### SAN DIEGO NOTES

- **The Padres earned their third walk-off victory of the season** and their first since May 30 vs. MIA when Hunter Renfroe recorded a walk-off single in the bottom of the 9<sup>th</sup> inning.
  - Entering play today, the Padres were tied for second-fewest walk-off wins this season...the three walk-off victories match their total set in 2017.
- **Christian Villanueva recorded his first career walk-off hit...**his 46 RBI this season tie Benji Gil (46 RBI in 1995) for the most of any Mexican-born rookie in ML history in a single season.
- **Clayton Richard** has tossed 5.0 innings-or-more in each of his last five starts since July 25, and has done so in 24 of his 26 outings this season...tonight's contest marked his first start at home against the Diamondbacks since May 21, 2017, and in 20 career starts vs. ARI, owns a 10-6 record with a 4.40 ERA (58 ER, 118.2 IP).
- **Freddy Galvis** owns a .525 SLG in August, his highest since he posted a .527 SLG in August of 2016...is 3-for-5 with bases loaded this season with 10 RBI, after going just 2-for-12 with bases loaded last season.
- **Eric Hosmer** extended his hitting streak to seven games, the longest active streak on the team (.346, 9-for-26)...has reached base via hit or walk in 23 of his last 24 games (.371 OBP) and has hit safely in 21 of his last 24 games (.309 BA).

### ARIZONA NOTES

- **The Diamondbacks** have scored at least one run in the first inning in six consecutive games since Aug. 12 (15 runs total), matching the franchise record, done four times, most recently from April 21-26, 2017 (per Elias).
  - The club's 107 runs in the first inning are the third most in team history, trailing 1999 (125) and 2017 (108).
- **Zack Godley** made his career-high-tying 25<sup>th</sup> start of the season (also 25 in 2017)...owns a 4-0 record with a 3.26 ERA (18 ER, 49.2 IP), .231 opponent average and 58 strikeouts over his last nine games (eight starts)...has not yielded a home run in his last 10 games (nine starts) and his last 211 batters faced since Starlin Castro's roundtripper on June 26 at MIA.
  - Has gone 0-3 with a 6.55 ERA (16 ER, 22.0 IP) in five career games (four starts) at Petco Park.
- **Paul Goldschmidt** logged a season-high-tying four RBI tonight (June 9 at COL)...has reached base safely in nine consecutive plate appearances (six hits, three walks), tying the club record...overall, has reached base safely in 24 straight games since July 23, the longest streak of his career.
  - Extended his hitting streak to 11 games, going 21-for-48 (.438) over that time...in his last 12 games vs. the Padres, is batting .469 (23-for-49) with four doubles, a triple, three homers and 14 RBI.
- **Eduardo Escobar** went 3-for-5 and recorded his seventh three-hit game of the season ...has reached base in 28 of his last 31 games (.393 OBP) with eight doubles, four home runs, 23 RBI and 16 walks.
