TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Mets finish a four-game set today with the 16th meeting between the teams this season...The Braves will return here September 25-27 for three more games in the penultimate series of the season.

A The Braves dropped their first game here this season last night with a 3-0 loss...In the first three-game series here, May 1-3, the Braves outscored the Mets, 21-2, and overall have outscored their rivals, 27-8, in New York this season.

A The Braves have won 11 of the 15 games with New York this season after taking the first two games of this series...The club has won double-digit games against the Mets in 12 of the last 18 seasons...The franchise record for most wins in a season over the Mets is 14, first set by the 1964 and matched by the 1966 club...The Braves and Mets play four more times this season.

A RHP Julio Teheran is set to face the Mets for the fourth time this season...The right-hander is 1-1 with a 0.86 ERA (2 ER/21.0 IP) in his three starts against the Mets this season, and has limited New York hitters to a .153 average.

A RHP Corey Oswalt has never faced the Braves...The rookie has made his last three starts here at Citi Field, going 1-1 with a 3.38 and a .118 average against.

TEHERAN VS. THE METS: RHP Julio Teheran is 9-6 with a 2.33 ERA (37 ER/143.0 IP) in 23 career games, 22 starts against the Mets, and has allowed just eight home runs.

A Teheran has gone 7.0 innings three times this season; all three starts are against the Mets...He went 7.0 scoreless on April 21 and May 3 before allowing two runs, earned, over 7.0 innings on May 30 at SunTrust Park.

A The right-hander is 6-2 with a 2.14 ERA (16 ER/67.1 IP) in 11 career starts at Citi Field...He tossed a one-hitter here on June 19, 2016 in a 6-0 victory to begin a four-game winning streak in New York, which he takes into today's start...He owns a 0.76 ERA (3 ER/35.1 IP) over the five-game stretch.

A Overall, over his last 13 starts against the Mets, dating to June 21, 2015, Teheran has allowed more than two runs in a start against New York once (1.63 ERA)...Despite the personal success, the Braves are just 7-6 in these starts.

VENTERS: LHP Jonny Venters fanned two over a perfect inning last night, and since being acquired on July 26, the left-hander has allowed two baserunners over three scoreless outings.

A Venters allowed five runs, earned, in his lone start this season...As a reliever, the lefty has compiled a 0.55 ERA (1 ER/16.1 IP) with 14 strikeouts.

HITS: 1B Freddie Freeman singled and doubled last night, giving him a N.L.-high 132 hits, one more than teammate Nick Markakis...Freeman is on pace for a career-best 200 hits, while Markakis is on pace for 198.

A No pair of Braves teammates have ever reached 200 hits in the same season...The last major league team with multiple players reaching 200 hits in a season was the 2016 Boston Red Sox (Mookie Betts and Dustin Pedroia)...The last National League team to have two players reach that milestone was the 1998 Colorado Rockies (Dante Bichette and Vinny Castilla).

A Four different Tigers reached 200 hits in 1937 to set the major league record (Pete Fox, Charlier Gehring, Hank Greenberg and Gee Walker).

A OF Ender Inciarte had 201 hits last season and the Braves have had consecutive 200-hit seasons four times before in franchise history...The first was in 1893 and 1894, when Hugh Duffy had 203 and then 237 hits...Dick Burrell had 200 hits in 1925, before Ed Brown collected 201 the next year...Hank Aaron had 200 in 1956 and Red Schoendienst had the same total in 1957...Finally, Ralph Garr has 200 and then 214 hits in 1973 and 1974

THE BULLPEN: The Braves bullpen tossed 3.0 more scoreless innings last night, running its scoreless streak to 9.0 consecutive innings...Since allowing 10 runs over a two-game stretch, July 8 and July 10, Atlanta relievers have compiled a 2.45 ERA (14 ER/51.1 IP) and not surrendered a lead.

A The Braves bullpen 2.45 ERA over this stretch (since July 11) is the third best in baseball and trails only the San Francisco Giants (2.40) for tops in the National League...Oakland leads with a 2.29 mark,

DAY GAME: The Braves are set to play their 37th day game of the season today...They are 22-14 (.611) in these contests, the second-best record in the National League...Only the Chicago Cubs are better.

A OF Ronald Acuña Jr. is hitting .355 (22-for-62) in 17 day games this season...His average is tied for second-highest among qualifying N.L. players.

VS. THE N.L. EAST: The Braves are 33-17 (.660) against the National League East this season...The club has a +85 run differential against the division this season and have gone 11-2-3 in intradivision series play this season.

A Only Boston (.720) and Cleveland (.681) have better intradivision records.

A The Braves went 33-43 (.434) against their own division last season.

A The Braves have not had a winning intradivision record since 2014, when they went 40-36...Over the three previous seasons, the club went 103-124 (.454) against the N.L. East.

Today's Game

- A** Set to make his 22nd start of the season and the 184th (187th appearance) of his career.
- A** Is 9-6 with a 2.33 ERA (37 ER/143.0 IP) in 23 career games against New York, including 22 starts...Has allowed two runs over 21.0 innings (0.86 ERA) in his three starts against them this season.
- A** Tossed 22.0 consecutive scoreless innings against the Mets from the second inning of his start on 9/17/17 to the fourth frame of his most recent turn, 5/30 at SunTrust Park...It was Teheran's second career stretch of at least 20.0 straight scoreless innings against New York...His 29.0 straight scoreless frames from 6/21/15-9/9/16 is the second longest all time verses the Mets (courtesy STATS LLC).
- A** Took a no-hitter into the seventh inning in his last start at Citi Field, 5/3...Asdrúbal Cabrera doubled with two outs in the frame to break up the no-hit bid, Teheran's longest since 2013.
- A** Since his first full season in 2013, Teheran's 2.13 ERA (32 ER/135.0 IP) against the Mets is the second-best mark against the club among qualified starters in the majors...Only Max Scherzer (2.07) has a lower ERA against New York in that span.
- A** Allowed two earned runs or fewer in 19 of his 22 career starts against the Mets, including 18 quality turns.
- A** Has completed at least 6.0 innings in each of his last 13 starts against New York dating to 6/21/15, and is 5-3 with a 1.63 ERA (16 ER/88.1 IP) in that span.
- A** Teheran's run of at least 6.0 innings is the longest such streak of his career against any one opponent, and is tied for the longest active run against the Mets...Max Scherzer has also done so in 13 straight turns against New York.

2018 Recap

- A** Earned his eighth win after beating Miami, 5-3, in his last start...Allowed four hits, four walks and three runs over 5.0 innings.
- A** Has walked multiple batters in each of his last 13 games, the second-longest active streak in the majors.
- A** Held Arizona to four hits and three walks over 6.1 scoreless innings 7/15...Fanned six.
- A** The start was his sixth scoreless effort of at least 6.0 innings and no more than four hits on the season, the most such starts in the majors.
- A** Held San Diego hitless over 6.0 innings, 6/17...Was the first hitless start of his career.
- A** Became the sixth Atlanta pitcher (eight times overall) to not allow a hit in a start of at least 6.0 innings and the first since RHP Aaron Harang went 7.0 innings on 4/18/14 at New York-NL.
- A** Fanned 11, becoming just the second Atlanta pitcher to strike out double digits in a no-hit outing...Kent Mercker fanned 10 in his no-hitter on April 8, 1994 at Los Angeles (NL).
- A** Reinstated from the 10-day disabled list, 6/16...Missed nine games with a right thumb contusion after going on the D.L. on 6/5.
- A** Tossed just 4.0 innings, 6/4 at SD, before leaving with a right thumb contusion...Allowed five hits and four runs, including a season high-tying three home runs.
- A** Placed on the 10-day disabled list the following day, 6/5...The D.L. stint was the second of his career and his first since 2016.
- A** Lost his second consecutive start despite allowed five hits and two runs over 7.0 innings, 5/30 vs. NYM...Has gone 7.0 innings three times this season, and all three have come against the Mets.
- A** Snapped his scoreless streak against the Mets at 22.0 innings after allowing a run in the fourth inning...His streak was the longest in the majors against the Mets since Teheran also had a 29.0-inning run from 6/21/15 to 9/9/16.
- A** Turned in a "quality" start, 5/25 at BOS, allowing four hits and three runs over 6.0 innings of work...Threw a season-most 109 pitches.
- A** Took the loss after Atlanta fell 6-2...The loss snapped a career high-tying four-game winning streak that dated to 4/16 vs. PHI...Went 4-0 with a 2.06 ERA (8 ER/35.0 IP) over the run, which spanned six total starts.
- A** Allowed a then season-high six runs over 5.0 innings, 5/20 vs. MIA...Left the game trailing 6-0 before Atlanta rallied for a 10-9 win.
- A** Won his third consecutive start, 5/14 at CHI, after holding the Cubs to four hits and four runs over 6.0 innings...All four runs scored on a pair of two-run homers.
- A** Allowed two runs in the bottom of the second to snap a 16.0-inning scoreless streak, the second-longest such stretch of his career...Tossed a career-most 23.0 consecutive scoreless innings in 2016.
- A** Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings, 5/9 at TB...Allowed four hits and fanned seven...Logged consecutive scoreless starts for the fifth time in his career.
- A** The outing vs. TB snapped a streak of 11 consecutive starts within the N.L. East, dating to 9/6/17.

Career Recap

- A** Signed a six-year contract through 2019, with an option for 2020, on February 14, 2014... Is a two-time National League All-Star (2014, '16).

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 6 **1st Batter/Retired:** 36/27 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 9/3

- Over his last 27 appearances, dating to 5/19, has a 2.03 ERA (7 ER/31.0 IP) with a .162 (17-for-105) opponents' average and six holds...Six of the 27 games have spanned at least 2.0 innings.
- Tossed a scoreless ninth and 10th innings, 7/2 at NYY, to earn his second win of the season... Has gone more than 1.0 inning in 10 outings this season, compiling a 0.84 ERA (2 ER/21.1 IP) with 29 strikeouts.
- Opponents are 3-for-24 (.125) with runners in scoring position, including 1-for-12 (.083) with two outs.
- Earned his first career hold with a scoreless seventh inning, 6/24 vs. BAL...Became the sixth Atlanta pitcher with a hold this season.
- Right-handed batters have just 12 hits in 89 at-bats (.135) against him...Lefties are hitting .276 with 16 hits (58 at-bats), seven walks, three doubles, four home runs and 11 RBI.
- Set career highs in IP (3.0) and strikeouts (8), 6/2 vs. WSH... Became the first Braves reliever in 110 seasons to strike out at least eight batters in that few innings...MIL's Josh Hader struck out eight in 2.2 IP, 4/30/18 at CIN.

Saves/Opp: 11/13 **Holds:** 5 **1st Batter/Retired:** 44/29 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 15/2

- Atlanta acquired him, 7/29, from the Baltimore Orioles in exchange for an international signing slot...Made his Braves debut, 7/30 vs. MIA, with a scoreless eighth inning to earn his fourth hold of the season.
- Has tossed 2.0 scoreless innings with a pair of holds in two games with Atlanta.
- Went 1-2 with a 4.85 ERA (21 ER/39.0 IP) in 42 games with Baltimore, converting 11-of-13 save chances.
- Holding right-handed batters to a .278 (27-for-97) average, while lefties are hitting .325/.402/.429 in 88 plate appearances.
- Since 2015, ranked fourth in the American League with 242 appearances.
- The 32-year-old as an eight-year major league veteran, pitching to a career record of 30-21 with a 3.16 ERA (152 ER/432.1 IP) in 397 games prior to Atlanta acquiring him...Was named an American League All-Star in 2016 while going 10-4 with a 2.05 ERA.

- Is one of three rookie relievers for Atlanta with at least 10 holds...No other team has more than one...Ranks second on the team with his 12 holds...Dan Winkler leads the club with 18.
- His 53.1 innings pitched are most by an Atlanta rookie reliever since Craig Kimbrel had 77.0 innings in 2011.
- Has a 4.28 ERA (13 ER/27.1 IP) in his last 23 appearances dating to 5/21 at PHI...Pitched to a 0.69 ERA in his first 20 games of the season with just six walks...Has walked 12 over this skid.
- Is 3-1 with a 2.00 ERA (6 ER/27.0 IP) in 22 games at SunTrust Park.
- Tossed 3.0 perfect innings of relief, 7/5 at MIL.
- Leads Atlanta relievers with four wins.
- Holding batters to a .189 (17-for-90) average with men on base and has allowed just nine hits (9-for-52, .173) with runners in scoring position...Batters are hitting .252 (26-for-103) with no one on base.
