SAN DIEGO NOTES

- Tonight marked the first time in Padres history where the lone hit of the game was recorded by a pitcher (including starting pitcher, reliever or pinch-hitting pitcher)...the last time a team's lone hit in a game was by a pitcher who did not start the game was on June 28, 1935 by Pittsburgh's Mace Brown at Chicago-NL, who entered the game as a reliever (ELIAS).
- **Bryan Mitchell** made his first career start and appearance against the Giants tonight...has pitched to a 4.14 ERA (25 ER, 54.1 IP) in 12 career starts with 25 strikeouts.
- Freddy Galvis has reached base safely in 13 of the 14 games played to start the season, recording a .418 OBP in that time.
- Clayton Richard is 3-for-4 (.750) in his career as a pinch-hitter...recorded a hit in consecutive games for the first time since he hit in three straight games in 2013.
- Colten Brewer made his Major League debut in the sixth inning.

SAN FRANCISCO NOTES

- Chris Stratton tossed a career-high 7.0 innings tonight, surpassing his previous career-high of 6.2 IP (3x; last: September 29, 2017 vs. San Diego)...is 2-1 in three career games, two starts, vs. the Padres with a 3.21 ERA (5 ER, 14.0 IP).
- **Buster Posey** extended his hitting streak to 10 games (.441, 15-for-34)...has hit .309 (67-for-217) in 56 all-time games at Petco Park.
- Hunter Pence snapped an 0-for-7 slump with a single in the first inning.
