CHICAGO CUBS NOTES

ANTHONY RIZZO (2-for-5, HR, 2B, R, 2 RBI) has homered in consecutive games for the fifth time this season ... has reached in nine-straight games and has five homers and eight RBI during that stretch.

© Hit his 182nd career home run with the Cubs, surpassing Alfonso Soriano for 11th in franchise history ... in 10th is Hack Wilson with 190.

KYLE HENDRICKS has struck out at least seven batters in each of his last three outings ... tied for the longest streak in his career (September 23-October 3, 2015) ... is 3-1 with 38 strikeouts and a 3.53 ERA (14 ER/35.2 IP) in his last six starts ... has walked two or fewer batters in each of his last eight starts.

© Retired the first six batters to start the game after retiring the previous 17 batters he had faced in his last outing at St. Louis on July 29.

KYLE SCHWARBER (2-for-3, HR, 2B, R, RBI) has 20 home runs on the season ... is the first Cubs outfielder with at least 20 homers in back-to-back seasons since Alfonso Soriano in 2011 (26) and 2012 (32) ... his sixth game this season with two extra-base hits.

NOTES: The Cubs are now 5-1 against the Padres this season and have won five games in a season series vs. San Diego for the first time since going 5-2 in 2008.

© The Cubs are 16-6 in their last 22 home games and improved to 12-5 in home games this season in which they hit two or more homers.

© The Cubs have scored five or more runs in an inning 16 times this season, the most in the N.L. and third most in the majors behind only Boston (18) and Cleveland (17) ... eight of those 16 innings have come at Wrigley Field.

© Jason Heyward (3-for-4, RBI) has 10 games with at least three hits this season.

© Addison Russell (1-for-4, RBI, R) has hit safely in his last five games.

© Steve Cishek (1.1 IP, 3 SO) has not allowed a hit in five-straight outings (5.0 IP, 6 SO).

© Pedro Strop (1.0, 2 SO) has converted on each of his last four save opportunities, adding to the longest streak of his career.

SAN DIEGO PADRES NOTES

AUSTIN HEDGES (1-for-3, HR, 2 RBI, R) has hit four homers in his last eight games ... had hit just four homers in his first 43 games of the season prior to that stretch ... is 7-for-17 (.412) with two homers and six RBI against the Cubs this season.

WALKER LOCKETT made his second-career start and pitched a career-high 5.0 innings

© His six strikeouts are the most by a Padres starter in an outing since Joey Lucchesi struck out six on July 23 at the Mets.

NOTES: The Padres have lost seven of their last nine games against the Cubs.

© The Padres are 8-24 this season in games in which they allow multiple homers.

© The Padres have allowed at least five runs in an inning 17 times this season, tied with Miami for the most in the N.L. and trailing only the White Sox (18).

© Manuel Margot (1-for-4, 2B, RBI, R) is 8-for-24 with three doubles, two RBI and four runs scored against the Cubs this season.

© Travis Jankowski (1-for-4, R) has hit safely in his last four games.

© Eric Hosmer (1-for-4, R) has hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games.

© Hunter Renfroe (1-for-3, 2B, RBI) has 25 extra-base hits out of his 49 total hits this season.
