THE TWINS: The Twins completed their six-game homestand with a record of 4-2, going 2-1 vs. Kansas City and 2-1 vs. New York-AL...tonight they will begin their final roadtrip of the season with four at Kansas City tonight-Sunday, three at Detroit Monday-Wednesday, an off-day in Oakland next Thursday and three against the A's next weekend.

THE JAKE ODORIZZI GAME: The Twins beat the Yankees last night at Target Field by a score of 3-1, winning the series...Jake Odorizzi (6-10) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on one hit in 7.1 innings pitched...he carried a no-hitter into the eighth inning before allowing a Greg Bird double...the pitching combined to allow just two hits, fourth time this season the staff has allowed as few as two hits...the win marked just the 10th this season (10-49) when scoring three-runs-or-fewer.

NO, YOU FIRST: The Twins are using an "Opening Pitcher" followed by a "Primary Pitcher" for the fourth time this season...below are the three previous times:

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the 16th of 19 games this season...they have gone 8-7 against KC this season, going 1-5 at Kauffman Stadium and 7-2 at Target Field...the Twins have gone 5-1 in their last six vs. KC.

☞ The Twins have lost five straight at Kansas City, their last win coming May 28...their longest losing streak at Kauffman is nine games, from April 8-September 28, 2016.

☞ Eddie Rosario is hitting .300 (30-for-100) with 16 RBI in his last 24 games vs. KC...in his last 12 at Kauffman, he is hitting .404 (21-for-52) with 11 RBI and six multi-hit games.

☞ Robbie Grossman has reached safely in 11 straight at Kauffman Stadium...he has 21 career hits at Kauffman and 15 walks, the difference of a .280 average and a .400 on-base percentage.

MAUER AND KC: Joe Mauer is hitting .318 (248-for-779) with 45 doubles, four triples, 14 home runs, 122 RBI and a .401 on-base percentage in 209 career games against the Royals...he ranks sixth all-time in batting average against KC (minimum 500 at-bats), trailing Rod Carew (.345), Ivan Rodriguez (.337), Wade Boggs (.332), Alex Rodriguez (.329), Derek Jeter (.322)...in his last 17 games against the Royals, he is hitting .375 (27-for-72) with a .423 on-base percentage and seven multi-hit games...below are Mauer's all-time ranks vs. KC:

NOTE: Mauer's last extra-base hit was a grand slam on September 11 vs. New York-AL.

BAT MAN ROBBIE: Robbie Grossman is hitting .317 (20-for-63) with six doubles, six RBI, 11 walks and a .434 on-base percentage in his last 21 games, since August 5...since that date his OBP ranks seventh best in the AL (minimum of 50 at-bats).

MR. ROGERS NEIGHBORHOOD: Taylor Rogers enters tonight riding a 19.2 scoreless innings streak, dating back to July 30...it marks the longest Twins streak since Caleb Thielbar's 19.2 scoreless inning streak from May 20-July 6, 2013...the last one longer was Jesse Crain in 2010, pitching 20.2 straight scoreless from June 13-August 4, 2010...the club record is 36.0 straight, held by J.C. Romero, from June 26-September 11, 2004.

☞ It is the second longest active scoreless streak in baseball, trailing Chris Sale (29.0).

ROUGH ROAD: The Twins have gone 24-47 on the road this season, having lost five straight, their last win coming August 31 at Texas...their 24 road wins rank 26th in baseball...they have been out-scored on the road 367-289 (-78).

THIS AND THAT:

☞ Twins starting (and 'opening') pitching has posted a 1.44 ERA (25.0 IP, 4 ER) with an opponent batting average of .133 in their last five.

☞ Joe Mauer is hitting .400 (30-for-75) with runners in scoring position this season, tied with Wilson Ramos for second most in baseball, trailing J.D. Martinez (.401).

LAST START: Gonsalves did not factor into the decision on September 7 vs. Kansas City in his fourth start of the season...went 2.1 innings and allowed five runs on five hits, three walks, and one strikeout...this marked his second shortest appearance of the season, with his shortest being 1.1 innings in his big league debut...when Gonsalves exited the game he had allowed three runs to score and left two men on base...Alan Busenitz entered the game and gave up a three-run home run, allowing both inherited runners to score.

AGAINST THE ROYALS: Gonsalves is facing Kansas City for the second time in his career, with his last start being his previous...has made two starts against the American League Central, going 0-1 with a 22.09 ERA (3.2 IP, 9 ER)...made one career minor league start against a Kansas City affiliate as a member of Rookie Elizabethton, earned the win over Burlington on June 25, 2014 after shutting out the Royals on two hits with nine strikeouts over 6.0 innings.

2018 ON THE FARM: Gonsalves began the season in Double-A Chattanooga where he went 3-0 across four starts with a 1.77 ERA (20.1 IP, 4 ER), two home runs allowed, 10 walks and 25 strikeouts...was named Twins Minor League Pitcher of the week for the week of April 22-28...promoted to Triple-A Rochester and made his first start for the Red Wings on May 1... had three winning months in Rochester, going 4-1 in May, 2-0 in July and 2-0 in August...in July, he went 2-0 with a 0.88 ERA (30.2 IP, 3 ER) across five starts.

KEEP 'EM COMIN': Gonsalves became the 12th different starting pitcher the Twins have used this year (not including the three openers)...he is one of 33 different pitchers to make an appearance this year (including outfielder Ryan LaMarre, infielder Willians Asutdillo, catcher Mitch Garver and catcher Chris Gimenez), tied for third most in the AL with Oakland.

2017 RECAP:

- Spent first career spring training with Twins and reassigned to minor league camp March 13; reported to Double-A Chattanooga.
- Began season on 7-day disabled list with left rotator cuff strain.
- Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Month for June, going 4-1, 2.32 ERA (31.00 IP, 8 ER) in five starts for the Lookouts.
- Ranked third on Chattanooga staff in wins (8), innings pitched (87.1), and strikeouts, despite pitching just three months.
- Promoted to Triple-A Rochester August 7.
- Made five appearances (four starts) for Red Wings in August where he finished the season.
- Named left-handed starting pitcher on the Twins Organizational All-Star team by MiLB.com.
- Ranked fourth best prospect and best changeup in Twins system by Baseball America, entering 2018...ranked 78th best prospect in baseball by MLB.com.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - JOSE BERRIOS, RHP (SEASON: 11-11, 3.83 ERA ; CAREER: 28-26, 4.50 ERA)

Berrios is making his 30th start for the season and fourth against the Royals...last start came against Kansas City at Target Field where he suffered the loss after 6.0 innings and allowing three hits and just one run...is 2-2 in his career against Kansas City...his loss to Kansas City in his last start marked his first divisional loss of the season...is 7-1 with a 2.54 ERA (78.0 IP, 22 ER) across 12 starts against the American League Central this season.
