WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost six of the last seven games, eight of 12 and 15 of 20 as they continue a six-game, seven-day homestand this afternoon vs. the Minnesota Twins.
- RHP James Shields, who has not won a start since Opening Day (3/29) at Kansas City, is scheduled to start for Chicago.
- The Sox 9-22 (.290) mark is the third-worst in baseball ahead of Baltimore (8-25) and Cincinnati (8-25).
- The White Sox went 3-4 on their last trip, losing both games in St. Louis after winning three of five at Kansas City.
- Following today's series finale vs. the Twins and an off day Monday, the Sox will conclude the homestand next Tuesday and Wednesday vs. the Pirates ... the club will then take a five-game trip to Wrigley Field (5/11-13) and Pittsburgh (5/15-16).
- The White Sox went 1-5 on their last homestand vs. Houston (0-3) and Seattle (1-2) from 4/20-25.

TODAY'S STORYLINES

- Chicago is a season-high 13 games under .500 ... the club's 9-22 start is its worst since 1950 (also 9-22) ... the last time the Sox started with a 9-23 record or worse was 1948 (8-24).
- The White Sox 3-12 (.200) home record is the worst in MLB, and the club's worst 15-game start in Chicago since 1971 (opened the season with a 2-14 home mark).
- Chicago has lost six of the last seven games, eight of the last 11 and 12 of the last 17 vs. Minnesota.
- James Shields is 0-3 with a 6.15 ERA (18 ER/26.1 IP), 23 strikeouts, 1.48 WHIP and eight home runs allowed over his last five starts (two quality) vs. the Twins.
- Yolmer Sánchez is hitting .340/.375/.472 (18-53) with five doubles, one triple and eight RBI in the last 13 games.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

- Minnesota scored multiple runs in three of the first four innings, and recorded 19 baserunners overall in its 8-4 victory.
- The Twins scored three times in the first, three in the third and twice in fourth, and held an 8-2 lead after six.
- The White Sox scored just four runs despite registering 11 hits, including four doubles and two home runs ... the Sox went 3-10 with RISP, left five runners on base, did not record a walk and struck out 11 times.
- Héctor Santiago suffered the loss in his second start of the season after allowing eight runs on six hits and six walks in 3.1 IP ... Chicago's bullpen combined to work 5.2 scoreless IP.
- Tim Anderson went 3-4 and recorded his second career multi-homer game (also Opening Day at Kansas City).

STREAKING IN CHICAGO

- The White Sox need to win this afternoon's game vs. Minnesota to avoid losing their fifth consecutive series at Guaranteed Rate Field to start the season.
- The five-series home losing streak would be the second-longest in franchise history (two-plus games per series) to open a season ... the 1971 Sox lost each of their first six home series.

HAWK AND WIMPY: THE SERIES FINALE

- Today's game marks the final time Ken "Hawk" Harrelson and Tom "Wimpy" Paciorek will work together in the Sox TV booth ... 2018 is Harrelson's final season calling White Sox games.
- Paciorek, who is filling in for regular TV analyst Steve Stone this series, is one of many special guests who will visit and work with Harrelson on Sunday home games this season.
- Harrelson and Paciorek were part of Chicago's popular TV broadcast team from 1990-99.

PROVIDING RELIEF

- Chicago relievers own a 1.56 ERA (7 ER/40.1 IP) with 34 strikeouts and four holds over the last 12 games since 4/24 ... the 1.56 ERA is the lowest in the major leagues during that span.
- The White Sox bullpen has worked 2.0-plus IP 10 times, 3.0-plus IP six times and 4.0-plus IP four times ... the group has held the opponent scoreless in seven contests.
- By comparison, Sox relievers owned a 6.27 ERA (26 ER/37.1 IP) and .308 opp. average (45-146) in the previous seven games.

THANK YOU FOR YOUR SERVICE

- The White Sox today are hosting Nurse Appreciation Day and celebrating the role nurses play in delivering the highest level of quality care to their patients.
- The first 1,500 fans/nurses who purchased a specially-priced ticket will receive a White Sox scrub top.
- The Sox also provided tickets to the Rush University Medical Center ICU staff as part of today's promotion ... tickets were distributed to the staff and nurses caring for RHP Danny Farquhar, who is being treated following a brain aneurysm.

WHITE SOX VS. MINNESOTA

- Minnesota leads the season series, 3-1, with 15 games left.
- The Sox are hitting .227/.266/.424 with six home runs, own a 5.14 ERA (20 ER/35.0 IP) and have been outscored, 23-14.
- Games from 4/13-15 were postponed (see schedule at right).
- The Sox have lost six of the last seven games, 12 of the last 17, and are 5-10 in the last 15 at Guaranteed Rate Field.
- Chicago went 7-12 vs. Minnesota in 2017 (4-6 at Guaranteed Rate Field) to fall to 3-12-2 in the last 17 season matchups.
- The White Sox trail in the all-time series, 426-476 ... they are 231-220 at home (117-101 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 195-256 on the road (36-41 at Target Field).

STREAKING THROUGH BIRMINGHAM

- Class AA Birmingham C Zack Collins is hitting .429 (15-35) with two doubles, one triples, two homers, seven RBI, 12 walks and a .583 on-base percentage during his 10-game hitting streak.
- Barons OF Eloy Jiménez is hitting .381 (16-42) with four doubles, three home runs, 12 RBI and a .381 on-base percentage during his current nine-game hitting streak.

PUT AWAY THE SUITCASE

- The White Sox currently are in a stretch playing 17 of 19 games in Chicago, including 14 at Guaranteed Rate Field, from 5/3-24.
- Following this six-game homestand vs. Minnesota and Pittsburgh, the Sox will play three games at Wrigley Field (5/11-13) and four-game series vs. Texas (5/17-20) and Baltimore (5/21-24).
- The club's only road games are at the Pirates from 5/15-16.
- Chicago has been outscored, 83-48, at Guaranteed Rate Field.

ONE (RUN) AND DONE

- Chicago has gone 4-9 in one-run games in 2018, tied for the second-most in the major leagues behind Tampa Bay (5-10) ... the nine one-run losses are the second-most in baseball.
- The White Sox have scored one run or less eight times this season, tied for the fifth-most in baseball.
- The Sox were 21-23 in one-run games in 2017.

LOOKING FOR CENTRAL COMMAND

- The White Sox are 6-8 against the American League Central in 2018 after going 33-43 (.434) last season.
- Chicago has lost 10 of its last 13 games vs. the AL Central at Guaranteed Rate Field, being outscored 80-49.
- The Sox are 297-385 vs. the AL Central since 2009, posting a losing record every season except 2012 (37-35).

STOP! THIEF!

- The White Sox lead the American League and rank second in baseball with 31 stolen bases ... the club ranks fourth in the major leagues with an 81.6 (31-38) success rate.
- Tim Anderson (2nd, 10), Leury García (T4th, 6), Adam Engel (T7th, 5) and Yoán Moncada (T13th, 4) rank among AL leaders.
- The Sox are on pace to steal 162 bases this season ... by comparison, they stole 71 bases in 2017 and 77 in 2016.

STOP! THIEF! - PART 2

- White Sox catchers are tied for the American League lead and tied for second in MLB with 10 catcher caught stealing in 2018.
- Omar Narváez (six) is tied for third and Wellington Castillo is tied for sixth among AL catchers.
- The Sox 14 combined caught stealing mark (pitchers and catchers) is tied with Miami for the most in MLB.

QUALITY AND QUANTITY

- The White Sox have made a major-league leading 1,326 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, three more than the second-place New York Mets (1,322) and 44 more than Oakland (1,282), the next-closest American League team.

NO RISP, NO REWARD

- The White Sox rank 12th in the American League with a .214 (54-252) average with RISP this season.
- Chicago is hitting .265 (35-132) with RISP in the last 17 games, up from .158 (19-120) over their first 14 ... the Sox have been limited to two hits or less with RISP 23 times (zero hits 10 times).

ON DECK: VS. PITTSBURGH PIRATES

- The White Sox conclude this homestand with a brief two-game series vs. the Pittsburgh Pirates.
- The Sox opened interleague play by losing two games at St. Louis from 5/1-2 ... both games ended with 3-2 finals.
- Chicago leads the all-time series vs. Pittsburgh, 17-13 ... it is 9-5 at Guaranteed Rate Field and 8-8 at the Pirates.
- The White Sox were swept in the last season series in 2015, losing two games in Chicago and two at PNC Park.

SHIELDS AT A GLANCE

- Is scheduled to make his eighth appearance, and seventh start, of 2018, fifth at Guaranteed Rate Field and first vs. Minnesota ... is looking to record his first win since his season debut on 3/29 at Kansas City.
- Has gone 0-3 with a 6.50 ERA (13 ER/18.0 IP), 1.56 WHIP, .257 opponents average and 10 walks over his last four games (three starts).
- Ranks 70th all-time in major-league history with 2,099 strikeouts, 18 behind the late Roy Halladay (2,117) for 69th all-time (see chart at right).
- Is 10-22 with a 5.91 ERA (175 ER/266.2 IP), 200 strikeouts, 61 home runs allowed and a 1.56 WHIP over 50 appearances (49 GS/19 QS) since being acquired by the White Sox from the Padres in a trade on 6/4/16.
- Ranks among the active MLB leaders since 2007 in games started (2nd, 357), IP (2nd, 2,322.0), pitches thrown (2nd, 36,581), complete games (T4th, 22), shutouts (5th, 9), opponents GIDP (5th, 192), quality starts (6th, 218), strikeouts (8th, 1,995) and wins (10th, 133).

LAST START

- Received a no decision on 5/1 vs. St. Louis despite allowing one run on two hits with zero walks and four strikeouts over 6.0 IP.
- Surrendered a leadoff home run to Tommy Pham before retiring the next 15 Cardinals he faced.
- Departed with the White Sox leading, 2-1, after throwing 93 pitches (60 strikes) ... Joakim Soria allowed two runs in the ninth, including a game-ending single to Yadier Molina, as St. Louis recorded a 3-2 win.
- Recorded his first quality start since 4/11 vs. Tampa Bay (1 ER/6.1 IP) ... worked at least 6.0 IP in consecutive starts for the first time this season.

35TH AND SHIELDS

- Is 8-13 with a 5.39 ERA (98 ER/163.2 IP), 168 hits allowed (37 homers), 75 walks, 128 strikeouts, a .260 opponents average and 1.48 WHIP in his 29 starts (14 quality) at Guaranteed Rate Field with Chicago.
- Prior to joining the White Sox, was 4-1 with a 3.00 mark (24 ER/72.0 IP), 1.33 WHIP, 47 strikeouts and nine home runs allowed over 11 starts (nine quality starts) as a visitor at Guaranteed Rate Field.
- Over his 40 career outings in Chicago, has allowed three runs or less 26 times and two or less 18 times ... has worked at least 6.0 IP in 31 of 40 starts ... 23 of his starts have been quality.

OUTLIERS ON THE BASES

- Opponents are hitting .360 (18-50) with runners on base, .379 (11-29) with RISP and .375 (6-16) with RISP/two outs this season ... owns a .195 opponents average (17-87) with the bases empty.
- By comparisons, owns the following career opponent averages: .259 (1,480-5,719) with the bases empty, .256 (946-3,692) with runners on, .248 (498-2,011) with RISP and .218 (196-900) with RISP/two outs.
- The .218 mark with RISP/two outs is the 24th-lowest among active right-handers.

RARE RELIEF WORK

- Suffered the loss on 4/18 at Oakland after entering the game in the 14th inning ... surrendered a game-ending, RBI single to Matt Olson with two outs in the 14th.
- Marked just his second career relief appearance ... pitched out of the bullpen for Tampa Bay on 6/19/10 vs. Florida, earning the win with 1.0 scoreless IP.
- Started the club's next game on 4/20 vs. Houston, becoming the first White Sox pitcher to finish a game and start the following contest since Gene Nelson in 1986 (4/27 at Detroit and 4/29 vs. Baltimore).

OPENING DAY HONORS

- His season debut marked his eighth career Opening Day start following four with Tampa Bay (2008-10, '12), two with Kansas City (2013-14) and one with San Diego (2015).
- Is 2-2 with a 4.98 ERA (26 ER/47.0 IP) and 30 strikeouts in the eight OD outings.
- Is tied with the Dodgers' Clayton Kershaw for the fourth-most Opening Day starts among active pitchers ... joined Edinson Vólquez as the only active pitchers to start season openers for four different teams (STATS).

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Has made 20-plus starts in every major-league season, joining Cole Hamels and Justin Verlander as the only pitchers since 2006 to accomplish that feat ... recorded at least 10 victories, 200.0 IP and 160 strikeouts each season from 2007-15.
- Is 3-6 with a 5.46 ERA (36 ER/59.1 IP) and 45 strikeouts over 11 career postseason starts (four quality starts) ... pitched in the postseason with Tampa Bay (2008, 2010-11) and Kansas City (2014) ... made three World Series starts with the Rays (2008) and Royals (2014).
- Was an American League All-Star with Tampa Bay in 2011.

NOT DIGGING THE LONG BALL

- Has surrendered just three home runs this season ... by comparison, allowed 10 home runs in his first seven appearances (all starts) in 2017.
- Has given up at least one home run in 30 of his last 38 starts (50 total), allowed 70 homers since 2016 and 103 since 2015 ... has allowed 103 homers since 2015, the most in baseball during that span.
- Allowed 27 home runs last season, his fewest since 2014 (23) ... surrendered a major-league leading 40 home runs in 2016 after leading baseball with 33 in 2015 ... became the first pitcher to lead MLB in homers allowed in consecutive seasons since Tom Browning in 1988-89.
- Has allowed 1.73 homers per 9.0 IP since 2015 (536.1 IP), the third-highest mark in the major leagues.

HELP WANTED

- Chicago has scored just five runs of support in his last four starts after scoring 17 runs in his first two.
- Received a 5.46 run support average (71 RS/117.0 IP) over his 21 starts last season, compared to a 3.22 mark (65 RS/181.2 IP) in 2016 ... his 4.66 career RSA is tied for the 10th-lowest among active pitchers.
- His 3.22 RSA in 2016 was the lowest in baseball and the lowest of his career.
- Owns a 4.87 RSA (144 RS/266.0 IP) as a starter since joining the Sox (49 starts), receiving the following run support marks: zero runs (12x), one (7x), two (8x), three (7x), four (4x), five (3x) and six-plus (8x).
