Beginning **4/27**, **Reds relievers** lead the Major Leagues in **strikeouts** (83) and rank second in **bullpen ERA** (2.72, 76ip, 23er) behind the **Cubs** (2.52, 64.1ip, 18er).

### EXTRA, EXTRA!

**Tucker Barnhart** last night pinch hit in the ninth inning and grounded out, snapping a streak in which he had produced at least **1 extra-base hit in 6 consecutive apps** (11-23, .478, 4 2b, 1 3b, 1hr, 6rbi, .870slg, .520obp)...was the longest active streak in the **Major Leagues** and the longest XBH streak by a Reds batter since **Jay Bruce's** 7-game streak from **6/20-6/26, 2014**.

### ROAD WARRIORS

This road trip began a stretch in which the Reds will play **5 straight road series** and **16 straight road games** in the **Mountain** and **Pacific Time Zones**...last year the Reds went **5-12 in 17 games** and **1-3-1** in their **5 series** in those **western time zones** (1-3 at SF, 0-3 at LAD, 0-3 at SD, 2-2 at Col, 2-1 at Ari).

**TODAY'S GAME:** Is **Game 3** (0-2) of a 3-game series vs **Devon Bridges' Giants** and **Game 7** (4-2) of a 7-game West Coast road trip that included the Reds' **first series win** vs LAD since **September 2013**, their **first series win at Dodger Stadium** since **June 2011** and their **first 4-game sweep** of the Dodgers since **August 1976**...following this series and tomorrow's off day, on **Fri** the Reds return to **Great American Ball Park** for **7 games** vs the **Cubs** (4g) and **Pirates** (3g), including a **day/night DH** on **Saturday**.

**SERIES NOTES:** Over the last 2 seasons the Reds have followed a **4-game winning streak vs SF** with a **5-game losing streak vs SF**...beginning with the **2008 season** the Reds are **40-29 vs SF** (.580), the best winning percentage of any Giants opponent since then (minimum 50 games)...**Reds vs Giants** information is on media guide **Page 330**.

**WE LEAVE OUR HEARTS...** Beginning **6/29/12**, including that 2012 season's **National League Division Series**, the Redlegs have won **15** of the last **25** meetings at SF's **AT&T Park** but have lost the last **5** games here...the Giants' 17-inning, 3-2 win here on **5/12/2016** was the Reds' longest game by inning since a **19-inning**, 5-4 loss on **5/25/2011** at **Phi** and the second-longest game in the history of **AT&T Park** (**5/29/2001**, 1-0 Giants loss vs Diamondbacks in 18 innings).

**CUBS UP NEXT:** The Reds and Cubs on Friday begin a 3-game series at **Great American Ball Park**, Chi's second visit to the **Queen City** already this season...in the **1-0 win on 4/2**, in the fourth game of the season, the Reds shut out the Cubs on 2 hits or fewer for the first time since **8/14/13** at Wrigley Field...**Billy Hamilton** has **31 stolen bases** vs the Cubs, the second-most by a Reds player vs Chi in the live ball era (**Barry Larkin**, 32)...over the **previous 3 seasons** (2015-2017), the Cubs' **.702 winning percentage** vs the Reds (40-17) was the best by any team against any division opponent...the Cubs won **30** of the last **42 games** vs Cin and **10** of the last **13 series**...**Cubs batters** have homered in **19** of their last **22 games** at **Great American Ball Park**...**Reds vs Cubs** information is on media guide **Page 320**.

**APRIL 19:** The Reds are **11-14** since **4/19**, when they replaced manager **Bryan Price** and pitching coach **Mack Jenkins**...bench coach **Jim Riggleman** became interim manager, Class AAA Louisville manager **Pat Kelly** (#60) was promoted to serve as interim bench coach, and Class AA Pensacola pitching coach **Danny Darwin** (#52) joined the Reds' Major League staff as interim pitching coach...later in the year, the team will conduct a thorough managerial search for a permanent replacement...**Price** went **279-387 (.419)** in his 5 seasons as manager, including **3-15 this year**.

**7-YEAR ITCH:** The **10-4** **Reds** victory on **4/23** vs **Atl** was the first for **Jim Riggleman** as his team's full-time manager since a **1-0 Nationals** win vs the **Mariners** on **6/23/11**...since 1900, he is **1 of 14** **managers** to work for at least **5** **Major League teams** (SD, Chc, Sea, Wsh, Cin)...**Jimmy Dykes**, **John McNamara** and **Dick Williams** each managed **6 teams**...the others who managed **5 teams** are **Chuck Dressen**, **Bucky Harris**, **Rogers Hornsby**, **Davey Johnson**, **Billy Martin**, **Bill McKechnie**, **Jack McKeon**, **Lou Piniella**, **Jeff Torborg** and **Joe Torre**.

**THE DRAFT:** The Reds will select **fifth overall** in the **June 4** first-year player draft, then **47th** (2nd round), **72nd** (Competitive Balance Round B), **82nd** (3rd round) and **109th** (4th round)...the **Tigers**, **Giants**, **Phillies** and **White Sox** will pick first through fourth, respectively...Senior Director of Amateur Scouting **Chris Buckley** will be available in Great American Ball Park's **Crosley Room** following the Reds' final selection of the day...the draft will begin at **7:00 p.m.** with the broadcast live on **MLB Network**...2018 Reds Hall of Fame inductee **Adam Dunn** will represent the organization at the draft...the draft will have **40 rounds**...the lists of Cin's **2017 draft picks** and **No. 1 draft picks** are on media guide pages **216-217**.

**REHABBING:** RHP **Anthony DeSclafani** (left oblique strain) and RHP **Michael Lorenzen** (right shoulder strain) on **Monday** began rehabilitation assignments for Class AA Pensacola...**DeSclafani** started and threw 3.0 perfect innings in the **4-1 Blue Wahoos loss** at **Biloxi** (4k, 31 pitches, 24 strikes), followed by 2 sets of 15 pitches in the bullpen...**Lorenzen** threw a scoreless fourth inning (1h, 1k, 12 pitches, 8 strikes)...**Lorenzen** was scheduled to throw another inning earlier this morning vs **Biloxi**...both have been on the Reds' disabled list all season.

**FRONT OFFICE NEWS:** Reds President of Baseball Operations **Dick Williams** on last week announced the promotion of **Nick Krall** to General Manager...**Krall** had been the club's Vice President, Assistant General Manager since November 2015...**Williams** will remain the club's President of Baseball Operations and will continue to oversee the organization's entire baseball operations department.

**IN A PINCH:** In his last **5 pinch-hit apps**, **Jesse Winker** walked, singled (RBI), doubled, singled and singled...he is the first Reds batter to **reach base safely** in **5 consecutive pinch-hit apps** since **Todd Frazier** did it from **4/20-5/2, 2012** and the first Reds batter to **produce a hit** in **4 straight pinch-hit apps** since **Brayan Pena** from **7/8-8/9, 2014**...**Fred Lewis** was the last Reds batter to **reach base safely** in **6 consecutive pinch-hit apps** (**6/13-7/2, 2011**)...**Rick Auerbach** was the last Reds batter with **hits** in **5 straight pinch-hit apps** (**8/14-9/13, 1978**)...courtesy Elias Sports Bureau.

**PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** **Scooter Gennett** has been named National League **Player of the Week** for the second time in his career...he is the second Reds player this season to receive the award (**Joey Votto**, 4/23-4/29)...in 5 apps last week **Gennett** hit **.591** (13-22, 2 2b, 4hr, 10rbi), including a streak in which he homered in 4 consecutive games for the first time in his career...he led National League batters in **hits**, **hitting** and **slugging percentage** (1.227), tied for the NL lead in **HR** and **total bases** (27), ranked second in **on-base percentage** (.591), T3rd in **runs scored** (7) and **extra-base hits** (6) and fourth in **RBI**...since RBI became a statistic in 1920, he became the sixth player in franchise history to produce at least 1 HR and 4 RBI in 4 consecutive games, joining **Devin Mesoraco** (6/20-6/24, 2014), **Jay Bruce** (9/2-9/5, 2012), **Eric Davis** (9/3-9/6, 1984), **Frank Robinson** (7/22-7/24, 1961) and **Ted Kluszewski** (7/4-7/7, 1956).

## RED HOTS

**Matt Harvey** this afternoon is making his second appearance for the Reds...will make his **fourth career** appearance and start vs the **Giants**, his first since **June 2015**, and his **third career** appearance at **AT&T Park**...in his Reds debut, Fri's 6-2 win at LAD, left with a 5-0 lead after allowing just 1 hit on a routine fly ball that dropped between **CF Billy Hamilton** and **RF Scott Schebler**, both of whom lost the ball in the lights...began the season with the **Mets** and went **0-2, 7.00** in **4 starts** and **4 relief apps** before he was **designated for assignment** on **5/5**...on **5/8** was acquired by the Reds in exchange for **C Devin Mesoraco** and **cash**... from **2012-2018** for the **Mets** went **34-37, 3.66** in **104 starts** and **5 relief apps**.

# Friday vs Cubs - #34 Homer Bailey, RHP

## RED HOTS

**Homer Bailey** on Fri vs Cubs will make his team-high **10th start of the season** and the **202nd appearance and start of his career**...will be his **19th career appearance and start vs the Cubs**...in his career has faced only the **Brewers** (27gs), **Cardinals** (25gs) and **Pirates** (22gs) more...his **3 quality starts** are **1 QS** shy of staff leader **Tyler Mahle**...Reds batters have scored **29 runs** in his **9 starts**, including **17 runs** while he is in the game...on **5/7 vs NYM** made the **200th appearance and start of his career**...in the 3-2 loss on **4/15 vs StL**, following a rain delay of 2 hours, 36 minutes, threw the **100th quality start** of his career (196th appearance)...in the 2-0 loss on **3/30 vs Wsh** made the first **Opening Day start** of his Major League career...has the **third-longest tenure** of any Major League pitcher with his current team (June 2007), trailing only **Sea's Felix Hernandez** (August 2005) and **StL's Adam Wainwright** (September 2005)...was on the **Reds' Opening Day roster** for the first time since **2014**...is approaching **1,200 innings** (1,172.1) and **1,000 strikeouts** (955).

- In the ninth inning last night pinch hit and grounded out, snapping a season-high 7-game hitting streak during which he hit .481 (13-27, 4 2b, 1 3b, 1hr, 6rbi, .815slg, .517obp).
- In his last 12 apps reached base safely 24 times via hit or walk (15-39, .385, 9bb).
- In 2017 became only the third catcher in Reds history to win a Rawlings Gold Glove Award for defensive excellence, joining Johnny Edwards (1963, 1964) and 10-time winner Johnny Bench (1968-1977).
- In 2017 established a new single-season franchise record for highest fielding percentage by a catcher (.999) and tied Brayan Pena's 2015 club mark for fewest errors in a season by a catcher (1e, 953tc).
- Monday's 2-run HR off Chris Stratton was the 300th hit of his career...is approaching 100 career runs (96).

### 2 ALEX BLANDINO, inf Road Trip: 6g, 1gs at SS, 1gs at 2B, 4-10, 2 2b, 2rbi

- Since a 1-for-17 start is hitting .333 (17-51), including a career-high 7-game hitting streak from 4/20-4/29.
- Has made 17 starts (9gs at 3B, 7gs at 2B, 1gs at SS on Thu at LAD), most recently Sun at LAD (2B, 2-4, 1rbi, 2r).
- Fri at LAD played RF for the last out of the seventh inning, his first professional appearance in the outfield, then played SS in the eighth and ninth.
- On 4/10 at Phi made his Major League debut with a start at 3B (0-3).
- On 4/13 vs StL pinch hit and singled off Matt Bowman for his first Major League hit.

- Beginning with the 2016 season is 1 of only 4 Major League players to produce at least 76 doubles, 71 HR and 222 RBI (Nolan Arenado, Manny Machado, Justin Upton).
- Is trying to join Hall of Famer Frank Robinson as the only players in Reds history to produce at least 70 extra-base hits in 3 straight seasons.
- Has made 4 apps this season and 37 apps in his career at 1B...has made 24 career starts at that position, including 2 starts at 1B this season (4/12 vs StL, 5/15 at SF).
- In the ninth inning of last Wed's 10-inning, 2-1 win vs NYM entered the game as a defensive replacement in LF, then led off the bottom of the 10th with his first career walkoff HR (off AJ Ramos).
- In 2016 was a National League All-Star and in each of the 2016 and 2017 seasons was a finalist for the Rawlings Gold Glove Award...in 2017, led all Major League outfielders with 15 assists, the most by a Reds outfielder since Pete Rose had 15 assists in 1973.
- Fri at LAD made his 400th career appearance...is approaching 200 career runs (191).

### 4 SCOOTER GENNETT, 2b Road Trip: 12-23, 1 2b, 2hr, 6rbi, 4r

- Hit safely in 7 of his last 8 apps, raising his average 40 points from .283 to .323 (16-35, .457, 3 2b, 4hr, 10rbi).
- Hit safely in 13 of his last 15 starts (27-66, .409, 5 2b, 6hr, 17rbi).
- Played in 41 of the Reds' 43 games, off only on 5/9 vs NYM and Sun at LA and including 36 starts...from 4/30-5/4 missed 4 starts with inflammation in his right shoulder but pinch hit in each game.
- In the 12-inning, 9-7 win on 4/24 vs Atl produced his third career 2-homer game (off Brandon McCarthy, Max Fried), his first career walkoff HR (2-run off Fried) and a successful suicide squeeze bunt...became the first Major League player to produce in a game a sac bunt and 2 HR, including a walkoff, since LAD's Hee-Seop Choi on 6/20/05 vs Min and the first Reds batter to do it since Reggie Sanders on 5/31/94 vs Montreal.
- Was born in Cincinnati and lived in nearby Lebanon until he was 9 years old, when his family moved to Sarasota.

### 6 BILLY HAMILTON, cf Road Trip: 6-19, 1 3b, 2rbi, 3sb

- Hit safely in 11 of his last 14 apps, raising his batting average from .169 (14-45, .311, 2 2b, 1 3b, 1hr, 4rbi, 3sb).
- Has made 9 starts batting leadoff, a team-high 25 starts batting ninth and 2 starts batting eighth...has made 15 straight starts batting ninth since he led off on 4/26 vs Atl.
- 6 times this season walked twice, tying his single-game career high...has 24 career 2-walk games, including 6 last season.
- In Sun's 5-3 win at LA recorded 3 steals in a game for the 18th time in his career.
- Since his debut on 9/3/13 leads all Major League players in steals with 251, sixth on the Reds' all-time list since 1898...Reds Hall of Famer Eric Davis is fifth at 270.
- If he reaches 60 stolen bases in 2018 will become the first player in Major League history to steal at least 10 bases in each of his first 6 seasons while establishing a career high in each of those 6 years...is tied with Jose Reyes, Cesar Cedeño and Bert Campaneris as the only players to do it in 5 straight years.

### 12 ROSELL HERRERA, inf/of Road Trip: 2g as PH, 0-2

- Name is pronounced row-SELL her-RARE-uh.
- Made 6 of his 9 apps as a pinch hitter (0-6), including each of his last 4 apps (0-4).
- On 5/1 vs Mil made his only start, played 2B...in his first plate appearance singled off Chase Anderson for his only career hit.
- Was promoted from Louisville on 4/26, when 3B Eugenio Suarez came off the 10-day disabled list and OF Phillip Ervin and IF Cliff Pennington were optioned to Louisville.

- In the eighth inning of the 7-4 loss on 4/26 vs Atl made his Major League debut, pinch hit vs Shane Carle and grounded out (4-3)...became the fourth Reds player to make his Major League debut this season (IF Alex Blandino, RHP Zack Weiss, RHP Tanner Rainey).
- In 15 apps for Louisville hit .311 (5 2b, 2 3b, 3hr, 10rbi, 2sb)...when promoted led the International League in extra-base hits (10) and total bases (37) while ranking second in the IL slugging percentage (.607)...for the Bats played LF (4g), CF (2g), RF (3g), 2B (2g), SS (1g) and 3B (5g).
- As a non-roster invitee to Major League spring training camp hit .267 in 23 apps and 6 starts (1 2b, 1 3b, 2hr, 8rbi, 2sb, 7r)...on 3/22 was reassigned to minor league camp...wore uniform #81.

### 9 JOSÉ PERAZA, ss Road Trip: 4-25, 1 2b, 1sb

- Accent mark on the "e" in José.
- Among National League shortstops ranks among the leaders in hits and hitting.
- Beginning 4/23 has hit safely in 18 of his last 22 apps, including 6 multi-hit games (28-97, .289, 3 2b, 2hr, 6rbi, 3bb, 4sb, 14r).
- Since an 0-for-12 start to the season is hitting .285 (45-158).
- Started at SS in 41 of the Reds' 43 games and has appeared in 42 games.
- In the batting order hit first (7gs, last on Tue at SF), second (26gs), seventh (6gs) and eighth (2gs, 4/1 vs Wsh, 4/7 at Pit).
- Made his first professional apps in right field in the eighth and ninth innings of Fri's 6-2 win at LAD...does have Major League experience in CF (16g) and LF (8g).
- Received consideration for the National League Player of the Week Award for 4/23-4/29, won by teammate Joey Votto...in 7g that week hit .441 with 2 HR and 5 RBI (.618slg, .457obp).

### 43 SCOTT SCHEBLER, of Road Trip: 4-20, 1 2b, 2hr, 4rbi

- Tue at SF fell a triple shy of becoming the sixth Reds batter to hit for the cycle...Eric Davis was the last Reds batter to do it (6/2/89 vs SD).
- Homered in 2 of his last 4 apps, including Sat's go-ahead 3-run HR off LAD's J.T. Chargois and Tue's solo HR off SF's Chris Stratton.
- In 24 apps since he came off the disabled list on 4/20 is hitting .244 (20-82, 4 2b, 4hr, 15rbi).
- From 4/9-4/19 missed 10 games (1-9) while on the 10-day disabled list with a right ulnar nerve contusion...suffered the injury in the third game of the season, when he was hit on the right elbow by a Sean Doolittle pitch.
- On 4/23 vs Atl made his sixth career start batting leadoff, just his second the last 2 seasons in that spot in the order...in 2017, made his only start batting leadoff on 9/21/17 vs StL.
- Has made 16 starts in RF, 6 starts in CF and 1 start at DH.

### 7 EUGENIO SUÁREZ, inf Road Trip: 6-24, 1 2b, 2hr, 5rbi

- First name is pronounced Ay-you-hay-nee-oh...accent mark on the "a" in Suárez.
- In 19 apps since he came off the disabled list on 4/26 is hitting .297, including 7 multi-hit games (22-74, 6 2b, 5hr, 23rbi).
- Hit safely in 7 of his last 9 apps (12-36, .333, 3 2b, 3hr, 10rbi).
- From 4/9-4/25 was disabled with a fractured right thumb...suffered the injury on 4/8 at Pit, when in the fourth inning he was hit by a Jameson Taillon pitch...missed 16 games (3-13).
- In the 14-3 loss on 4/6 vs Pit started at 3B but moved to SS in the eighth inning...was his only game at SS since 8/20/17, when he made his only appearance of last season at that position...in his career has made 181 apps and 167 starts at SS.
- On 3/16 signed a 7-year contract extension through the 2024 season with a club option for 2025...following last season was eligible for arbitration for the first time while under team control through 2020.

### 19 JOEY VOTTO, 1b Road Trip: 7-18 (.389), 1hr, 3rbi, 4bb, 4r, 1sb

- Left Tue's game in the middle of the fourth inning with lower back tightness...didn't start last night but pinch hit in the ninth inning and struck out.
- Has appeared in 42 of the Reds' 43 games and started 41 games...missed his only game on 4/12 vs StL, snapping at 202 games his streaks of consecutive games played and consecutive games started...prior to that 4/12 day off, had appeared in and started every Reds game since he was given the day off at StL on 9/2/16, when Ivan De Jesus Jr. played 1B...during his 202-games started streak played 1,733.1 of the Reds' 1,782.1 innings in the field (97%)...was the longest games started streak by a Reds player since Pete Rose started 370 consecutive games from 1973-1976.
- Last night's hitless pinch-hit at bat snapped a streak in which he had reached base safely in 18 consecutive apps vs the Giants (5/17/15-5/14/18, 20-64, .313, 6 2b, 2hr, 10rbi, .500slg, .439obp)...it also snapped a 9-game hitting streak at AT&T Park (14-37, .378, 3 2b, 1hr, 4rbi, .541slg, .429obp).
- Last night's hitless pinch-hit at bat snapped a 6-game hitting streak that tied his season high (8-21, .381, 1hr, 4rbi, 4bb, 4r, 1sb, .524slg, .480obp).
- Beginning 4/15 has reached base safely in 27 of his last 29 apps (30-97, .309, 5 2b, 6hr, 19rbi), including a season-high 16-game on-base streak from 4/15-5/1...his 11-game on-base streak was snapped last night (15-40, .375, 3 2b, 2hr, 8rbi, .600slg, .468obp).
- From 4/24-4/27 vs the Braves and Twins homered in 4 consecutive apps, a career high and 1 shy of the franchise record.
- In the first inning on 4/16 at Mil singled off Brent Suter for his 1,600th career hit.
- In the first inning on 4/17 at Mil recorded his 1,000th career walk (off Junior Guerra)...is donating to the National Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum in Cooperstown the batting helmet he wore for his 1,000th walk.
- Reached 1,000 walks in 1,446 apps, the fourth-fewest games to 1,000 walks in National League history.
- Pete Rose (1,210) is the only other player in Reds history with at least 1,000 walks...Miguel Cabrera and Albert Pujols are the only other active players in the Major Leagues with at least 1,000 hits and 1,000 walks.
- From 4/23-4/29 was the NL Player of the Week, his fifth career weekly award.
- Is approaching 1,500 career apps (1,472).

### 33 JESSE WINKER, of Road Trip: 3gs in LF, 2gs in RF, 5-21, 2 2b, 1rbi

- Ranks among the National League rookie leaders in most statistical categories.
- In 24 apps beginning 4/18 is hitting .271 (23-85), including a career-high 9-game hitting streak from 4/18-4/27 that ranks as the longest by a Reds batter this season.
- From 4/10-5/6 reached base safely in 22 consecutive apps (21-71, .296, .386obp), the longest on-base streak by a Reds batter this season and when snapped the second-longest active on-base streak in the Major Leagues (Phi's Odubell Herrera, 35g).
- In his last 5 pinch-hit apps walked, singled (RBI), doubled, singled and singled.
- Has made 20 starts in RF, 10 starts in LF and 1 start at DH...leads the team with 25 starts batting leadoff...on 4/12 vs StL, with Votto off, made his first career start batting third in the order.
- Made his first Opening Day roster...was 1 of 5 rookies on the Opening Day roster (RHP Tyler Mahle, RHP Jackson Stephens, RHP Zack Weiss, OF Phillip Ervin).
- Was the Reds' Opening Day starter in LF...batted leadoff.
