Ichiro Suzuki is batting .329 (932x2836) with 103 doubles, 31 triples, 29 home runs, 238 RBI and 166 walks vs. left-handed pitchers in his career...his .329 average vs. lefties is the highest among all active left-handed batters, while also ranking the 6th-highest among all active players in the Majors (min 750 PA).

The Mariners relievers are averaging 10.47 strikeouts per 9.0 inning (38 SO, 32.2) this season, which is the 4th-highest in the Majors...trails only New York-AL (13.30), Washington (10.74) and New York-NL (10.71).

The Mariners and Royals meet for the 3rd of 7 games this season (0-1)...Seattle and KC will also meet in Seattle June 29-July 1...dating back to 2012, Seattle is 24-20 vs. Royals, including going 13-11 at Kauffman Stadium:

TODAY'S TILT...the Mariners conclude their first road trip of the season, a 5,200-mile, 10-day, 8-game odyssey, with the final of 3 games vs. the Kansas City Royals (1-1)...opened the trip splitting a 2-game series with San Francisco (1-1) and played 2 of the 3 scheduled games vs. Minnesota (1-1)...after this series with the Royals will return to Seattle to begin a 7-day, 7-game homestand on Friday vs. the Oakland Athletics (3 G) and the Houston Astros (4 G)...today's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS...won 3 of first 4 games to start the season, but 2-3 over last 5 games...team is 3-3 during the day and 2-1 at night...Seattle is 2-1 at Safeco Field and 3-3 on the road.

- **AL Central** - the Mariners face an AL Central opponent in 12 of their first 24 games of the season (4-3)... Seattle went 18-16 vs. the Central in 2017, their first winning season since going 19-14 in 2014.
- **Seeing Double** - **Robinson Canó** is tied for 2nd with Rogers Hornsby for most home runs by a second baseman in Major League history, trailing only Jeff Kent's 377 career home runs.
- **Left vs. Right** - the Mariners are 2-0 when facing a left-handed starter and 3-4 vs. right-handed starters.
- **Four Square** - Seattle is 4-1 when scoring 4 runs-or-more, but 1-3 when scoring 3-or-fewer runs.

ENJOY THE OFF DAY...tomorrow marks the Mariners fifth off day in the first 15 days of the season (4 scheduled off days & 1 postponed game)...Seattle has played 9 games this season, which is tied for the fewest in the Majors with Kansas City and Minnesota...Texas leads the Majors Leagues with 13 games played...beginning on Friday, the Mariners will play 17 consecutive games (April 13-29) before their next scheduled off day on April 30...the Mariners also are entering a stretch on Friday where they play 23 games in 24 days and 36 games over 38 games (April 13-May 20)...Seattle's only two off days during this stretch are Monday, April 30 and Monday, May 7.

RUBBER-GAME RECORDS...the Mariners are 1-0 in rubber games this season (game to decide outcome of a 3-game series), winning the final game of the series vs. Cleveland (3/29-4/1)...in the first 3 series this season the Mariners are 1-0-2...in 2017 the Mariners went 10-7 in rubber games.

HOMESTAND HIGHLIGHTS...the Mariners return to Seattle for a 7-day, 7-game homestand beginning on Friday that features American League West foes the Oakland Athletics (Fri.-Sun.) and the Houston Astros (Mon.-Thurs.)...the homestand also features College Night and Ben Gamel Cap Night on Fri., April 13, Salute to Armed Forces Night on Sat., April 14, BECU Value games, April 15-18, Bark at the Park Nigh on Tue., April 17 and Safeco Field Soil Day on Thur., April 19...tickets for all games are available at Mariners.com/tickets.

EIGHT IS GREAT...**Dee Gordon** has hit safely in the first 9 games of the season, batting .342 (13x38) with 6 runs scored, 1 home run, 3 RBI, 2 walks and 5 stolen bases...his 9-game hitting streak is currently tied with Brian Dozier-MIN for the longest active streak in the American League...his 9-game hitting streak is also tied (6x) for the longest in the Majors this season...with a hit today, Gordon will record his 9th career 10+-game hitting streak in a single season (last: 17 G, Aug. 27-Sept. 14, 2017).

STREAKING...dating back to Sept. 26, 2017, **Dee Gordon** has hit safely in 15 consecutive games, batting .359 (23x64) with 13 runs scored, 1 double, 1 triple, 1 home run, 3 RBI, 2 walks and 9 stolen bases...his 15-game hitting streak combined over the last 2 seasons is the 2nd-longest in his career, trailing only a career-high 17-game hitting streak, Aug. 27-Sept. 14, 2017...also dating back to Aug. 27, 2017, Gordon has hit safely in 38 of 42 games, including 21 multi-hit contests, batting .363 (66x182) with 32 runs scored, 3 doubles, 4 triples, 2 home runs, 11 RBI, 4 walks and 17 stolen bases... during this stretch Dee ranks 3rd in the Majors with a .363 average (min. 75 PA), trailing only Josh Reddick-HOU (.369/38x103) and Buster Posey-SF (.364/44x121).

DON'T YOU KNOW...**Robinson Canó** has reached base safely in all 9 games this season, including 8 games with at least 1 hit...overall he is batting .414 (12x29) with 9 runs scored, 4 doubles, 4 RBI, 2 HBP and 6 walks...among American League he currently ranks 2nd in average (.414) and on-base percentage (.414), 5th in OPS (1.092), T7th in runs (9) and T8th in doubles (4).

KKKKKKKKKK...**Edwin Díaz** has struck out 11 of the 14 batters he has faced this season (0 H, 2 HB), averaging 24.75 strikeouts per 9.0 innings over his first 4 appearances this season...in his career, Díaz has recorded a strikeout rate of 13.91 per 9.0 innings, the 4th-highest since making his debut in 2016...trails only Dellin Betances-NYY (15.32), Craig Kimbrel-BOS (15.24) and Andrew Miller-CLE (14.35) while ranking ahead of Kenley Jansen-LAD (13.85).

MILESTONE TRACKER...**Kyle Seager** is in his 8th season with Seattle, since making his debut in 2011 and is quickly moving up the Mariners all-time offensive rankings:

- **Seager** (215) trails Raúl Ibañez (216) by 1 double for 5th-most in franchise history.
- **Seager** (154) trails Raúl Ibañez (156) by 2 home runs for 6th-most in club history.
- **Seager** (529) trails Bret Boone (535) by 6 RBI for 8th-most in franchise history.
- **Seager** (363) trails Raúl Ibañez (367) by 4 walks for 8th-most in club history.

SOLVING SOUTHPAWS...over the last 2 season, **Jean Segura** is batting .336 (44x131) with 6 doubles, 1 triple, 3 home runs, 13 RBI and 15 walks vs. left-handed pitchers...during this stretch, his .336 average this season vs. left-handed opponents is the 8th-highest in the American League... **Ichiro Suzuki** (.347/17x49, 3 2B, 5 RBI, 4 BB) and **Guillermo Heredia** (.309/42x136, 7 2B, 4 HR, 14 RBI, 8 BB) each have hit over .300 vs. lefties dating back to the beginning of 2017.

AS YOU KNOW...the Mariners are 28-22 (.560) over their last 50 games on the road dating back to June 18, 2017...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...the Mariners are 9-4-3 in their last 16 road series (min. 2 games in series)?...the Mariners .656 series winning percentage is the 6th-highest in the Major League since June 30, 2017, trailing only the Los Angeles Dodgers (.719/11-4-1), the Boston Red Sox (.700/10-4-1), the Chicago Cubs (.700/9-3-3), the Cleveland Indians (.667/10-5-0) and the Houston Astros (.656/9-4-3).
