The Mariners are 9-2 this season on Saturday's...the highest winning percentage on Saturday's this season, ranking ahead of Boston (8-2).

16-4

The Mariners are 16-4 over their last 20 games (5/18-current)...marks their best 20-game stretch since going 16-4 from May 28-June 13, 2003.

VS. TAMPA BAY

The Mariners and Rays meet for the 6th (5-0) of 7 games this season...Seattle swept a 3-game series vs. the Rays at Safeco Field, June 1-3...the Mariners are 14-3 in their last 17 games vs. the Rays, dating back to the start of the 2016 season:

TODAY'S TILT...the Mariners continue a 6-day, 6-game road trip covering over 5,600 miles with the third game of a 4-game series with Tampa Bay (2-0)...opened the road trip splitting a 2-game set with Houston (1-1)...the Mariners will return home to Seattle on June 11 to begin a 7-day, 7-game homestand that features 3 games vs. the Angels and 4 games vs. the Red Sox...today's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners have won 7 of their last 8 games, 11 of their last 14, 16 of their last 20 and 18 of their last 24...Seattle is 26-12 in its last 38 games, 31-15 over its last 46 games and 36-19 in its last 55 games...Seattle is 12-10 during the day and 29-12 at night...Seattle is 20-12 at Safeco Field, 20-11 on the road.

- **Extra, Extra!** - the Mariners are 6-0 in extra-inning games this season...tied with Texas (6-1) and Toronto (6-1) for the ML-lead in extra-inning wins.
- **Walk it Off** - the Mariners (5) are tied with the Yankees for 3rd-most walk-off wins in the ML, trailing only the Cardinals (7) and Braves (6)...each of the Mariners 5 walk-off wins has come during extra-innings.
- **Multi-Hit Madness** - **Jean Segura** leads the Major Leagues with 28 multi-hit games, ranking ahead of Nicholas Castellanos-DET (26) and Nick Markakis-ATL (26)...Segura leads the Majors with 12 games of 3+ hits, ahead of Nicholas Castellanos-DET (11).
- **Four Score** - Seattle is 28-8 when scoring 4-or-more runs, but 12-15 when scoring 3-or-fewer runs.
- **Scoreless** - **RH Chasen Bradford** has an active 8.2 scoreless innings streak over his last 8 games (5/17-c)...his scoreless streak is currently the T10th-longest active streak in the American League.
- **Series Stuff** - the Mariners have won or tied 16 of their first 19 series, posting a series record of 11-3-5.
- **It's a Dee Thing** - the Mariners are 10-1 when Dee Gordon starts at second base this season.
- **Ouch** - **Nelson Cruz** is tied for the Major League lead with C.J. Cron-TB with 10 HBP...his 10 HBP are the 2nd-most in his career, trailing only 12 HBP in 2017.

HOT START...Seattle is 40-23 (.629) through its first 63 games of the season, its 3rd-best record in club history, trailing only 2001 (49-14/.778) and 2003 (42-21/.677)...the Mariners currently have a +1.0 lead over the Astros in the American League West...prior to this season, the last time the Mariners led the AL West outright after May was at the end of play on Aug. 24, 2003.

HIGH WATER MARK...the Mariners are a season-high 17 games over .500 at 40-23...with a win tonight, Seattle would be 18 games over .500 for the first time since being 73-55 (.556) after game #128 of the 2007 season...marks the 7th season in club history to be at least 17 games over .500 at any point in a season.

ON RUN...the Mariners are 20-9 (.690) in 1-run games, and their 20 wins and 29 games decided by 1 run are both the most in the Majors...their 29 games decided by 1 run are the most through a team's first 63 games of a season since the 2001 Dodgers (29) and most by an AL team since the 1993 Royals (29)...their 20 wins match the most through 63 games since Baseball Reference data is available (1908), joining the 1993 Royals, 1989 Astros, 1984 Blue Jays, 1978 Giants and 1966 Indians...they have won their last 4 games decided by 1 run (all against the Rays), are 7-1 in 1-run games since May 25 and 11-2 in 1-run games dating back to May 18 vs. DET.

AS THE STARTING PITCHING GOES...since May 16, the Mariners starters are 11-1 (team is 16-6 overall) with a 2.25 ERA (36 ER, 144.0 IP) with 105 strikeouts and 31 walks in 22 games...Seattle **starters** lead the Major Leagues in ERA during that span, ranking ahead of St. Louis (2.71/39 ER, 129.1 IP) and New York-NL (2.88/39 ER, 122.0 IP)...the 144.0 innings pitched by Mariners **starters** are the most in the Majors since May 16...during this same stretch, Mariners relievers are 5-5 with 9 saves and a 2.76 ERA (19 ER, 62.0 IP).

ROLLING IN ST. PETE...the Mariners have won 11 of the last 14 games and 14 of the last 20 games in St. Petersburg (since July 21, 2012)...the 20-game stretch followed an 8-game losing streak at Tropicana Field (8/19/11-7/20/12)...the Mariners swept a 3-game set in Seattle earlier this season (June 1-3) and overall are 21-6 in the last 27 games against the Rays (since June 7, 2014).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN...**Jean Segura** is batting .366 (48x131) with 26 runs scored, 11 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs, 21 RBI, 6 walks and 9 stolen bases in 30 games on the road this season, including batting .434 (23x53) with 9 runs scored, 4 doubles, 1 home run, 6 RBI and 4 stolen bases in his last 12 road games (5/9-c)...among all American League players, his .366 road average is the 3rd-highest this season, trailing only Jose Altuve-HOU (.415/56x135) and Andrelton Simmons-LAA (.370/40x108)...he also ranks 2nd in hits, 4th in runs, T4th in doubles, 9th in on-base percentage (.391) and T10th in RBI.

RIBBIES...Seattle boasts 3 of the top-10 players in the American League in RBI on the road this season...Kyle Seager ranks 2nd in the American League with 26 road RBI, while Mitch Haniger ranks 3rd with 25 RBI and Jean Segura ranks T10th with 21 road RBI.

IN A GROOVE...dating back to May 16, **Ben Gamel** has hit safely in 14 of his last 17 games, including at least 1 hit in 14 of his 15 starts...during this stretch, he is batting .389 (21x54) with 7 runs scored, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run, 3 RBI, 1 HBP, 5 walks and 3 stolen bases...during this stretch his .389 batting average is the 3rd-highest in the American League (min. 50 AB), trailing only Jose Altuve-HOU (.402/35x87) and **Jean Segura**-SEA (.390/32x82)...Gamel has also reached base safely in all 8 games he has appeared in vs. the Rays, including at least 1 hit in 7 games...overall is batting .414 (12x29) with 4 runs scored, 1 double, 1 triple, 1 RBI, 1 HBP and 5 walks.

SOLVING SOUTHPAWS...**Jean Segura** (.355/27x76, 7 2B, 3B, 1 HR, 10 RBI, 3 BB), **Mitch Haniger** (.319/22x69, 6 2B, 3B, 2 HR, 16 RBI, 8 BB) and **Denard Span** (.308/12x39, 2B, HR, 10 RBI, 7 BB) are each batting at least .300 vs. left-handed pitchers this season...among American League leaders in average vs. lefties, Segura (8th) and Haniger (12) each rank in the top 12, while Segura also ranks T3rd in doubles (7) and Haniger ranks T4th in RBI (16) and T7th in doubles (6)...**Kyle Seager's** 18 RBI vs. lefties this season rank 2nd in the American League, trailing only Nomar Mazara (19).

AS YOU KNOW...**Mike Zunino** has thrown out 9 of 23 attempted base stealers (39.1%, 14 SB, 9 CS) this season (excludes all pitcher caught stealings)...**AND AS YOU MAY ALSO KNOW**...among all qualifying catchers, Zunino's 39.1% caught stealing percentage trails only Salvador Perez-KC (58.8%, 7 SB, 10 CS) for the highest in the Major Leagues...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...Zunino has thrown out 5 of 7 attempted base stealers (71.4%) in the 7th inning or later?...Zunino 5 caught stealings and caught stealing percentage in the 7th inning or later both lead the Major Leagues.

ABOUT FÉLIX...

- 32-year-old right-hander is making his 389th career start and his 18th career start vs. Tampa Bay today.
Is the only active pitcher in MLB who holds his current club's all-time record for career wins and career strikeouts (see more in "He's Our Leader").
Is the second pitcher in franchise history to record 300 games started as a Mariner (also: Jamie Moyer, 323 GS w/Seattle 1996-2006).
Signed a 7-year deal through the 2019 season on Feb. 13, 2013.
In 2010 won the AL Cy Young, garnering 21 of 28 first-place votes...joined Randy Johnson (1995) as only Mariners pitchers to win the Cy Young...named Sporting News AL Pitcher of the Year...was 2nd in Cy Young voting in 2014.
ML debut Aug. 4, 2005 at Detroit...Safeco debut vs. MIN Aug. 9, 2005.
At 19 years, 118 days old at debut, was the 3rd-youngest player to debut in Mariners history & 2nd-youngest pitcher...youngest pitcher since Jose Rijo worked as reliever in '84 (19 years, 54 days, 7/6/84 at MIN).
Born in Valencia, VZ...signed as 16-year-old non-drafted FA 7/4/02.
A.L. All-Star: 2009, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 (starter) & 2015, most by any Mariner pitcher and 4th most overall behind Ken Griffey Jr. (10), Ichiro Suzuki (10) and Edgar Martinez (7).
Threw the first Perfect Game in Mariners history, and 23rd in ML history, Aug. 15, 2012 in a 1-0 victory over Tampa Bay at Safeco Field (9.0,0,0,0,12)...7th PG in MLB history to be decided in a 1-0 game, and 1st in the AL since 1984.
Is 29-11 with a 2.89 ERA (125 ER, 388.2 IP) in 56 career GS in June.

LAST OUTING...

pitched a season-high 8.0 innings, allowing just 1 run on 5 hits and 1 walk while striking out 7 batters...retired the side in order in the 1st, 3rd, 7th and 8th innings...sole run came on an RBI double in the 4th inning...marked the first time Félix has gone 8.0-or-more innings since Aug. 20, 2016 vs. Milwaukee (8.0,7,2,2,1,8).

IT'S NOT SHOCKING...

Félix's 1.89 ERA (27 ER, 128.2 IP), .184 batting average against (83x450) and 9.4 strikeouts-per-9.0-innings vs. the Rays are his best marks against any American League team...in 17 career starts vs. Tampa Bay, he has struck out 135 batters, his highest tally against any non-AL West opponent.

BRIGHT AND EARLY...

in his career, Félix is 57-40 with a 3.16 ERA (307 ER, 873.1 IP) with 803 strikeouts and 261 walks in 132 daytime starts...of those, 87 have been quality starts, including 3 of his 6 daytime starts in 2018...the Mariners are 72-60 in Félix's starts during the day...MLB defines a day game as any game that begins prior to 5:00 p.m. local time.

IMPRESSIVE START...

since 2005, has recorded 55 starts in which he has thrown at least 6.0 innings and not allowed a run...that total ranks 2nd among starting pitchers behind only Clayton Kershaw (63)...the next closest pitcher is Justin Verlander with 51...during this stretch Félix has recorded 252 quality starts, the 2nd-most in the Major Leagues, behind only Verlander (266).

HE'S OUR LEADER...

became the Mariners all-time career leader in strikeouts on April 23, 2016 at the Angels (previous: Randy Johnson, 2,162)...became the club's all-time career leader in wins on May 9, 2016 vs. the Rays (previous: Jamie Moyer, 145)...is the only active pitcher in MLB who holds his current club's all-time record for career wins and strikeouts...Chicago-AL's James Shields holds both records for Tampa Bay, while Arizona's Jorge De La Rosa owns both records for Colorado.

VENEZUELAN PRIDE...

Félix is one of two pitchers from Venezuela to win the Cy Young (also: Johan Santana, 2004 & 2006)...among pitchers born in Venezuela, Félix holds the all-time record for wins (166), starts (388), innings pitched (2,576.2) and strikeouts (2,404).

2017 SEASON RECAP...

went 6-5 with a 4.36 ERA (42 ER, 86.2 IP) with 78 strikeouts and 26 walks in 16 starts...placed on the 10-day DL on April 26 with right shoulder inflammation...activated on June 23 after making three rehab starts (6/6, 6/11, 6/17 w/AAA Tacoma)...spent a second stint on the 10-day DL on Aug. 5 (retro to Aug. 2) with right shoulder bursitis...activated on Sept. 14.

CAREER...

has spent entire pro career with Seattle...6-time All-Star (2009, 2011-15), 2-time ERA champ (2010, 2014), 2010 AL Cy Young Award winner...is 166-118 with a 3.26 ERA (929 ER, 2576.2 IP) in 388 career starts with 25 CG, 11 ShO, and 1 perfect game...holds Mariners all-time career records for wins (166), starts (388), quality starts (252), innings pitched (2576.2) and strikeouts (2,404).

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTING PITCHER: LHP JAMES PAXTON (5-1, 2.95)

29-year-old left-hander is scheduled to make his 14th start of the season tomorrow against the Rays...is 5-0 with a 1.60 ERA (9 ER, 50.2 IP) since the start of May and 7 of his last 8 outings have been quality starts...W#5 in his last start, a 7-1 Mariners win on 6/5 at HOU (7.2,9,1,1,1,6)...tossed second complete game of his career on 5/19 vs. DET (9.0,3,2,2,1,8,HR-1)...pitched the 6th no-hitter in Mariners history, needing just 99 pitches in W#2, a 5-0 Mariners win on 5/8 at TOR (9.0,0,0,0,3,7); first complete game and first shutout of his career...notched a career-high 16 strikeouts in the Mariners 2-3 loss to OAK on 5/2 (7.0,5,0,0,1,16)...SPRING TRAINING: Went 1-0 with an 8.27 ERA (15 ER, 16.1 IP) with 17 strikeouts and 5 walks in 5 starts...2017: Went 12-5 with a 2.98 ERA (45 ER, 136.0 IP) with 156 strikeouts and 37 walks in 24 starts...named the 2017 Mariners Pitcher of the Year by the Seattle BBWAA...led club in wins (12) and strikeouts (156)...earned a career-high 12 wins...logged 136.0 IP, the most in his career (previous: 121.0 IP in 2016)...CAREER: 35-21 with a 3.23 ERA (181 ER, 504.1 IP) in 87 starts in parts of 6 seasons...selected by Seattle in the 4th round of the 2010 MLB First-Year Player Draft...vs. TB: Is making his 3rd career start vs. Tampa Bay...is 2-0 with a 3.00 ERA (4 ER, 12.0 IP) in 2 career starts against the Rays...earned the win in his last start against Tampa Bay on June 16, 2016 (6.0,7,3,3,2,5).
