FISH BITES

The Marlins continue a 10-game, 11-day road swing with the middle game of this three-game series against the St. Louis Cardinals tonight at 7:15 p.m. LHP **Wei-Yin Chen**, making his eighth start of the season, is facing St. Louis for just the second time in his career. He went 6.0 innings on July 15, 2016 at Busch Stadium, allowing four runs on six hits with a walk and five strikeouts in the Marlins 7-6 win. The Cardinals are countering with RHP Jack Flaherty, who is making his first career start against the Marlins. Miami came into their current trip off a three-game homestand against the Nationals (0-3). Prior to that series, Miami completed a six-game road trip, going 1-2 against Atlanta and 2-1 against the Mets. The current trip started in San Diego (1-3), and then went to Arizona (0-3). The Marlins are in a stretch that will see them play 49 games in 52 days from May 25 to the All-Star Break.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

Miami snapped a season-long six-game losing streak with a 7-4 win over the St. Louis Cardinals. The Marlins scored twice to take a 2-1 lead in the third, with the second run coming home on an RBI-single by **Brian Anderson**. In the fifth, **Justin Bour** broke a 2-2 tie with a sac fly to left, and Anderson put the Marlins up for good with a two-run homer. **JT Riddle** led off the sixth with a home run for a 6-4 lead. **Derek Dietrich** added more insurance with a sac fly to third to score **JB Shuck**. Anderson led the offense, going 3x5 with a run scored, home run and three RBI. Dietrich and Riddle also had two-hit games. **José Ureña** earned his first win of the season, snapping a seven-game slide, and **Kyle Barraclough** earned his second save of the season.

TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS

The Marlins today optioned RHP **Odrisamer Despaigne** to Triple-A New Orleans and selected the contract of RHP **Ben Meyer** (#51) from NOLA. In 10 starts with the Baby Cakes, Meyer went 3-4 with a 4.09 ERA (50.2/23). For his career, the Marlins 29th round selection in the 2015 Draft has gone 14-20 with a 2.97 ERA (294.0/97) in 92 appearances (32 starts).

DAY 2 DRAFT OVERVIEW

The Miami Marlins made eight selections on Day 2 of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft yesterday. The Club began the day by taking University of Kentucky outfielder Tristan Pompey in the third round (No. 89 overall). University of Mississippi catcher Nick Fortes (Deland, FL) was taken in the fourth round, followed by RHP Chris Vallimont (Erie, PA) out of Mercyhurst College; C Cameron Barstad (Redwood City, CA) out of Junipero Serra High School; RHP Cason Sherrod (Dallas, TX) from Texas A&M; RHP Peyton Culbertson (Collierville, TN) out of Arkansas State University; RHP Jake Walters (Maylene, AL) from University of Alabama; and RHP Tanner Andrews (Rochester, IN) from Purdue University.

INTERNATIONAL APPEAL

Wei-Yin Chen is making his 156th career appearance (152nd career start) with his start against the Cardinals tonight. Among pitchers born in Taiwan, Chen leads all in innings pitched (894.0), starts, and strikeouts (696). He ranks second in career wins with 54, behind Chien-Ming Wang (68). Wang ranks second in innings pitched (845.2), starts (126), and strikeouts (394).

FINDING HIS RHYTHM

Derek Dietrich has been one of the Marlins hottest hitters of late, posting a .383 (18x47) average since May 20. He has recorded at least one hit in 12 of 14 games, including two career high-tying three-hit efforts. His average since that date ranks seventh among NL hitters, while his on-base percentage (.444) is tied for seventh.

DANDY ANDY

Since May 15, **Brian Anderson** has posted a .363 average (29x80), recording at least one hit in 16 of 20 games, including 12 multi-hit efforts. He is tied with Brandon Crawford and Scooter Gennett for second in the National League in hits over that span, behind Freddie Freeman (30), while his average ranks sixth.

- Ranks second in the NL and is tied with Nicholas Castellanos for third in the Major Leagues in hits with runners in scoring position (22) this season, behind Freddie Freeman (23) and Jean Segura (23). His .407 RISP average ranks fifth.
- Has a hit in last four at-bats with RISP; first Marlin with 4x4 stretch with RISP since Dee Gordon (June 13-18, 2017). - *Elias*
- Last Marlin to have 5x5 streak was **Derek Dietrich** (Sept. 14-24, 2016). - *Elias*
- Is on a 7x8 stretch with RISP, first Marlin to have 7x8 stretch with RISP since Dietrich (Sept. 11-24, 2016). - *Elias*
- Last Marlin to go 8x9 was **Martín Prado** (July 23-30, 2016). - *Elias*
- Club record for consecutive hits in AB with RISP is seven, by Prado (July 23-29, 2016) and Luis Castillo (June 13-24, 2001). - *Elias*

ROOKIE LEADER

Brian Anderson has appeared in all 60 games for the Marlins this season - the only rookie to appear in each of his team's games in 2018. Anderson leads all qualified Major League rookies in games, at-bats (225), runs (31), hits (67), and on-base percentage (.371); tied for the lead in multi-hit games (20); ranks second in average (.298), walks (21), and doubles (14); is tied for second in RBI (28); third in slugging percentage (.418); is tied for third in triples (2).

- Ranks second among National League players 25-younger in hits, behind Ozzie Albies (69).
- Owns three outfield assists in 32 G in RF - his first action at the position in his professional career. Is tied with Cincinnati's Jesse Winker for most assists among MLB rookies.
- His three assists are the most by a Marlins rookie since Marcell Ozuna (8) and Jake Marisnick (5) in 2013.
- Is on pace to record 109 hits before the All-Star Break, which would be the most ever recorded by a Marlins rookie and would tie Rocco Baldelli for the third-most by any Major League rookie since 2000 (Ichiro-133 in 2001; Hideki Matsui-114 in 2003). Alex Gonzalez currently holds the Franchise record with 99 in 1999, while Gaby Sanchez ranks second with 95 in 2010. He is also on pace to record 46 first-half RBI, which would rank as the fourth-most by a Marlins rookie.

I'LL TAKE A HALF-DOZEN SHRIMP

The Southern League today announced the rosters for its 2018 All-Star Game, and six members of the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp were named to the South Division squad. Right-handed pitchers Nick Neidert and Pablo Lopez (promoted today to Triple-A New Orleans), left-handed pitcher Jose Quijada, catcher Rodrigo Vigil, infielder Eric Jagielo, and outfielder Monte Harrison will represent the Jumbo Shrimp on June 19 at Regions Field in Birmingham, Alabama.

SERIES NOTES

- After allowing five runs in the eighth inning on August 26, 1998 at Busch Stadium, Miami hit four home runs in the ninth and scored six times to force extra innings in an eventual 7-6 loss (10 innings). The four home runs is a Club record for one inning.
- The Marlins set a club record by playing a 20-inning game on April 27, 2003 vs. St. Louis. The Fish also set a club record by drawing 16 walks.

Wei-Yin Chen tonight will be making his eighth start of the season since coming off the 10-day disabled list on April 28. Began season on DL with a left elbow strain.

Made two rehab appearances at Single-A Jupiter, allowing just one run over 7.2 innings, with just one walk and 11 strikeouts. In first appearance, April 17 vs. Lakeland, allowed one run and three hits over 2.2 innings. In second start, April 22 vs. St. Lucie, tossed two-hit, 5.0-inning complete game. Struck out seven without issuing a walk, tossing total of 73 pitches (60 strikes).

Will be just second career start vs. St. Louis. The first came here at Busch Stadium on July 15, 2016. Did not factor in the decision, a 7-6 win, after allowing four runs on six hits (two home runs) and one walk over 6.0 innings, with five strikeouts.

Made his first start of season on April 28 vs. Colorado, earning a win after allowing just one run on four hits (one home run), two walks, and a hit batter over 5.1 innings, with three strikeouts. In his next two starts, went 0-2 with 16.71 ERA (7.0 ip/13 er), and an average against of .400 (12x30) with 10 extra-base hits (4 2B, 3B, 5 HR, 1.100 SLG).

Bounced back in next three starts despite not factoring in a decision (team 1-2), combining for 1.59 ERA (17.0/3) with a .180 average against (11x61) and two extra-base hits allowed (2B, HR). Walked six (1 IBB) and struck out 14 in that time. Was in line for the win on May 20 at Atlanta, before bullpen surrendered six runs in ninth inning for a 10-9 walk-off loss.

In last start, May 31 at San Diego, made shortest start of Marlins' career (1.2 ip), allowing four runs on four hits and two walks in an 8-3 loss.

His start on May 26 vs. Washington marked 150th of career. Among pitchers born in Taiwan, Chen leads all in innings pitched (894.0), starts (151) and strikeouts (696). He ranks second in career wins with 54, behind Chien-Ming Wang (68). Wang ranks second in innings pitched (845.2), starts (126), and strikeouts (394).

Opened 2017 on 25-man roster, but made just five starts before beginning DL stint on May 5. Reinstated on September 4, after which he made just four relief appearances before being shut down with left elbow discomfort following outing on Sept. 22. Finished with 2-1 record and 3.82 ERA (33.0/14).

Best start of the year came on April 18 at Seattle, holding Mariners hitless over 7.0 innings while striking out two and issuing just two walks. Marked first start of career holding an opponent hitless. Previous low-hit start was one, done on June 2, 2016 vs. Pittsburgh (6.0 ip).

Allowed season-high tying seven hits, with four runs and two walks, along with three strikeouts, over 5.0 innings on April 26 at Philadelphia. Loss marked first and only defeat of season.

Recorded season-high seven strikeouts in final start, on May 1 vs. Tampa Bay. Did not receive a decision despite allowing just two runs and two hits over 6.0. Also walked a season-high four.

Upon reinstatement from DL, made first career relief appearance on September 4 vs. Washington, tossing 1.0 perfect inning. Allowed one run on two hits over 6.0 innings (1.50 ERA) in four relief outings to close out season.
