TODAY'S GAME: The Dodgers and Giants play game two of this three-game series... the Giants enter today having lost seven of their last eight while the Dodgers have won 11 of their last 15...one more Dodgers win or a Cardinals loss would send LA to the playoffs for the sixth-consecutive year.

ON THE MOUND: RHP Dereck Rodriguez will face the Dodgers for the first time in his career... Rodriguez has a chance to become the first rookie since José Fernández (2.19 ERA) in 2013 to record an ERA of 2.50 or lower with 15 or more starts... he enters his outing today having lost his last three decisions.

TOUGH ON US: LHP Clayton Kershaw will take the mound today as the winningest visiting pitcher in the 19-year history of AT&T Park with a 13-4 record and a 1.30 ERA in 22 games (21 starts)...Kershaw or

and a 1.30 ERA in 22 games (21 starts)...Kershaw owns a 22-10 record with a 1.58 ERA in 44 career games (43 starts) against San Francisco.

INSIDE THE SERIES: The Giants need just one more win against the Dodgers to win the season series over LA for the third time in the last four years and for the sixth time in the last nine seasons.

THANK YOU FANS: The Giants have topped three million in attendance for the ninth-straight season and for the 17th time in 19 years at AT&T Park.

TROUBLE SCORING AT HOME: The Giants have been held to two runs or fewer in 13 of their last 16 home games...SF is 6-10 in this stretch.

DRIVING IN RUNS: No Giant has driven in 10 runs this month (**IF Evan Longoria** leads the club with nine RBI)...since RBI became an official stat in 1920, there has never been a September when no Giant reached double figures in RBI...the departed Andrew McCutchen still leads the club with 55 RBI this season, which is the lowest for a Giants team leader in a full season as long as RBI have been an official statistic...**IF Brandon Crawford** and **IF Evan Longoria** each have 54 RBI (*Stats, LLC*).

THANKS JOE: Giants national cross checker, **Joe Strain**, is here today as he's retiring at the end of the year following 40 years in the Giants' organization as a player, coach and scout...signed as an undrafted amateur free agent in 1976 out of the University of Northern Colorado, Strain played three minor league seasons for the Giants before making his Major League debut on June 28, 1979...after his playing career, Joe managed the Low A affiliate Everett Giants from 1984-1989 before becoming a scout in 1990...he worked his way up the scouting ranks, eventually becoming a national cross-checker for the Giants.

BETTER D: The Giants' 25 defensive runs saved this year are the 10th-most in MLB...last season, SF had -44 defensive runs saved, 25th in MLB (per Fangraphs).

ROUGH MONTH: The Giants are just 5-19 (.208) this month, posting the lowest winning percentage in the month of September of any MLB team...SF is hitting a MLB-low .214 this month, scoring just 63 runs in 24 games (2.6 r/g)...the Giants' five wins this month are their fewest in any full calendar month (non-strike year) in SF-era history (since 1958)...SF had six wins in April 1972 and April 1980.

HOW LOW CAN YOU GO: Beginning June 1, the Giants have posted a 3.45 ERA, which ranks as the third-best figure in the Majors behind Los Angeles-NL (3.29) and Houston (3.37).

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#57 RHP Dereck Rodriguez 6-1, 215, 26 years old (June 5, 1992) 6-4 Record, 2.50 ERA

- 26-year-old right-hander is slated to make his 19th and final start of the 2018 season...today's outing will mark his 21st appearance of the year.
- The Giants are 9-9 overall when he takes the hill as a starter, going 5-6 at home and 4-3 on the road...the Giants have lost each of his last six starts and eight of his last 10.
- Was charged with four runs on seven hits in 6.0 innings in his last start on Saturday at St. Louis in a 5-4, 10-inning loss to the Cardinals...it marked the first time since his second big-league start that he allowed more than three earned runs in a game...he also did it at Washington on June 9 (5er)...prior to his most recent outing, Rodriguez had 15 consecutive starts of allowing three runs or fewer.
- Among NL rookie qualifying pitchers he ranks first in ERA (2.50), third in opponents batting average against (.216) and sixth in innings pitched (115.1ip).
- His 2.50 ERA is the sixth-lowest among MLB pitchers with at least 100.0 innings pitched and the third-lowest in the NL behind Jacob deGrom (1.70) and Aaron Nola (2.45).
- Hs 2.50 ERA would be the lowest by a Giants rookie (minimum 100 innings) since Hall of Famer Hoyt Wilhelm (2.43) in 1952.
- Is 4-3 with a 2.15 ERA in 11 starts here at AT&T Park this season, however has lost each of his

last three home starts...the Giants have lost six of his last seven home outings...has allowed three runs or fewer in all 11 home starts this season.

- He's the first Giants pitcher since 1900 to pitch 6+ innings and allow two or fewer runs in at least 13 of his first 16 career starts
- Missed 10 games from Aug. 16-23 with a right hamstring strain, an injury he suffered Aug. 14 at Los Angeles-NL during an on field incident involving teammate **Nick Hundley** and Yasiel Puig that cleared the benches.
- Opponents are just 18-for-82 (.220) off him with RISP, including a .154 clip (8-for-52) in his last 14 games.
- Signed a minor league contract with the Giants on November 15, 2017...was invited to Major League camp as a non-roster invitee.
- Is the son of former Major League catcher and Hall of Famer, Ivan Rodriguez.
- Was drafted in the sixth round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft by the Minnesota Twins...spent his first three professional seasons as an outfielder before converting into a pitcher in 2014.
- Did not pitch above double-A last season while in the Twins organization.

NOTES: The 26-year-old is slated to make his 29th career Major League start and his final start of the season...has gone 7-12 with a 4.22 ERA (74er, 158.0ip) in 28 outings, with the Giants going 12-16 in those games...his 130 strikeouts are the 10th-most by a rookie starting pitcher in franchise history...received a losing decision in the Giants' 9-2 loss at St. Louis last Sunday...allowed two runs on six hits over 5.0 innings...did not allow a home run for the first time since his start on Aug. 31 against New York-NL...has received three or fewer runs of support in 21 of his 28 starts...has faced the Dodgers once this season and threw six scoreless inning while only allowing two hits...did not receive a decision in the Giants' 2-1 victory.
