### SAN DIEGO NOTES

- **Jordan Lyles** made his first start against the Braves since May 23, 2014... allowed 11 hits tonight, the most he has allowed in any outing this season (previous high was seven).
- **Franmil Reyes'** home run in the 9th inning was the fourth longest in Petco Park history (per Jeff Praught)...has homered in five of his last eight games and in six of his last 12 (owns a .714 SLG since his first homer on May 21 at WSH).
- **Freddy Galvis'** five-game hitting streak is the longest active streak on the team...is batting .278 (5-for-18) with a triple and three RBI over that span.
- **Cory Spangenberg** made his first-career pitching performance...is the first Padre position player to pitch since Erik Aybar on June 8, 2017 at ARI.

### ATLANTA NOTES

- **Sean Newcomb** has not allowed a home run in his last 42.0 IP...his 42.0-inning run is the longest active streak by a starter in the majors and the longest by a Braves starter in consecutive outings since Kris Medlen tossed 43.0 consecutive homerless innings over his final six starts in 2013.
  - o Is 7-1 with a 2.49 ERA (19 ER, 68.2 IP) in 12 games started this season and has won seven consecutive decisions...improves to 2-0 with a .000 ERA (0 ER, 12.0 IP) in two career starts vs. SD.
- **Freddie Freeman** went 4-for-4 tonight with two doubles, a homer, two RBI and three runs scored...his four hits in tonight's game are the most he's hit this since he recorded five hits on May 10th at MIA...has hit safely in 16 of his last 17 games (.391, 27-for-69) with a .455 OBP.
  - o Tallied three extra base hits for the second time this season, tying his own and Kurt Suzuki's three XBH for the most in a game by a Brave this season.
- **Charlie Culberson** extended his hitting streak to six-games, batting .429 (9-for-21) with a .714 SLG during that time...over his last 11 games, has a .364 average with six extra base hits and nine RBI.
  - o Tallied his fourth three-hit game (last: April 14 at CHC) and first stolen base of the season.
- **Nick Markakis** is leading the National League in hits (81) and multi-hit games (26)...is batting .328 (40-for-122) with 10 doubles and 20 RBI in his career against the Padres.
- **Dansby Swanson** is hitting .246 (15-for-61) with four doubles and four homers over 18 games since returning from the 10-day disabled list...nine of his 15 hits in that span have gone for extra bases.
