SAN DIEGO NOTES

- Today's game-time temperature was marked at 85 degrees, making it the hottest home game of the year for the Padres.
- **Joey Lucchesi** allowed a career-high three home runs today after not allowing a home run in his previous five starts and 23.2 IP from June 25-July 23...in his five starts since being reinstated from the 10-day DL on June 25, he is 2-3 with a 4.13 ERA (11 ER, 24.0 IP).
- **Manuel Margot** extended his hitting streak to a career-long 10-consecutive games, batting .378 (14-for-37) with three doubles, a triple and a home run since July 13...his streak is the second-longest of any Padre this season (behind Christian Villanueva's 11-game streak April 13-28).
- **Wil Myers** has five doubles and seven RBI in his last six games, going 8-for-24 (.333) over that time...owns a .663 slugging percentage in the month of July, his highest mark in a month since he slugged .765 in June of 2016.
 - His 23 RBI this month are tied with MIL's Christian Yelich for the most in the NL and entered today tied for fourth-most in the majors in that time.
 - Has gone .353 (12-for-34) vs. ARI this year and his 12 hits are his most vs. any single team this season.
- **A.J. Ellis** went 2-for-3 today and logged his first extra base hit since his double on June 14 at ATL.

ARIZONA NOTES

- The Diamondbacks earned their second three-game sweep at Petco Park in club history (also: April 24-26, 2006) and have won six of their last eight games...the club is now 19-7 on the road since June 8.
- **Clay Buchholz** owns a 3-0 record with a 1.96 ERA (5 ER, 23.0 IP) over his last four starts...allowed three earned runs in today's outing, the most he's allowed since June 12 vs. PIT when he surrendered five runs (earned).
 - Is 3-1 with a 2.10 ERA (8 ER, 34.1 IP) in six road starts this season and has allowed two or fewer runs in 10 of his last 13 road starts dating back to Aug. 18, 2016...since 2009, leads the majors with a .696 winning pct. (48-21) on the road.
- **Paul Goldschmidt** belted his team-leading 23rd homer of the season...has reached base in 29 games on the road, the longest road streak of his career and the longest active on-base streak in the majors, surpassing Alex Bregman's 28-game road streak.
 - Has gone 32-for-101 (.317) with six home runs and 16 RBI in his last 26 games.
- **Nick Ahmed** went 3-for-4 with a run scored...is hitting .315 (28-for-89) with seven doubles, four home runs and 19 RBI in his last 24 games.
 - Recorded his 14th home run of the year to add to his career-high.
- **David Peralta** exited today's game with right shoulder tightness.
