## NATIONALS NEWS

### MOVING ON...

The Washington Nationals dropped the series finale against the Miami Marlins, 10-2 but managed to walk away with a series win, going 3-1 in the four-game series...The Nationals scored 37 runs in this four-game series against the Marlins, the second-most in a four-game series in Nationals history (2005-pres.).

- The Nationals begin one last seven-day road trip before the All-Star Break that will include games against the Pittsburgh Pirates (3 G) and the New York (4 G).

### IT'S ALL IN THE STARS

As the hometown club, the Washington Nationals will be well represented at next week's Midsummer Classic... Nationals closer **Sean Doolittle**, outfielder **Bryce Harper** and right-handed pitcher **Max Scherzer** have been selected to represent the Washington Nationals in the 2018 Major League Baseball All-Star Game.

- Doolittle earned his second All-Star nod, his first since 2014 with Oakland.
- Harper will start in the National League outfield for the fourth consecutive year and for the fifth time overall...It will mark Harper's sixth All-Star appearance in seven Major League seasons.
- This marks the sixth straight All-Star selection for Scherzer, four of which have been with the Nationals.

### VOTE FOR TREA!

Shortstop **Trea Turner** was named one of five candidates for the National League Final Vote to the All-Star Game...Fans can cast their votes from now through Wednesday at 4:00 p.m. by visiting Nationals.com or MLB.com...The winners of the Final Vote will be announced live on MLB Network on Wednesday at 8:00 p.m. ET.

- Washington's come-from-behind win on Thursday night was powered by Turner, who went 3-for-5 with two home runs (including the go-ahead grand slam), eight RBI and three runs scored...His eight RBI were tied for the most by a leadoff hitter in Major League history and were tied for second-most in a game by any hitter in Nationals history (2005-pres.).
- Over his last 18 games, **Trea Turner** is 28-for-79 (.354) with one double, one triple, four homers, 12 RBI, six walks, two stolen bases and 17 runs scored...He has a .407 on-base percentage and a .544 slugging percentage during this stretch.
- Turner leads National League shortstops in Wins Above Replacement (3.1), according to FanGraphs.com...He is hitting .278 with 14 doubles, two triples, 11 home runs, 37 RBI, 40 walks, 22 stolen bases and 54 runs scored in 89 games...His 22 stolen bases rank tied for third in the National League.

### REYNOLDS REVS IT UP

Following a week in which he hit .625 (10-for-16) with two doubles, three homers, 12 RBI, three walks and seven runs scored in seven games, Nationals infielder **Mark Reynolds** was rewarded by being named the National League Player of the Week on Monday.

- This marks his fourth career Player of the Week honor and his first since April 25, 2010 as a member of the Arizona Diamondbacks...His week included his second career walk-off home run, a pinch-hit solo shot on Friday against Miami followed by a historic performance on Saturday where he went 5-for-5 with a double, two home runs, 10 RBI and three runs scored in Washington's 18-4 win.

### DOOOOOOOOOOOOOOOOOOOOOOO

Closer **Sean Doolittle** leads National League relievers in strikeout-to-walk ratio (16.33), opp. OBP (.167) and WHIP (0.54)...He leads the National League with a 95.7 save% (22-for-23), while his 22 saves rank fourth in the National League.

- In 15 games dating to May 22 vs. San Diego, Doolittle has gone 2-0 while converting all 12 saves...During this stretch, he has allowed just one earned run in 16.2 IP (0.54 ERA)...He has struck out 17 batters and has not issued a walk...Opposing batters are hitting .127 (7-for-55) with one extra-base hit (HR).
- Doolittle has thrown at least 1.0 inning without issuing a walk in 29 straight appearances...That run is a Major League record, topping BOS **Koji Uehara's** 28-game run from Aug. 4, 2013 to April 17, 2014.

### SUMMER OF SOTO

**Juan Soto** leads all MLB rookies (min. 175 PA), in batting average (.302), on-base percentage (.419), and OPS (.956)...His .537 slugging percentage is second behind NYY **Gleyber Torres** (.555)...Though he was called up on May 20, he ranks among NL rookies in walks (3rd, 30), HR (T3rd, 8), doubles (T5th, 11) and RBI (T6th, 26).

- Since May 15 (the date of his "first" game due to the suspended game vs. NYY), he leads National League rookies in walks (1st, 30), home runs (T1st, 8), doubles (T2nd, 11), and RBI (1st, 26).
- Among all National League players (min. 175 PA), Soto ranks in on-base percentage (2nd, .419) and OPS (5th, .956).

### EXTRA! EXTRA!

Since June 15, **Anthony Rendon's** 17 extra-base hits are third-most in MLB behind STL **Matt Carpenter** (18) and HOU **Alex Bregman** (18)...On the season, Rendon is tied for 10th in the National League with 37 extra base hits...His 25 doubles rank fourth in the National League.

### HARPER'S HOMERS

**Bryce Harper** clubbed his 21st home run of the season on July 2, a solo shot in the eighth inning...Harper's 21 home runs rank third-most in the National League.

- Harper's 35 extra-base hits rank third among NL outfielders behind ATL **Nick Markakis** (37) and ARI **David Peralta** (36).

## NATIONALS HISTORY

### July 9 (5-5 on this date)

2010 - **Andres Torres** homered on the game's fifth pitch, but **Stephen Strasburg** took charge and blanked the Giants thereafter as the Nationals pounded the Giants, 8-1, at Nationals Park. **Adam Dunn** homered twice off **Matt Cain** (27th career multi-homer game) and nearly homered again, as his sixth-inning double crashed two feet from the top of the left-center field fence

## OPPONENT

### PITTSBURGH PIRATES

Former National **Felipe Vázquez** (formerly Rivero) now pitches out of Pittsburgh's bullpen...In the late 1930s and early 40s, the Negro League's Homestead Grays played their home games at Forbes Field in Pittsburgh, but also scheduled games in D.C. at their alternate home, Griffith Stadium.

### THE SERIES

The Nationals and Pirates will play seven times in 2018...Washington dropped the season series (3-4) in 2017 for the first time since 2013...The Nationals have won six of the last eight matchups and since May 24, 2014, Washington is 19-10 against Pittsburgh.

## DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

**#68 - JEFY RODRIGUEZ - RHP**

Tall, hard-throwing righty was added to Washington's 40-man roster following the 2017 season...Embarked on his first Major League Spring Training in 2018...Baseball America cites him as the No. 24 prospect in Washington's Minor League system and as having the "Best Fastball" among Nationals farmhands.

**AGAINST THE PIRATES:** Has never faced the Pirates.

**LAST START:** In his second career start, he tossed 4.0 IP striking out three batters along the way while giving up four runs on five hits...He did not factor into the decision of Washington's 8-6 win over the Baltimore Orioles.

**2018 NOTES**

- Was recalled on July 5 for third career Major League stint...Made two starts in his previous stint.
- Was recalled on June 19 for his second career Major League stint.
- Made his Major League debut on June 3 at Atlanta...Was called upon in the bottom of the first inning after Jeremy Hellickson left the game due to injury...Impressed with 4.2 innings of four-hit, shutout ball...Struck out three batters while issuing just two walks.
- Is 5-3 with a 3.31 ERA in 13 starts for Double-A Harrisburg...Has 72 strikeouts and a .222 opp. batting average.
- Has not allowed an earned run in his last three Double-A starts...Has allowed just four hits while striking out 21 batters.
- Has struck out a season-high nine batters twice (4/18 vs. Reading and 5/21 at Hartford).

**2017 NOTES**

- Went 4-3 with a 3.32 ERA in 12 games (10 starts) for Single-A Potomac.
- Left-handed batters hit just .175 with a .283 on-base percentage and a .213 slugging percentage against him (14-for-80, 3 2B, 23 SO).
- Finished the season strong, posting a 2.81 ERA (5 ER/16.0 IP) with a .196 opponent batting average (10-for-51) in his final five games/three starts.
- Improved his WHIP (1.11), hits per 9.0 IP (6.9), strikeouts per 9.0 IP (8.1), walks per 9.0 IP (3.0) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.68) during the 2017 season as compared to 2016, with all numbers proving better than his career numbers
