WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers beat the Red Sox in last game on Wed., 8-2, and are 1-2 on this 6-game, 7-day homestand against BOS (1-2) and LAA (3 G) leading up to the All-Star break...Texas has lost 3 of 4, 6 of 8, and 7 of 10, with club's 7-11 (.389) record beginning 6/18 ranking as T4th-lowest win pct. in A.L. in that span...since 6/18, have won consecutive games just once, 6/24-25 at NYY, and are seeking to win a 2nd straight game tonight...club is still 14-12 (.538) since 6/9, 6th-best in the A.L. in that stretch...Texas has won 15 of 28 and 28 of 52...club has a 36-34 (.514) record beginning 4/20, 8th-best in A.L., this after opening the year at 5-10. • At 41-44 (.482), the Rangers are 9th in the A.L. in winning percentage...club is under .500 for the 8th straight day, this after a .500-or-better record on 6 of the 7 previous days... Texas has had a winning record on just 3 occasions in the last 43 days, 34-33 on 6/17, 38-37 on 6/25, and 39-38 on 6/27...current win pct. is same thru 85 G as 2015 (41-44/42-44)...club was 53-32/53-33 in 2016. • Team is currently 3 games below .500...club has been season-high 3 G above .500 twice, last on 5/21 (24-21), and was a 2017 high 7 games under .500 (13-20) on 5/8...season best 10-G win streak from 5/9-19 was 4th-longest in franchise history...the Rangers are 4-3-2 in their last 9 overall series.

IN THE STANDINGS: The Rangers are in 3rd place for a 2nd straight day after 5 days in 4th...days in each position in 2017 (alone or tied): 1st-0 days, 2nd-26, 3rd-25, 4th-31, 5th-13...Texas has gained ground in the A.L. West just twice in the last 19 days, currently 16.5 games back...season-high 17.0-G deficit both Tuesday and Wednesday, team's greatest at any point since end of the 2014 season (21.0 GB)...The Rangers are still just 3.5 GB of a wild card spot in the A.L.

AT HOME: The Rangers have lost 3 of 5, 5 of 9 and 10 of last 16 at home, going 7-11 in home games since 5/29 after opening year w/ a 16-8 record in Arlington...that season-opening span included an 8-0 homestand from 5/10-18, just 2nd undefeated homestand of 7+ G in Rangers history (also 8-0, 5/20-29/05)...club's 23-19 (.548) record ranks T7th in the A.L. • Texas ranks 2nd in A.L. w/ both 234 runs and 5.57 R/G at home in '17 (NYY: 242/6.05).

VS. LOS ANGELES-AL: Rangers are 3-3 vs. Halos in '17, winning series 4/11-13 at LAA (2-1) and losing series 4/28-30 in Arlington (1-2)...have lost 2 of 3, but have won 3 of last 5 since dropping 1st meeting of '17...team is 5-2-1 in 8 series vs. Halos in 2016-17...Texas has won 7 of last 12 meetings after a 2-5 span, but is just 25-38 overall since start of 2014 after posting a 15-4 mark in 2013...Texas went 10-9 vs. the Angels last season, winning season series for 1st time since 2013...club was 6-3 in Arlington last year, taking all 3 series, but is just 11-21 in home games vs. LAA since start of 2014...Angels lead all-time series 365-336, but Rangers have leads of 184-170 in Arlington, including 102-98 at GLPIA...final 3 series between the clubs come in a span of 28 days from 8/21-9/17.

RECENT GAME TIMES: The Rangers' 2:52 contest on Wed. vs. BOS - albeit with a rain delay of 1:26 before 1st pitch - was the Rangers' shortest home contest since 5/17 vs. PHI (2:48)...team has still played 19 consecutive home games of 2:50-or-longer, the 2nd-longest span in club history (29 from 7/26-9/26/02)...only 2 ML clubs have fewer home games under 2:50 than Texas (5) this season: BOS (3) and CWS (3).

ELVIS UPDATE: Elvis Andrus was placed on MLB's Paternity Leave List on Wednesday and he remains on the list for tonight's game...Andrus' wife, Cori, gave birth to Elvis Emilio (8.1 lbs., 20.5 inches) at 1:22 a.m. on Thursday morning...this marks the first time that Andrus has not been on the Rangers' active roster in the regular or postseason since he made his big league debut on opening day in 2009. • Andrus finished 4th in the 2017 Esurance MLB All-Star Game Final Vote in the A.L., won by KC's Mike Moustakas.

TRANSACTIONS: Texas recalled INF Drew Robinson from Round Rock today for his 4th stint w/ the club...RHP Nick Martinez was optioned yesterday...additionally, RHP Ernesto Frieri has cleared waivers and been offered an outright assignment at Round Rock.

THE CAPTAIN: Adrian Beltre hit career double no. 601 on Wednesday, tying Barry Bonds for 16th on the all-time list...his 2975 hits are 32nd all-time and 10 shy of tying Sam Rice for 31st place (see charts on this page). • Against LAA, Beltre owns his highest career totals vs. any opponent in games (237), runs (122), hits (255), 2B (51), HR (40), RBI (147), SB (13), BB (64), and TB (434)...among Halos opponents, the 40 HR are T4th-most ever w/ Reggie Jackson (70-A. Rodriguez, 49-R. Palmeiro, 45-H. Killebrew), the 51 2B rank 3rd (61-G. Brett, 53-C. Yastrzemski), and 147 RBI are 5th (Palmeiro next at 153)...at Globe Life Park, Beltre is a .328/.399/.527/.926 (66-201) hitter vs. LAA w/ 10 HR and 39 RBI in 55 G.

HAMELS STILL WINNING: Cole Hamels enters tonight's start with a 3-0 record, and he also has a team-high 3 wins lost - games in which he exited in position to win before the bullpen gave up the lead...he has gone 25-6 (.806) over 51 reg. season starts for Texas since he was acquired from PHI in a 7/31/15 trade, 2nd-best win pct. in MLB in that span - min. 25 decisions (Kershaw-.825, 33-7).

CASHNER COMES THROUGH: Andrew Cashner's game score (Bill James formula) of 68 on Wed. vs. BOS (7.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R 0 ER) was his highest of '17, and tied Cole Hamels (7/1 at CWS) for best game score by a Ranger since Yu Darvish on 6/23 at NYY (7.0 SHO IP)...Cashner's 7.0 IP marked longest start for TEX since 6/24 at NYY (Bibens-Dirkx: 7.0 IP)...the rotation's 5 wins since 6/21 have all come from different starters: Perez, Bibens-Dirkx, Martinez, Hamels, Cashner.

ODOR'S LINE: Rougned Odor, who exited Wednesday's game with a left hand contusion, produced a boxscore line of 1-3-1-2 (AB-R-H-RBI)...according to Elias Sports Bureau, he was the 1st player this season to put together a boxscore line produced only 26 other times since the majors began recording RBIs in 1920...Elias says that included among the list of 1-3-1-2 players are six Hall-of-Famers (Ty Cobb, Mel Ott, Mickey Mantle, Luis Aparicio, Reggie Jackson, Jeff Bagwell).

ABIT INSIDE: Shin-Soo Choo was hit with Doug Fister's 1st pitch in the 1st inning on Wed., just 3rd time since pitches were 1st tracked in 1988 that a Texas leadoff batter was hit with a game's 1st pitch...Ian Kinsler had the others: 4/9/13 vs. TB (Ro. Hernandez), 9/20/07 vs. BAL (Victor Zambrano). • Batters have 7 HBP in the past 6 G, including season-high 3 HBP on Wed. vs. BOS (most since 3 on 9/20/16 vs. LAA), as season total of 40 HBP ranks 3rd in A.L./6th in MLB.

SHORTS: Rangers are wearing blue jerseys tonight in memory of the fallen Dallas police officers who lost their lives one year ago...please note Saturday's start time is 8:05 pm CT... Wed. was just 3rd time in last 7 seasons for TEX bullpen to record 6+ outs on 17-or-fewer pitches (also 5/16/17 vs. PHI, 5/13/15 vs. KC)...Wed. was also 1st TEX win when allowing 2+ R, but zero ER, since 5/25/13 at SEA (5-2 win)...Rangers' 4 home saves are MLB-low, last 5/14 vs. OAK (Bush)...since 6/17, TEX has out-homered opponents 42-to-19.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

#35 Cole Hamels, LHP
(3-0, 4.12)

TONIGHT: The 33-year-old left-hander is slated 8th start of the season in tonight's series opener with the Halos...has gone 1-0, 7.36 (9 ER/11.0 IP) in 2 G/GS since his return from the DL, raising season ERA from 3.03 to 4.12...earned win in last start on Sat. at CWS and enters tonight having retired 19 consecutive batters faced...is 3-0, the 2nd-longest season-opening win streak of his career (5-0 in 2016), and he also has a team-high 3 wins lost - games in which he exited in position to win before the bullpen gave up the lead...was on the disabled list 4/30-6/25 with a right oblique strain suffered when he was warming up for a start on 5/2 at HOU, the longest DL stint of his career...went 1-0 with a 1.04 ERA (1 ER/8.2 IP) in a pair of rehab starts with Double-A Frisco...has received 5+ runs of support in each outing and is receiving 8.86 runs of support per 9...has gone 25-6 (.806) over 51 regular season starts for Texas since he was acquired from PHI in a 7/31/15 trade, and the Rangers are 37-14 (.725) in those games...combined to post at least 200.0 innings and 200 strikeouts in a season for the 5th time in his career in 2016, doing so in 4 of the last 5 years, joining David Price (4) and Max Scherzer (4) as only pitchers with as many instances since 2012...has earned the win in each of the Rangers' division-clinching games over the past 2 seasons... Texas is 3-4 in his 7 starts...will be working on extra 5-days' rest.

LAST START: Earned win in last outing on Sat. at CWS, a 10-4 TEX victory (6.2 IP, 2 H, 2 R-ER, 0 BB, 6 SO, 1 HR, 96 pitches/63 strikes)...all 3 baserunners allowed in the start came in a 3-batter sequence with one out in the 1st inning (2B by Melky Cabrera, 2-R HR by Jose Abreu, HBP by Todd Frazier), but Hamels would retire the final 19 straight to end the outing...his 68 game score was 2nd-highest in '17 (73 on 4/21 vs. KC).

VS. LOS ANGELES-AL: Is 2-1, 2.93 (13 ER/40.0 IP) in 6 G/GS in career vs. Los Angeles-AL, making 5 quality starts and holding Halos to a .203/.297/.283/.580 slash line...lone meeting in '17 was on 4/11 at LAA (ND, 7.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R-ER), allowing his lone run in the 7th and exiting with a 5-1 lead before Sam Dyson permitted 3 R in the 9th inning to tie the game, which Rangers lost 6-5 in 10 innings on Carlos Perez's walk-off single against Jeremy Jeffress...had 3 starts against the Angels in 2016, winning his 1st start on 4/9/16 at Angel Stadium (6.0 IP, 1 ER) before a pair of no decisions on 5/1/16 in Arlington (5.0 IP, 4 ER) and 9/10/16 at LAA (6.0 IP, 2 ER).

DISABLED LIST: Was on the disabled list, 4/30-6/25, with a right oblique strain, an injury he suffered while warming up prior to a scheduled start on 5/2 at HOU... was the longest DL stint of his career, as he had never missed more than 29 days (3/26-4/23/14)...was placed on the disabled list on 5/3 and threw for the 1st time on 5/24...threw off the mound for the 1st time in bullpen session on 6/4...was 1-0 with a 1.04 ERA (1 ER/8.2 IP) in a pair of rehab starts with Double-A Frisco...made his 1st rehab start on 6/16 vs. San Antonio (3.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R-ER, 0 BB, 3 SO, 35 pitches/25 strikes)...following his outing, Hamels threw an additional 22 pitches in the bullpen...last outing was on 6/21 vs. Midland (5.2 IP, 2 H, 1 R-ER, 2 BB, 5 SO, 1 HR, 81 pitches/56 strikes).

AT HOME: Is 2-0, 3.05 (7 ER/20.2 IP) w/ 3 QS in 3 G/GS in Arlington this season, as tonight will be his 1st home start since 4/26 vs. MIN...has gone 2-1, 3.84 (26 ER/61.0 IP) over his last 9 home starts dating back to the 2016 All-Star break... has gone 12-2, 4.04 (77 ER/171.1 IP) in 26 career starts at Globe Life Park... Texas is 21-5 in his 26 career starts in this facility with the Rangers.

2017: Lucroy (5.64 ERA) has caught 4 of 7 starts and Chirinos (2.53 ERA) has caught 3 outings...through 7 starts, his swing and miss percentage (16.4%), SO/9 (4.53), and SO% (12.3) are all career lows...has held LHB 5-for-28 (.179)...top 2 spots in the order are a combined 10-for-39 (.256), while the rest of the lineup is 25-for-118 (.212)...batters leading off an inning have reached in 19 of 45 frames (10-for-36 with 7 BB and 2 HBP), but were 0-for-7 on Sat. at CWS...opposition is batting .200 (7-35) with RISP...opponents by time through order: 1st PA-.231 (12-52); 2nd PA-.217 (13-60); 3rd PA-.220 (9-41); 4th PA-.250 (1-4)...has received 5+ runs of support in each outing and is receiving 8.86 runs of support per 9...his 2 errors are T3rd-most among A.L. pitchers...in ND on 6/26 at CLE, had leads of 7-1 and 9-3 but could not escape the 5th inning in eventual 15-9 TEX loss.

ALL I DO IS WIN: His 15 wins in 2016 were T2nd-most in his career (17 in 2012, 15 in 2007)...has gone 25-6 (.806) over 51 starts since the 7/31/15 trade to the Rangers, best win pct. in A.L. (min. 25 decisions) in that span and 2nd-best in MLB (Kershaw-.825, 33-7)...according to STATS LLC, he was one of just 5 pitchers since 1913 to win at least 19 of his 1st 22 decisions with a single club, joining Vida Blue as only pitchers to do it for an A.L. club...won a career-high 12 consecutive decisions from 8/23/15-5/22/16 before loss on 5/27/16 vs. PIT...it matched the longest win streak by a starter in Rangers history (Bobby Witt - 12 G in 1990) and was the longest by a left-hander. — Has been the winning pitcher in each of the Rangers' division-clinching victories the past 2 seasons: 10/4/15 vs. LAA and 9/23/16 at OAK.
