RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals are 39-27 post All-Star Break and 40-27 under manager **Mike Shildt** since he took the post on July 15. The Cardinals are T1st in wins (39) in the National League since the All-Star Break, while St. Louis' .591 winning percentage ranks 7th in MLB over that period. Entering July 15, the Cardinals had T9th-most wins in the NL (47) and currently have the 6th-most wins (87) in the NL.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals, who were swept in 3-games by the Brewers earlier this week, lost yesterday's series opener to the Cubs, 8-4, extending their losing streak to 4 games, matching their season high...St. Louis enters play today in 3rd place in the N.L. Wild Card race, 6.0 games back of Milwaukee and 2.0 games back of the Dodgers...the Cardinals are currently in 3rd place in the NL Central, 7.0 games out of first place.

TIE-BREAKERS: In the event of postseason tie-breakers, the Cardinals have won their season series with Los Angeles (4-3) and could potentially host a tie-breaker game with Los Angeles on Monday, Oct. 1 at 3:09 p.m. CT on ESPN.

WINNING SEASONS: The Cardinals have posted their 11th consecutive winning season, something they'd done just once previously in franchise history, when they compiled 15 consecutive winning seasons from 1939-1953.

MILES ON THE ROAD: **Miles Mikolas** is a perfect 9-0 on the road this season, one of two pitchers in Cardinals history with a perfect road winning percentage (Eddie Yuhas, 9-0 in 1952). Is one of eight pitchers in MLB history (since 1913) to post a road record of 9-0 or better in a single season (last: Daisuke Matsuzaka, BOS, 9-0, in 2008).

CATCH THIS: **Yadier Molina** hit his 20th homer on Tuesday, two shy of his career high 22 in 2012...Yadier joined **Ted Simmons** (1977 & 1979) as the lone Cardinals catchers with multiple 20+ homer seasons.

CARPENTER CHASING N.L. HR TITLE: **Matt Carpenter** hit his NL-leading 36th home run last Sunday and is trying to become just the 8th Cardinal (12th instance) to lead the league in round-trippers: **Albert Pujols** (2009-10); **Mark McGwire** (1998-99); **Johnny Mize** (1939-40); **Joe Medwick** (1937); **Rip Collins** (1934); **Jim Bottomley** (1928) and **Rogers Hornsby** (1922 & 1925).

A TASTE FOR CHICAGO: **Matt Carpenter** has hit eight home runs in 17 games against the Cubs this season, the most by any opposing player in 2018, and tied with **Jim Edmonds** (2004), **Albert Pujols** (2004), **Stan Musial** (1950) and **Rogers Hornsby** (1925) for most in a season among Cardinals. The most ever hit in a single season by a Cubs opposing player was **Ralph Kiner** (13, PIT, 1949). Carpenter's eight are the most since **Greg Vaughn** hit nine in 13 games vs. CHI with Cincinnati in 1999...**WRIGLEY WALLOPS:** **Carpenter** has hit six homers at Wrigley Field this season (all during July 19-22 five-game series), tying **Les Bell** (1925) for the most in a single-season by a Cardinal.

POWER PLAY: St. Louis has homered in 115 of 160 games this season, going 77-38 (.670 win pct.) in those games (10-35 when not homering)...their 77 wins lead the NL & rank 5th in MLB (Yankees, 1st-89)...St. Louis' 205 HR's are 3rd in NL behind the Dodgers (228) & Brewers (214)...**HOMERS AWAY FROM HOME:** St. Louis is an NL-best 41-20 (.672) when homering on the road, and trails only Oakland (132) in road homers (122) among all Major League teams.

TRIPLES TRIVIA: The Cardinals have hit a Major League low nine triples this season and finished with a record single-season low of four at Busch Stadium III...the Cardinals have never finished a season in single-digits in three-baggers.

GAMES THAT MATTER: The Cardinals today will play their 1,292nd regular season game out of 1,294, dating back to Opening Day of 2011, during which they still maintain playoff aspirations and have yet to be eliminated. **"MO"- MENTUM:** In their 11 seasons under President of Baseball Operations **John "Mo" Mozeliak**, the Cardinals have won 984 regular season games, trailing only the Yankees (1,009) & Dodgers (989), while they & the Yankees are the only teams to have posted 11 consecutive winning (+.500) seasons in that time period.

CHICAGO CONNECTIONS

Catcher **Yadier Molina** and infielder **Javier Báez** were teammates for runner-up Puerto Rico in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

Outfielder **Dexter Fowler** played the 2015-16 seasons with Chicago...initially became a Cub via trade by the Astros for pitcher **Dan Straily** and infielder **Luis Valbuena**...Fowler and pitcher **Tyler Chatwood** were teammates in Colorado (2012-13).

Infielder **Paul DeJong** graduated from nearby Antioch (Ill.) Comm. High School...played college baseball at Illinois State Univ. (2013-15) while majoring in biochemistry and pre-medicine.

Pitcher **Daniel Poncedeleón** was selected by the Cubs in the 14th round of the 2013 MLB draft, but did not sign.

Pitcher **Bud Norris** (July 29, 2009 with Houston), infielder **Matt Carpenter** (June 4, 2011), second baseman **Kolten Wong** (August 13, 2016), pitcher **Luke Weaver** (August 13, 2016) all made their MLB debuts against the Cubs.

Infielder **Jedd Gyorko** and Cubs First Base coach **Will Venable** were teammates in San Diego for two seasons (2013-15).

Pitcher **Luke Gregerson** was born in and resides in Park Ridge, Ill...graduated from Morton High School in Berwyn, Ill...played college baseball at St. Xavier University (Ill).

Pitcher **Brandon Morrow** was a teammate of **Brett Cecil** in Toronto (2010-14) and **Jedd Gyorko** in San Diego (2016).

Utility man **Ben Zobrist** graduated from nearby Eureka (Ill.) High School.

Cubs Assistant Hitting Coach **Andy Haines** managed Cardinals outfielder **Marcell Ozuna** in the Marlins minor league organization at three different levels for five seasons (2010-13, '15).

Outfielder **Jason Heyward** played the 2015 season with St. Louis...originally traded by Atlanta with pitcher **Jordan Walden** to St. Louis for pitchers **Tyrell Jenkins** & **Shelby Miller** (Nov. 17, 2014).

Pitcher **Steve Cishek** appeared in 27 games with St. Louis during the second half of the 2015 season...originally traded by the Marlins to St. Louis for pitcher **Kyle Barraclough** (July 24, 2015).

Cubs Bullpen Coach **Lester Strome** pitched for the Triple-A Louisville Redbirds (1987-88) in the Cardinals' minor league organization.

Cubs Director, Player Development **Jaron Madi-son** previously served as the Cardinals Assistant Director of Scouting from 2008-09.

Cubs Catching Coach **Mike Borzello** played four seasons (1991-94) in the Cardinals minor league system...originally selected by St. Louis in 1991.

Cardinals broadcaster and Hall of Fame outfielder **Jim Edmonds** played part of 2008 with the Cubs.

Cardinals V.P./General Manager **Michael Girsch** is a Chicago native...graduated from the University of Notre Dame and the University of Chicago.

TODAY'S GAME

- Makes his team-leading 32nd start of the season (42nd career start) and 69th career appearance.
- Is 9-0 on the road this season, one of two pitchers in Cardinals history with a perfect road winning percentage (Eddie Yuhás, 9-0 in 1952). Is one of eight pitchers in MLB history (since 1913) to post a road record of 9-0 or better in a single season (last: Daisuke Matsuzaka, BOS, 9-0, in 2008).
- With a win today, will become the first Cardinal since Adam Wainwright to win five games in only five starts in the month of September, and the 3rd Cardinals pitcher all-time (Flint Rhem, 1930).
- Trying to become the first Cardinal to win 18 games in a season since Adam Wainwright (20) in 2014, and the first Cardinal to post 18 wins in his first season with the Redbirds since Darryl Kile (20) in 2000.
- Leads the National League in winning percentage (.810) and is currently tied for the 6th-best winning pct. in a Cardinals single-season.
- Ranks among National League pitchers in wins (17, T3rd), ERA (2.94, 6th), innings (192.2, 8th), games started (31, T12th), WHIP (1.09, 7th) and quality starts (19, T8th).
- His 15.1 pitches per inning ranks 2nd in the National League (NYM's J. deGrom, 14.8), the lowest average by Cardinals pitcher since John Lackey (14.3 in 2015).
- Leads the National League in fewest walks/9 IP (1.35). The last Cardinal to lead the NL in walks/9 IP was Joel Piñeiro (1.14) in 2009. Has issued one or fewer walks in NL-leading 24 starts and no walks in 11 starts (T2nd in NL behind PIT's Ivan Nova, 12).
- Ranks among NL leaders strikeout/walk ratio (4.83, 4th), baserunners/9 IP (10.14, 7th), HR/9 IP (0.75, 5th), ground ball pct (51.0, 2nd), OPP OBP (.281, 7th) & SLG (.357, 7th).
- Has limited the opposition to 3 runs or fewer in 14 of last 17 starts (2 or fewer in 13).
- Limiting opposing right-handers to a .269 opponent slugging pct, 3th-lowest in the NL and currently 6th-lowest in Cardinals single-season history...Jose DeLeon's .240 from 1989 ranks 1st.
- Pitched 7.0 or more innings in 11 starts (T6th in NL) and at least 6.0 innings in 23 of his 31 starts this season (T7th NL).
- Nineteen of his 69 runs (27.5%) allowed have come in the 4th inning (5.23 ERA).
- Sports a 17-0 record with six no-decisions (St. Louis is 22-3) when receiving two or more runs of support in his starts.

LAST TIME OUT

- Earned his team-leading 17th win of the season and his 4th in as many starts in a 9-2 victory over San Francisco last Saturday at Busch Stadium.
- Held the Giants to his season-low two hits and struck out eight, his highest total against a National League team.
