Extra-Base Hits

2B Ozzie Albies collected his 50th extra-base hit of the year last night, doubling in the first inning.

Albie's double tied him with Hank Aaron (1957) and Wally Berger (1934) as the second quickest player to 50 extra-base hits over the franchise's last 110 seasons.

Aaron holds the Braves record over the last 110 seasons for quickest to 50 extra-base hits, reaching the mark by game No. 71 in 1959.

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Brewers continue a four-game set today with the third meeting between the clubs this season...The Braves took four of six matchups last year to win the season series with Milwaukee for the third time in the last four seasons... The Brewers will travel to Atlanta for a three-game set, August 10-12.

A Atlanta has not lost a set in Milwaukee since 2013...They have dropped the first two games of this series.

A RHP Anibal Sánchez is scheduled to make his ninth career appearance, all starts, against Milwaukee...The right-hander is 2-2 with a 6.37 ERA (29 ER/41.0 IP) lifetime against Milwaukee, and has allowed 23 runs, 22 earned, over his last four starts (10.42 ERA) that date back to 2010 and his time with Florida.

A RHP Aaron Wilkerson has never faced Atlanta and is set to make his fifth career appearance, third start, today...In his only game at the major league level this season, the native of Fort Worth, Texas allowed five runs, earned, over 3.0 innings of relief on July 1 at Cincinnati.

SKID: The Braves lost their season-high fourth consecutive game last night...They were the only National League team to not have a losing streak longer than three games this season.

A Last season, the Braves suffered a five-game losing streak by game No. 7...They lost a season-high six games four different times.

SIGNED: The Braves signed 33 of their 39 draft choices from the 2018 First-Year Player Draft, after they inked a deal with RHP Victor Vodnik of Rialto High School in Rialto, Calif ahead of yesterday's 5 p.m. signing deadline...Vodnik was the only high schooler the club signed.

A The club signed nine of their first 10 picks.

A The Braves used 34 of their 39 total picks on collegiate players, including second-round pick OF Greyson Jenista from Wichita State University...Of the 33 signees, 32 came from the collegiate ranks...Eighteen are pitchers, four are outfielders, three are catchers and eight are infielders.

A The complete list of signed players can be found on page seven of the notes at the bottom of the minor league report.

LONG RELIEF: LHP Jesse Biddle tossed 2.0 scoreless innings last night, his ninth relief outing of more than three outs this season.

A In these nine outings, Biddle has tossed 19.1 shutout innings, striking out 28 and allowing just 12 hits.

A Biddle has compiled a 10.0 K/9 ratio this season.

OZZIE: 2B Ozzie Albies finished 1-for-4 with his 29th double of the year yesterday, and the second baseman has now tied the single-season franchise record for most two-base hits prior to the All-Star game...Marcus Giles also had 29 in 2003.

A Albies now has a N.L.-most 50 extra-base hits this season, the third most prior to the All-Star break in franchise history...The club record is 53 by Hank Aaron in 1959...Darrell Evans is the only other Braves hitter to reach 50 by the break, finishing with 51 in 1973.

A He became the sixth second baseman (seventh time overall; Chase Utley accomplished the feat twice) in MLB history to collect at least 50 extra-base hits before the All-Star Game and the first since Ian Kinsler (52) and Utley (53) in 2008...The record is 54 by San Francisco's Jeff Kent in 2000.

A Albies is on pace for 93 extra-base hits this season... Only one other second baseman in the modern era (since 1900) reached that mark: Rogers Hornsby did it twice, finishing with 102 in 1922 for St. Louis and 94 in 1929 for Chicago (NL).

A The franchise's modern-era record is 92 by Hank Aaron in 1959...Giles had the most for a Braves second baseman with 72 in 2003.

A Albies has now hit safely in 15 of his last 16 games (30-for-73, .411)...Albies' hot streak began with a pinch-hit double on June 17 vs. San Diego, the first game he did not start this season.

MINTER: A.J. Minter has converted all four of his save chances this season, and is the first Braves left-hander with multiple saves in a season since Jonny Venters had five in 2011.

A The last rookie lefty with more than four saves in a season was Chris Sale, who had eight in 2011.

50 WINS: Atlanta is looking for its 50th win of the season today, and the club is trying to become the 18th Braves team in franchise history to reach that milestone prior to the All-Star break.

A The franchise record is 61 by the 2003 team...The last Braves team to reach 50 by the break was the 2014 club, which went 52-43.

LATE-GAME BRAVES: The Braves plated three of their four runs in the seventh inning last night, and have now scored 158 times after the sixth inning this season... That total is third most in the majors and trails only Chicago's 161 sum for the most in the National League.

A SS Dansby Swanson had both of his hits last night in these later inning, and he is hitting .324 (34-for-105) after the sixth inning this season...That is the fifth-best average in the National League.

RUNS: The Braves have scored 431 times this season, one off the National League lead of Chicago.

Today's Game

- A* Makes his 10th start of the season (11th appearance) and the 272nd (295th appearance) of his career.
- A* Faces Milwaukee for the ninth time in his career...Is 2-2 with a 6.37 ERA (29 ER/41.0 IP) in his first eight appearances.
 - A* His 6.37 ERA against the Brewers is his highest against any team in the National League...Only Texas (8.37 ERA) and Baltimore (7.03 ERA) have scored against him at a higher clip.
 - A* Brewers batters have hit .335 (58-for-173) against him...Among active pitchers to have at least 40.0 innings against any one opponent, Sanchez's .335 average against Milwaukee is 12th highest in the majors.
- A* Last pitched on Monday, 7/2, and starts today on four days' rest...Is 1-0 with a 0.95 ERA (2 ER/19.0 IP) in his previous three starts on four days' rest this season.
 - A* Is 2-2 with a 4.35 ERA (15 ER/31.0 IP) in six starts with five or more days between turns.
- A* Allowing opponents to hit just .195 (8-for-41) with runners in scoring position, including a .105 (2-for-19) mark in such situations with two outs.

2018 Recap

- A* Turned in a quality outing during his last turn, 7/2 at NYY...Allowed six hits and three runs over 6.0 innings in a no decision...Atlanta won 5-3 in 11 innings.
 - A* The win for Atlanta snapped a two-game losing streak for the club in Sanchez's starts...The Braves are 6-2 over his last eight turns.
- A* Tossed just 4.2 innings, 6/26 vs. CIN, and allowed five hits and two runs to take his second consecutive loss.
 - A* Was removed after throwing just 73 pitches due to cramping in his right calf.
- A* Took his first loss of the season, 6/20 at TOR...Allowed five hits and a season high-tying four runs over 5.0 innings...Set season highs in walks (4) and strikeouts (7).
 - A* The loss snapped a streak of three straight wins to open the season...Opened a season 3-0 for the second time in his career...Won the first four decisions of his major league career to open his rookie campaign 4-0 in 2006.
- A* Won two consecutive starts, 6/9 at LAD (5.1 IP, 2 R) and 6/14 vs. SD (7.0 IP, 0 R)...The wins were the first of his career against each team.
 - A* Entered the stretch winless against just three major league teams, all three of which played in California...Was winless against the Dodgers, Padres and Los Angeles Angels (0-4) before defeating Los Angeles-NL and San Diego in his last two turns.
- A* Allowed a pair of unearned runs over a season most-tying 7.0 innings, 6/3 vs. WSH...Allowed just four total baserunners.
 - A* His 2.01 career ERA (33 ER/147.2 IP) against the Nationals/Expos is the lowest all-time mark by a qualifying pitcher against the franchise...His .900 (9-1) winning percentage is tied for the best mark all-time against the Nationals/Expos (minimum 10 decisions).
- A* Returned from the disabled list, 5/29, and started that night vs. NYM...Allowed five hits and four runs over 4.0 innings in a no-decision.
 - A* Missed 37 games after suffering a right hamstring strain on 4/18.
- A* Began a rehabilitation assignment with Triple-A Gwinnett on 5/21 and made two rehab starts with the Strippers...Combined to go 0-1 with a 10.80 ERA (8 ER/6.2 IP).
- A* Suffered a right hamstring strain during pregame warmups on 4/18 and was placed on the 10-day disabled list that night.
- A* Snapped a career-long six-game losing streak, 4/13 at CHI...Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts, allowing just three hits and one walk in the Braves' 4-0 shutout of the Cubs.
 - A* Went 0-6 with a 6.51 ERA (34 ER/47.0 IP) during the losing streak, which dated to 8/6/17 at BAL and spanned 11 games (10 starts)...Received just 13 runs of support during the stretch, an average of 1.18 runs per turn...Received either one or zero runs of support in eight of the 11 games.
- A* Made his first start of the season and went 5.0 innings and allowed seven hits and two runs, 4/7 at COL...Atlanta lost 3-2 in the 10th inning.
 - A* Is undefeated in six career starts against the Rockies...Sánchez is one of nine pitchers in history to make at least five starts against the Rockies and log an ERA under 2.00...Only five of those pitchers -- Sánchez, Jacob deGrom, Tom Koehler, Mark Prior and Bill Swift -- have done so without taking a loss
- A* Made his Braves debut with 3.0 innings of scoreless relief on 4/2 vs. WSH...Allowed one hit and three walks after having his contract selected from Triple-A Gwinnett that afternoon.
 - A* Signed by Atlanta to a minor-league contract on 3/16 after spending the bulk of spring training in camp with the Twins.

Career Recap

- A* 2018 marks his 13th major league campaign...Played the first six-and-a-half seasons (2006-12) of his career with the Marlins, before spending the last five-and-a-half seasons (2012-17) with Detroit.

Jesse Biddle • LHP • 6-5 • 220 • 26 yrs • #63

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 2 **1st Batter/Retired:** 27/19 **Inherited Runners/Score:** 6/3

- Over his last 17 appearances, has a 2.11 ERA (5 ER/21.1 IP) with a .155 (11-for-71) opponents' average.
- Tossed a scoreless ninth and 10th innings, 7/2 at NYY, to earn his second win of the season... In four extra-inning outings this season, has tossed 8.0 scoreless innings with four hits and 14 strikeouts.
- Earned his first career hold with a scoreless seventh inning, 6/24 vs. BAL, and has holds in two of his last five outings...Became the sixth Atlanta pitcher with a hold this season.
- Right-handed batters have just nine hits in 75 at-bats (.120) against him...Lefties are hitting .333/.429/.619 with 14 hits, six walks, three doubles, three home runs and nine RBI.
- Set career highs in IP (3.0) and strikeouts (8), 6/2 vs. WSH... Became the first Braves reliever in 110 seasons to strike out at least eight batters in that few innings...MIL's Josh Hader struck out eight in 2.2 IP, 4/30/18 at CIN.

Shane Carle • RHP • 6-4 • 210 • 26 yrs • #51

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 11 **1st Batter/Retired:** 36/23 **Inherited Runners/Score:** 15/3

- Is one of three rookie relievers for Atlanta with at least 10 holds...No other team has more than one.
- Is one of nine relievers in the majors with at least four wins and 10 holds.
- Tossed 3.0 perfect innings of relief, 7/5 at MIL...Had allowed five earned runs over his previous 3.1 frames, spanning two appearances.
- Holding batters to a .182 (14-for-77) average with men on base and has allowed just six hits (6-for-44, .136) with runners in scoring position...Batters are hitting .253 (23-for-91) with no one on base.
- Has a 5.40 ERA (12 ER/20.0 IP) in his last 16 appearances dating to 5/21 at PHI...Pitched to a 0.69 ERA in his first 20 games of the season.

Sam Freeman • LHP • 5-11 • 180 • 31 yrs • #39

Saves/Opp: 0/3 **Holds:** 6 **1st Batter/Retired:** 42/27 **Inherited Runners/Score:** 29/8

- Is 1-3 with a 6.88 ERA (13 ER/17.0 IP) in his last 18 appearances...Surrendered 15 hits and nine walks during the spell, including a pair of home runs, and has allowed at least one run in eight of those outings.
- Had a 8.49 ERA (11 ER/11.2 IP) in 12 games in June.
- Left-handed batters are hitting just 9-for-48 (.188) against him.
- Has inherited 29 runners on the season, and has stranded 21 (73%)...Inherited just 19 runners last season.
- Took the loss, 4/23 at CIN...The loss snapped a streak of 190 consecutive games without a loss, the longest such active streak in the majors at the time...Freeman's run, which is the third-longest in MLB history, dated to 10/3/12...Only Trevor Miller (240 games, 2006-09) and Peter Moylan (present) had a longer streak in MLB history.

Luiz Gohara • LHP • 6-3 • 265 • 21 yrs • #53

Saves/Opp: 1/1 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 7/5 **Inherited Runners/Score:** 2/1

- Recalled, 7/4, from Triple-A Gwinnett for his second stint on the active roster...Also up from 5/8-6/16...Opened the season on Atlanta's disabled list (left ankle sprain), before being returned from his rehab and optioned to Gwinnett on 4/27.
- In three starts with the Stripers since being optioned, is 1-1 with a 4.09 ERA (5 ER/11.0 IP)...Fanned 13... Earned his first win of the season in his last appearance, 6/30 at Charlotte (5.0 IP, 2 ER).
- His appearance on 6/4 at SD was his first since 5/23 at PHI in a 4.0-inning start...Reinstated from the Restricted List on 6/3...Was originally placed on the Bereavement/Family Medical Emergency List on 5/25.
- Earned his first professional save in his season debut (3.0 IP, 1 R/ER), 5/10 at MIA.

Luke Jackson • RHP • 6-2 • 210 • 26 yrs • #64

Saves/Opp: 1/1 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 10/7 **Inherited Runners/Score:** 5/1

- Threw a career-most 62 pitches over 3.0 innings, 7/3 at NYY...Allowed one run and struck out five.
- Earned his first win of the season with a scoreless 11th inning, 6/25 vs. CIN...Is 3-0 in his major league career.
- Is 1-0 with a 3.38 ERA (5 ER/13.1 IP) in 10 relief appearances with Atlanta this season...Earned his first career save on 6/5 at SD.
- Has fanned 18 batters in his 13.1 innings with Atlanta, and has struck out 52 batters in 34.2 combined innings (13.5 SO/9.0 IP) between the Braves and Triple-A Gwinnett.
- Signed as a major league free agent, 6/17, his fourth stint with Atlanta this season...Was with the Braves most recently from 6/5 before being DFA'd on 6/13 and outrighted to Gwinnett on 6/14...He elected free agent on 6/15...Also with Atlanta from 4/4 to 4/15 and 5/6 to 5/8.
- Went 2-1 with a 1.69 ERA (4 ER/21.1 IP) in 10 appearances (one start) w/ Gwinnett.

A.J. Minter • LHP • 6-0 • 215 • 24 yrs • #33

Saves/Opp: 4/4 **Holds:** 11 **1st Batter/Retired:** 39/26 **Inherited Runners/Score:** 10/3

- Has pitched to a 1.26 ERA (2 ER/14.1 IP) over his last 15 games, allowing opponents to hit just .111 (5-for-45)... Has recorded 17 of the 43 outs via strikeout during this stretch (40%), and has walked just two.
- Has not blown a lead this season...Is a perfect 11-for-11 in hold chances and has converted all four of his save opportunities...Four saves are second most among rookie relievers in the majors.
- Used 12 pitches to strike out the side, 6/6 at SD...Was his second career outing that went at least 1.0 inning with him striking out each batter he faced (also 4/11/18 at WSH, 13 pitches)
