**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Braves and Diamondbacks continue a four-game set tonight with the fifth meeting between the clubs this season...The Diamondbacks won two-of-three games at SunTrust Park earlier this season, winning a 2-1 and 3-0 game to open the series, before the Braves took a 5-1 decision in the final game before the All-Star break.

- A* The Braves moved to 15-9 this season in series-opening games on the road, including 6-1 in such games since the All-Star break with last night's 7-6, 10-inning win.
- A* The Braves have not won a series in Arizona since taking three-of-four in 2012...They are 6-10 overall since 2013 here, including 0-4-1 in series play.
- A* RHP Kevin Gausman has never faced Arizona...The Diamondbacks are one of four teams the righty has no career appearances against...Baltimore, Colorado, and San Diego are the other three.
- A* LHP Patrick Corbin dropped his first career decision to Atlanta earlier this season, losing 5-1 after going 6.0 innings and allowing four runs, earned on July 15 at SunTrust Park...Despite the defeat, Corbin is 4-1 with a 1.69 ERA (8 ER/42.2 IP) in eight career games, six starts, against Atlanta.

**ON THE ROAD:** With last night's win, the Braves improved to a National League-best 40-29 (.580) on the road this season...Atlanta trails only Houston (47-21, .691), Boston (49-26, .653) and Oakland (41-28, .594) for the major league lead.

- A* With one more win away from SunTrust Park, the Braves will ensure they finish with a winning road record for the first time since going 46-35 in 2012.
- A* The Braves have 12 more road games left this season.
- A* From 2013-2017, the Braves went 174-230 (.431) on the road...That was the seventh-worst record in all of baseball.
- A* Over that stretch, the Braves were 29-64 (.312) on the road against the N.L. West...They are 5-5 so far this season.

**GAUSMAN:** RHP Kevin Gausman is set to make his seventh start with Atlanta tonight...Since joining the club after a July 31 trade with Baltimore, Gausman is 4-1 with a 1.66 ERA (7 ER/38.0 IP) and a .190 average against in six starts.

- A* Since joining the Braves, Gausman ranks tied for third in the National League in wins (4), and eighth in ERA (1.66) opponents average against (.190).
- A* Since the Braves inserted Gausman into the rotation, Atlanta starters have compiled a 3.00 ERA (68 ER/204.0 IP), the fifth-best mark in all of baseball.

**NEVER QUIT WITH SNIT:** The Braves collected their 17th last at-bat win last night, beating Arizona, 7-6, in 10 innings...The 17 such victories are tied for the fourth most in the National League and two off the lead of the San Francisco Giants...The Cubs and Dodgers both have 18 last at-bat wins.

- A* Since Brian Snitker was named interim manager on May 17, 2016, the Braves have 54 last at-bat wins, the most in the National League.
- A* The Braves led the N.L. in last at-bat victories the last two seasons...They had 20 in 2017 and 19 in 2016.
- A* The Braves have scored 227 times in the seventh inning or later this season, tied for the second-most such runs in the National League this season...Only Chicago has more at 252.

**DOUBLES:** OF Nick Markakis collected his 40th double of the season last night, becoming the first National League player to reach that mark this season.

- A* He is one of five active players with five 40-double seasons (Robinson Canó, Albert Pujols, Miguel Cabrera, David Wright).
- A* Markakis is now nine shy of the Braves' modern-era franchise record for doubles in a season...Marcus Giles set the mark with 49 in 2003...Hugh Duffy holds the overall franchise record with 51 in 1894.
- A* 1B Freddie Freeman hit his 37th double of the season last night, and now ranks 4th in the National League in two-base hits...Markakis and Freeman are trying to become the second pair of Braves teammates to both reach 40 doubles in a season...Jeff Francoeur (40) and Chipper Jones (42) accomplished the feat in 2007.
- A* The Braves have 276 two-base hits this season, the most in the National League, and 24 more than the next closest club, the Cubs...Atlanta is on pace to finish with 319 doubles this season...The Braves franchise record for doubles in a season is 328, set by the 2007 club.

**CAMARGO:** 3B Johan Camargo hit his 16th home run of the season last night, driving a 6th-inning pitch from Zack Greinke over the wall in right field.

- A* Since becoming the starting third baseman on May 20, Camargo has 14 home runs...That is second most on the team to OF Ronald Acuña Jr., who has 20.

**HOME RUNS:** With another home run this season, OF Ronald Acuña Jr. will tie Eddie Mathews and Orlando Cepeda (25 homers) for the fifth most home runs in a single season prior to turning 21...Al Kaline sits in fourth place with 27 in 1955, while Conigliaro had 32 in 1965...Frank Robinson hit 34 in 1956, while Mel Ott holds the record with 42 in 1929.

## Jonny Venters • LHP • 6-3 • 200 • 33 yrs • #48

- Saves/Opp:** 2/3    **Holds:** 10    **1st Batter/Retired:** 38/31    **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 19/7
- Has allowed two runs over 17 games (14.0 IP) since Atlanta acquired him on 7/26...Has a 1.29 ERA with the Braves.
  - In 38 relief appearances this season, is 4-0 with two saves and a 0.98 ERA (3 ER/27.2 IP)...Allowed five runs in 0.1 inning in his only start, 6/6 at WSH.
  - Earned the win in back-to-back appearances, 9/1 and 9/2 vs. PIT...Won consecutive games just once previously in his career, 5/1 vs. STL and 5/5 vs. MIL in 2011, also with Atlanta.
  - Earned his first save with Atlanta with a scoreless ninth inning on 8/21 at PIT...The save came exactly seven years to the day since he recorded his last save as a Brave in 2011.
  - Atlanta acquired him from the Tampa Bay Rays, 7/26, in exchange for an international signing slot...Rejoined the Braves after spending three seasons in Atlanta, 2010-2012.

## Bryse Wilson • RHP • 6-2 • 235 • 20 yrs • #72

- Saves/Opp:** 0/0    **Holds:** 0    **1st Batter/Retired:** 1/0    **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 0/0
- Allowed three runs over 1.0 inning in his first relief appearance, 9/3 vs. BOS...In three relief outings between Atlanta and Gwinnett, has an 18.00 ERA (6 ER/3.0 IP)...Has a 3.15 ERA (45 ER/128.2 IP) in 24 starts.
  - Recalled, 9/1, from Triple-A Gwinnett for his second stint on the active roster.
  - Is the youngest pitcher in the majors, and was the eighth-youngest Braves pitcher to start his debut since 1908.
  - Tossed 5.0 scoreless innings in his major league debut, 8/20 at PIT, to beat the Pirates 1-0...Became the youngest pitcher in major league history to win his debut 1-0.

## Dan Winkler • RHP • 6-3 • 210 • 28 yrs • #58

- Saves/Opp:** 2/4    **Holds:** 22    **1st Batter/Retired:** 63/43    **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 29/8
- Has allowed runs in back-to-back appearances after snapping a 14-appearance scoreless streak and allowing a career high-tying four runs, 9/5 vs. BOS, while not retiring a batter...Prior to the outing, had allowed one total run in his last 18 outings (16.1 innings) for a 0.55 ERA with 18 strikeouts.
  - His 22 holds are a team high...Is 22-for-24 in hold chances...Is the second rookie in Atlanta-franchise history to reach 20 holds in a season, joining teammate Jonny Venters who did so in 2011 (24 holds).
  - Earned his second career save 8/20 at PIT...Is 2-for-4 in save opportunities this season.
  - Has allowed an earned run in just 10 of his 63 appearances this season...Logged 19 consecutive outings without an earned run (16.1 IP), 4/17 to 6/3.
  - Has limited right-handed hitters to a .181 (25-for-138) average with five extra-base hits.

## Kyle Wright • RHP • 6-4 • 215 • 22 yrs • #73

- Saves/Opp:** 0/0    **Holds:** 0    **1st Batter/Retired:** 1/1    **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 0/0
- Atlanta selected his contract from Triple-A Gwinnett, 9/1, for his first stint on the active roster...Made his major league debut vs. Boston on 9/4 and tossed 2.0 scoreless innings with a pair of strikeouts.
  - Became just the second Braves pitcher to debut against the Red Sox, joining Kyle Davies (5/21/05)...Wright fanned the first batter he faced, Jackie Bradley Jr., on five pitches for his first career strikeout.
  - Was Atlanta's first-round draft selection in 2017 and is the first player from that draft to make the major leagues...The last Braves player to make the majors the year after he was drafted was LHP Alex Wood, who debuted in 2013.

# Braves Bits

## Ronald Acuña Jr. • OF • 6-0 • 205 • 20 yrs • #13

- ARI Series:** .000 (0-5)    **Last HR:** 9/5 vs. BOS (Velasquez)  
**Road Trip:** .000 (0-5)    **Current Streak:** 0-7  
**Season Long Streak:** 11 games, 8/8-18 (21-45, .467, 8 HR)

- Has eight leadoff home runs this season to set the franchise single-season record and pass the previous mark of seven, set by Marquis Grissom in 1996.
- Since moving to the leadoff role in the first game out of the All-Star break on 7/20 at WSH, has hit .320 (57-for-178) with 17 home runs, 32 RBI, 38 runs scored, nine stolen bases, a .402 on-base percentage and a .680 slugging percentage in 46 games.
- His 17 home runs since the break are the second most in baseball, while his 38 runs are third and his 56 hits are tied for fourth.
- Has made starts at all three outfield positions (11 games, 7 starts in center field; 81 games, 76 starts in left field; 3 games, 3 starts in right field).
- Finished August with 39 hits, becoming the first National League rookie over the last 110 seasons to collect at least 39 hits and 11 home runs in a calendar month...Won the N.L. Rookie of the Month award for August...Also Named as the N.L. Player of the Week for the week ending 8/19.
- Is one of seven players in baseball history to reach 24 home runs in a season prior to his 21st birthday.
- Homered in five straight games, 8/11-8/14, to tie the franchise modern-era record for most consecutive games with a homer...Prior to Acuña Jr., the last Braves player to homer in five straight was Brian McCann in 2006...Acuña Jr. became the youngest player in baseball history to homer in four straight games.
- His streak of three consecutive games with a lead-off home run ended, 8/15, after he was hit with the first pitch by José Ureña...He became just the second player with as long a streak in baseball's modern era; Baltimore's Brady Anderson holds the major league record with four straight, accomplishing the feat from April 18-21, 1996.
- Reinstated from the 10-day disabled on 6/28...Went to the DL on 5/28 and missed 28 games with a left knee mild ACL sprain, left knee contusion and lower back contusion.
- Atlanta selected his contract from Triple-A Gwinnett, 4/25.

## Lane Adams • OF • 6-4 • 220 • 28 yrs • #18

- ARI Series:** DNP    **Last HR:** 3/31 vs. PHI (Florimon)  
**Road Trip:** DNP    **Current Streak:** 0-6  
**Season Long Streak:** 1 game, 4x, last: 4/14 (1-4, .250)

- Pinch ran and scored the game-tying run, 9/1 vs. PIT in his first action since re-joining the Braves...Struck out yesterday, 9/5 vs. BOS in his only at-bat since.
- The Braves selected his contract from Triple-A Gwinnett, 9/1...Marks his second stint on the active roster after he made his first Opening Day roster...Also spent time in the Cubs organization, 5/5-6/30...Returned to Atlanta on 7/17.
- Hit .166 (29-for-175) with no homers in 62 MiLB games this season...Stole 12 bases.
- Ranked fourth in MLB last season with 12 pinch-hit RBI.

## Ozzie Albies • INF • 5-8 • 165 • 21 yrs • #1

- ARI Series:** .200 (1-5)    **Last HRs:** 9/3 vs. BOS (Kelly)  
**Road Trip:** .200 (1-5)    **Current Streak:** 2 games (2-10, .200)  
**Season Long Streak:** 11 games, 6/17-7/2 (22-51, .431, HR)

- N.L. Ranks:** runs (4th, 92), doubles (7th, 34), extra base-hits (T8th, 60), total bases (9th, 260), multi-hit games (T7th, 44), hits (T10th, 152).
- Has four extra-base hits (a double, a triple and two home runs) over his last 30 games with an at-bat...His two homers are his only homers over his last 43 games with an at-bat...Hit 247 homers through his first 90 games.
- Hitting .247 (38-for-154) with a .331 slugging percentage in 43 games since the All-Star break.
- Has 12 games with multiple extra-base hits this season, five away from the Atlanta franchise record held by Chipper Jones (1999) and Javy Lopez (2003).
- Homered from both sides of the plate, 7/11 vs. TOR, for his first career multi-HR game.
- Selected to his first career All-Star Game in his first full major league season.

## Johan Camargo • INF • 6-0 • 195 • 24 yrs • #17

**Season Long Streak:** 10 games, 6/22-7/4 (15-42, .357, 2 HR)

- Since being named the starting third baseman on 5/20, is hitting .285 (96-for-337) with a .355 on-base percentage and 14 home runs in 93 games.
- His 14 home runs over this stretch are the second most on the team...Only OF Ronald Acuña Jr. has more with 20.
- Has hit fifth in the lineup 27 times...Batting .333 (35-for-105) with a .388 on-base percentage and a .514 slugging percentage in these games.
- Leads the team in RBI since the beginning of June with 51...His eight game-winning RBI since his season debut on 4/18 are second most on the club (Freeman, 11).
- Hitting .340 (34-for-100) with a .438 on-base percentage with runners in scoring position.

## Charlie Culberson • INF • 6-1 • 200 • 29 yrs • #16

- Since the All-Star break is hitting .314 (27-for-86) with six home runs and a .605 slugging percentage in 31 games...Homered in three straight games, 8-7-8/8.
- Has played seven positions - LF (29 games, 23 starts), 3B (15 games, 13 starts), SS (12 games, 8 starts), 2B (9 games, 8 starts), 1B (2 games, 0 starts), RF (2 games, 1 start), P (1 game, 0 starts)...Tossed his first career inning, 8/17 vs. COL...Team is 31-22 when he starts.
- Since the beginning of May is batting .299/.340/.527 over 79 games with an at-bat...Opened the season with three hits (two singles) in his first 27 at-bats (.111).
- Is 5-for-31 (.161) with two home runs as a pinch-hitter this season.
- With 6/3's home run, he became the first player in Atlanta-era history with two pinch-hit game-ending home runs in the same season.
- All of Culberson's four game-ending RBI have come on home runs.

- Pinch hit and flew out to center in his Braves debut, 8/30 vs. CHI.
- Is a career .188 (13-for-69) hitter as a pinch hitter with two home runs.
- Hitting .262 (60-for-229) with 11 home runs against righties this season.
- Acquired along with cash from Kansas City, 8/29, for a player to be named later or cash considerations.
- Hit .242 (74-for-306) with 13 home runs and 48 RBI in 86 games for the Royals this season, his first with Kansas City
