MARINERS NOTES:

- The Mariners have won or tied 21 of their first 24 series, posting a series record of 15-3-6.
- **Mike Leake** has thrown 6.0 or more innings in each of his last 6 starts.
- **Nelson Cruz** (1x3, R, HR, BB) has homered in 5 of his last 9 games...is batting .310 (22x71) with 12 runs, 2 doubles, 9 home runs and 19 RBI in his last 20 games (5/28-current).
- **Dee Gordon** (3x5) has recorded 9 games with 3-or-more hits, 2nd most on the Mariners, trailing only Jean Segura (14)...his 18 multi-hit games are tied with Kyle Seager for 2nd-most on the Mariners, trailing Segura (32).
 - Has hit safely in 6 straight games...he is batting .423 (11x26) with 4 runs during that span.
- **Ben Gamel** (1x4) has hit safely in 6 straight games, batting .421 (8x19) with 5 runs and 2 RBI over that span.
 - He is batting .400 (26x65) in 23 games at Safeco Field this season.
- **Mitch Haniger** (1x4, R, BB) has drawn a walk in 5 of his last 6 games and has 9 walks in 16 games since June 1.
- **Kyle Seager** (0x4) snapped a season-high 6-game hitting streak (6/10-6/16)...batted .304 (7x23) with 3 runs, 1 double, 1 home run, 2 RBI and 1 stolen base during that span.

RED SOX NOTES:

- The Red Sox are 18-5 in series finales, including 14-2 on getaway days...they are 18-5 in day games and have won 5 straight day games on the road.
- Red Sox starting pitchers have allowed 2 earned runs or fewer in 12 of the club's last 14 games.
- Boston is 36-7 this season when scoring 5-for-more runs and 31-3 when scoring first, the best mark in the Majors.
- The Red Sox hit 3-or-more home runs in a game for the 10th time this season.
 - Boston is the only team in the Majors with as many as 6 players with double-digit home runs: Martinez (22), Betts (18), Benintendi (12), Bogaerts (12), Devers (11) and Moreland (10).
- **Eduardo Rodriguez** earned his team-leading 9th win of the season, extending his career-long winning streak to 6 consecutive starts...the Red Sox are 13-1 in Rodriguez's starts this season.
- **Xander Bogaerts** (2x5, 2 R, 2 RBI, HR) hit his 4th home run of the series...he batted .313 (5x16) with 4 runs, 3 home runs and 6 RBI in the four-game series.
- **Rafael Devers** (2x5, HR, 3 RBI) has hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games...his 21 home runs are 3rd-most by a Red Sox hitter before his 22nd birthday since 1908.
- **Mitch Moreland** (2x4, 2 RBI) recorded his first hit of the series, snapping an 0-for-10 slump with a 2-out, 2-RBI single in the 3rd inning.

BOSTON MANAGER ALEX CORA:

On Rodriguez:

"He was good. To see him go 6, everybody was excited. He had to work for it, that 5th inning, he limited the damage, and then, where they were in the lineup...I'm going hitter by hitter but Gamel was going to be his last one. He did a good job, good fastball, and he was a lot more aggressive in the strike zone. They just put up good at bats and also the tempo, I know you guys like it."

On the Cruz home run:

"He's a good pitcher. That's going to happen. 3-2 cutter, I think that was in the heart of the plate and he put a good swing on it, but he bounced back there and he got him out. He's been great for us. He's doing an outstanding job."
