## SAN DIEGO NOTES

- **Eric Lauer** worked a career-high 8.2 IP while also tossing a career-high 115 pitches in tonight's game...is 5-0 with a 2.35 ERA (12 ER, 46 IP) when he gets at least three runs of support (happened in eight of his 15 starts).
  - His nine pickoffs are the most by any Major League rookie in a single season since Clayton Richard had nine in his rookie season in 2009...are also the most of any Padres pitcher in the first half of the season in club history (previous record was held by Bruce Hurst in 1989 with seven).
  - Since 2000, only four pitchers (including Lauer) have had nine-or-more pickoffs before the first half of a season (James Shields had 10 in 2011, Greg Smith had 10 in 2008 and Chris Capuano had nine in 2005).
- **Wil Myers** has combined for six home runs in the past four games, making him the third Padre to ever hit six-or-more in four games...Nate Colbert did so twice; had seven HR from July 30, 1972 to Aug. 1, 1972 and had six HR from Aug. 1, 1972 to Aug. 3, 1972 (Aug. 1 was a double header at ATL)...Ken Caminiti also had six HR from Sept. 16, 1995 to Sept. 19, 1995.
  - Is the first Padre to have a four-game home run streak since Alex Dickerson and Matt Kemp both had four-game streaks in July 2016.
- **Austin Hedges** belted his fourth homer and fifth multi-hit game of the season...has hit safely in five of his last six games (7-for-19, .368) with a double and two home runs and has reached base safely via hit or walk in nine of his last 10 games with a .382 OBP
- **Freddy Galvis** has hit in six of his last seven games vs. LAD since May 5 of this season, batting .304 (7-for-23) with two doubles and a homer.

## LOS ANGELES NOTES

- **Rich Hill** tossed a season-high 7.0 IP in tonight's game...is 4-4 with a 3.44 ERA (20 ER, 52.1 IP) in nine career starts against the Padres.
  - Dodger starting pitchers have pitched at least 6.0 innings in 11 of the last 15 games...this is the fourth time a starter has gone 7.0 innings in that span.
  - Surrendered his first three-run homer as a Dodger to Austin Hedges in the fifth inning.
- **Max Muncy** belted his team-leading 21<sup>st</sup> home run of the year...has reached base safely in 37 of his last 39 games since May 23.
- **Cody Bellinger** logged his 20<sup>th</sup> double of the season, tying Chris Taylor for the team lead...has gone .318 (21-for-66) with five home runs, four doubles and two triples in 16 career road games against SD.
