TRIBE HEADLINES

» **EDWIN ENCARNACION** was named American League Player of the Week yesterday, earning his 6th career weekly honor...Encarnacion led all Major Leaguers last week with five homers and 13 RBI, batting .407 (11-27) to extend his hit streak to a season-high 10 games...his multi-homer effort on Sunday was his 3rd of the season, giving him 16 longballs (T6th in A.L.) on the season.

» **COREY KLUBER** is set to face Milwaukee for a second time this season, after taking the loss at Miller Park on May 8 (6.0IP, 5H, 3R/ER, 1BB, 4K)...has recorded a quality start in each of his 12 outings this season, the longest streak by a Tribe starter to open a campaign since Hall of Famer **Stan Coveleski** in 1918...he owns a career record of 12-5 with a 2.29 ERA in 20 Interleague starts.

» The Indians made four picks (T-most in MLB) yesterday in the first night of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft, selecting **C NOAH NAYLOR**, **RHP ETHAN HANKINS**, **RHP LENNY TORRES JR.** and **RHP NICK SANDLIN**.

STRANGE BREW

» The Indians and Brewers are set to meet for their second and final two-game series this season...the clubs split a similar set at Miller Park on May 8 & 9, with the clubs splitting the two contests...tomorrow's starter **CARLOS CARRASCO** earned a complete-game win in the Tribe's 6-2 win on May 9, striking out 14 batters (the most by a Tribe pitcher this season).

» The series in Milwaukee marked the clubs' first regular-season matchup since 2015, when the Tribe went 3-1 in the season series.

» Since the Brewers left the American League in 1998, the Indians have gone 11-13 (.458) in 24 Interleague matchups between the clubs...in a series that dates back to 1969, the Tribe is 205-207 (.498) all-time against their former divisional rival.

INTERLEAGUE INTERFACE

» This mid-week series marks the Tribe's fourth set of Interleague contests this season, all of which have been two-game series...Cleveland holds a 4-2 record against the National League in 2018, including a mark of 3-1 against Chicago-NL.

» The Indians' 20 Interleague matchups this season will all come against the teams of the N.L. Central division...in addition to "home-and-home" series with Milwaukee, Chicago-NL and Cincinnati, Cleveland will host Pittsburgh for three games (July 23-25) and travel to St. Louis for another three (June 25-27).

» Cleveland has gone 56-50 (.528) vs. the N.L. since 2013, and 193-196 (.496) overall since Interleague play began in 1997.

FAB FIVE

» **MICHAEL BRANTLEY**'s 8th-inning homer on Sunday made him the fifth Tribe player this season to reach the 10-homer, 30-RBI threshold...Brantley (10HR, 38RBI) joined **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** (18HR, 41RBI), **EDWIN ENCARNACION** (16HR, 40RBI), **FRANCISCO LINDOR** (14HR, 35RBI) and **YONDER ALONSO** (11HR, 33RBI).

» The Indians are one of two MLB teams boasting five batters with 30-or-more RBI (Boston)...they are also one of just two teams claiming five hitters with 10-plus homers (New York-AL).

» Achieving the feat in just 58 team games, the 2018 Tribe are the second-fastest team in club history to see five players reach 10 homers and 30 RBI...the 1995 club turned the trick in 56 team games (**Eddie Murray**, **Manny Ramírez**, **Albert Belle**, **Paul Sorrento** and **Jim Thome**).

SUNDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians lost Sunday's series finale at Minnesota in walk-off fashion, falling 7-5 for their third consecutive defeat.

» **EDWIN ENCARNACION** went 2-for-4 with two homers and four RBI, extending his season-long hit streak to 10 games...marked Encarnacion's third multi-homer game of 2018.

» **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** became the fifth Tribe player to reach 10 home runs, as he tied the game at 5-5 with a solo shot in the top of the 8th inning...**JASON KIPNIS** posted his fifth multi-hit game in his last nine contests, going 2-for-4 with a pair of singles.

» **MIKE CLEVINGER** did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on seven hits (2 HR) over 6.0+ innings of work...**CODY ALLEN** was saddled with the loss after surrendering **Eddie Rosario**'s third home run of the game.

PARROT OF THE WEEK

» **EDWIN ENCARNACION** was named American League Player of the Week for the period ending June 3, his 6th career weekly honor (first since August 30, 2015 with Toronto)...over the past week, Encarnacion batted .407 (11-27) with an MLB-high five homers, two doubles, nine runs scored and an MLB-high 13 RBI.

» Encarnacion collected his third multi-homer game of 2018 (T2nd in MLB) in Sunday's ballgame (also did so on April 1 at Seattle & May 2 vs. Texas)...his 31 career games with two-or-more home runs are T3rd among active players (**Albert Pujols** - 57, **Adrian Beltre** - 32, **Giancarlo Stanton** - 31).

» He enters play tonight on an active 10-game hit streak (3rd-longest by an Indians batter in 2018), over which he is hitting .425 (17-40) with six homers, three doubles, 15 doubles and 14 runs scored.

» Since May 1, Encarnacion is batting .330 (34-103) with 10 homers (T4th in MLB), six doubles, 20 runs scored and 30 RBI (T1st in MLB)...his 16 homers this season are T6th in the American League.

KLUBER DAY

» **COREY KLUBER** is set to make his second career start and appearance against the Milwaukee Brewers, as well as his second this season...Kluber took the loss in a quality start at Miller Park on May 8, allowing three runs on five hits over 6.0 innings (1BB, 4K) in the Tribe's 3-2 loss...owns a record of 12-5 with a 2.29 ERA (36ER/141.2IP) in 20 career Interleague starts.

» **Kluber is coming off a dominant win in his last start on May 30 vs. Chicago-AL, striking out 10 batters over 6.0 shutout innings...** has not walked a batter in each of his last four starts, amounting to a career-long walkless streak of 28.1 innings.

» He has begun his 2018 campaign with 12 consecutive quality starts, the longest season-opening streak by a Tribe starter since Hall of Famer **Stan Coveleski** began his 1918 campaign with 16 straight quality starts...**his streak of 24 consecutive starts allowing three-or-fewer runs (dating back to August 3, 2017) is the longest of its kind by an American League pitcher in the Baseball Reference Play Index era (1908-)**...**Jake Arrieta**'s run of 29 straight starts between 2015-16 is the last longer streak by a National League hurler

» Enters play ranked 2nd in the A.L. with a 2.02 ERA, also sitting 2nd in home ERA (1.26), 2nd in walks per 9.0 innings (1.1), T2nd in wins (8), 3rd in innings pitched (84.2), 3rd in night ERA (1.85), 7th in opponent batting average (.198) and T8th in strikeouts (88).

TRANSACTION

» The Indians today activated **LONNIE CHISENHALL** from the 10-game Disabled List...in a corresponding move, **BRADLEY ZIMMER** has been optioned to Triple-A Columbus.

» Chisenhall has been on the Disabled List since April 8 with a right calf strain...he has batted .235 (4-17) in seven games with Cleveland this season, and hit .286 (8-28) with two homers and six RBI across nine Minor League rehab appearances.

» Zimmer has batted .226 (24-106) in 34 games for Cleveland with two homers, five doubles and nine RBI...he was on the D.L. with a left rib contusion from May 15-30, and appeared in two games for the Tribe following his May 31 activation.

SCORE TACTICS

» The Indians have scored 291 runs this season, good for 4th in the American League (6th in MLB)...the club ranks 3rd in the A.L. with a .767 OPS, 4th with 206 extra-base hits, T5th with 33 steals, T6th with 517 hits, T6th with 113 doubles & 8th with a .254 team batting average.

» **Cleveland has also slugged 88 home runs this season, which are T2nd in MLB (New York-AL - 94, Boston - 88).**

» The Tribe's 189 runs scored since May 1 (6.10 runs per game) are the most in MLB.

DRAFT RECAP

» The Indians made four selections in the first night of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft...with the 29th overall pick in Round 1, Cleveland selected **C NOAH NAYLOR** out of St. Joan of Arc Catholic High School (Mississauga, Ontario).

» The Tribe also drafted **RHP ETHAN HANKINS** (pick #35, compensation), **RHP LENNY TORRES JR.** (pick #41, competitive balance Round A) and **RHP NICK SANDLIN** (pick #67, Round 2).

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

1989: 2018 Hall of Fame inductee **Jim Thome** is drafted out of Illinois Central College by Cleveland in the 13th round of the Amateur Draft...just two years later, Thome would make his Major League debut for the Tribe on September 4, 1991...Thome spent 13 seasons (1991-2002, 2011) in a Tribe uniform, and remains the all-time franchise leader in home runs (337) and walks (1008).

TONIGHT'S START VS. MILWAUKEE

» Reigning American League Cy Young award winner Kluber is scheduled to make his 13th start of the season in the opener of this two-game set vs. the Milwaukee Brewers...

» Will be pitching today on extended five days' rest after his last outing on May 30 vs. Chicago-AL...earned his eighth win of the year, limiting the White Sox to three hits across 6.0 shutout innings...

» Has allowed three-or-fewer runs in each of his last 24 starts dating back to August 3, 2017, which is the longest streak by an Indians starter in the Baseball-Reference Play Index era (1908-)...since the start of 2011. Kluber's streak is tied with Clayton Kershaw (also 24G) for the 2nd-longest such streak, behind Jake Arrieta (29G).

» Will make his second career start vs. Milwaukee tonight, after facing them for the first time earlier this year on May 8 at Miller Park...recorded a quality start but took the loss (6.0IP, 5H, 3R/ER, 2HR, 1BB, 4K).

» Enters tonight among the ranks of the American League pitching leaders in ERA (2.02, 2nd), home ERA (1.26, 2nd), wins (8, T2nd), innings pitched (84.2, 3rd), night ERA (1.85, 3rd), and opponent batting average (.198, 7th).

» Kluber has also recorded 12 quality starts to begin the season, the longest such streak by a Tribe starting pitcher since Hall-of-Famer Stan Coveleski began the 1918 campaign with a string of 16 quality starts.

LAST TIME OUT

» Kluber win his third consecutive decision in his last start, defeating Chicago-AL on May 30 at Progressive Field.

» Scattered three hits over 6.0 shutout innings, striking out 10 batters...has four outings with 10-plus strikeouts this season, which is T3rd in MLB.

» Has not walked a batter in his last four starts, spanning 28.1 innings and marking a new career-long stretch...streak is the longest such run by a Tribe pitcher since Josh Tomlin did not walk a batter in a span of 29.2 innings, from May 12 - June 10, 2017.

VS. MILWAUKEE | INTERLEAGUE PLAY

» Kluber makes his second career start and appearance vs. the Brewers tonight, as well as his second start in Interleague play this year...first career outing against Milwaukee came earlier this season, on May 8 at Miller Park.

» Took the loss in that outing despite recording a quality start...allowed three runs on five hits (two home runs), with one walk and four strikeouts across 6.0 innings.

» In 2017, made four Interleague starts vs. Arizona, Colorado, Los Angeles-NL and San Diego...went 1-2 with a 1.80 ERA (6ER/30.0IP), with 35 strikeouts and three walks. » Struck out 10-plus batters in three of his four Interleague starts last year...recorded 35 total strikeouts compared to just three walks...his SO/BB ratio of 11.67 led American League starting pitchers and ranked 2nd in MLB (min. 2GS in Interleague Play).

» Owns a 12-4 record and 2.29 (36ER/141.2IP) ERA in 20 career Interleague starts... Kluber's 12 Interleague wins are tied with CC Sabathia, Cliff Lee and Bartolo Colón for the most by a Cleveland starter since the beginning of regular season Interleague play in 1997.

» Since Kluber made his MLB debut in 2011, his 2.29 ERA in Interleague outings ranks 2nd in MLB (min. 100IP), behind LAD's Clayton Kershaw (1.85).

AT PROGRESSIVE FIELD

» Tonight marks Kluber's seventh start of the season at home...is 5-0 with a 1.26 ERA (6ER/43.0IP) in his home outings...enters tonight's game T1st in the American League in wins at home as well as 2nd in home ERA.

» Has not allowed an earned run in his last three home starts, spanning 19.1 innings...marks a new career-long span in terms of both starts and innings pitched. » Last season, went 10-2 with a 1.81 ERA (23ER/114.2IP) in 16 home starts...his home ERA led the American League and ranked 2nd in MLB...also marked the lowest such ERA by an Indians pitcher since Gaylord Perry's 1.77 home ERA in 1972.

COMPLETE COREY

» Kluber tossed his 16th career complete game in his first start of the year on March 29 at Seattle...marked the first Opening Day complete-game by a Cleveland pitcher since Jake Westbrook on April 4, 2005 at Chicago-AL (1-0 loss), and the first such complete game in MLB since Clayton Kershaw threw a complete-game shutout on April 1, 2013 vs. San Francisco.

» Struck out eight batters, the 2nd-most by a Tribe starter on Opening Day over the last 14 seasons (2005-18), behind Justin Masterson (10K on April 5, 2012 vs. Toronto). » Kluber threw just 91 pitches in the game, marking the second-lowest complete-game pitch count of his career...needed just 85 pitches to shut out the Mariners on July 30, 2014 (9.0IP, 3H, 8K) in Cleveland.

CAREER SNAPSHOT & 2017 HIGHLIGHTS

» Won his second career American League Cy Young Award in 2017, becoming the first pitcher in club history to win the award multiple times, and the 19th multiple winner in MLB since 1956.

» Became the first Indians pitcher since Mike Garcia in 1949 to lead MLB in ERA (2.25), and ranked near the top of the A.L. leaderboard in virtually every other pitching category (see chart), including wins (18, T1st), pitcher bWAR (8.2), strikeouts (265, 2nd) and opponent batting average (.193, 141-732).

» Won the A.L. Pitcher of the Month award three times, June (4-0, 1.26ERA), August (5-1, 1.96 ERA) and September (5-0, 0.84 ERA), becoming the first triple winner since Houston's Dallas Keuchel in 2015.

» Kluber is in his ninth season with the Cleveland organization after being acquired from the San Diego Padres on July 31, 2010 in a three-team trade that sent RHP Jake Westbrook (from Cleveland) & LHP Nicholas Greenwood (from San Diego) to the St. Louis Cardinals and moved OF Ryan Ludwick from St. Louis to San Diego.

» Signed a five-year contract extension with the Indians through 2019 on April 5, 2015...the deal includes club options for 2020 & 2021.

» Made his MLB debut on September 1, 2011 in relief against the Oakland Athletics...made three relief appearances as a September call-up with Cleveland in 2011...has five career relief appearances, last on April 20, 2013 at Houston.

» Kluber was originally selected by San Diego in the 4th round of the 2007 June draft out of Stetson (FL) University, where he played three seasons...the Birmingham, Alabama native attended Coppell (TX) High School, located in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex.
