NATIONALS NEWS

AUSTIN'S POWER

The Washington Nationals topped the New York Mets, 6-0, on Saturday afternoon behind 5.0 innings of one-hit, shutout ball from **Austin Voth**. He struck out five batters and walked just two en route to his first Major League win...With the outing, Voth became the third Nationals pitcher this season to go at least 5.0 IP and allow one hit or fewer (also: **Max Scherzer** on April 14 vs. Colorado and **Jeremy Hellickson** on Aug. 10 vs. Chicago-NL).

- Following today's season finale against the New York Mets, the Nationals will welcome the Miami Marlins for the final home series of the 2018 season starting Monday.

HE'S STREAKING

Anthony Rendon has reached base safely in a career-high 30 straight games dating to Aug. 21...It is the longest active streak in Major League Baseball and is tied for the third-longest streak in the National League this season...**Christian Yelich** also had a 30-game streak from Aug. 11 to Sept. 15...**Matt Carpenter** is second on the list with a 35-game streak (7/8-8/17) and **Odubel Herrera** had the longest streak in the NL this year (40 G, 3/30-5/19)...During the streak, Rendon is hitting .345 with a .430 on-base percentage and a .595 slugging percentage.

- On the season, Rendon ranks in the NL in doubles (2nd, 41), average (6th, .305), slugging percentage (9th, .522), extra-base hits (10th, 64) and OPS (10th, .892).
- Since 2016, his 120 doubles are tied for the most in the National League with **Nick Markakis** (120) and are tied for third in all of Major League Baseball behind **Jose Ramirez** (139), **Mookie Betts** (132) and **Markakis**.

EVERYDAY TREA

Trea Turner has played in each of Washington's 155 games this season, making 151 starts and four appearances off the bench...The only player in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to appear in all 162 games in a season was **Ryan Zimmerman**, who started all 162 games in 2007.

- If Turner starts each of the eight games left on the schedule, he will tie **Alfonso Soriano** (158 in 2006) for second on the list behind Zimmerman's 162 starts in 2007.
- Turner enters Sunday riding a career-long 22 game on-base streak dating to Aug. 29.
- With 122 in hand, Turner is tied with **Ian Desmond** for the most stolen bases as a National (2005-pres.).

CHASING 100-100-100

Bryce Harper enters Sunday with 97 runs scored, 98 RBI and 125 walks in 2018...He is looking to become the sixth player since 2014 to record at least 100 runs, RBI and walks in a season...He would join **Joey Votto** (2017), **Aaron Judge** (2017), **Mike Trout** (2016), **Paul Goldschmidt** (2015) and **Jose Bautista** (2015, 2014).

- On the season, he ranks in the National League in HR (T2nd, 34), OBP (5th, .391), runs (T7th, 97), RBI (6th, 98), XBH (11th, 63) and OPS (11th, .886).
- His career-high 125 walks lead MLB and the most in a season in Nationals history (2005-pres.).

BEST OF THE BEST

Since the All-Star break, Washington's offense ranks in the National League in on-base percentage (1st, .346), batting average (1st, .262), doubles (1st, 115), stolen bases (1st, 45), runs (2nd, 309), walks (2nd, 243), OPS (2nd, .779) and slugging percentage (3rd, .434).

- Washington's second-half surge has placed them among the top five NL offenses in 2018 in on-base percentage (2nd, .331), runs (4th, 726), home runs (5th, 183), slugging percentage (5th, .414) and OPS (4th, .745).

NATIONALS HISTORY

September 23 (6-7 on this date)

2007 - The 41-year old RFK Stadium, one-time home to the NFL Redskins and American League Senators, hosted its 1,047th and final Major League Baseball game as Washington beat the Phillies, 5-3. Closer **Chad Cordero** fittingly threw the final pitch. When The District's new expansion team moved to Texas in 1972, the 56,000-seat facility lost baseball until the Montreal Expos arrived in D.C. to become the Nationals in 2005.

DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A) 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

#23 - ERICK FEDDE - RHP

Former first-round pick (No. 18) in the 2014 First-Year Player Draft has provided depth to Washington's starting rotation since making his debut in 2017...Entered the 2018 season rated as the No. 3 prospect in Washington's Minor League system per *Baseball America*...As a starter, has recorded 8.7 strikeouts per nine innings across 60 career Minor League starts.

AGAINST THE METS: Faces the Mets for the second time in his career...His third career start - and final start of the 2017 season - against the Mets on Aug. 27, 2017...Allowed five earned runs on seven hits with five strikeouts in 6.0 innings of work.

LAST START: Was strong through 4.0 shutout innings on Sept. 17 at Miami before surrendering two earned runs in the fifth before being lifted from the game...Allowed two earned runs on two hits, but was done in by four walks...Did not factor into the decision.

2018 NOTES

- Has pitched to a 1.80 ERA (2 ER/10.0 IP) with 15 strikeouts and a .121 opp. AVG (4-for-33) across his last two starts.
- Made his best start of the season on Sept. 11 at Philadelphia...Struck out nine batters in 5.2 shutout innings...Issued two walks and allowed two hits in Washington's 3-1 win.
- Made three rehab starts before returning to the active roster on 9/4...Recorded a 2.45 ERA (4 ER/14.2 IP) with 13 strikeouts against five walks.
- Allowed just three Triple-A home runs in 14 starts for the Chiefs...All three homers came on May 2 at Lehigh Valley.
- Did not issue a walk in his previous two Minor League starts prior to his promotion on June 13...Has posted a 4.07 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 11 Triple-A starts (61 SO/15 BB).
- He tossed 5.0 innings giving up four runs on six hits, while walking one and striking out three against the New York Yankees on June 13...Did not earn a decision in the Nationals 5-4 win over the Yankees.
- Made his first MLB start of the season on May 23 vs. San Diego...Allowed three earned runs on six hits in 5.2 innings of work as the Nationals fell to the Padres, 3-1...Struck out six batters while walking just one.
- Began the season with Triple-A Syracuse...Made eight starts, going 1-1 with 4.35 ERA (20 ER/ 41.1 IP) before being recalled on May 23.
- On May 18 vs. Lehigh Valley (PHI), tossed 6.2 innings, allowing one unearned run on four hits...Struck out six and walked two.
- Fanned a season-high 10 batters on May 7 vs. Scranton-Wilkes-Barre (NYY).
- Started the season strong, allowing three earned runs in 15.0 IP (1.80 ERA) across his first three starts.
- Tossed shutout appearances on April 8 at Scranton-Wilkes-Barre (5.0 IP, 4 H, BB, 2 SO) and April 20 at Louisville (5.0 IP, 2 H, BB 7 SO).

2017 NOTES

- Began the season with Double-A Harrisburg before being promoted to Triple-A Syracuse on June 13...Made seven starts for Harrisburg (2-3, 3.16 ERA, 35 SO, 14 BB, 3 HR) and 10 appearances out of the bullpen (1-0, 2.63 ERA, 19 SO, 4 BB, HR).
- Began his stint with Syracuse in the bullpen (6 G, 1-0, 3.86 ERA, 7 SO, BB) before moving to the rotation (6 GS, 0-2, 5.11 ERA, 18 SO, 4 BB).
- Had his contract selected from Syracuse on July 30...Made his MLB debut that day against Colorado (4.0 IP, 10 H, 7 ER, 2 BB, 3 SO).
- In his second start, Aug. 6 at CHI, struck out seven batters in 5.1 innings of work...Enjoyed four MLB stints with Washington.
- Placed on the 60-day DL on Sept. 4 with a right forearm flexor strain, ending his 2017 season.

- Ranked second among Nationals farmhands in ERA (3.12) and fourth in strikeouts (123).

- Was named Carolina League Pitcher of the Week on July 17.
- From May 23 to Aug. 5, posted a 0.62 ERA (4 ER/57.2 IP), struck out 60 batters and walked 10 while posting a 4-1 record over 11 games (10 starts).
- Entered the season rated as the No. 82 prospect in all of baseball, according to *Baseball America*...For the second straight season, boasted the "Best Slider" in the organization, per *Baseball America*.
