THE GIANTS: Defeated the Diamondbacks by a score of 7-0 last night...it marked SF's first shutout at Chase Field since April 2, 2014...the Giants have won six of their last seven and nine of their last 11 contests.

GOING FOR THE SWEEP: San Francisco is attempting to secure their third series sweep of the season and first since winning three against the Phillies from June 1-3...the Giants last swept Arizona Sept. 9-11, 2016 here at Chase Field.

WINNING MONTH: San Francisco finished the month of June with a 18-10 (.643) record, the sixth-best winning pct. in the Majors...it marked the Giants best record in a single month since posting a 21-8 (.724) record in May 2016.

FROM MAY TO JUNE: Giants' pitchers lowered their ERA from 5.39 in May to a 2.70 figure in June...their 2.69 difference in ERA is the second largest improvement from May to June all-time (*Stats, LLC*)... San Francisco's 2.70 ERA in June ranked as the second-best figure in the Majors behind only the Yankees (2.62 ERA).

ON THE MOUND: LHP Derek Holland has posted a 2-1 record with a 2.38 ERA (6er, 22.2ip) over his last four starts...he's made two career starts against the Diamondbacks, going 0-1 with a 3.60 ERA (2er, 10.0ip)...he'll oppose RHP Zack Godley, who worse start this season came against the Giants on June 4...he allowed a season-high seven runs in just 3.1 innings of work.

LOAD 'EM UP: The Giants are hitting .323 (21-for-65) with eight doubles, nine walks and 59 RBI with the bases loaded, which ranks as the highest average in the National League and third-highest figure in the Majors behind Cleveland (.339) and Houston (.333).

CLOSE CALLS: 17 of the Giants last 24 games have been decided by two runs or fewer with five of San Francisco's last six contests having been decided by one-run...the Giants have posted a 14-13 record in one-run games and a 23-21 record in one or two run games this season.

ROAD WOES: The Giants are 18-26 (.409) on the road this season, the second lowest road winning percentage in the NL (Miami: .395)...San Francisco has lost 18 of their last 27 road games, however they are 7-6 in their last 13 contests away from AT&T Park.

GIANTS AT CHASE: The Giants have four players on their active roster that have .300-or-better career batting averages here at Chase Field...**IF Pablo Sandoval** ranks sixth among all active players with a .326 average (76-for-233) while **C Buster Posey** ranks eighth with a .324 clip (82-for-253)...**IF Joe Panik** is batting .318 (35-for-110) and **OF Hunter Pence** is at .317 (73-for-230).

ON THE MEND: RHP Jeff Samardzija (right shoulder tightness) is scheduled to make his fourth rehab appearance this Monday for Sacramento...**RHP Johnny Cueto** (right elbow sprain) will throw a bullpen on Monday.

ON DECK: Following today's game San Francisco will travel to Denver for a three game series against the Rockies (Monday-Wednesday)...the Giants have won 11 of their last 18 games versus Colorado, however they have dropped 12 of their last 14 games at Coors Field.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#45 LHP Derek Holland
6-2, 215, 31 years old (October 9, 1986)
5-7 Record, 4.24 ERA

- The 31-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 17th start in a Giants uniform...has posted a 5-7 record with a 4.24 ERA (40er, 85.0ip) over his first 15 starts.
- The Giants are 8-8 in his 16 starts and have won five of his last six and eight of his last 12 outings.
- Did not factor into the decision in his last start on June 26 vs. Colorado...threw a season-high 6.2 innings, allowing one runs on six hits with a season-high eight strikeouts in the Giants 3-2 victory over the Rockies...it marked the most innings he's thrown in a game since May 21, 2017 at SEA (8.0ip).
- Has posted a 2-1 record with a 2.38 ERA (6er, 22.2ip) over his last four starts.
- Has held left-handed batters to a .141 clip (9-for-64), which ranks as the fourth-lowest average in the National League and .172 slugging percentage, which ranks first among starters in the Majors.
- Has struck out 22 batters in his last 17.2 innings pitched, covering his past three outings (11.21 SO/9).
- Has pitched better during the day this season, going 4-1 with a 2.54 ERA (8er, 28.1ip) in five day starts, compared to a 1-6 record with a 5.08 ERA (32er, 56.2ip) in 11 starts at night.
- Has made two career starts against the Diamondbacks, both coming this season...he's 0-1 with a 3.60 ERA (2er, 10.0ip) over his two starts...Holland has never pitched at Chase Field.
- Has allowed 36 extra-base hits, tied for the sixth-most in the National League (22 doubles, two triples, 11 home runs).
- Signed by the Giants to a minor league contract in Feb. and made the team as a non-roster invitee.
