WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers lost to the Angels, 3-0 in THE CAPTAIN: Adrian Beltre enters the 2nd 'half' with 2978 last game on Sun. in Arlington, finishing with a 3-3 record on 6-game homestand against BOS (1-2) and LAA (2-0) leading up to the All-Star break...Sunday's loss snapped a 3-game win streak, just 4th win streak of 3+ G in 2017 and longest since 5 in a row 6/9-13... Texas has still lost 7 of 11. 8 of 13. and 12 of 21...club is still 16-13 (.552) since 6/9, 6th-best in the A.L. in that stretch...Texas has won 17 of 31 and 30 of 55...club has a 38-35 (.521) record beginning 4/20, 5th-best in A.L. and 10th in MLB, this after opening the year at 5-10.

- At 43-45 (.494), Rangers are 9th in the A.L. in winning percentage...club has been under .500 for 10 straight dates, this after a .500-or-better record on 6 of the 7 previous days... Texas has had a winning record on just 3 occasions in the last 50 days, last 39-38 on 6/27...club was 54-34/54-35 thru 88/89 G in '16.
- Team was last at .500 on 6/28 (39-39)...club has been season-high 3 G above .500 twice, last on 5/21 (24-21), and was a 2017 high 7 games under .500 (13-20) on 5/8...season best 10-G win streak 5/9-19 was 4th-longest in franchise history...the Rangers are 5-3-2 in their last 10 overall series.

IN THE STANDINGS: The Rangers were T2nd place at the break in the A.L. West at the break, this after club was in 4th place as recently as a loss on 7/4 vs. BOS...days in each position in 2017 (alone or tied): 1st-0 days, 2nd-33, 3rd-25, 4th-31, 5th-13...Texas has gained ground in the A.L. West just 3x in the last 26 days, currently 16.5 games back, 2nd-largest deficit at the break in last 14 seasons (-21.0 GB in 2014)... season-high 17.0-G deficit both 7/4-5, team's greatest at any point since end of the 2014 season (-31.0 GB)...the Rangers are still just 3.0 GB of a wild card spot in the A.L.

VS. KANSAS CITY: Rangers won all 4 meetings in 1st series 4/20-23 in Arlington and have won club-record 10 straight against the Royals since last loss 7/22/16 at KC...team's 10-1 (.909) record vs. KC since start of last season is highest win pct. for any team against another in 2016-17 (min. 10 G)...Rangers are 7-2-2 in last 11 series at The K...Texas has edge in all-time series at 257-255-1, but Royals have leads of 143-115-1 in KC and 138-111 at The K...Rangers have won 4 of last 6 games in this park, but dropped 7 of 12...still own 21-14 (.600) record at Kauffman since start of '08.

• Current 10-G win streak for TEX is club's longest ever vs. Royals (previous 7 in 1998-99) and longest against one opponent since 12 straight vs. HOU in 2013-14.

ON THE ROAD: The Rangers have dropped 4 of 5, 5 of 7, and 7 of last 11 road games since a season-best 6-G road win streak from 5/28-6/13...club is still 10-7 in road contests since 5/28...prior to this 10-7 span, the club had won just 6 of its previous 17 away contests...the Rangers' .429 (18-24) road winning percentage is 10th in the A.L....it is the team's lowest away percentage through 42 games since 2007 at .357 (15-27/16-27)...club was 24-18/24-19 in 2016.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Texas is opening the 2nd 'half' on the road for a 4th straight season, matching a club record (2005-08, 1995-98)...will also be on road post-break for 7th time in 8 years, and 11th time in 13 years beginning 2005.

- Rangers have lost 1st series following the break for 4 straight seasons since taking 2 of 3 in Seattle in 2012...this will be the 1st time to ever face the Royals in 1st series after the AS break.
- This 10-G road trip would be the longest right after the AS break for Texas since 2006, when team played 11 consecutive road games at BAL/TOR/BOS/CWS, a span which included a one-game makeup date at Fenway on 7/20...this will be 3rd straight year with a 9+ G trip following the break.

BARELY OUT OF TUESDAY: Three ML teams did not have a player appear in Tuesday's All-Star Game: TEX (Darvish selected, pitched Sunday and was replaced), LAA (Trout injured), and MIL (Corey Knebel DNP)...it was 3rd time in club history for no Ranger to appear in ASG (also 1972/2007).

career hits, 32nd all-time and 22 shy of becoming the 31st player in baseball history to reach 3000 hits...the only players w/ 3000 career hits while appearing primarily at 3rd base are HOFers George Brett (3154) and Wade Boggs (3010)... Beltre is also 32nd all-time with 1598 career RBI, passing Brett (1596) on Saturday vs. LAA.

KANSAS CITY, HERE I COME: Adrian Beltre's .344 (114-331) career average vs. KC is the 3rd-highest by any Royals opponent with 300+ plate appearances (see chart)...the .344 avg. and .946 OPS vs. KC are his highest against any A.L. opponent...he also owns a .366 (64-175) career average at The K, 3rd-highest all-time at this park (125+ PA's) to only Erick Aybar (.372) and Ichiro Suzuki (.370)...Beltre has hits in 21 of his last 22 games at The K.

CHOO TOO: Shin-Soo Choo, who celebrated his 35th birthday yesterday with a workout here at The K, is a career .329/.423/.526/.949 hitter vs. KC, all his highest marks vs. any A.L. opponent...he owns a .335 (57-170) average at The K, his 2nd-highest figure at any A.L. park (.348 at Camden

THE SKINNY: At the break, the Rangers rank among A.L. leaders in HR (2nd, 135), steals (2nd, 76), runs (3rd, 444), and SLG (5th, .430), tied with the Dodgers for most HR in MLB since 6/17 (47)...the team's .240 avg. is also 2nd-lowest in the A.L., while 819 SO are 3rd-most in the league...pitching staff has A.L.'s 8th-best ERA at 4.31, including 4th-best starters figure (4.25), while bullpen is tied (also NYY) for MLB lead w/ 17 blown saves and has lowest save pct. (43.3%, 13-30) in majors...13 saves mark lowest TEX total at break since 1984 (12) and 18 relief losses are 2nd most in A.L.

SECOND HALF SPECIAL?: The Rangers combined for an 87-59 (.596) record in 2nd 'half' games in 2015-16, 3rd-best in MLB to only the Cubs (100-48, .676) and Blue Jays (86-56, .606)...Adrian Beltre has a career .295/.351/.509/.860 slash line in games after the break, all figures well above his prebreak marks of .278/.329/.457/.786...Beltre's .940 OPS after break in 2015-16 was 8th-best in MLB (400+ PA's).

THE LONG BALL: The Rangers had the 3rd-highest HR total in MLB before the break at 135, trailing only HOU (148) and MIL (138)...it was the 4th-highest pre-break HR total in club history (147 in 2005, 137 in 2001, 136 in 2003)...the club has scored 49.1% of its runs (218/444) via the HR, 3rd-highest percentage in MLB to TOR (53.0%, 191/382) and OAK (50.0%, 191/382).

SHORTS: Joey Gallo walked in all 3 PA's on Sunday vs. LAA, the 1st Ranger w/ BB in each of 3+ PA's in a game since Ian Kinsler on 9/30/09 at LAA (3 BB/3 PA)...tomorrow's game will air on FS1 with the announcing duo of Ryan Lefebvre and C.J. Nitkowski...Rangers' 5.05 R/G in the 1st 'half' was highest average for club since 2012 (5.15 R/G), but .240 BA was 2nd-lowest in TEX history (.226 in 1972)...Rangers' .221 road avg. is lowest in MLB.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

#33 Martin Perez, LHP (4-6, 4.60)

TONIGHT: The 26-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 17th start and appearance of the season in tonight's road trip opener against Kansas City... marks 6th road outing of '17, as 5 of last 6 starts have come at home...last worked on 7/3 vs. BOS, taking no decision in a 7-5 Texas loss in 11 innings...was on DL from 6/24-7/3 with right thumb fracture/laceration...has a 2-game winning streak dating to 6/17, but is still 2-1, 5.84 (24 ER/37.0 IP) in his last 7 starts (beg. 5/24 at BOS) to raise season ERA nearly a full run from 3.71 to 4.60...has one quality start in his last 6 outings (6/22 vs. TOR)...has averaged 4.30 runs of support per 9 innings (42 RS/88.0 IP), 2nd-lowest on staff (Darvish-3.49) and 8th-lowest in A.L...his 6 losses are 3rd-most on staff (Cashner-7, Darvish-8)...pitched for Team Venezuela in the 2017 World Baseball Classic won by the United States...made a team-best 33 starts in 2016, only member of Texas rotation to not miss a start last season...matched a career high w/ 10 wins and pitched a career-high 198.2 innings...signed a 4-year contract on 11/7/13 through 2017 with club options for 2018, 2019, and 2020...Texas is 6-10 in his 16 starts.

AT THE BREAK: Is averaging a career-high 6.55 SO/9, but his 3.68 BB/9 figure would also be highest of his career, surpassing 3.55 mark in 2012...opponent batting average (.314) is 3rd-highest among A.L. starters...ranks 1st on staff and T2nd in A.L. with 15 GIDP (TOR's Marcus Stroman-20)...has made 11 of his 16 starts in Arlington, tied with teammate Yu Darvish and tonight's counterpart Jason Hammel for most home starts in A.L...each of his 4 wins have come in Arlington.

<u>LAST START:</u> Took no ND on 7/3 vs. BOS (5.2 IP, 7 H, 5 R-2 ER, 4 BB, 3 SO, 102 pitches/57 strikes), a 7-5 Texas loss in 11 innings...exited with 2 outs, the bases loaded, and the game tied 2-2 in the 6th inning...all 3 runs would eventually score with Tony Barnette on the mound...following a 2-out walk in the 2nd inning, he set down 9 of the next 11 hitters he faced...Mike Napoli hit a game-tying HR off Craig Kimbrel to lead off the 9th, but Andrew Benintendi's 2-run single broke a 5-5 tie in the 11th...matched a season high with 4 walks...activated from DL prior to game and made his 1st start since 6/22 vs. TOR...loss snapped a 3-game Texas winning streak with Perez on the mound.

VS. KANSAS CITY: Making 3rd career start vs. KC and 1st in '17, as he did not pitch in the 4-G series between these clubs in April...has no record, 1.42 ERA (2 ER/12.2 IP) in 2 career GS...opposed Ian Kennedy on 7/30/16 vs. KC, taking ND (7.0 IP, 1 R-ER), as Texas won 2-1 on walkoff HR by Mitch Moreland...took ND in only start at Kauffman on 9/20/13 (5.2 IP, 1 R-ER)...has not allowed HR in 12.2 IP.

ON THE ROAD: Seeking 1st road win of '17, as he has gone 0-2 with a 4.15 ERA (12 ER/26.0 IP) in 5 G/GS away from Arlington, quality starts in 2 of 5... last pitched on road on 6/10 at WAS (5.0 IP, 2 R-ER)...has allowed one HR on road and none in last 4 starts...lone HR was solo shot by Nelson Cruz on 4/14 at SEA...is one of 5 A.L. starters to allow one-or-zero road HR in '17 (min. 25.0 IP), and teammate Andrew Cashner is only pitcher to allow zero...opp. batting .327/.375/.413 on road compared to .309/.379/.478 at home.

2017: Opp. batting .314/.378/.459/.836...his 111 hits allowed are 10th-most among A.L. starters, while 1.67 WHIP ranks 3rd-highest in A.L. (BAL's Kevin Gausman-1.76; BAL's Wade Miley-1.75)...averaging 17.5 pitches per inning, 8th-highest in A.L...would be the most pitches per inning of his career...opp. batting average on balls in play (.362) is 2nd-highest in A.L. (Gausman-.371)...has recorded 5 outs this season in the 7th-and-later...Robinson Chirinos has caught 11 starts (3-5, 4.98, 33 ER/59.2 IP), and Jonathan Lucroy has caught him 5 times (1-1, 3.81, 12 ER/28.1 IP)...opp. batting .247 (22-89) w/ RISP, with at least one hit w/ RISP in 7 straight starts...opp. leading off an inning are batting .356 (32-90) w/ 9 XBH (4 HR, 5 2B) and 5 BB, including a .375 avg/1.188 OPS by 1st batter of the game with 2 leadoff HR allowed...opp. average by time through order, 1st PA: .285 (37-130); 2nd PA: .302 (38-126); 3rd PA: .366 (34-93); 4th PA: 2-4...HR by Kole Calhoun on 4/30 vs. LAA was his 1st HR to a LHB at Globe Life Park since 5/10/14 vs. BOS (David Ortiz)...went 0-4 over 6 starts from 4/14-5/11, dropping 4 consecutive starts 4/19-5/6...1st Ranger w/ 4+ losses at end of April since Jason Jennings (5) in 2008...won back-to-back starts from 6/17-22 for 1st time in '17.

<u>DISABLED LIST:</u> Placed on the DL on 6/24, retroactive to 6/23, with a fracture/laceration at the tip of his right thumb...activated prior to start on 7/3 vs. BOS... did not require a rehab assignment...sustained injury when he caught his thumb in the hinge section of a hotel room door on the evening of 6/22 in New York.

NOT THE NORM: Has produced a groundball percentage (number of fair groundballs hit -- hits, outs and errors) of 45.5% this season (122 GB/68 FB), but has induced 49.2% ground balls (29 GB/13 FB) over last 3 starts...the current 45.5% mark for the year would be the lowest percentage of his career, as he entered 2017 with a career GB% of 53.1%...additionally, has permitted left-handed batters to hit at a .319 (23-72) clip, this after holding LHB to a .228 (93-408) career mark entering '17...held LHB to .176 avg. (24-136) in '16, lowest in A.L. and 4th-lowest in MLB...lefties are just 1-for-15 in last 3 outings.

RUN SUPPORT: Has averaged 4.30 runs of support per 9 inn. (42 RS/88.0 IP), 2nd-lowest on staff (Darvish-3.49) and 8th-lowest in A.L...received 2 RS on 7/3 vs. BOS, this after 5+ runs of support in 4 of his previous 7 outings...has netted 2-or-fewer runs of support in 10 of 16 starts, including 6 in a row spanning 4-G losing skid...has won 4 of 6 G in '17 when receiving 3+ runs of support.
