TWINS NOTES:

- **THE TWINS** are now 6-6 at Target Field this year...the Twins have now lost 2 games in a row and 10 out of their last 11...The Twins are now 1-12 when they are out hit by their opponent and 0-13 when trailing after the eighth inning...the Twins all-time records against the Blue Jays is now 165-219 and at home 92-103.
- **LANCE LYNN** started his fifth game of the season today and allowed six runs on seven hits over 5.0 innings...in the fourth inning he eclipsed the 1,000 inning mark for his career...he surrendered two home runs for the second consecutive game.
- **EDUARDO ESCOBAR** (1-for-5) extended his current hitting streak to seven games, batting .393 (11-for-28)...hit a home run in the fifth inning, his 15th extra-base hit...entering the game he led the team in both categories.
- **LOGAN MORRISON** (0-for-3) hit by pitch in the bottom of the second inning extending his on-base streak to four games...he's batting .286 (4-for-14) with 1HBP and two walks during the streak.
- **ROBBIE GROSSMAN** (2-for-4) has eight hits in his last 17 at bats, batting .471 with three RBI and two three-hit games.
- **MAX KEPLER** (3-for-5) recorded a triple in the fourth inning, his first off the season...this marks his 13 extra base hit of the season, entering today's game he was second on the team (11) behind Eduardo Escobar (14).
- **MITCH GARVER** (2-for-4) extended his hitting streak to five games, he's hitting .412 (7-for-17) during the streak...this marks his second consecutive multi hit game and third of his career...in the eighth inning he threw out Gurriel Jr. attempting to steal second base, this is his first CCS of the season and the second of his career.

TORONTO NOTES:

- **THE BLUE JAYS** have won two in a row, improving their record to 16-12...they are now 13-0 when leading after the eighth inning and improved to 7-5 on the road.
- **AARON SANCHEZ** made his sixth start of the season, allowed four runs on six hits over 6.0 innings...this is the fifth time this season he has had a start of 6.0 or more innings.

- **YANGERVIS SOLARTE** (3-for-5) this marked his eighth multi-hit game of the season, first three hit game...entering today he was second on the team behind Kevin Pillar (8).
- **KEVIN PILLAR** (1-for-5) hit a double in the second inning, extended his hitting streak to 5 games and is hitting .389 (7-for-18) during the streak...this also marks his 16th extra-base hit of the season, entering today he was first on the team in this category.
- **JUSTIN SMOAK** (1-for-5) hit a two-run home run in the fourth inning, entering the game Smoak led the team with 15 RBI.
- **RUSSELL MARTIN** (1-for-4) hit a solo in the fifth inning, his third of the season.
- **LOURDES GURRIEL Jr.** (2-for-5) recorded his second multi hit game of the season and his career.
