3.83 ERA (42.1 IP, 18 ER) with 20 walks and 38 strikeouts...in his last start against St. Louis on May 8, earned his third win of the year after allowing one run on two hits and two walks with three strikeouts over 5.0 innings...in six career starts against Seattle, has gone 1-3, 4.97 ERA (29.0 IP, 16 ER) with 17 walks and 31 strikeouts...Odorizzi is in his first season with Minnesota after spending 2012 with Kansas City and 2013-17 with Tampa Bay.
