#### Transactions

#### In Good Company

The Brewers own a record of 52-35, which ties the 1982 team for the best record through 87 games in franchise history.

#### 18 and I Like it

With a win tonight, the Brewers would be 18 games over .500 for the first time since the team owned a record of 51-33 on 6/30/14.

#### Save and Sound

**LHP Dan Jennings** converted his second career save last night....he became the sixth Brewer to convert a save this season....only the Philadelphia Phillies (8) have had more pitchers record a save this season....San Francisco and Tampa Bay have also had 6 different pitchers convert a save.

#### What a Relief

Brewers relievers own a 3.01 ERA (311p, 104er), which ranks second in the National League, trailing only the Diamondbacks (2.54era)....the bullpen has struck out 361 batters, which leads the NL and is second to only the Yankees' 395 for the MLB lead.

#### Night Moves

The Brewers own a 36-15 record when playing at night....the team's .706 winning percentage under the lights is the best in the majors.

#### Hit a Homer and it's Over

The Brewers are 45-14 when hitting a home run....the team's .763 winning percentage is the best in the Major Leagues.

#### Let's Go Streaking!

The Brewers have hit a home run in a season-high 11 consecutive games....the team has smashed 18 home runs in that span.

#### It's Miller Time!

**INF Brad Miller** is on a career-high 9-game hitting streak....it is the longest hitting streak by a Brewer this season....Miller is batting .355 (11-for-31) with 5 runs, 3 doubles, 2 homers, 6 RBI and a 1.057 OPS in the streak that dates back to 6/26.

**ON THE ROAD:** The Brewers are 24-18 on the road, going 8-4-2 in series play....had a season-high 5-game road winning streak from 4/30-5/11....the team went 40-38 on the road last season, going 13-11-2 in series play.

**MANAGER:** **Craig Counsell** is in his fourth season as manager of the Brewers (271-277) and third full season....he was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing **Ron Roenicke**....bio is on p. 44 of the media guide.

**COACHES:** Hitting coach **Darnell Coles** (4th season), pitching coach **Derek Johnson** (3rd season), coach **Jason Lane** (3rd season), bench coach **Pat Murphy** (3rd season), third base coach **Ed Sedar** (12th season, 8th as 3B coach), first base/infield coach **Carlos Subero** (3rd season) and bullpen coach **Lee Tunnell** (6th season) all returned from the 2017 staff.

**LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE:** The Brewers have made 13 replay challenges, going 4-9....their last challenge (lost) came on 7/5 vs. Atlanta as a hit by pitch call involving Ronald Acuña Jr. stood....team went 17-27 in 44 replay challenges last season.

## TONIGHT'S STARTER: #51 - RHP FREDDY PERALTA (5gs, 3-1, 2.28)

**PERALTA AT A GLANCE:** Freddy Peralta, 22, will make his sixth start.....Peralta last started last Sunday at Cincinnati and took an 8-2 loss (5ip, 5h, 3r, 3er, 3bb, 5k, 1wp).....the team is 4-1 in his starts.....he has 2 quality starts.....opponents are batting .128 (12-for-94, 1hr).....he entered 2018 as the ninth-best prospect in the organization according to *Baseball America*.....Peralta was acquired from Seattle, along with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki, in exchange for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15.....he was added to the 40-man roster on 11/20/17..... bio on p. 120 of the media guide.

**FREDDY K-RUEGER:** Peralta made his Major League debut on 5/13 at Colorado and earned a 7-3 win (5.2ip, 1h, 0r, 2bb, 13k).....he took a no-hitter into the sixth inning before allowing a 1-out single to David Dahl.....he tied for the fourth-highest strikeout total in a MLB debut of any pitcher in baseball since 1893.....his 13 strikeouts marked a franchise rookie record.....he was the ninth pitcher (13x) overall in franchise history to have 13 or more strikeouts in a game.

**PERFECT TIMING!** Peralta made his Major League debut on Mother's Day in front of his mother (Octavia), father (Pedro) and girlfriend (Maritza), all of whom had never seen him pitch professionally.....they were in town originally to see him pitch at Triple-A Colorado Springs..... when Chase Anderson was scratched due to illness, Peralta instead pitched for the Brewers.

**AT COLORADO SPRINGS:** Peralta was recalled from Triple-A Colorado Springs, where he went 6-1 with a 2.75 ERA in 12 starts (59ip, 45h, 20r, 18er, 27bb, 84k, 1hr).....his 84 strikeouts led the Pacific Coast League at the time of his promotion.....the team went 8-4 in his starts..... opponents batted just .208 (45-for-216, 1hr).

**LAST SEASON:** Peralta went 3-8 with a 2.63 ERA and 1 save in 25 games / 19 starts between Class-A Carolina and Double-A Biloxi.....he held opponents to a .178 batting average with 169 strikeouts in just 120.0 innings.....his 169 strikeouts led Brewers minor leaguers and tied for ninth in Minor League Baseball.....his 2.63 ERA ranked second among Brewers farmhands..... he was a Carolina League All-Star.

**AT HOME:** Is 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA in 1 start (7ip, 0er).

**ON THE ROAD:** Is 2-1 with a 3.05 ERA in 4 starts (20.2ip, 7er).

**AT THE PLATE:** Is 0-for-9 with 6 strikeouts.
