Folty vs. the East

RHP Mike Foltynewicz is set for his 16th start against the N.L. East, and is 8-4 with a 1.88 ERA (19 ER/91.0 IP) and 95 strikeouts in intradivision starts this season.

Since the Braves joined the N.L. East in 1994, only one Atlanta pitcher has produced a lower single-season ERA in these games (min. 10 starts)...Jair Jurrjens went 9-1 with a 1.69 ERA in 15 starts against the East in 2009.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Phillies open a three-game series tonight with the 17th meeting between the teams this season...These three games will close out the regular season for both teams...The Braves opened the year with a three-game set against the Phillies and will open next year against them as well.

A The Braves lead the season set, 11-5, and swept a four-game set from Philadelphia last Thursday through Sunday, September 20-23.

A Since the team moved to Atlanta in 1966, the Braves' most single-season wins over Philadelphia is 12, done by the 2012 team...They have now won at least 11 games over Philadelphia in six of the last seven years; they went 6-13 against the Phillies last season.

A RHP Mike Foltynewicz is set for his sixth start against Philadelphia and his first since beating them on September 22 at SunTrust Park to help the Braves clinch the National League East...The righty is 2-1 with a 2.08 ERA (7 ER/30.1 IP) in his five games against the Phillies this season.

A RHP Jerad Eickhoff is set for his first start of the season and his third appearance...The righty went to the disabled at the beginning of the season with a right lat strain before the club reinstated him on September 3...He is 3-3 with a 2.91 ERA (19 ER/58.2 IP) in 11 career games, all starts, against the Braves.

90 WINS?: With one victory in their final three games, the Braves would earn their 90th win of the season... They would become the first National League team to reach 90 wins in a season following three or more consecutive 90-loss seasons since the 1991 Braves.

A That 1991 club went 94-68 and reached the World Series after four consecutive 90-loss seasons.

A The Braves went 67-95 in 2015, 68-93 in 2016 and 72-90 last season.

A The Braves are looking for the franchise's 18th 90-win season since Major League Baseball went to a 162-game schedule in 1962 for the NL.

A The 18 total 90-win seasons since 1962 would be tied for the second most in the National League with St. Louis (87-72 this season) and San Francisco...The Dodgers, 88-71 this year, lead with 23 such seasons.

A The Yankees have the most 90-win seasons in all of baseball with 28.

SOME CLARITY: Last night's loss coupled with Chicago's 3-0 win vs. Pittsburgh locked the Braves into playing the National League West winner in the NLDS...The Rockies have the same 89-70 record as Atlanta and currently lead the Dodgers by one game.

A Both the Dodgers and Rockies went 5-2 against the Braves this season should the teams tie.

162: OF Nick Markakis has started every game this season and is trying to become the fifth Braves player since the National League went to a 162-game schedule in 1962 to start all 162.

A OF Felix Milan did in 1969, before OF Andruw Jones started 162 in 1999...OF Jeff Francoeur started every game in consecutive seasons, 2006 and 2007, before 1B Freddie Freeman accomplished the feat in 2014.

A Freeman pinch-hit last night and has played in every game this season...If he and Markakis play in each of the final three games of the season, it will mark just the 10th and 11th time in franchise history that a player appeared in all 162 games, and the first time that two players accomplished the feat in the same season.

UNDER .200: RHP Julio Teheran dropped his opponent's batting average against to a franchise single-season record low .196 (122-for-623) after allowing two hits over 6.0 innings last night...Greg Maddux held the previous record with a .197 mark (147-for-748)...Teammate RHP Mike Foltynewicz has the third lowest mark in franchise history at .198 (129-for-650)...Prior to this season the Braves, Maddux was the only Atlanta qualifying pitcher to ever finish a season with a batting average against lower than .200.

A The only National League pitcher with a better mark than Teheran is RHP Max Scherzer (.188), while RHP Jacob deGrom is between Teheran and Foltynewicz at .196.

A Over the last 110 seasons, only three teams have had two qualified pitchers each finish with an average against below .200.

A The 1968 Cleveland Indians had three (Sam McDowell, Sonny Siebert, and Luis Tiant) while the 2015 Los Angeles Dodgers (Zack Greinke and Clayton Kershaw) and 1986 Houston Astros (Nolan Ryan and Mike Scott) had two.

VS. THE N.L. EAST: The Braves are 48-25 (.658) against the National League East this season...The club has a +115 run differential against the division this season and have gone 14-4-4 in intradivision series play.

A Only Boston (.699) has a better intradivision record.

A The Braves went 33-43 (.434) against their own division last season.

A Since moving to the N.L. East in 1994, the Braves most ever wins against the East was 51 in 2004... Their best record was 35-16 (.686) in 1999.

A The club's best ever intradivision record was 55-23 (.705) in 1993, their last in the N.L. West.

A The Braves have not had a winning intradivision record since 2014, when they went 40-36...Over the three previous seasons, the club went 103-124 (.454) against the N.L. East.

Tonight's Game

- A* Set to make his 31st start of the season and the 96th of his career...Is his 116th career appearance.
- A* Faces the Phillies for the sixth time this season and for the 13th time (12th start) in his career...Is 5-3 with a 3.39 ERA (25 ER/66.1 IP) over his first 12 turns.
- A* Is 2-1 in five starts against them this season, pitching to a 2.08 ERA (7 ER/30.1 IP) and not allowing more than two runs in any of the five starts... Atlanta is 2-3 as a team.
- A* Also faced the Phillies in his last start and has faced the same opponent in consecutive turns just twice in his career...Is 1-0 with a 2.82 ERA (4 ER/12.1 IP) in his opening two starts, while going 0-2 with a 4.22 ERA (5 ER/10.2 IP) in two starts when facing the same opponent again.
- A* Makes his 16th start against the N.L. East, and is 8-4 with a 1.88 ERA (19 ER/91.0 IP) and 95 strikeouts in intradivision starts this season.
- A* Since the Braves joined the National League East in 1994, only one Atlanta pitcher has produced a lower ERA in intradivision games (min. 10 starts) in a single season...Jair Jurrjens went 9-1 with a 1.69 ERA in 15 starts against his own division in 2009.
- A* Has allowed opponents to hit just .198 against him this season, yielding 129 hits in 650 at-bats...His .198 opponents' average is sixth lowest in the majors.
- A* Only one qualified pitcher in franchise history has held opponents to an average under .200...Opponents batted .197 against Greg Maddux in 1995.
- A* Braves starter Julio Teheran ranks third in the majors with a .196 opponents' average...Only three teams in major league history have had multiple qualified starters hold opponents to an average under .200, with the 2015 Dodgers (Clayton Kershaw & Zack Greinke) being the last to do so.

2018 Recap

- A* Made his final regular season start at SunTrust Park, 9/22 vs. PHI...Earned the win as Atlanta clinched the N.L. East division title...Finished the season 5-4 with a 3.19 ERA (34 ER/96.0 IP) in his home park.
- A* Opponents batted just .199 against him at SunTrust Park, logging 66 hits in 345 at-bats.
- A* Since the Braves moved to Atlanta in 1966, only three pitchers allowed a lower opponents average at home in a single season...Damian Moss set the Atlanta-era record with a .184 average in 2002, while Tom Glavine allowed a .186 mark in 1997 and opponents hit just .189 against John Smoltz at Atlanta-Fulton County Stadium in 1989.
- A* Tossed his second complete game of the season, 9/11 at San Francisco...Held the Giants to six hits and one run on 108 pitches, fanning seven.
- A* Lost the bid for his second shutout of the season when San Francisco plated its only run of the game in the bottom of the ninth...Shut out Washington on 6/1, the first of his career.
- A* The complete game was the first for a Braves pitcher on the road since 2016, when Julio Teheran blanked the Mets on June 19.
- A* Foltyniewicz became the first Atlanta pitcher with two complete games in a single season since Shelby Miller logged two in 2015.
- A* Made six starts in August, and went 3-2 with a 2.09 ERA (9 ER/38.2 IP) and 41 strikeouts.
- A* His run last month followed five starts in July during which he went 2-3 with a 5.72 ERA (18 ER/28.1 IP).
- A* Faced the Cubs, 8/30, and allowed five runs (four earned) over 6.0 frames to take the loss...Was his second start against Chicao at SunTrust Park this season.
- A* Became the first Atlanta pitcher to make two starts against the Cubs at his home park in a single season since Greg Maddux did so in 1998.
- A* Made his eighth career appearance against Colorado, 8/18, and tossed 7.0 scoreless innings...Did not earn the win after the Rockies won, 5-3, in 10 innings.
- A* All eight of his appearances against Colorado have come with Atlanta, and the Braves are 0-8 in those games...Atlanta has been outscored 49-17.
- A* Was selected to his first major league All-Star Game after going 7-5 with a 2.66 ERA (30 ER/101.2 IP) over 18 games to open the season...Fanned 120 batters over 101.2 innings of work.
- A* Tossed a scoreless fourth inning in his All-Star Game debut, retiring José Ramírez, Manny Machado and José Abreu, while walking Aaron Judge.
- A* Threw the first shutout of his major league career, 6/1 vs. Washington...Allowed just two hits and struck out 11.
- A* Became the seventh pitcher in Atlanta-era history to throw a two-hitter or better with double-digit strikeouts and the first since Greg Maddux fanned 14 Brewers in a two-hit, 1-0 win on May 2, 2001 at Turner Field.

Career Recap

- A* Acquired by the Atlanta Braves along with RHP Andrew Thurman and INF Rio Ruiz from the Houston Astros in exchange for C/OF Evan Gattis and RHP James Hoyt on 1/14/15.

- Recalled, 8/29, from Triple-A Gwinnett for his fourth stint on the active roster...Was also up from 8/11-18, and on 8/7 and 7/31...Was added to the roster as the 26th man for the doubleheader on 8/7...Had his contract selected, 7/31, and started versus Miami in his major league debut...Optioned to Triple-A Gwinnett postgame that night.
- Has allowed seven earned runs over 3.0 innings in two relief appearances with the Braves...Last pitched for Atlanta on 8/17 vs. COL (1.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R).
- Started vs. MIA, 7/31, in his major league debut...Allowed nine hits and five runs (four earned) over 5.0 innings to earn the win...At the age of 20 years, 352 days, became the youngest left-hander to win his debut for the Braves since Charlie Vaughan did so on September 3, 1966 at the age of 18 years, 332 days.
- Is 6-4 with a 2.72 ERA (34 ER/112.1 IP) in 19 starts for Triple-A Gwinnett this season.

- Allowed a season-most three earned runs, 9/17 vs. STL, after walking two and allowing a three-run homer...Twelve of the 22 earned runs he has allowed this season have come via home run, including four of his last seven.
- Has allowed six earned runs in his last 3.0 innings (five appearances)...Opponents are hitting .333 and he has issued four walks in that span.
- Has a 3.16 ERA in 58 relief appearances for Atlanta this season, the sixth-lowest ERA by a left-handed rookie reliever in franchise history...Jonny Venters' 1.95 ERA in 2010 is lowest.
- Pitched more than 1.0 inning in 14 outings this season, compiling a 0.95 ERA (3 ER/28.1 IP) with 43 strikeouts...Three of his five wins this season have come in outings longer than 1.0 inning.
- Opponents are 10-for-50 (.200) with runners in scoring position, including 4-for-22 (.182) with two outs.
- Set career highs in IP (3.0) and strikeouts (8), 6/2 vs. WSH... Became the first Braves reliever in 110 seasons to strike out at least eight batters in that few innings...MIL's Josh Hader struck out eight in 2.2 IP, 4/30/18 at CIN.

- Has allowed eight hits, one walk and one hit by pitch in his last 5.0 innings (5.40 ERA and 1.80 WHIP).
- Last night at NYM, surrendered his first home run since joining Atlanta on 7/29, a three-run shot in the seventh inning with ATL trailing 1-0.
- Has allowed just four earned runs in 26 appearances (22.02IP) since the Braves acquired him on 7/29...Earned his first save with Atlanta, 9/6 at ARI, and has eight holds since being acquired.
- Took his second loss with Atlanta, 8/31 vs. PIT after allowing one unearned run in 0.2 innings...Both of his losses with the Braves, and his two blown saves, have come in games in which he did not allow an earned run.
- Holding right-handed batters to a .247 (37-for-150) average, while lefties are hitting .333/.426/.419 in 123 PA.
