**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The Cardinals are 30-18 post All-Star Break and 31-18 under manager **Mike Shildt** since he took the post on July 15. The Cardinals and Athletics have the most wins in the NL since the All-Star Break (30), while St. Louis .625 winning percentage ranks 3rd in MLB over that period. St. Louis has won 20-of-its-last-29 games overall. Entering July 15, the Cardinals had T9th-most wins in the NL (47) and currently have T3rd-most wins (78) in the NL.

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** The Cardinals are at 14 games over .500 entering play today and currently reside in 3rd place in the NL Central, 5.0 games out of first place, and hold the 2nd spot in the NL Wild Card standings, trailing Milwaukee by 2.5 games. The Cardinals have 6 games remaining against teams ahead of them in the standings, the Cubs and Brewers.

**THE BIG BEAR:** In five games since Sunday (9/3-present), **Marcell Ozuna** leads the National League in total bases (24), co-leads in home runs (5, T.Story), ranks 2nd in .OPS (1.500) and slugging (1.091), and 7th in batting average (.409). Ozuna has 11 home runs and is slugging .547 in 39 games since the All-Star Break (10 home runs w/ .385 slugging in 90 games before).

**AVOIDING THE BROOM:** With a win today, the Cardinals are looking to avoid a three-game series sweep for the third time this season and first since June 29-July 1 vs. Atlanta. St. Louis has been swept twice by the Tigers in franchise history when they lost six consecutive meetings at Comerica Park (June 23-25, 2006 & May 18-20, 2007).

**ROAD WARRIORS:** The Cardinals' 41 road wins co-lead the National League (Atlanta) and are the club's most since 48 road victories in 2016 (29 in 2017). On the road since July 15, the Cardinals lead the National league in wins (17), win pct. (.633) and home runs (48).

**INTERLEAGUE ACTION:** St. Louis is 180-174 all-time in Interleague play, with a .510 win percentage that leads all NL clubs (Mets, .507)...this season, St. Louis is 10-9 (5-4 on the road) needs a win today for winning Interleague record for first time since 2015 (11-9) and 13th time in 22 seasons (since 1997)...St. Louis is 88-90 all-time in American League ballparks.

**DESIGNATED TO HIT:** Cardinals designated hitters are the all-time leaders amongst NL teams in batting (.301, 209-694), on-base percentage (.377) & slugging percentage (.510).

**INTERLEAGUE ENFORCER:** **Matt Carpenter** enters today's Interleague matchup leading all active players with a career .611 slugging pct. and OPS (1.023) in those contests while ranking 5th in batting (.326) and 2nd in on-base pct. (.412).

**MAKE IT A LITTLE BADER:** Outfielder **Harrison Bader** leads Major League outfielders in 5-star catches (7) and Outs Above Average (20) (*Statcast*), and co-leads the Majors with Detroit outfielder **JaCoby Jones** with 21 defensive runs saved (*Fangraphs*). His 8 outfield assists rank T6th in the National League and and co-lead NL rookies with Miami's **Brian Anderson**.

**CHICKS DIG THE LONG BALL:** St. Louis have homered in 103 of 142 games this season, going 70-33 (.680 win pct.) in those games (8-31 when not homering)...their 70 wins lead the NL and rank 5th in MLB (Yankees, 77)...among MLB clubs going yard, only the Red Sox (76-20, .792) and Astros (75-29, .721) have better winning percentages...St. Louis' 188 home runs are 2nd-most in the NL and trail the Dodgers (198)...280 of the Cardinals 655 runs scored (42.8%) this season have come via the long ball.

**ROAD BOMBS:** St. Louis is an NL-best 39-19 (.672) while homering on the road, and trails only Oakland (117) in road homers (116).

**POSTCARDS:** Two Cardinals minor league affiliates are currently competing in the postseason. The defending PCL Champion **Memphis Redbirds** (AAA) currently lead the Oklahoma City Dodgers, 2-1, in the best-of-five PCL Semifinals...last night's game was postponed due to rain, setting up a doubleheader today at AutoZone Park, beginning t 2:05 pm CT. The **Peoria Chiefs** (A) currently lead Cedar Rapids Kernals (Twins), 1-0, in the best-of-three Semifinals, and play Game Two at home at 4pm CT. The Cardinals minor league organization finished 492-402 overall and .550 winning percentage that ranked 3rd behind Tampa Bay (.604) and Houston (.562).

#### DETROIT CONNECTIONS

Cardinals Director of Communications **Brian Bartow** is a native of Battle Creek Mich...graduated from Ferris State College in Big Rapids, Mich.

**1934 World Series:** The "Gas House Gang" won the NL pennant on the final day of the season, then defeated Detroit in the Series, four games to three, for their third championship in eight years. **Dizzy and Paul Dean**, each won two games over the Tigers. The final game of the Series, won by the Cardinals, 11-0, was marked by **Commissioner Kenesaw Landis'** order to eject **Ducky Medwick** from the game. Medwick slid hard into Tigers third baseman **Marv Owen** in the sixth inn., so infuriating Detroit fans that they bombarded Medwick with empty bottles, fruit, vegetables and debris when he took his position in left field in the bottom of the inning. Landis removed Medwick to halt the disturbance...1934 was the last World Series in which both teams were led by player-managers.

**Jim Adduci's** father, **Jim Adduci**, was drafted by the Cardinals in the 7th round in 1980...appeared in 10 games for the Cardinals in 1983.

Hall of Fame Cardinals Manager **Whitey Herzog** played in 52 games for Detroit during the 1963 season...became a Tiger via trade with Baltimore, packaged with catcher **Gus Triandos** in exchange for catcher the **Dick Brown** (Nov. 26, 1962).

**1968 World Series:** 50 years ago, the Tigers overcame a 3-1 deficit and defeated the defending World Series champion Cardinals, four games to three, for their first championship since 1945... Left-hander **Mickey Lolich** hurled three complete-game victories (1.67 ERA) to earn MVP... Gibson won two games and set Series records by striking out 17 batters in Game One and 35 in the Series. **Lou Brock** batted .464 and stole seven bases. Current Cardinals Hall of Fame broadcasters **Tim McCarver** and **Mike Shannon**, each homered and played all seven games.

Tigers Special Assistant to the GM **Jim Leyland** spent six seasons (2000-05) as a scout for the Cardinals, scouting NL clubs from Pittsburgh and AL clubs from Cleveland.

**2006 World Series:** The Cardinals secured a playoff berth on the final day of the regular season by winning the NL Central Division and went on to capture the 10th World Championship in franchise history, topping the Tigers in five games...the Cardinals won the Fall Classic with the fewest regular-season wins during a full season in major league history (83)...St. Louis pitchers limited the Tigers to 32 hits in 44 IP with a 2.05 ERA. **David Eckstein** batted .364 (8-22) with three doubles and four RBI to be named MVP...**Tony La Russa** joined **Sparky Anderson** (Reds & Tigers) as only the second manager to win the World Series with teams in both leagues...notable Cardinals to appear include **Yadier Molina** and **Adam Wainwright**.

**TODAY'S GAME**

- Makes his 16th start of the season (23rd appearance) and 25th career Major League start (50th career appearance).
- Since August 8, ranks 7th among N.L. pitchers in 6th in ERA (1.59), 6th in wins (3), opp BA (.168) and 7th in H/9 IP (5.72).
- Has not allowed an earned run in his last 10.0 straight innings pitched.
- Only earned run allowed in his last three starts (17.0 IP) was a pinch-hit solo home run to Matt Holliday (COL) at Coors Field on August 25 in a no decision matching his career-high with 7.0 innings.
- Was 3-1 with a 3.06 ERA in six starts for the Cardinals in the month of August.
- Is 4-5 with 3.29 ERA (29 ER/79.1 IP) in 15 starts for St. Louis, averaging 7.5 strikeouts/9 IP (66 K).
- Is 2-0 with a 2.70 ERA in seven relief appearances (16.2 IP).
- Is limiting the opposition to a .205 BAA (72-352) this season & he sports a .207 Opp. BAA (60-290) as a starting pitcher. Opp. are hitting just .182 (323-176) at Busch Std.
- Six of the 7 HR's he's allowed this season have been hit by left-handers: Odúbel Herrera, Freddie Freeman, Pablo Sandoval, Tucker Barnhart, Ben Zobrist & Anthony Rizzo.
- Features a split-finger change-up nicknamed the "Vulcan" due to his unique four-finger grip. Has highest pct. of swing & miss (4.2) on a change-up of any Cardinals pitcher.

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Tied his career high with five walks over 4.1 innings allowing three unearned runs on two hits at Washington in a no decision the Cardinals won 11-8.
- Has not allowed an earned run in his last 10 straight innings.
