ROAD TRIPPIN' REDBIRDS: The Cardinals begin a nine-game/10-day road trip to Pittsburgh, Miami, and Kansas City tonight with the first of three games against the Pittsburgh Pirates. This stretch ties the Cardinals' longest road trip of the season (9 games, July 2-11 - ARI, SF, CWS). St. Louis is 8-7 post All-Star Break and 9-7 under interim manager **Mike Shildt** since he took the post on July 15.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today tied with Pittsburgh for 3rd place in the National League Central, 6.5 games out of first place and 4.0 games out of the second Wild Card position.

ROSTER MOVES: This afternoon, the Cardinals announced that left-handed pitcher **Tyler Lyons** cleared outright waivers and was outrighted to Memphis (AAA), and right-handed pitcher **Greg Holland** cleared release waivers and was released.

TAKING CARE OF BUSINESS: The Cardinals are 31-24 against the NL Central this season (17-16 on the road), with only Atlanta (32-16 vs. NL East) sporting more divisional wins in the NL. St. Louis has 53 games remaining on their schedule with 21 against NL Central opponents (CIN 3; PIT 9; CHI 3; MIL 6).

CARPENTER WINS PLAYER OF THE MONTH: **Matt Carpenter** was voted NL Player of the Month for July yesterday...the 32-year-old batted .333 (31-for-93) with 22 runs scored, 8 doubles, 11 home runs, 21 RBI and 19 walks across 26 games.. among July qualified NL hitters, Carpenter finished 1st in runs, home runs, extra-base hits (19) and slugging pct. (.774), 2nd in on-base pct. (.447), T2nd walks, T4th in doubles, T5th in RBI, and 6th in hits. It was Carpenter's first career NL Player of the Month Award and the St. Louis' first since **Albert Pujols** in August 2010.

THATS A WALK-OFF: **Jose Martínez** sent Cardinals fans home happy yesterday with a two-run pinch-hit single in the bottom of the 9th, becoming the 7th different Cardinal with a walk-off RBI. It marked the Cardinals' 9th walk-off win this season and only the third not on a home run. The last time the Cardinals trailed entering the bottom of the 9th and won with a pinch-hit in the bottom of the ninth was June 17, 2004 vs. Oakland; St. Louis trailed 4-2 heading into the bottom of the ninth and **Reggie Sanders** delivered a pinch hit walk-off RBI single to break a 4-4 tie (*Elias*). St. Louis' nine walk-off wins lead MLB, are the club's most since 2015 (9), and are four fewer than the franchise record of 13 from the 1991 and 1992 seasons.

MOLINA MILESTONES: With tonight's game behind the plate, **Yadier Molina** reaches 1,793 career games at catcher and ties Hall of Famer **Gabby Harnett** (1922-41) for 14th place all-time among catchers in Major League history...Hall of Famer **Rick Ferrell** (1929-47) ranks 13th with 1,806 games.

YOUNG GUNS: The Cardinals used six pitchers in Wednesday night's win, with five pulling rookie status. Only starting pitcher, **Luke Weaver**, does not qualify as a rookie. The 21-year old rookie, **Jordan Hicks**, had appeared in more games than any of his other pitching mates as he made his 51st appearance (T8th NL) of the season, while Weaver (44th career), **Mike Mayers** (40th career), winning pitcher **Austin Gomber** (18th), **Daniel Poncedeleon** (3rd) and **Dakota Hudson** (3rd), all saw action in the win. The last time the Cardinals used five or more rookie pitchers in a game was September. 25, 2017 vs. Cubs (**Luke Weaver**, **Jack Flaherty**, **Ryan Sherriff**, **Sandy Alcántara**, and **Josh Lucas**) (*Elias*).

NEW FACES: Only six Cardinal players have been active for every game this season (**Jordan Hicks**, **Bud Norris**, **Miles Mikolas**, **Francisco Peña**, **Matt Carpenter**, **Marcell Ozuna**), while six coaches remain from St. Louis' Opening Day roster.

PITTSBURGH CONNECTIONS

Pitcher **Carlos Martínez** was teammates with Pirates pitcher **Ivan Nova** and outfielders **Starling Marte** and **Gregory Polanco** for the Dominican Republic in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

Infielder **Paul DeJong** was originally selected by the Pirates in the 38th round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

Pitching coach **Mike Maddux** signed with the Pirates in April 1995 and pitched in eight games before being released in May.

Pitcher **Miles Mikolas** spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason...traded by San Diego with infielder **Jaff Decker** to Pittsburgh in exchange for outfielder **Alex Dickerson** (November 25, 2013), then traded by Pittsburgh to the Rangers in exchange for infielder **Chris McGuinness** (December 30, 2013).

Infielder **Jedd Gyorko** was born in Morgantown, WV...played at West Virginia University (2008-10).

First base coach **Oliver Marmol** was originally selected by the Pirates in the 31st round of the 2004 MLB draft, but did not sign.

Pitcher **Tyler Webb** was claimed off waivers by the Pirates from the Yankees in the 2016 Rule 5 Draft...pitched in eight Spring Training games for Pittsburgh in 2017, but was returned to the Yankees before the regular season began.

Outfielder **Dexter Fowler** and outfielder **Corey Dickerson** were teammates in Colorado in 2013.

Catcher **Francisco Peña's** father, **Tony**, was an All-Star catcher for the Pirates (1980-86)...later traded by Pittsburgh to the Cardinals for pitcher **Mike Dunne**, catcher **Mike LaValliere** and outfielder **Andy Van Slyke** (April 1, 1987.)

Catcher **Yadier Molina** (June 3, 2004), pitcher **Matt Bowman** (April 6, 2016), infielder **José Martínez** (September 6, 2016) and pitcher **Austin Gomber** (June 2, 2018) all made their MLB debuts against Pittsburgh.

Infielder **David Freese** played parts of five seasons in St. Louis (2009-13)...member of the 2011 World Series Champions...hit only walk-off home run in Cardinals WS history in Game 6... recognized as 2011 WS and NLCS MVP...selected to 2012 NL All-Star ...later traded by St. Louis with RHP **Fernando Salas** to the Angels for OF **Peter Bourjos** and OF **Randal Grichuk** (November 22, 2013)...graduated from Lafayette (Mo.) High School in Wildwood.

Manager **Clint Hurdle** was selected by St. Louis from the Mets in the 1985 Rule 5 Draft and played in 86 games for the Cardinals in 1986.

Infielder **Sean Rodriguez's** father, **Johnny**, is the manager of the Springfield Cardinals (AA) of the Texas League.

Pitching Coach **Ray Seearge** was selected by St. Louis in the 22nd round of the 1976 MLB Draft... later traded to the Mets for catcher **Jody Davis** in 1979...began coaching career in the Cardinals minor league system as Pitching Coach with Madison (1994), Peoria (1995-96) and Prince William (1997).

Pirates Baseball Operations Senior Advisor **Nick Leyva** was drafted by St. Louis in the 24th round in 1975...played three minor league seasons in the Cardinals system (1975-77)...managed six minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization (1978-83)...served as St. Louis' First Base Coach (1984-85) and Third Base Coach (1986-88).

Former Cardinals (1983-86) and Pirates (1987-94) All-Star outfielder **Andy Van Slyke** is being honored and celebrated in a pair of bobbleheads this season at Busch Stadium (April 24 vs. New York Mets) and PNC Park (August 4 vs. St. Louis).

Cardinals Baseball Information & Media Services Coordinator **Chris Tunno** graduated from nearby Canfield (Ohio) High School.

Pirates Manager of Business Communications & Social Media **Terry Rodgers** previously worked as a Public Relations Specialist in the Cardinals Communications department (2010-11).

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Makes his 9th start of the season (16th appearance) and 18th career Major League start (43rd career appearance).
- Has taken rotation spot of Michael Wacha, who's currently on DL with left oblique strain.
- Is 1-4 with 3.80 ERA (18 ER/42.2 IP) in eight starts for St. Louis, averaging 7.6 strikeouts/9 IP (36 K).
- Is 2-0 with a 2.70 ERA in seven relief appearances (16.2 IP).
- Is limiting the opposition to a .200 average against (44-220) this season, 3rd-lowest (min. 250 batters faced) in the NL behind Max Scherzer (.183) & Aaron Nola (.199). He sports a .203 OPP AVG (32-158) as a starting pitcher.
- All six home runs allowed this season have been hit by left-handers: Odúbel Herrera, Freddie Freeman, Pablo Sandoval, Tucker Barnhart, Ben Zobrist & Anthony Rizzo.
- Features a split-finger change-up nicknamed the "Vulcan" due to his unique four-finger grip. Has the highest pct. of swing & miss on a change-up of any Cardinals pitcher.

LAST TIME OUT

- Took the mound for ESPN Sunday Night game last Sun. (7/29) and was charged with 5-2 loss, allowing three runs (2 earned) on 2 HR's in 4.1 IP.
- The 4.1 IP matched his shortest start of the season (also 5/19 vs. PHI).

- Threw 1.0 inning of relief in a 7-3 defeat at Cincinnati allowing 2-run HR by T. Barnhart.
- Had 5.0 scoreless innings in Game 2 of 7/21 doubleheader against the Cubs at Wrigley Field as Cards scored five unanswered runs over the final three innings for a 6-3 victory.
- Was the most recent Cardinals pitcher to start Game 2 of a doubleheader since Marco Gonzales vs. MIL (6/13/17) and to do so against the Cubs since Tim Cooney (7/7/15).
- Had a career-best scoreless innings streak of 9.0 innings from 7/15-7/21.
- Hurlled 4.0 scoreless innings without allowing at hit vs. CIN (7/15) to earn the win in Mike Shildt's managerial debut. It was the longest relief outing by a Cardinals pitcher in 2018 and the 2nd-longest relief outing of Gant's career (4.2 IP at BOS 4/27/16 w/ATL).
- Took the rotation turn of Michael Wacha (10-day D.L.) and tossed 7.0 scoreless innings with one infield hit allowed, earning a 4-0 win against Cleveland (6/25).
- Was recalled from Memphis (AAA) on 6/21 and worked 2.0 innings in relief at MIL, striking out 2 and allowing 4 unearned runs on 3 hits.
- Was 5-1 with a 1.65 ERA in his eight starts overall at Memphis (AAA) this season.
- Struck out 7 in consecutive starts: 5/19 vs. PHI & 5/25 at PIT (14 K's/9.2 IP).
- Worked in relief of Adam Wainwright in St. Louis' 5-3 loss to the Padres at PETCO Park (5/13). Set single-game team highs for relief IP (3.2) and tied for strikeouts in relief (4).
