THE TWINS: After completing their final roadtrip of the season with a record of 5-5 (1-3 vs. Kansas City, 3-0 vs. Detroit and 1-2 vs. Oakland), the Twins began their final homestand with a loss to the Tigers last night...tonight they will play the second of three with Detroit... after tomorrow night's series finale, the Twins will welcome in Chicago-AL for four games over the weekend (doubleheader Friday) to complete the 2018 season.

MAUER MAKES HIMSELF NUMBER ONE: The Twins lost to the Tigers last night by a score of 4-2 at Target Field, allowing four runs in the top of the eighth inning...Gabriel Moya was the Opener with a scoreless first and Kohl Stewart was the Primary, pitching 6.0 scoreless innings...Joe Mauer had two of the Twins nine hits, and one walk...he has now passed Harmon Killebrew, moving into sole possession of first on the Twins all-time list for times on base (since 1961):

NOTE: Mauer has reached base against Detroit 352 career times, 132 more than the next active player (Alex Gordon - 220).

TWINS AND TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the 18th of 19 scheduled meetings in 2018...the Twins have gone 10-7 this season, 5-3 at home and 5-4 at Comerica Park...they have gone 17-8 in their last 25 vs. Detroit.

☞ Twins have scored 80 runs against the Tigers this season, second most to Kansas City (96).
☞ Tyler Austin is hitting .419 (13-for-31) with three home runs and 10 RBI in nine games vs. the Tigers this season.
☞ Ehire Adrianza is hitting .362 (17-for-47) with six doubles and 11 RBI vs. Detroit in 15 games this season.
☞ Joe Mauer is hitting .342 (13-for-38) in 10 games vs. Detroit this season.

MAUER AND THE TIGERS: Joe Mauer is hitting .306 (244-for-798) with 43 doubles, two triples, 18 home runs, 121 RBI, 105 walks and a .386 on-base percentage in 214 career games vs. the Tigers...below are his ranks among actives against Detroit in a few categories:

PITCHERS ON STRIKE: Twins pitchers have struck out 1,318 batters this season, 127 more than the next on the club list, coming in 2016 when they struck out 1,191...starters have struck out 733 hitters, fifth most in club history (best being 870 in 1967)...relievers have struck out 585, the best in club history (next, 536 in 2016).

EVERYDAY EHIRE: Ehire Adrianza has started 16 of the Twins last 19 games at third base...he has hit safely in a career-high eight straight games, hitting .364 (12-for-33) with seven doubles and six RBI in that span...he has driven in 13 runs this month in 18 games played, tied with Jake Cave for most on the club.

MAUER MAKING THE MOST OF IT: Joe Mauer is hitting .357 (15-for-42) with one home run, seven RBI, four walks, eight runs scored, a .404 on-base percentage and six multi-hit games in his last 11.

MINNESOTA, NICE: The Twins have gone 43-32 at home this season, compared to 29-52 on the road...43 home wins are their most since winning 46 in 2015...the Twins won 41 games at home last season...they have gone 24-12 at Target Field since June 24...since that date, they have the fifth best home winning percentage in baseball (.667), trailing Boston (.775), Oakland (.732), Tampa Bay (.721) and Colorado (.700).

DOUGIE BASEBALL IN THE BUILDING: Former Twins first baseman and Triple-A Toledo Manager Doug Mientkiewicz has joined the Tigers' coaching staff for September...Mientkiewicz was drafted by the Twins in the fifth round of the 1995 First-Year Player Draft and played parts of seven seasons with the Twins from 1998-2004, hitting .275 (590-for-2147) with 146 doubles, 43 home runs and 266 RBI...he was the AL Gold Glove winner at first base in 2001.

THE REMAINS: The Twins have six games remaining on the 2018 schedule, all home games...four night games and two day games...they play Detroit twice and Chicago-AL four times, including a doubleheader with the White Sox on Friday (makeup game from weather postponements in mid-April)...the Twins will begin their 2019 schedule with the Indians at Target Field on March 28.

LAST START: Odorizzi earned his second straight win on September 18 over Detroit after allowing two runs on four hits and one walk with six strikeouts...shutout the Tigers over the first 6.0 innings on one hit before allowing three hits and a pair of runs in the seventh inning...first time this year he's recorded an out in the seventh inning in consecutive starts...only his second road win of the year...second fewest pitches thrown in a start where he's thrown at least 6.0 innings in his career (previous low: 83 pitches over 6.0 innings on May 20, 2015).

AGAINST THE TIGERS: Odorizzi is making his eighth career start and third of the season against Detroit...is 3-1 with a 3.15 ERA (40.0 IP, 14 ER) with 14 walks, 45 strikeouts and allowed just one home run across his previous seven starts...making second consecutive start against Detroit...in his only start against Detroit at Target Field on August 19, did not factor into the decision after allowing four runs on four hits and two walks with seven strikeouts over 5.0 innings...has not lost a decision vs. DET since August 20, 2014...in 13 starts against the AL Central this year, is 1-4 with a 4.93 ERA (65.2 IP, 36 ER) with 26 walks and 68 strikeouts.

FINDING STRIDE: Odorizzi enters tonight with a two-game win-streak...his career-high is three, done twice: August 14-25, 2016 and July 12-28, 2014 both with Tampa Bay.

CAREER YEAR?: Odo will be making his 32nd start tonight, marking the third time in his career he has made 30+ starts in a season and the first time since making 33 in 2016 for Tampa Bay...since 2016 Odorizzi ranks tied for third among American League starters with 92 starts...since 2014 he ranks tied for fourth with 151 starts...has recorded 159 strikeouts this season, 15 short of his career high 174 in 2014.

- Eclipsed 800 career strikeouts in his last start at DET.

ON THE FIRST PITCH: Through his 31 starts this season, Odorizzi has allowed a .455 (25-for-55) average on the first pitch against a batter...on the 0-0 count, six of the 25 hits have been home runs and eight have been doubles...his .455 average is the highest of any full season in his career.

- On the contrary, when Odorizzi gets two strikes on a batter he is holding hitters to a .171 (62-for-363) average.

QUALITY NOT QUANTITY: Over his 31 starts this season, Odorizzi has averaged just over 5.1 innings/start...of starters with at least 3 starts, his 161.1 innings ranks as the fourth-fewest in MLB...his 18.6 pitches/innings ranks highest in baseball...he averages 4.34 pitches/batter faced which is most in MLB...though his starts have been on the short side, his 78 earned runs allowed ranks tied-10th fewest in the American League among qualified pitchers who have started at least 30 games.

- His start on August 24 snapped his MLB record stretch of 26 games started without recording an out in the 7th inning.

HOME AND ROAD: Has gone 5-4, 4.40 ERA (77.2 IP, 38 ER) in 15 home starts this season, compared to 2-6, 4.30 ERA (83.2 IP, 40 ER) in 16 road starts...at home Odo has walked 25 batters and 40 on the road...among starters on the Twins Odorizzi has received the second most runs of support at home (43)...in contrast, he has only received 32 runs of support on the road, which is tied for second fewest of any starter with at least 15 road starts in baseball...two road wins are tied for fewest among pitchers with at least 80.0 IP on the road.

STILL NEED HELP: In Odorizzi's 31 starts in 2018, the Twins offense has supplied 76 total runs, good for a run support average of 4.24 runs per game...the 76 runs of support rank tied seventh fewest in baseball among starters with at least 28 starts and his 4.12 RSA ranks ninth lowest in the American League.
