**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The Cardinals are 32-18 post All-Star Break and 33-18 under manager **Mike Shildt** since he took the post on July 15. The Cardinals have the most wins in the NL since the All-Star Break (32), while St. Louis .640 winning percentage ranks 3rd in MLB over that period. St. Louis has won 22-of-its-last-31 games overall. Entering July 15, the Cardinals had T9th-most wins in the NL (47) and currently have T3rd-most wins (80) in the NL.

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** The Cardinals are at 16 games over .500 entering play today and currently reside in 3rd place in the NL Central, 3.5 games out of first place, and hold the 2nd spot in the NL Wild Card standings, trailing Milwaukee by 2.5 games. The Cardinals have six games remaining against teams ahead of them in the standings, the Cubs and Brewers.

**THE HOME STRETCH:** The Cardinals, who have matched the Cubs & Phillies for fewest home games played (69) amongst all N.L. teams, will be home for 12 of their remaining 18 regular season games...the Cardinals 38-31 (.551) home mark is 5th among N.L. teams.

**WINNING SEASONS:** The Cardinals need two wins to record their 11th consecutive winning season, something they've done just once previously in franchise history, when they compiled 15 consecutive winning seasons from 1939-1953.

**CENTRAL CASTING:** The Cardinals 39-29 (.574) mark against N.L. Central teams, is tie for the top winning pct. with the Pirates (35-26; .574) amongst divisional foes. In addition to this week's three-game series with Pittsburgh, the Cardinals have three games remaining with both the Brewers & Cubs...they're 8-8 vs. Milwaukee and 9-7 vs the Cubs this season.

**THE HUNT FOR A RED OCTOBER:** The Cardinals have 13 games (LAD-4, at ATL-3, MIL-3, at CHI-3) remaining with teams currently in contention for playoff positions...the SF Giants (3 games) are the only remaining team on the Cardinals slate that is under .500.

**COMEBACK CARDS:** The Cardinals used a four-run 8th inning last night to overcome a 6-4 deficit, as they posted their 9th win of the season when trailing after seven innings...the Cardinals 9 wins when trailing after 7 innings is tied with Washington for the most amongst N.L. teams...the Cardinals are tied with Milwaukee for the N.L. lead in walk-off wins with 10 and St. Louis is 43-16 (.729) when scoring last this season, trailing only Atlanta (48-15, .762) and Milwaukee (51-17, .750) in win pct.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** **Matt Carpenter** collected his N.L. best 40th double last night...it marked his 3rd season of 40+ doubles, tied for 5th most all-time among Cardinals (Musial 9; Medwick 7; Pujols 6; Hornsby 5; Bottomley 3).

**WELCOME HOME MATT:** With his next run scored, **Matt Carpenter** will tie **Albert Pujols** (312) for first all-time in runs scored at Busch Stadium III...Carpenter has scored runs in 7-straight games against the Pirates.

**BACK TO THE FUTURE:** With his 2nd save in as many days last night, **Carlos Martínez** upped his save total to three (5 career)...Tsunami closed out a 7-6 win at Washington with 2.0 scoreless innings last Wed. (9/5) and since joining the bullpen last month, Martínez is 1-0 with a 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP/2 ER) with 3 saves & 4 holds...Carlos appeared in 20 games as a reliever during his rookie season of 2013 and appeared in 12 games during the Redbirds postseason run, going 0-1 with a 3.55 ERA (12.2 IP/5 ER), appearing in five of the six games during the 2013 World Series.

**THE BIG BEAR:** In seven games since Sept. 3, **Marcell Ozuna** leads the National League in total bases (27), is 2nd in home runs (5), ranks 4th in .OPS (1.300), 4th in slugging (.900), and T9th in batting average (.400). Ozuna has 11 home runs and is slugging .539 in 41 games since the All-Star Break (10 home runs w/ .385 slugging in 90 games before).

**POWER PLAY:** St. Louis has homered in 104 of 144 games this season, going 71-33 (.683 win pct.) in those games (9-31 when not homering)...their 71 wins lead the NL and rank 5th in MLB (Yankees, 1st-80)...St. Louis' 189 HR's are 2nd in the NL to the Dodgers (202).

#### PITTSBURGH CONNECTIONS

**Carlos Martínez** was teammates with Pirates **Ivan Nova** and **Starling Marte** and **Gregory Polanco** for the Dominican Republic in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

**Paul DeJong** was originally selected by the Pirates in the 38th round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

**Matt Adams** was born in Philipsburg, Pa...graduated from Philipsburg-Osceola High School...attended Slippery Rock University (2007-09).

Pitching coach **Mike Maddux** signed with the Pirates in April 1995 and pitched in eight games before being released in May.

**Miles Mikolas** spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason...traded by San Diego with infielder **Jaff Decker** to Pittsburgh in exchange for outfielder **Alex Dickerson** (Nov. 25, 2013), then traded by Pittsburgh to the Rangers in exchange for infielder **Chris McGuiness** (Dec. 30, 2013).

**Francisco Pena's** father, **Tony**, was an All-Star catcher for the Pirates (1980-86)...later traded by Pittsburgh to the Cardinals for pitcher **Mike Dunne**, catcher **Mike LaValliere** and outfielder **Andy Van Slyke** (April 1, 1987.)

First base coach **Oliver Marmol** was originally selected by the Pirates in the 31st round of the 2004 MLB draft, but did not sign.

**Jedd Gyorko** was born in Morgantown, WV...played at West Virginia University (2008-10).

**Yadier Molina** (June 3, 2004), **José Martínez** (September 6, 2016) and **Austin Gomber** (June 2, 2018) made their MLB debuts against Pittsburgh.

Manager **Clint Hurdle** was selected by St. Louis from the Mets in the 1985 Rule 5 Draft and played in 86 games for the Cardinals in 1986.

Pitching Coach **Ray Searge** was selected by St. Louis in the 22nd round of the 1976 MLB Draft...later traded to the Mets for catcher **Jody Davis** in 1979...began coaching career in the Cardinals minor league system as Pitching Coach with Madison (1994), Peoria (1995-96) & Prince William (1997).

Pirates Baseball Operations Senior Advisor **Nick Leyva** was drafted by St. Louis in the 24th round in 1975...played three minor league seasons in the Cardinals system (1975-77)...managed six minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization (1978-83)...served as St. Louis' First Base Coach (1984-85) and Third Base Coach (1986-88).

Cardinals Baseball Information & Media Services Coordinator **Chris Tunno** graduated from nearby Canfield (Ohio) High School.

Pirates Manager of Business Communications & Social Media **Terry Rodgers** previously worked as a Public Relations Specialist in the Cardinals Communications department (2010-11).

**TONIGHT'S GAME**

- Makes his 29th start of the season (39th career start) and 66th career appearance.
- Is T2nd in NL to NYM's Jacob deGrom (14.8) in fewest pitches per inning (15.0), the lowest average by Cardinals pitcher since John Lackey (14.3 in 2015).
- Trying to become first Cardinal to post 15 wins in the team's first 145 games since Carlos Martinez (16 in 2015) and the first to do so in his first season with the Redbirds since Mark Mulder did so (16 in 2005).
- Leads the National League in fewest walks/9 IP (1.40). The last Cardinal to lead the NL in walks/9 IP was Joel Piñeiro (1.14) in 2009. Has issued one or fewer walks in NL-leading 21 starts and no walks in 10 starts (T3rd in NL).
- Ranks among NL leaders in wins (14, T4th), winning pct. (.778, 3rd), ERA (3.06, 7th), innings pitched (173.2, 7th), WHIP (1.13, 7th), strikeout/walk ratio (4.41, 5th), baserunners/9 IP (10.52, 7th), HR/9 IP (0.73, 4th), ground ball pct (51.3, 4th), OPP SLG (.365, 9th) and quality starts (17, T6th).
- Has limited the opposition to 3 runs or fewer in 11 of last 14 starts (2 or fewer in 10).
- Limiting opposing right-handers to a .276 opponent slugging pct. 4th-lowest in the NL and currently 9th-lowest in Cardinals single-season history...Jose DeLeon's .240 from 1989 ranks 1st.
- Pitched 7.0 or more innings in nine starts (T7th in NL) and at least 6.0 innings in 21 of his 28 starts this season (T6th NL).
- 18 of his 64 runs (28%) allowed have come in the 4th inning (5.46 ERA).
- Sports a 14-0 record with six no-decisions (St. Louis is 19-3) when receiving two or more runs of support in a start.
- Ranks 5th in the National League in home ERA (2.31). All four of his losses this season have come at home, despite allowing three runs or fewer in all four defeats.

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Earned his team-leading 14th win of the season, pitching 6.2 innings while matching his career-high allowing 12 hits in a win at WSH. Did not walk a batter for the 10th start.
- Hit safely for the 6th time in his last nine games. STL has won all eight games in which he has recorded a hit this season.

- On the road, he is 8-0 with a 3.86 ERA in 14 road starts; his eight road wins are T3rd-most in the NL and he is the only NL pitcher with a perfect 1.000 win percentage with seven or more decisions. His last road loss was August 2, 2014 at Cleveland (w/ Texas).
- Selected by Major League Baseball to represent the Cardinals on the 2018 National League All-Star team...it was his first MLB All-Star nod and second recognition of his career (2010 Midwest League Mid-Season All-Star with Fort Wayne).
- Missed the All-Star Game in Washington D.C., as he returned home to Jupiter, Fla., with his wife Lauren, as they welcomed twin daughter & son on July 16.
