**#13 • NICK AHMED • R/R**      **6-2 • 195 • 28 (March 15, 1990)**  
**COL Series:** 0-10, RBI, BB, SB      **Trip:** 0-10, RBI, BB, SB

- ◆ Boasts a career-high in homers (16), doubles (29) and RBI (66).
- ◆ Is hitting .277 (41-for-148)/.779 OPS with 4 homers and 26 RBI in his last 47 games.
- ◆ His 16 homers and 65 RBI are third most by a D-backs shortstops...needs 1 RBI to pass Stephen Drew (65 in 2009) for second place and 2 to tie Drew's club record in 2008 [stats as SS only].
- ◆ His 55 defensive runs saved at shortstop since 2015 are second in the NL behind Addison Russell (57) and ahead of Brandon Crawford (53).

**VS. ROCKIES**  
 Has 6 doubles, 1 triple, 3 home runs, 17 RBI and a .991 OPS in 14 games this season.

**#4 • KETEL MARTE • S/R (kuh-TELL)**      **6-1 • 185 • 24 (Oct. 12, 1993)**  
**COL Series:** 2-4, 3B, 4 RBI      **Trip:** 2-4, 3B, 4 RBI

- ◆ **NL RANKINGS:** 1st in 3B (11).
- ◆ Own career highs in virtually all offensive categories, including home runs (10), doubles (23), RBI (51) and hits (119).
- ◆ Tied his career high with 4 RBI on Sept. 11 @ Rockies (also: July 20 vs. Rockies).
- ◆ Is hitting .310 (13-for-42) in his last 15 games.
- ◆ Is batting .373 (25-for-67)/.476 OBP with 2 homers and 10 RBI in last 25 home games.
- ◆ Leads NL second baseman with a .993 fielding pct. (3 E in 447 TC).

**#5 • ALEX AVILA • R/L**      **5-11 • 210 • 31 (Jan. 29, 1987)**  
**COL Series:** 1-5, HR, RBI, BB, R      **Trip:** 1-5, HR, RBI, BB, R

- ◆ Boasts a .884 OPS with 6 doubles, 5 home runs, 16 RBI and 21 walks in last 32 games.
- ◆ Ranks fifth in the NL with a 32.1 caught stealing pct. (9-for-28) [min. 50 G].
- ◆ Made his first appearance as a pitcher on July 11 @ Rockies (0 ER in 2.0 IP).
- ◆ Reached base a career-high-tying 5 times on July 7 vs. Padres.

**#2 • JEFF MATHIS • R/R**      **6-0 • 205 • 35 (March 31, 1983)**  
**COL Series:** 1-4      **Trip:** 1-4

- ◆ Is batting .258 (8-for-31) over his last 13 games.
- ◆ His 3.03 catcher ERA leads the NL and ranks third in the Majors [min. 200.0 IC] behind Brian McCann/HOU (2.43) and Josh Phegley/OAK (2.59).
- ◆ Has a 80-game errorless streak (726 TC) as catcher since June 22, 2017.

**#19 • SÓCRATES BRITO • L/L**      **6-2 • 215 • 26 (Sept. 6, 1992)**  
**COL Series:** 1-1      **Trip:** 1-1

- ◆ Recalled from Triple-A Reno on Sept. 1.
- ◆ In 114 games for Reno, he hit .318 (136-for-428)/.383 OBP/.540 SLG with 34 doubles, 5 triples, 17 homers, 69 RBI, 44 walks and 15 stolen bases.

**#36 • JOHN RYAN MURPHY • R/R**      **5-11 • 205 • 27 (May 13, 1991)**  
**COL Series:** -      **Trip:** -

- ◆ 9 home runs and 24 RBI are career highs (previous: 3 HR & 14 RBI in 2015).
- ◆ His 9 homers are tied for eighth among NL catchers [as catcher only].
- ◆ In 41 starts overall, is batting .226 (36-for-159) with 6 doubles, 9 homers and 23 RBI.

**#3 • DANIEL DESCALSO • R/L**      **5-10 • 190 • 30 (Oct. 19, 1986)**  
**COL Series:** 0-5, 2 BB      **Trip:** 0-5, 2 BB

- ◆ 12 home runs and 55 RBI are a career high.
- ◆ Has reached base safely in 28 of his last 30 starts, posting a .408 on-base pct.
- ◆ Made his fifth career pitching appearance on July 11 @ Rockies (3 ER in 2.2 IP).
- ◆ Since 2010, ranks among active NL pinch hitters in plate appearances (1st, 281), times on base (1st, 85), hits (1st, 54), home runs (3rd, 6) and RBI (T-3rd, 33).

**#16 • CHRIS OWINGS • R/R**      **5-10 • 185 • 27 (Aug. 12, 1991)**  
**COL Series:** 0-1      **Trip:** 0-1

- ◆ Recalled from Triple-A Reno on Sept. 1...in 21 games with the Aces, hit .286 with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 1 home run, 11 RBI and 15 runs scored.
- ◆ Has made 39 appearances in right field, 13 in center field, 12 at third, 9 at second base and 3 in left field...has not committed an error in right field (55 TC).
- ◆ Since 2013, ranks sixth in MLB with an 84.1 stolen base pct. [min. 50 attempts].

**#14 • EDUARDO ESCOBAR • R/L**      **5-10 • 185 • 29 (Jan. 5, 1989)**  
**COL Series:** 5-12, HR, 3 RBI, 3 R      **Trip:** 5-12, HR, 3 RBI, 3 R

- ◆ **MLB RANKINGS:** 2nd in 2B (45).
- ◆ Has a career high 81 RBI...needs 1 home run to establish a career high.
- ◆ Is hitting .260 (38-for-146)/.325 OBP/.438 SLG with 8 doubles, 6 home runs, 18 RBI and 14 walks in 40 games since joining the D-backs.
- ◆ His .981 fielding pct. (5 E in 270 TC) ranks second among all third basemen, behind Anthony Rendon/WSH (.982).
- ◆ Acquired from the Twins on July 27 for 3 Minor Leaguers.

**#6 • DAVID PERALTA • L/L**      **6-1 • 215 • 31 (Aug. 14, 1987)**  
**COL Series:** 2-10, HR, 2 RBI, BB, 2 R, SB      **Trip:** 2-10, HR, 2 RBI, BB, 2 R, SB

- ◆ **NL RANKINGS:** 3rd in GW RBI (14), 9th in SLG (.518).
- ◆ His 26 homers are a career high...needs 1 RBI to set a career high.
- ◆ Has hit safely in 6 of his last 7 games (.333; 8-for-24).
- ◆ Leads the NL with a .326 average vs. right-handers.
- ◆ In 25 games in August, hit .361/1.141 OPS with 4 doubles, 10 home runs and 21 RBI.
- ◆ Since 2017, ranks among NL outfielders in AVG (5th, .292), OPS (7th, .835), SLG (8th, .484), RBI (8th, 130) and OBP (10th, .351).

**#44 • PAUL GOLDSCHMIDT • R/R**      **6-3 • 225 • 31 (Sept. 10, 1987)**  
**COL Series:** 4-10, 2 2B, RBI, BB, 2 R, SB      **Trip:** 4-10, 2 2B, RBI, BB, 2 R, SB

- ◆ **NL RANKINGS:** 1st in Times On Base (257), 1st in OPS (.963), 2nd in OBP (.403), 2nd in SLG (.560), T-2nd in HR (33), 4th in GW RBI (13), 4th in EXBH (70), 5th in BB (88), T-5th in H (163), 7th in R (92), 8th in AVG (.300).
- ◆ Reached base safely in a club-record 48 straight road games (.397; 73-for-184).
- ◆ In 96 games since May 23, is hitting .348 (129-for-371)/1.097 OPS with 23 doubles, 28 home runs, 70 RBI and 60 walks (was hitting .198 on May 22)...was 128th in OPS (.625) in the Majors on May 22 and entered today's game fifth overall (.963).
- ◆ Is batting .392 (47-for-120)/1.196 OPS in his last 32 games.
- ◆ Has reached base safely in 18 consecutive games (.338; 22-for-65) and in 45 of his last 46 games (.354, 62-for-175/1.097 OPS).
- ◆ Owns the all-time Chase Field home run record (99)...also set the D-backs all-time walk record, surpassing Luis Gonzalez (650).
- ◆ Named to a club-record sixth NL All-Star Team...lone NL player to make the last 6 All-Star teams, and 1 of 3 players in MLB to do so (also: Mike Trout and Salvador Perez).
- ◆ Is a member of the D-backs' 20th Anniversary Team.
- ◆ Has recorded his fourth career season of 30+ doubles and 30+ home runs, extending his franchise record

 Is batting .393 (42-for-107) with 11 doubles, 10 home runs, 35 RBI and a 1.277 OPS in his last 27 games.

- ◆ Is batting .321 (9-for-29)/.829 OPS in his last 8 games.
- ◆ Is a member of the D-backs' 20th Anniversary Team.
- ◆ NL Player of the Week for April 30-May 6, hitting .423 with 4 homers, 8 RBI and 1.448 OPS, his fourth weekly honor...also named NL Player of the Month for April.

**#9 • JON JAY • L/L**      **5-11 • 195 • 33 (March 15, 1985)**

- ◆ Is batting .286 (30-for-105) over his last 23 starts.
- ◆ Leads the Majors with 15 HBP since his first game with the D-backs on June 8.
- ◆ Acquired from the Royals on June 6 for LHP Gabe Speier and RHP Elvis Luciano.

**#28 • STEVEN SOUZA JR. • R/R**      **6-4 • 220 • 29 (April 24, 1989)**  
**COL Series:** 0-7, SB      **Trip:** 0-7, SB

- ◆ Is batting .293 (29-for-99) in 26 starts on the road.
- ◆ On the 10-day disabled list from March 29-May 3 and May 22-July 5 with a strained right pectoral...suffered the original injury on March 21 diving for a ball.

**#47 • PATRICK KIVLEHAN • R/R**      **6-2 • 220 • 28 (Dec. 22, 1989)**  
**COL Series:** 1-1      **Trip:** 1-1

- ◆ Acquired from the Mets on Sept. 6 for cash considerations and had his contract selected from Triple-A Reno prior to the game.
- ◆ Combined to hit .298 with 29 doubles, 20 home runs and 71 RBI in 113 games between Triple-A Louisville (Reds) and Triple-A Las Vegas (Mets).
- ◆ Appeared in 123 Major League games with Padres (2016) and Reds (2016-17).
