TRIBE HEADLINES

» The Indians' 34-29 record through 63 games sits two wins ahead of the 102-win 2017 club (32-31)...Cleveland enters play tonight with the largest divisional lead in MLB, matching their season-high with a 5.0-game lead over second-place Detroit.

» FRANCISCO MEJÍA has been recalled from Columbus to begin his second stint at the Major League level...he hit .154 (2-13) as a September call-up last season, and he is batting .350 (14-40) for Triple-A Columbus since May 26.

» CARLOS CARRASCO is set to make his first start against Chicago-AL in the 2018 campaign...he posted a 3-0 record with a 1.23 ERA (4ER/29.1IP) in four starts vs. the White Sox in 2017, including a complete-game win (3H, 1R/ER, 0BB, 9K) here at Guaranteed Rate Field on September 6, 2017.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians returned to their high-water mark of five games over .500 as they won 9-2 in their series finale at Detroit...marked their first win in a road rubber match this season.

» MELKY CABRERA and ERIK GONZÁLEZ drove in three runs apiece, as González broke the game open with a bases-clearing double in the 6th inning...YAN GOMES belted his 8th longball of the season with a two-run shot in the 8th inning.

» FRANCISCO LINDOR snapped an 0-for-20 slide as he went 3-for-5 with a double and two runs scored, notching his 10th three-hit game of 2018 (T3rd in MLB).

» COREY KLUBER became the first American League pitcher to reach 10 wins, allowing two runs on five hits over 8.0 strong innings...Kluber fanned eight batters and did not walk a batter, extending his career-long walkless streak to 43.1 innings...the streak now represents the 4th-longest streak by an Indians pitcher in the Baseball Reference Play Index era (1908-), as well as the longest since a 48.0-inning streak by Paul Byrd from April 26-June 6, 2007.

SOUTH SIDE STORY

» The Indians travel to Guaranteed Rate Field tonight for the first contest in a four-game set in Chicago...marks the second of six series between the Tribe and White Sox.

» The Indians previously hosted Chicago-AL in a three-game series at Progressive Field from May 28-30...the Tribe swept the three contests in Cleveland, outscoring the White Sox 25-10.

» Cleveland went 13-6 in their season series against Chicago-AL last season, including a mark of 8-2 at Guaranteed Rate Field.

» The Indians own an overall franchise record of 1063-1081 (.496) against the White Sox in a 118-year-old rivalry (1901-)...since Terry Francona became Tribe manager in 2013, Cleveland has gone 63-35 (.643) vs. Chicago-AL.

CENTRAL FOCUS

» Tonight's contest marks the fourth of 16 consecutive scheduled games against A.L. Central opponents, Cleveland's longest divisional stretch of the season...with the exception of the team's recent two-game set vs. Milwaukee, 23 of the Tribe's 25 contests from May 28 - June 20 are scheduled against divisional opponents.

» Cleveland has gone 16-9 thus far against the A.L. Central, going 5-2-1 across eight completed series...the club's .640 intra-divisional winning percentage is currently the 4th-best in the American League (7th in MLB)...the Tribe is 5-7 in divisional road games, compared to 11-2 at Progressive Field.

» The Indians have allowed three-or-fewer runs in 16 of their 25 divisional contests this season, going 14-2 in those games.

STARTING STRONG

» The Indians' starting pitching has been an asset throughout the season, and Tribe starters enter play today with a 3.45 ERA (2nd in A.L., 4th in MLB).

» Cleveland has posted 28 starts of 7.0-or-more innings this season, the most in MLB...COREY KLUBER's performance yesterday afternoon gave the Tribe 41 quality starts on the season, 2nd-most in MLB behind Houston (49).

» Tribe starters rank 2nd in MLB with 407.0 innings pitched this season, yet they have allowed just 99 walks, the 3rd-fewest in MLB...the rotation's rate of 2.19 walks per 9.0 innings is the lowest among all MLB teams.

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

1976: With Cleveland trailing 4-3 in the bottom of the 13th inning, player-manager Frank Robinson inserts himself as a pinch-hitter and delivers a walk-off two-run homer to give the Indians a 5-4 win over the Chicago White Sox at Cleveland Municipal Stadium...the clutch blast marked Robinson's 584th career homer, and the future Hall of Famer would hit just two more homers for the Tribe before retiring at the end of the 1976 campaign.
