CARDINALS NOTES

- Miles Mikolas** made his 22nd start of the season, first against the Rockies in 2018 and first career start (3rd app.) vs. the Rockies...is 6-0 in day game this season and 7-0 career...has held his opposition to three runs or less in his last eight starts...was his 3rd no decision in his last four starts.
- Miles Mikolas** has three hits in his last five games...scored his 2nd career MLB run and his first since his home run at MIL (4/2).
- Chasen Shreve** earned his first win as a Cardinal and was the third Cardinals pitcher to earn his first win with the club during this season (**Dakota Hudson & Austin Gomber**).
- Harrison Bader** has scored a run in three straight games...has stolen a base in consecutive games for the second time this season and was the last Cardinals player to steal a base in consecutive games (4/19 at CHI & 4/20 vs. PIT).
- Tyler O'Neill** has an RBI in back-to-back games for the the 3rd time in his career.
- Marcell Ozuna** recorded his 5th outfield assist of the season.
- Marcell Ozuna was removed from the game in the 5th inning with a left toe injury.*
- Greg Garcia** singled in the 9th inning giving him his first hit in six games (last; 7/25 at CIN)...scored his first run since a solo home run at CHI (7/20).
- José Martínez** recorded his first walk-off RBI of his career...had his 19th career pinch-hit (19-43, .443), 5 RBI.
- The **Cardinals** have won every home series vs. Colorado since 2010 and are 34-13 at Busch Stadium III all-time vs. the Rockies, the Cardinals highest winning pct. (.723) against any National League opponent at thtis stadium...won by walk-off for the 9th time this season and only the 2nd not on a home run (**Dexter Fowler**, 4/26 vs. NYM)...was their 24th comeback win of the season...are 3-0-4 in four-game series this season...have four wins when trailing after eight innings, tied for the most among National League teams (4-46).

ROCKIES NOTES


- Antonio Senzatela** made his fifth start (15th app.) of the season, first against the Cardinals in 2018 and third of his career (1-1)...last season, earned a win a Coors Field tossing 8.0 scoreless innings and lost at Busch Stadium allowing four runs over four innings...has started his last four games after beginning the season with 10 relief appearances...has held his opposition to one run or less in each of his last two starts.
- Wade Davis** suffered his 5th blown save of the season, tied for the National League lead in that category...was his 2nd game in which he suffered a blown save and the loss in the same game (6/17 at TEX).
- Carlos González** dropped his 2nd bunt hit of the season.
- Gerardo Parra** has an RBI in three straight games with multi-hit games in three of the four games of this series...has hit safely in his last 8 games vs. STL and his last 12 starts vs. the Cardinals (20-46, .435).

 *The Rockies requested a crew chief review on the safe call on Paul DeJong stealing second base in the 8th inning. Call overturned (Time: 2:10).*

 **The Rockies** lost by walk-off for the 5th time this season...took their 4th loss when leading after eight innings (5-4)...went consecutive games without a home run for the first time since 6/10-12...are 10-20 when not hitting a home run...collected their 11th bunt hit of the season...lost three games in a series for the first time since a three-game sweep vs. ARI (6/8-10).
