#### GOING OUT IN STYLE

» A walk-off homer by **YAN GOMES** helped Cleveland earn its first series win of 2018 as the Tribe beat the Kansas City Royals, 3-1, in yesterday's rubber match.

» The Indians scored three times on just one hit over the final 2.0 innings to erase a 1-0 Kansas City lead...**BRADLEY ZIMMER** led off the bottom of the 8th inning with a walk, stole second base and scored on an RBI groundout by **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** to tie the score at 1-1...after **YONDER ALONSO** drew a walk in the bottom of the 9th, Gomes belted a walk-off, two-run homer to left field.

» **MIKE CLEVINGER** did not factor into the decision, allowing just one run over a career-high 7.1 innings as he scattered ten hits and two walks while striking out four batters...**TYLER OLSON** struck out both batters he faced and **CODY ALLEN** worked a 1-2-3 9th inning to pick up his first win of the season.

#### WALK-OFF GOMER

» A two-run homer by **YAN GOMES** gave the Tribe its first walk-off victory of the 2018 season after recording six during 2017.

» Three of the Tribe's six walk-off wins last season came via the longball: a solo homer by **FRANCISCO LINDOR** on July 22 vs. Toronto, a grand slam by **EDWIN ENCARNACION** on July 25 vs. Los Angeles-AL and a three-run homer by Gomes on August 8 vs. Colorado.

» Yesterday's victory also marked the fourth walk-off plate appearance of Yan Gomes's career, all of which have come with Cleveland...three of those four walk-off PAs have been home runs, including a three-run homer on May 20, 2013 vs. Seattle and the aforementioned instances in 2017 and yesterday...he also collected a walk-off single on June 1, 2016 vs. Texas.

#### TIGER BY THE TAIL

» The Indians and Tigers will meet tonight for the first of 19 matchups between the clubs this season, 10 of which are scheduled to occur here at Progressive Field.

» During the 2017 campaign, the Indians posted a 13-6 record against Detroit, winning the season series for a second consecutive year (first time doing so since 2007-08).

» Since the start of 2016, the Tribe has gone 27-10 against the Tigers, including a run of 11 straight victories from April 22 - July 5, 2016.

» The Tribe enters tonight on a seven-game winning streak against Detroit, holding the Tigers to three-or-fewer runs in each of those contests with a 0.86 ERA (6ER/63.0IP) in that span.

» Cleveland owns an overall franchise record of 1084-1118 (.492) against the Tigers in a 118-year-old rivalry (1901)...the two clubs have combined for six of the last seven A.L. Central division titles.

#### FAMILIAR FOE

» The Indians will face a familiar opponent this evening in **Francisco Liriano**, who has made 20 career appearances (15 starts) against Cleveland.

» 16 of those 20 appearances came during Liriano's tenure with the Twins (2005-12), while one other came with divisional rival Chicago-AL in 2012...Liriano has gone 5-6 in his career against the Indians with a 4.19 ERA (40ER/86.0IP).

» The Indians have gone on to win in seven of Liriano's last nine appearances against the club...the left-hander's last victory over Cleveland came on July 21, 2010 at Target Field with Minnesota.

#### FLEET OF FOOT

» With runs at a premium early in the season, the Indians have utilized strong baserunning to manufacture runs.

» The Indians lead the American League (2nd in MLB) with 10 stolen bases this season, against just one caught stealing...**FRANCISCO LINDOR** and **RAJAI DAVIS** are tied for the team lead with three steals each (T2nd in A.L.), while **BRADLEY ZIMMER** has two (T8th in A.L.).

» Cleveland has stolen 232 bases since the start of 2016, most in the American League in that span (led A.L. with 134 SB in 2016).

» On the other side of the basepaths, opponents have attempted just three stolen bases against Cleveland this year...**YAN GOMES** caught **Jorge Soler** stealing yesterday afternoon, and also picked **Mike Moustakas** off first base to collect a pair of assists.

#### WHAT A RELIEF

» The Tribe bullpen has allowed just one run over its last 11.0 innings, including 5.2 scoreless frames over the weekend vs. Kansas City...the Tribe's 3.12 relief ERA (9ER/26.0IP) ranks 5th in the American League.

» Four Tribe relievers (most in A.L., T2nd in MLB) have worked 3.0-or-more innings this season without surrendering a run: **CODY ALLEN** (5.0IP), **NICK GOODY** (4.2IP), **ANDREW MILLER** (3.1IP) and **MATT BELISLE** (3.0IP).

» Collectively on the season, 19 of the Indians' 24 relief appearances have been scoreless.

#### COREY IN THE HOUSE

» **COREY KLUBER** is set to make his third start of the season this evening, as well as his 2018 Progressive Field debut...marks the third time in his career to start three of the Tribe's first 10 games, previously doing so in 2015 and 2016.

» Despite two dominant starts to open his campaign (CG on 3/29 at Seattle, three hits in 7.0 innings on 4/4 at Los Angeles-AL), Kluber sits 0-1 entering tonight's start...he is the first Tribe pitcher to work at least 7.0 innings in each of his first two starts and remain winless since **CC Sabathia** in 2004 (0-0, 1.80 ERA after two starts).

» Kluber was dominant at Progressive Field in 2017, posting a 10-2 record with a 1.81 ERA (23ER/114.2IP) in 16 home starts...his 10 home wins last year were T1st in the American League, while his home ERA ranked 1st in the A.L. and 2nd in MLB (min. 80.0 IP).

#### CENTRAL FOCUS

» The Tribe is set to play a second consecutive series against a divisional foe as they open their 76-game divisional slate.

» Since July 1, 2017, the Indians have posted a 33-9 (.786) against A.L. Central teams, taking wins in each of their last 13 series vs. divisional opponents.

» Dominant pitching has been critical to the Indians' divisional success, as the team has posted a 1.84 ERA (50ER/244.0IP) in its last 27 divisional games, allowing two-or-fewer earned runs in 21 of those contests.

» Cleveland enters play today in 3rd place in the A.L. Central, 1.0 game behind leader Minnesota (4-3).

#### LOOKING FOR A SPARK

» After recording 10-or-more hits in 59 games last season (51-8 in those contests), the Indians are now the only team in MLB yet to reach double-digits (allowed 10 hits to Kansas City yesterday).

» The Indians rank last in MLB with a .159 team average (47-for-296) and 29th with 47 hits...they rank T9th in the American League with nine home runs this season, while they lead the A.L. with 10 steals (2nd in MLB).

» Both of the Indians' wins over the Royals this weekend came with just four hits on the afternoon...in 2017, the Indians recorded just one victory with less than five hits, which also came vs. Kansas City on September 17 (3H, won 3-2).

#### HOME COOKING

» Last year, the Indians posted a 49-32 (.605) record at Progressive Field, the 2nd-best home record in the American League and 4th-best in the Majors.

» Since the 2017 All-Star Break, Cleveland has gone an MLB-best 30-9 (.769) at home, including wins in 19 of their past 23 regular-season games here.

#### MISC. NOTES

» **ANDREW MILLER** has been particularly dominant in the first month of the season, as he has allowed no runs in March/April since the start of the 2015 season...that span encompasses 32 appearances and 35.1 innings pitched, as he has struck out 58 batters while allowing just 17 hits and 11 walks...Miller has allowed an opponent OPS of .356 in April over the past four campaigns.

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** enters play today with 499 career hits, looking to become the 7th current Indians player to reach the 500-hit milestone...his 364 hits since the start of 2016 are 2nd-most on the Indians, behind **FRANCISCO LINDOR** (367).

» **2015:** The Indians come within two outs of the first combined no-hitter in franchise history as they win 5-1 at Houston...Trevor Bauer worked the first 6.0 innings and struck out 11 batters, but five walks and 111 pitches forced an early exit...Kyle Crockett and Scott Atchison each tossed hitless frames to carry the no-hit bid into the 9th inning, but Nick Hagadone allowed a solo homer to Jed Lowrie with one out in the bottom of the 9th.

**TONIGHT'S START VS. DETROIT**

» Reigning American League Cy Young award winner Kluber will make his third start of the season in tonight's series opener against Detroit...marks his 166th career game started and his 171st career appearance...will celebrate his 32nd birthday tomorrow, April 10.

» Will be pitching on regular four days' rest after making his last start in the Tribe's series finale on April 4 at Los Angeles-AL...did not factor into the decision in the Indians' 3-2 loss...tossed 7.0 innings and held the Halos to two runs on three hits (one home run), striking out six batters and walking two.

» Is due to make his 23rd career appearance and 22nd career start against the Tigers...has compiled a 8-7 record and 3.97 ERA (59ER/133.2IP) in those starts.

» **Went 10-2 with a 1.81 ERA at home last season...his home ERA led the American League and ranked 2nd in MLB...home ERA was also the lowest mark by an Indians pitcher since Gaylord Perry posted a 1.77 home ERA in 192.**

**VS. DETROIT | A.L. CENTRAL**

» Kluber went 3-1 with a 3.73 ERA (13ER/31.1IP) in five starts against the Tigers last season, including his sixth career complete-game shutout on September 12 at Progressive Field (9.0IP, 5H, 8K)...overall, owns a 8-7 record and 3.97 ERA (59ER/133.2IP) in 22 games (21 starts) vs. Detroit in his career.

» **Over the past four seasons (2015-2018), Kluber is holding the Tigers to a .226 batting average, the lowest mark by any pitcher with at least eight starts against Detroit in that time span...his 3.06 ERA (24ER/70.2IP) is the 2nd-lowest within those same parameters.**

» **Has won each of his last six decisions against a divisional opponent, dating back to June 9, 2017...owns a 1.78 ERA (13ER/65.2) in that span.**

» Has dominated against the A.L. Central Division over the past few seasons, a key part of the team's overall success within the central...Kluber went 8-1 with a 2.57 ERA (24ER/84.0IP) in 13 starts against A.L. Central opponents last year.

» Since the start of 2016, Kluber has a 17-3 record and 2.47 ERA (47ER/171.1IP) against the A.L. Central...entering the 2018 season, his ERA was the second-lowest intradivisional mark in that span (min. 125.0IP).

**STARTING ON THE RIGHT FOOT | SERIES OPENER**

» In 2017, Kluber made eight starts in series openers, going 7-0 with a no-decision in those starts.

» Also posted a 1.91 ERA (13ER/61.1IP) in those outings, with 67 strikeouts...this included a trio of 11-strikeout performances on June 19 at Baltimore, August 3 vs. New York-AL and August 8 vs. Colorado.

**AT PROGRESSIVE FIELD**

» Kluber went 10-2 with a 1.81 ERA (23ER/114.2IP) in 16 home starts last season...ranked T2nd in MLB in wins...his home ERA led the American League and ranked 2nd in MLB...also marked the lowest such ERA by an Indians pitcher since Gaylord Perry's 1.77 home ERA in 1972.

» Since the start of 2016, Kluber is 20-7 with a 2.51 ERA (63ER/225.2IP) in 32 home starts...in that time span, his win total is 2nd in MLB, behind Rick Porcello (21), while his ERA is 3rd in MLB (min. 20 GS at home).

**COMPLETE COREY**

» Kluber tossed his 16th career complete game in his first start of the year on March 29 at Seattle...marked the first Opening Day complete-game by a Cleveland pitcher since Jake Westbrook on April 4, 2005 at Chicago-AL (1-0 loss), and the first such complete game in MLB since Clayton Kershaw threw a complete-game shutout on April 1, 2013 vs. San Francisco.

» Struck out eight batters, the 2nd-most by a Tribe starter on Opening Day over the last 14 seasons (2005-18), behind Justin Masterson (10K on April 5, 2012 vs. Toronto).

» Kluber threw just 91 pitches in the game, marking the second-lowest complete-game pitch count of his career...needed just 85 pitches to shut out the Mariners on July 30, 2014 (9.0IP, 3H, 8K) in Cleveland.

**SPRING TRAINING SUMMARY**

» Kluber made five Cactus League starts, going 4-0 with a 2.25 ERA (5ER/19.2IP)...tied for the MLB lead in wins and tied with teammate RHP Mike Clevinger for 5th in the Cactus League with 25 strikeouts.

**2017 AMERICAN LEAGUE RANKINGS**

» Kluber became the first Indians pitcher since 1949 (Mike Garcia, 2.36) to lead MLB in ERA, with a 2.25 mark.

» In addition, he ranked near the top of the American League leaderboard in virtually every other pitching category in 2017 (see chart), including wins (18, T1st), pitcher bWAR (8.2) and strikeouts (265, 2nd)...also led the A.L. in opponent batting average, holding hitters to a .193 (141-for-732).

**CY KLUBER: 2017 REGULAR SEASON HIGHLIGHTS**

» Became the first pitcher in Indians franchise history to win the American League Cy Young award twice (2014/2017) and the 19th multiple-winner in MLB since 1956.

» Won the A.L. Pitcher of the Month award three times, June (4-0, 1.26ERA), August (5-1, 1.96 ERA) and September (5-0, 0.84 ERA), becoming the first triple winner since Houston's Dallas Keuchel in 2015.

» Was on the disabled list from May 3-31 and made one rehab appearance at Double-A Akron on May 26...dominated after his activation from the D.L. on June 1, going 15-2 with a 1.62 ERA in his last 23 starts...led MLB (min. 80.0IP) with a 1.79 ERA in the second half.

» Recorded his 1,000th career strikeout on June 14 at Progressive Field...milestone came in his 148th career appearance, making him the fastest pitcher in Indians history to reach the mark...also struck out 10-plus batters in a franchise-record five consecutive starts from June 14-July 4...tied the record July 15-August 8...recorded eight-plus strikeouts in 14 straight starts from June 1-August 13, the 3rd-longest single-season streak in MLB history.

» Fanned his 200th batter of the season on August 23 vs. Boston, becoming one of three players in club history with 200-plus strikeouts in four consecutive seasons (Bob Feller, 1938-41 and Sam McDowell, 1965-70).

**2017 POSTSEASON RECAP**

» Started Games 2 and 5 of the 2017 American League Division Series against the New York Yankees...did not factor into the decision in Game 2 (2.2IP, 7H, 6R/ER, 2HR, 1BB, 4K) and took the loss in Game 5 (3.2IP, 3H, 3R/ER, 2HR, 2BB, 6K).
