Fool Me Once...

The Brewers have not lost consecutive games since losing 4 in a row in Chicago from 4/26-4/29....since then, the team has gone 20-9.

Cha-Ching!

Jhoulys Chacín is 3-0 with a 2.90 ERA over his last 9 starts (49.2ip, 16er)....the team has gone 9-3 in his starts this season, winning 7 of his last 8 starts.

How May I Assist You?

Lorenzo Cain has 7 outfield assists this season, which leads all National League outfielders and is tied for first among Major League outfielders, along with **Kole Calhoun** (LAA) and **Trey Mancini** (Bal).

Closing in on #200

Ryan Braun is 1 stolen base away from reaching #200 for his career....he ranks third in franchise history in stolen bases, trailing **Paul Molitor** (412) and **Robin Yount** (271).

Hader's Gonna Hate

The Brewers are 19-0 this season in games where **Josh Hader** pitches....he has 66 strikeouts in just 33.0 innings, most among Major League relievers, while holding opponents to a .094 batting average (10-for-106).

The Brewers are 12-5-1 in series play....have won 6 straight series. **Game 1:** 11-8, **Game 2:** 13-5, **Game 3:** 9-7, **Game 4:** 3-2

AT HOME: The Brewers are 18-11 at home, going 5-3-1 in series play....after a 2-6 start, the Brewers have gone 16-5 over their last 21 home games....the team had a season-high 6-game home winning streak from 4/17-4/22....the team went 46-38 at home last season, going 14-9-4 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 18-11 on the road, going 7-2-0 in series play....are 10-4 over their last 14 road games....the Brewers had a season-high 5-game road winning streak from 4/30-5/11....the team went 40-38 on the road last season, going 13-11-2 in series play.

MANAGER: **Craig Counsell** is in his fourth season as manager of the Brewers (256-263) and third full season....he was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing **Ron Roenicke**....bio is on p. 44 of the media guide.

COACHES: Hitting coach **Darnell Coles** (4th season), pitching coach **Derek Johnson** (3rd season), coach **Jason Lane** (3rd season), bench coach **Pat Murphy** (3rd season), third base coach **Ed Sedar** (12th season, 8th as 3B coach), first base/infield coach **Carlos Subero** (3rd season) and bullpen coach **Lee Tunnell** (6th season) all returned from the 2017 staff.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made nine replay challenges, going 3-6....their last challenge (won) came on 5/26 vs. New York-NL as an out call at first base involving Hernán Pérez was overturned....team was 17-27 in 44 replay challenges in 2017.

TODAY'S STARTER: #45 - RHP JHOULYS CHACÍN (12gs, 3-1, 3.69)

CHACIN AT A GLANCE: Jhoulys Chacin, 30, is making his 13th start of the season....Chacin last started last Sunday vs. New York-NL and received no decision in the Brewers' 8-7 victory (6.1ip, 8h, 5r, 5er, 1bb, 3k, 1hbp)....he has gone 3-0 with a 2.90 ERA over his last 9 starts (49.2ip, 16er)....the team is 9-3 in his starts this season....he has made 3 quality starts.... opponents are batting .239 (56-for-234, 5hr)....Chacin signed as a free agent on 12/21/17.... he is signed through the 2019 season....his name is pronounced "yo-LEASE sha-SEEN".... bio is on p. 81 of the media guide.

LAST SEASON: Chacin went 13-10 with a 3.89 ERA in a career-high 32 starts with San Diego....his 13 wins and career-high 153 strikeouts led the team....he held opponents to a .235 batting average (157-for-667, 19hr), which ranked in the NL....the Padres went 18-14 in his starts....he had 16 quality starts, tying Luis Perdomo for the team lead, going 10-3 with a 2.05 ERA in those starts (105.1ip, 24er)....Chacin went 9-5 with a 2.93 ERA over his last 20 starts (116.2ip, 38er).

CAREER: Is 62-68 with a 3.92 ERA in 207 games / 179 starts (1086.1ip, 473er)....is in his 10th Major League season....has pitched for Colorado (2009-14), Arizona (2015), Atlanta (2016), LA of Anaheim (2016), San Diego (2017) and Milwaukee (2018).

CAREER AT MILLER PARK: Is 1-2 with a 3.72 ERA in 8 starts (48.1ip, 20er)....prior to this season had not pitched at Miller Park since 2014....is 1-1 with a 2.79 ERA in 5 starts this season (29ip, 9er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 25-38 with a 4.28 ERA in 102 games / 85 starts (500.1ip, 238er)....was 4-7 with a 6.53 ERA in 16 starts in 2017 (80ip, 58er)....is 2-0 with a 4.46 ERA in 7 starts this season (34.1ip, 17er).

CAREER vs. WHITE SOX: His only career appearance came in a start last season for the Padres on 5/12 at Guaranteed Rate Field....he earned a 6-3 win (6.1ip, 7h, 3r, 3er, 1bb, 5k, 2hr, 1hbp, 1wp).

CAREER AT THE PLATE: Is a .189 (56-for-296) hitter with 1 HR....homered on 9/20/13 vs. Arizona (2-run off Randall Delgado)....has 7 walks and 66 strikeouts.

THIS SEASON: Is batting .143 (3-for-21)....has not walked and has 7 strikeouts....has 1 sac bunt....**LAST SEASON:** Batted .222 (12-for-54) with 4 RBI....did not walk and had 11 strikeouts....had 7 sac bunts.
