PITTSBURGH PIRATES (32-35) vs. ARIZONA DIAMONDBACKS (37-29)

June 13, 2018 at Chase Field, Phoenix, AZ --- GAME #68/ROAD #34

RHP JAMESON TAILLON (3-5, 4.08 ERA) vs. RHP ZACK GREINKE (5-4, 3.53 ERA)

THE PIRATES... have lost five of their last six games and have dropped 13 of their last 17...Have gone 6-18 in their last 24 games after their record was a season-high nine games over .500 on 5/17 (26-17)...Won consecutive games for the last time on 5/16-17...Won a season-high five straight games on two occasions (4/25-29 & 5/6-12)...Were 30-37 after 67 games in 2017 (31-37 after 68).

DIGGING THE DAYLIGHT: In 16 career starts during the afternoon, **Jameson Taillon** has gone 8-2 with a 2.89 ERA (93.1ip/30er) and the Pirates have won 12 of the 16, including eight of the last 10...Today marks Taillon's sixth afternoon start this season and his first on the road...The Pirates have never lost one of Jameson's road starts played in the daylight, going 4-0 and scoring 24 runs while he has gone 3-0 with a 1.71 ERA (21.0ip/4er) in the four starts

HEADING HOME: Following the game today the Pirates depart for Pittsburgh, where they are scheduled to begin a 10-game homestand Friday night against the Reds...After three games with the Brewers, the homestand concludes with four games against the Diamondbacks beginning next Thursday, June 21.

JOSH?: **Josh Bell** and **Josh Harrison** have combined to go 9-for-18 with seven walks and a HBP in the last three games...Bell went 3-for-5 Tuesday night and has now reached base safely 10 times in his last 13 plate appearances while Harrison has gone 5-for-11 with a homer and two RBI in the last three games.

BEHIND THE DISH: **Elias Díaz** has produced two multi-hit games while starting each of the last three contests and going 5-for-13...He is hitting .299 overall this season and has gone 6-for-16 with a homer and five RBI in his last four starts...In his 20 starts this season, Díaz is hitting .324 (24-for-74) with three doubles, four home runs and 14 RBI.

START ME UP: Rookie third baseman **Colin Moran** has reached base safely in each of his last 12 starts, going 13-for-42 (.310) with five walks...Overall he has reached base safely in 43 of his 50 starts at third base...Among National League rookies, Moran ranks second in batting average (.269), third in on-base percentage (.354) and third in RBI (25).

CATCH THIS: **Francisco Cervelli** and **Elias Díaz** have combined to produce the best batting average (.281) and the best OBP (.380) among all catching tandems in the Major Leagues this season...Their 47 combined RBI from the catching position are tops among N.L. teams and are second behind the Yankees (51) in MLB...Their 12 home runs while catching are tied with the Dodgers for the most among National League teams and are the most hit by Pittsburgh catchers since 2014 (13)...The Bucco backstops combined to hit six home runs in 2017, three in 2016 and seven in 2015.

HOT IN ARIZONA: In 11 career games at Chase Field, **Starling Marte** has gone 19-for-50 (.380) with a homer and 11 RBI...He has hit safely in 10 of the 11 games, including a four-hit performance on 4/24/17...**Gregory Polanco** is hitting .323 (20-for-62) with two home runs and eight RBI in 15 career games at Chase Field while **Josh Harrison** has reached base safely in 16 of his last 17 games played here, going 24-for-67 (.358) with nine doubles, a triple and a home run.

LEADING THE WAY: **Josh Harrison** connected off Kyle Hendricks for his seventh career home run leading off the first inning Sunday afternoon in Chicago...Harrison now ranks fifth in club history in leadoff homers behind **Barry Bonds** (20), **Al Martin** (10), **Bob Bailey** (8) and **Andrew McCutchen** (8)...The Pirates have now hit five leadoff home runs this season, the most by the club since smacking five such homers in 2009.

ROLLING MEADOWS: Beginning with the date of his first Major League game on 5/18, **Austin Meadows** ranks eighth among all National League players with a 1.027 OPS...He has hit safely in each of his last eight starts and in 16 of his first 19 big league starts overall, going 27-for-75 (.360) with five doubles, two triples, five homers and 10 RBI...Meadows was named the N.L. Rookie-of-the Month in May after hitting .409 with four HR in 13 games.

ROAD TRIP: Pittsburgh has gone 1-4 thus far on this six-game road trip after losing two-of-three at Wrigley Field over the weekend and dropping the first two tilts in Arizona...The Bucs have lost nine of their last 12 games played on the road after winning three straight between May 6-9...Overall the Pirates have produced a 14-20 record on the road this season.

GUNNING THEM DOWN: **Francisco Cervelli** has caught 10 runners attempting to steal this season; he had a total of nine last year...Among N.L. catchers, only Philadelphia's Jorge Alfaro has gunned down more runners this season (11).

DICKERSON DELIVERING: **Corey Dickerson** currently ranks eighth among the National League leaders with a .311 batting average and is tied for sixth with 74 hits...Dickerson has hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games (15-for-47, .319) and has produced a .333 (23-for-69) average in his last 18 games, dating back to 5/23.

ALL-STAR WORTHY: **Francisco Cervelli** enters today ranked first among all Major League catchers with a .386 on-base percentage...He also ranks second among all backstops in slugging percentage (.503) and OPS...Cervelli has already established a single-season career high in home runs (nine).

OFFENSIVE OUTFIELD: Pittsburgh outfielders have combined to produce the best OPS among National League teams (.813) and the third-best among all Major League teams behind Boston (.888) and the New York Yankees (.823)...The Pirates outfielders also lead the N.L. in total bases (382) and RBI (116).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

June 13, 1988: The Pirates shut out the Chicago Cubs 8-0 at Wrigley Field. Bob Walk pitched a complete game for the Bucs and improved his record to 7-4 while recording five strikeouts. Bobby Bonilla went 3-for-5 with a home run and three RBI. Barry Bonds was the leadoff batter and went 2-for-4 with a solo homer, a walk, a stolen base and three runs scored.

GHAD KUHL: The 25-year-old righthander will be making his 14th start of the season when he takes the mound against the Reds at PNC Park Friday night...His last start was a 3-1 loss to the Cubs at Wrigley Field Friday afternoon (5.1ip/8h/3r/2bb/6so)...Has been charged with seven runs in his last four starts (23.1ip) and has posted a 3.10 ERA (40.2ip/14er) in his last seven outings (Pirates are 4-3)...Has posted a 2.29 ERA (35.1ip/9er) in six starts against teams from the N.L. Central division in 2018.
