TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and Marlins play game two of this four-game series... SF lost the opener 7-5 last night, just the fifth time this season the Giants lost a game when scoring five or more runs...SF is now 2-2 on this 10-game road trip.

TODAY'S STARTER: RHP **Chris Stratton** will seek his team-leading eighth win of the season as he makes his 14th start of the year...the Giants have gone 10-3 in Stratton's starts this season, winning each of his last five trips to the mound... Stratton, who has never faced the Marlins, has gone 3-2 with a 3.86 ERA in six road starts in 2018.

FROM BASEBALL INFO SOLUTIONS: Opposing hitters are batting .322/.401/.566 against Stratton in his last eight starts...he held opponents to four hits and walks allowed on his curve and changeup in his first five starts this season, getting 21 outs, 59% for strikes...however, in his last eight starts, he's allowed 15 hits and walks allowed, getting 26 outs, 55% strikes.

ONE FOR 1,500: IF Evan Longoria is one game shy of 1,500 for his career...he played 1,435 of those with Tampa Bay.

INSIDE THE SERIES: The Giants went 1-5 against Miami last season and have lost 13 of their last 20 to the Fish since 2015...SF is 9-11 all-time here at Marlins Park, losing eight of the last 11 games.

TOUGH STRETCH: The Giants are in the middle of a 17-game stretch without an off day, and beginning last Friday, June 8, SF has just two off days leading up to the All-Star Break (that's 36 games in 38 days)...so far, the Giants are 2-2 in this stretch.

HOT SINCE MAY: Beginning May 1, **IF Brandon Crawford** has hit safely in all but six of his last 37 games, batting a MLB-best .430 (58-for-135) with 16 doubles, six homers and 28 RBI...he's raised his batting average by 144 points from .189 to his current .333 mark, which ranks as the fourth-best in the National League.

WINNING WAYS: Despite last night's loss, the Giants have still won eight of their last 11 games, outscoring opponents by a 57-34 margin...SF has won each of their last three series.

TOP TO BOTTOM: The top of the Giants' batting order last night - hitters 1 through 4 - combined to go 8-for-16 with five runs, a double, two RBI and three walks while hitters 5 through 9 went a combined 0-for-18 with two RBI and two walks.

RUNS ON THE ROAD: San Francisco is averaging 3.58 runs per game on the road (27th in MLB) compared to 5.03 at home (5th in MLB)...however, SF has scored 37 runs in their last seven road games (5.3 per game).

ON THE MOUND: Giants starting pitchers have totaled just 22 quality starts this season, tied for the fifth-fewest in the Majors...SF is 14-8 (.636) when receiving a quality start and 19-25 (.432) when they don't get a quality outing...Giants starters have logged 5.0-or-fewer innings in 14 of the last 20 games.

KEEP VOTING: MLB announced the first ballot update for the 2018 MLB All-Star Game and four Giants are among the leading vote-getters...**C Buster Posey** leads all NL catchers with 281,331 votes and **IF Brandon Crawford** paces all NL shortstops with 466,021 votes...**IF Brandon Belt** is third among first basemen with 162,750 votes and **IF Joe Panik** ranks fifth among second basemen with 62,325 votes.

This Date in Giants History: June 12, 2004

In an Orioles-Giants interleague game, **Barry Bonds** hit a home run, the 675th of his career, and Rafael Palmeiro hit his 536th and 537th to move past Mickey Mantle into 11th place on the career list...it was only the third time in Major League history that two players with 500 homers connect in the same game...**Willie Mays** and **Ernie Banks** did it in 1970, and Mays and Hank Aaron both homered in 1971.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#34 RHP Chris Stratton
6-2, 211, 27 years old (August 22, 1990)
7-3 Record, 4.63 ERA

- The 27-year-old right-hander is making his 14th start of the season...the Giants are 10-3 in his outings this year, going 6-1 at home and 4-2 on the road.
- San Francisco has won each of his last five trips to the hill...the Giants are 16-7 (.696) overall in Stratton's career starts.
- His seven wins are tied for the third-most in the NL behind St. Louis' Michael Wacha (8) and Washington's Max Scherzer (10).
- Has won his last four decisions, going 4-0 with a 4.68 ERA (13er, 25.0ip) in his last five outings...this is the longest winning streak of his career.
- The Giants tend to perform better when Stratton starts, as they are 10-3 (.769) with him on the hill this year...the only Giants starter with a higher team winning pct. in his starts is **Johnny Cueto** (.800, 4-1).
- Last pitched Wednesday versus Arizona and did not factor into the decision after allowing three runs on seven hits in just 4.0 innings...marked his seventh start of the season with 5.0-or-fewer innings pitched...the Giants won 5-4 in 10.0 innings on **Brandon Crawford's** game-ending run-scoring single.
- Stratton has a run-support average of 6.35 this season compared to 4.84 by all other Giants pitchers.
- Has allowed eight home runs in his last eight starts (37.0ip) after not allowing a homer in his first five starts this season (31.0ip).
- Has a 5.54 ERA (8er, 13.0ip) in the 1st inning.
- Left-handed batters are hitting .326 off him in his last eight games with 13 extra base hits...in his first five starts this year, lefties were hitting just .140 (8-for-57) off him.
- Stratton relies on six pitches...four seamer (56.6%, 91.1 mph), curve (15.1%, 77.3 mph), slider (11.7%, 83.1 mph), changeup (8.8%, 83.6 mph), sinker (4.9%, 90.4 mph), cutter (3%, 91.0 mph).
- Opponents are hitting .229 off his four seamer this year, .268 off his curve, .429 off his slider, .238 off the changeup, .375 off his sinker and .286 off the cutter.
- Missed four days on the Paternity List (April 25-29) when he flew home to Mississippi where he was able to meet his wife, Martha Kate for the birth of their second child, Mary Bennett Stratton, born April 25.

NOTES: The 25-year-old Miami, Florida native will make his 10th big league start tomorrow in game three of this four-game series...has gone 2-4 with a 5.06 ERA in nine starts, however has struck out 47 batters while issuing just nine walks...the Giants have won each of his last two starts...has worked past the 5th inning just five times in nine outings...even though he's never faced the Marlins in the big leagues, tomorrow will mark the second time he's pitched at Marlins Park...as a freshman at the University of Miami, he started and pitched 3.0 impressive innings against the Marlins in the team's stadium-opening exhibition in 2012.
