IN THE STANDINGS (75 days): The Brewers have spent the following number of days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central standings this season: **FIRST:** 34, **SECOND:** 28, **THIRD:** 9, **FOURTH:** 4, **FIFTH:** 0....the Brewers are currently in second place, trailing the Cubs by half a game....are ahead of the third-place Cardinals by 2.0 games and the fourth-place Pirates by 7.0 games.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Brewers are 13-7-1 in series play....won six straight series from 5/10-5/30: at Col (3-1), at Ari (2-1), at Min (2-1), vs. Ari (3-0), vs. NYM (3-1) and vs. StL (2-1).

AT HOME: The Brewers are 18-12 at home, going 5-3-1 in series play....after a 2-6 start, the Brewers have gone 16-6 over their last 22 home games....the team had a season-high 6-game home winning streak from 4/17-4/22....the team went 46-38 at home last season, going 14-9-4 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 21-15 on the road, going 8-4-0 in series play....are 13-8 over their last 21 road games....the Brewers had a season-high 5-game road winning streak from 4/30-5/11....the team went 40-38 on the road last season, going 13-11-2 in series play.

MANAGER: **Craig Counsell** is in his fourth season as manager of the Brewers (259-268) and third full season....he was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing **Ron Roenicke**....bio is on p. 44 of the media guide.

COACHES: Hitting coach **Darnell Coles** (4th season), pitching coach **Derek Johnson** (3rd season), coach **Jason Lane** (3rd season), bench coach **Pat Murphy** (3rd season), third base coach **Ed Sedar** (12th season, 8th as 3B coach), first base/infield coach **Carlos Subero** (3rd season) and bullpen coach **Lee Tunnell** (6th season) all returned from the 2017 staff.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 10 replay challenges, going 3-7....their last challenge (lost) came on 6/3 at Chicago-AL as an out call at second base involving Jonathan Villar stood....team was 17-27 in 44 replay challenges in 2017.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #57 - RHP CHASE ANDERSON (12gs, 4-5, 4.57)

ANDERSON AT A GLANCE: Chase Anderson, 30, is making his 13th start of the season and third against the Cubs.....Anderson last started last Wednesday at Cleveland and took a 3-1 loss (4.1ip, 4h, 3r, 3er, 3bb, 4k)....the team is 7-5 in his starts....he has 5 quality starts.... opponents are batting .232 (55-for-237, 13hr)....he was on the 10-day disabled list from 5/13-5/20 due to illness, retroactive to 5/10....Anderson, who made the first Opening Day start of his career, was acquired from Arizona, along with INF Aaron Hill, SS Isan Diaz and cash, for SS Jean Segura and RHP Tyler Wagner on 1/30/16....he is signed through the 2019 season with club options for 2020 and 2021....bio is on p. 60 of the media guide.

FITTING TRIBUTE: Prior to every home start, Anderson wears his late father's socks, cowboy boots, belt buckle, jeans and pink polo shirt to the park....his father, Robert, died in 2012.

LAST SEASON: Anderson went 12-4 with a 2.74 ERA in 25 starts....he set career highs for wins (12) and strikeouts (133)....the team went 14-11 in his starts....he produced 13 quality starts, going 8-2 with a 1.48 ERA in those starts (85ip, 14er)....opponents batted just .220 (113-for-514, 14hr)....he was named Brewers Pitcher of the Month for April (5gs, 2-0, 2.10era) and September/October (6gs, 4-1, 2.06era)....Anderson was on the 10-day disabled list from 6/29-8/19 with a left oblique strain....he ranked sixth in the National League in ERA (2.89) and eighth in WHIP (1.11) at the time of his placement on the DL.

CAREER: Is 40-33 with a 3.95 ERA in 116 games / 115 starts (625ip, 274er)....is in his fifth Major League season....has pitched for Arizona (2014-15) and Milwaukee (2016-current)....Anderson has gone 25-20 with a 3.77 ERA in 68 games / 67 starts as a Brewer (358ip, 150er).

CAREER AT MILLER PARK: Is 14-8 with a 3.93 ERA in 32 starts (176.1ip, 77er)....went 5-1 with a 2.51 ERA in 11 starts in 2017 (68ip, 19er)....is 2-2 with a 6.23 ERA in 6 starts in 2018 (30.1ip, 21er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 17-18 with a 4.04 ERA in 60 games / 59 starts (314.1ip, 141er)....went 7-3 with a 2.95 ERA in 14 starts in 2017 (73.1ip, 24er)....is 2-3 with a 3.12 ERA in 6 starts in 2018 (34.2ip, 12er).

CAREER vs. CUBS: Is 3-4 with a 3.33 ERA in 9 starts (48.2ip, 18er), including 0-2 with a 2.08 ERA in 2 starts this season (13ip, 3er)....has lost his last 3 starts against Chicago (19.1ip, 6er, 2.79era) with the Brewers getting shut out in each game (5-0, 3-0 and 1-0).

CAREER AT THE PLATE: Is a .093 (18-for-194) hitter....has not homered....has 2 walks and 103 strikeouts.

THIS SEASON: Is 1-for-15 with 10 strikeouts....has 2 sacrifice bunts....**LAST SEASON:** Batted .135 (7-for-52) with 3 RBI....did not walk and had 29 strikeouts....had 3 sacrifice bunts.
