BIRTHDAY BOY LEADS THE WAY

The Washington Nationals completed the two-game sweep of the Tampa Bay Rays on Wednesday afternoon thanks to an 11-2 victory...On his 28th birthday, **Anthony Rendon** went 4-for-5 with two doubles, three RBI, and four runs scored...**Michael A. Taylor** (3-for-5, 2B, 3 RBI, 2 R) and **Juan Soto** (2-for-4, 2B, RBI, BB, 2 R) also posted multi-hit efforts.

- The Nationals have won 11 of their last 15 games and since April 29, the Nationals (24-9, .727) boast the best record in Major League Baseball...They have outscored their opponents 145-89 during this stretch of games...Washington is ahead of the New York Yankees (23-9, .710) for the best record in MLB since April 29

MILESTONE WATCH

With two more wins, Nationals President of Baseball Operations and General Manager **Mike Rizzo** will record his 800th win since taking over the club during Spring Training 2009...Since the start of the 2009 season, the Nationals are 798-719 (.526) and dating to the start of the 2012 season, the Nationals have the best record in Major League Baseball (590-442, .572).

TAYLOR TIME

Over his last 15 games, **Michael A. Taylor** is hitting .315 (17-for-54) with six doubles, two triples, two homers, 10 RBI, five walks, five stolen bases and six runs scored...He has hit safely in 13 of the 15 games and has posted a .611 slugging percentage and a .984 OPS along the way.

SUMMER OF SOTO

Juan Soto has reached base safely in 13 of 16 games played this season, hitting .346 (18-for-52) with a .443 on-base percentage (9 walks/9 strikeouts) and a .538 slugging percentage (4 2B, 2 HR).

- Since joining the Nationals on May 20, Soto ranks among National League rookies in runs scored (1st, 11), on-base percentage (1st, .443), walks (1st, 9), slugging percentage (2nd, .538), OPS (2nd, .981), doubles (T3rd, 4), and batting average (4th, .346).

START ME UP

Washington's starting rotation leads the National League in ERA (2.89), strikeouts (412), opp. AVG (.212), opp. OBP (.273), hits per 9.0 IP (6.98), WHIP (1.05), and opp. OPS (1st, .631)...The staff ranks second in strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.00), strikeouts per 9.0 IP (9.92), and opp. SLG (.357), and third in home runs allowed per 9.0 IP (0.89).

- Since April 28, Nationals starters have allowed three earned runs or fewer in 33 of 35 starts.
- The Nationals boast four starters in the top 15 in the National League in ERA...No other team has more than three: **Max Scherzer** (2nd, 1.95), **Gio Gonzalez** (3rd, 2.27), **Stephen Strasburg** (13th, 3.20) and **Tanner Roark** (15th, 3.56).

BULLPENING

Over the last 15 games, **Henry Blanco's** bullpen has tossed 46.0 innings of relief, striking out 44 batters, walking 10 and surrendering just five earned runs along the way (0.98 ERA)...Nationals relievers have inherited 18 runners during this stretch and have allowed just one to score.

- Washington's 0.98 bullpen ERA is the best in Major League Baseball since May 21.
- On the season, Washington relievers rank among National League 'pens in inherited runners scored percent (2nd, 20.0%), strikeout-to-walk ratio (3rd, 2.90), and strikeouts per 9.0 IP (3rd, 9.38).

NATIONALS HISTORY

2010 – Prized pitching prospect **Stephen Strasburg** struck out 14 while tossing seven innings of four-hit, two-run ball in his MLB debut vs. Pittsburgh. Strasburg's electric performance came in front of a capacity crowd and a national television audience on MLB Network. Washington bested the Pirates, 5-2.

SAN FRANCISCO GIANTS

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** spent parts of the 1993 and 1994 season with the Giants and was a key member of the 1993 Giants that won 103 games...**Mark Melancon** pitched in 30 games for the Nationals in 2016.

The Nationals and Giants will meet six times this season...Washington is 13-10 against San Francisco since the start of the 2015 season.

DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

#37 - STEPHEN STRASBURG - RHP

Tall, powerful right-handed pitcher is a three-time All-Star who is Washington's all-time (2005-present) leader in wins (90) and strikeouts (1,381)... On May 10, 2016, he inked a seven-year contract extension that will keep him with the Nationals through the 2023 season.

AGAINST THE GIANTS: Makes his first regular season start against the Giants since Aug. 6, 2016 at Nationals Park...While the Nationals are 5-3 in his eight career starts against San Francisco, Strasburg's last win over them came on June 9, 2014 at SFG.

LAST START: Was strong through 6.0 innings before surrendering four runs (three earned) in the seventh inning as Washington fell to Atlanta, 4-0, on June 1 at ATL...Struck out 10 batters without issuing a walk, his third 10+ strikeout game of the season and his first outing in which he did not issue a walk.

2018 NOTES

- Ranks among National League pitchers in strikeouts (4th, 93), strikeout-to-walk ratio (5th, 4.89), WHIP (7th, 1.06), opp. OBP (7th, .274), wins (7th, 6), opp. AVG (10th, .220), and hits allowed per 9.0 IP (11th, 7.32),
- Ranks seventh in the National League with a 2.33 road ERA (10 ER/38.0 IP).
- Along with teammates **Gio Gonzalez** (3rd, .127) and **Max Scherzer** (4th, .150), he ranks in the top 10 in the NL in opp. AVG with runners in scoring position (8th, .196)...Opposing batters are 10-for-5144 with one triple, two homers and 18 RBI with runners in scoring position.
- Since Aug. 19, 2017, he ranks fourth in Major League Baseball with a 2.24 ERA among pitchers with at least 15 starts...Among National League pitchers during this stretch, he leads in ERA (2.24) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (5.38) and ranks in opp. OBP (2nd, .254), strikeouts (2nd, 156), opp. AVG (2nd, .201), opp. SLG (4th, .316), and strikeouts per 9.0 IP (4th, 10.61).
- Fanned a season-high 11 batters on May 2 vs. Pittsburgh...Allowed two earned runs on seven hits in 7.0 innings of work.
- Allowed just three hits while striking out eight batters and walking two in 8.0 shutout innings on April 10 vs. ATL...It was his longest outing since Sept. 10, 2017 at PHI (8.0 IP)...Earned his second win as Washington topped Atlanta, 4-1
- Opened his 2018 season by tossing 6.1 innings while allowing one earned run as Washington topped Cincinnati, 13-7, on March 31...The lone earned run came via fourth inning home run by **Scott Schebler**.

2017 NOTES

- Put together a strong first half of the season en route to being named an All-Star for the third time in his career.
- Was a finalist for the National League Cy Young Award...Capped 2017 being named National League Pitcher of the Month in September.
- Also ranked in NL in HR/9.0 IP (1st, 0.67), opp. SLG (1st, .317), opp. OPS (2nd, .581), WHIP (3rd, 1.02), opp. OBP (3rd, .265), & opp. AVG (3rd, .204).
- Coupled with Max Scherzer (2nd, 2.51) and Gio Gonzalez (5th, 2.96), Strasburg (3rd, 2.52), helped the Nationals become the first team with three starting pitchers ranking in the top five in the NL in ERA in 21 years (since the 1996 Atlanta Braves), according to the *Elías Sports Bureau*.
- On May 27 at San Diego, he struck out a career-high 15 batters in 7.0 shutout innings.
- On Aug. 19 at San Diego, he returned from a three-week stint on the disabled list...He went 5-1 with a 0.84 ERA (5 ER/53.2 IP) in his final eight starts of the regular season following reinstatement...He racked up 63 strikeouts, allowed just 10 walks and surrendered only one home run.

CAREER NOTES

- Is 85-47 with a 3.09 ERA in 184 starts since Sept. 6, 2011, his return from 2010 Tommy John Surgery.
- When starting, Washington is 123-73 (.628) since his debut...Since the start of 2016, the Nationals are 47-17 (.734) when he starts.
- Since 2012, he ranks in strikeouts per 9.0 IP (4th, 10.46), opp. SLG (5th, .352), opp. AVG (6th, .223), strikeouts (6th, 1,381), opp. OBP (8th, .280), strikeout-to-walk ratio (9th, 4.43), and ERA (9th, 3.12).

- Was recalled from Triple-A Syracuse on 5/21...Tallied 220 strikeouts in four seasons with KC, most of any left-handed reliever in franchise history.
