TRIBE HEADLINES

» The Indians own a 40-20 (.667) record vs. A.L. Central opponents this season, marking the 3rd-highest intradivisional winning percentage in MLB...the Tribe's 2.85 ERA vs. their own division is the lowest in MLB.

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** (30HR) has become the first player in club history to collect 40+ doubles, 30+ home runs and 20+ stolen bases in a season...he and **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** (37HR) are the first pair of switch-hitting teammates in MLB history to hit 30+ homers.

» Ramirez is one stolen base away from becoming the third player in franchise history to log a 30-homer/30-steal season (**Joe Carter** - 1987, **Grady Sizemore** - 2008).

» **MIKE CLEVINGER's** 2.20 ERA vs. the A.L. Central is the 2nd-lowest vs. the division (min. 60.0IP) behind **TREVOR BAUER** (1.93)...Clevinger ranks 8th in the A.L. with his 3.17 season ERA.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians brought the tying run to the plate in the 9th inning for a second consecutive game, but fell 5-1 in yesterday's series opener vs. Kansas City...Minnesota's 4-1 loss at Houston dropped the Tribe's "magic number" to clinch the A.L. Central title to 12.

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** (2-4) plated the Tribe's lone run with his 30th home run of the season, a solo shot in the bottom of the 9th inning...Lindor also had a single in the 3rd inning, and notched his 52nd multi-hit game of the season (2nd in MLB)...**MICHAEL BRANTLEY** (1-4) and **YONDER ALONSO** (1-3) were responsible for Cleveland's only other hits.

» **ADAM PLUTKO** was handed his fifth loss of the season, allowing four runs on seven hits over 6.0 innings of work...walked no batters and struck out a career-high eight.

NEW FACES

» The Indians today selected the contracts of **OF BRANDON BARNES** and **INF ADAM ROSALES** from Triple-A Columbus...the Tribe's active roster now stands at 31 players.

» **Barnes**, 32, batted .273 with 14 homers, 39 doubles (1st in I.L.) and 81 RBI (2nd in I.L.) in 132 games for the Clippers, earning International League Mid-Season and Postseason All-Star honors...the outfielder has appeared at the Major League level in parts of five seasons with Houston (2012-13) and Colorado (2014-16)...on July 19, 2013 vs. Seattle, Barnes hit for the eighth cycle in Houston Astros history.

» **Rosales**, 35, also spent the entire 2018 season with Columbus, batting .239 with 18 homers, 22 doubles and 61 RBI across 114 games...the infielder is a veteran of 10 Major League seasons with Cincinnati, Oakland, Texas, San Diego and Arizona.

ROYAL WELCOME

» The Indians are hosting the Royals this week in the fifth of six series between the two clubs this season...the Tribe will conclude their 2018 regular season with four games at Kauffman Stadium from September 27-30.

» Cleveland has gone 8-5 overall thus far against the Royals, taking two of three contests in a pair of series at Progressive Field (April 6-8, May 11-13)...the Indians earned a three-game sweep in their first series at Kansas City (July 2-4) but were bested two games to one in their most recent matchup (August 24-26).

» In a rivalry that dates back to 1969, the Indians own an all-time record of 366-333 (.524) vs. the Royals, as well as a 63-45 (.583) mark since **Terry Francona** became Tribe manager in 2013.

DIVISIONAL DOMINANCE

» Cleveland has gone 40-21 vs. A.L. Central opponents this season, with a record of 13-4-2 in series play...the Indians' .656 intradivisional winning percentage ranks 3rd in MLB behind Atlanta (.656) and Boston (.656) and Boston (45-19, .703 vs. A.L. East).

» **The Tribe has gone 23-7 in divisional home games** and 17-14 on the road...since June 17, Cleveland has won 12 of its last 15 divisional home games.

» **In 61 games vs. the A.L. Central, Tribe pitchers own a 2.85 ERA (173ER/546.0IP), marking the lowest intradivisional ERA in MLB...** seven of the Tribe's 14 shutouts this season (T2nd in MLB) have come against the A.L. Central, and the Indians have allowed three-or-fewer runs in 39 intradivisional games (33-6 in those contests).

K.C. AND THE SUNSHINE BAND

» **MIKE CLEVINGER** is set to make his fourth start of the season against Kansas City, entering play with a 1-0 record and a 2.57 ERA (6ER/21.0IP) in three previous starts vs. the Royals.

» Clevinger is starting on regular four days' rest after making his last outing on August 30 vs. Minnesota...earned his 10th win of the season after allowing two runs (both unearned) on four hits over 6.2 innings of work (1BB/9K)...finished August with a 3-0 record and a 2.21 ERA (9ER/36.2IP) in six starts, the 6th-lowest ERA (min. 20.0IP) in the American League last month.

» Tonight will mark Clevinger's 12th start this season against an A.L. Central opponent...**owns a 5-1 record with a 2.20 ERA (18ER/73.2IP) in 11 previous starts, marking the 2nd-lowest ERA against the division (min. 60.0IP) behind teammate TREVOR BAUER (1.93).**

» Clevinger has posted a 5-3 record with a 3.44 ERA (34RE/89.0IP) in 14 home outings this season, allowing no earned runs over 12.2 innings in his last two home starts (both wins).

» He enters play tonight with a 3.17 season ERA, the 8th-lowest mark in the American League...he also ranks 11th in the A.L. with 172 strikeouts and 13th with a .236 opponent batting average.

FRANKIE HITS 30

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** hit his 30th home run of the season yesterday afternoon (8th in American League), becoming the first player in franchise history to log a season with 40+ doubles, 30+ homers and 20+ stolen bases...he is also the first Tribe player to hit 30-or-more homers in consecutive seasons since **Travis Hafner** did so in 2005 & 2006.

» Lindor joined **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** (37HR, 3rd in A.L.) at the 30-homer milestone...**Lindor and Ramirez are the first switch-hitting teammates in MLB history to hit at least 30 home runs.**

» He continues to lead MLB with 112 runs scored, the most runs by an Indians player since **Grady Sizemore** scored 118 runs in the 2007 campaign...Sizemore was also the last Tribe player to lead the Majors in runs scored, doing so in 2006 with 134 runs.

» Lindor is batting .306 (76-248) in 60 games against the A.L. Central this season, leading all players with 18 home runs, 53 runs scored, 48 RBI and 16 doubles (T1st) vs. the division.

» His 52 multi-hit games this season lead the Indians and rank 2nd in MLB (Boston's **J.D. Martinez** - 55)...he also ranks among A.L. leaders in doubles (T2nd, 40), total bases (4th, 291), extra-base hits (5th, 71) and stolen bases (7th, 22).

KINGS OF K

» **ADAM PLUTKO's** outing yesterday marked the Tribe's 46th start with at least eight strikeouts, 2nd-most in MLB (HOU - 57)...conversely, Cleveland's 21 walkless starts of at least 6.0 innings rank 3rd-most in MLB (LAD - 32, SEA - 22).

» Tribe starting pitchers have recorded 903 strikeouts this season (2nd in MLB, Houston - 959) and have issued just 209 walks (4th-fewest in MLB)...the rotation's collective 4.32 K/BB ratio is the highest in MLB and currently stands as the highest mark in club history.

» The Indians currently boast three pitchers among the American League top 10 in strikeouts: **TREVOR BAUER** (4th, 214), **CARLOS CARRASCO** (6th, 187) and **COREY KLUBER** (9th, 180)...tonight's starter **MIKE CLEVINGER** (172 strikeouts) sits five punchouts shy of joining the A.L. top 10.

SOUTHPAW STUDS

» Since the All-Star break, Cleveland's four left-handed relievers have posted a combined 1.26 ERA (5ER/36.2IP), 2nd-lowest in MLB over that span (SD - 1.17).

» **OLIVER PÉREZ** has posted a 1.08 ERA (3ER/25.0IP) in 40 appearances this season, the lowest mark among left-handed relievers and 2nd-lowest among all relief pitchers (min. 30G), behind Oakland's **Blake Treinen** (0.91 ERA)...he currently holds the lowest-ever season ERA by a Tribe pitcher with 40-or-more appearances, just ahead of **José Mesa's** 1.12 ERA in 1995 (62 games/64.0 innings, finished 2nd in A.L. Cy Young voting).

» **BRAD HAND** has posted a 1.53 ERA (3ER/17.2IP) in 17 appearances since joining the Indians on July 20...his seven saves with Cleveland are the most by a Tribe left-hander since **Derek Lilliquist** had 10 in the 1993 campaign.

TONIGHT'S START

» The 27-year-old right-hander is due to take the ball in the middle tilt of this three-game series tonight vs. Kansas City...will mark his 28th outing of the season, as well as his 71st career appearance (59th start).

» Clevinger will pitch tonight on regular four days' rest after making his last start on August 30 vs. Minnesota, earlier this homestand...earned his 10th win of the year, holding the Twins to two unearned runs on four hits (one home run), with one walk and nine strikeouts in 6.2 innings.

» Has compiled a 5-1 record and 2.20 ERA (18ER/73.2IP) in 11 starts vs. the A.L. Central this season...his ERA is the 2nd-lowest mark by any pitcher against the division (min. 60.OIP)...Tribe starting pitchers own the top four lowest ERAs vs. the Central this season (**TREVOR BAUER** - 1.93, **CLEVINGER** - 2.20, **CARLOS CARRASCO** - 2.39 & **COREY KLUBER** - 2.45).

» Across his last four home starts, Clevinger has posted a 2-0 record and 1.40 ERA, allowing just four earned runs in 25.2 cumulative innings in those outings.

» Clevinger has five pickoffs this season, 2nd-most in the American League behind Seattle left-hander **Marco Gonzales** (6)...his five pickoffs are the most by an A.L. right-hander...marks the most pickoffs by an Indians pitcher in a single season since **LHP Tony Sipp** also had five in 2010, as well as the most pickoffs by an Indians right-hander since **Tom Candiotti** had six in 1989.

» Enters play tonight ranked among the American League pitching leaders in ERA (3.17, 8th), innings pitched (170.1, 8th) and opponent batting average (.236, 13th).

VS. KANSAS CITY | A.L. CENTRAL

» Clevinger is due to face Kansas City for the fourth time this season, compiling a 1-0 record and 2.57 ERA (6ER/21.0IP) in his three prior starts.

» Last faced the Royals on August 24 in Kansas City...recorded a quality start but did not factor into the decision in the Tribe's 5-4 loss (6.0IP, 4H, 3R/ER, 1HR, 2BB, 8K).

» Owns a career 4-0 record and 2.49 ERA (12ER/43.1IP) in eight appearances (seven starts) vs. Kansas City...his career 2.49 ERA vs. the Royals is his 2nd-lowest against a single opponent in his career, behind his 1.80 mark vs. Baltimore.

» Made his most recent home start vs. Kansas City on May 12, earning the win (7.2IP, 8H, 2R/ER, 0BB, 5K)...owns a career 2-0 record and 2.61 ERA (9ER/31.0IP) in five starts against the Royals at Progressive Field.

» Clevinger has found success in intradivisional starts this season, compiling a 5-1 record and 2.20 ERA (18ER/73.2IP) in 11 starts against the A.L. Central...his ERA vs. the A.L. Central is the 2nd-lowest by any pitcher against the division this year (min. 60.OIP), behind **TREVOR BAUER** (1.93).

» Clevinger has also struck out 75 batters in his intradivisional starts this season, the 3rd-most against the A.L. Central this season (**TREVOR BAUER** - 111, **CARLOS CARRASCO** - 82).

» He has also allowed three-or-fewer runs in each of his last seven starts against an intradivisional opponent, posting a 3-1 record and 1.96 ERA (10ER/46.0IP) in those outings.

AT PROGRESSIVE FIELD

» Clevinger will make his 15th home start of the season in tonight's contest...has compiled a 5-3 record and 3.44 ERA (34ER/89.0IP) in his prior home outings.

» Has emerged victorious in each of his last two home starts, on August 19 vs. Baltimore and August 30 vs. Minnesota, allowing no earned runs while striking out 16 batters in 12.2 innings across the outings.

» Has allowed three-or-fewer runs in nine of his 14 home starts and each of this last four, posting a 5-0 record and 1.75 ERA (12ER/61.2IP) in those outings...his nine starts are the 3rd-most on the club (**COREY KLUBER** - 11, **TREVOR BAUER** - 10).

2018 RECAP & HIGHLIGHTS

» Clevinger posted a 3-0 record and 2.21 ERA (9ER/36.2IP) in six August starts, his 2nd-lowest ERA in a single month (min. 5GS), behind Sept./Oct. 2017 (0.99 ERA)...his 39 punchouts also tied his most in a single month, alongside May and July 2018.

» Collected his 10th win of the season in his last start on August 30 vs. Minnesota (6.2IP, 4H, 2R/0ER, 1HR, 1BB, 9K), reaching the 10-win mark for the second time in his career after notching a career-best 12 victories in 2017.

» Did not factor into the decision despite recording a quality start at Kansas City on August 24 (6.0IP, 4H, 3R/ER, 1HR, 1BB, 8K)...marked his 17th quality start of the season, extending his career high mark.

» Tossed 6.0 shutout innings on August 19 vs. Baltimore...marked his second scoreless start of 6.0-or-more innings this season (eighth of his career)...Tribe starters have recorded 23 such starts this year, the most in MLB.

» Snapped his career-long four-decision losing streak with a win on August 13 at Cincinnati (5.0IP, 5H, 2R/ER, 2HR, 6BB, 4K).

» Recorded his second career start with zero walks on August 3 vs. Los Angeles-AL, after also doing so on May 12 vs. Kansas City.

» Clevinger matched his career high with 11 strikeouts on July 9 vs. Cincinnati...marked his fourth career start with 10-or-more strikeouts...the Tribe pitching staff has 23 such starts this season, which is the 2nd-most in MLB (Houston - 26).

» Notched his seventh win on July 1 at Oakland, holding the Athletics to three runs on eight hits (2BB, 5K) over 6.0 innings...marked his 11th quality start of the season, matching his career high (set in 2017).

» Concluded June with a 2-1 record and 2.78 ERA (10ER/32.1IP) in five starts...marked his 4th-lowest ERA in a single month in his career (min. 5G), trailing Sept./Oct. 2017 (0.99 ERA), August 2018 (2.21 ERA) and March/April 2018 (2.56 ERA)...his 33 strikeouts in June marked his 4th-most in a single month, behind his 39 punchouts in May, July and August 2018.

» On June 14 at Chicago-AL, set a new career-high with 11 punchouts in the Tribe's 5-2 win (7.0IP, 5H, 2R/1ER, 1BB)...combined with his start on June 19 (10K), struck out 10-or-more batters in consecutive starts for the first time in his career.

» Clevinger has also thrown 100-or-more pitches in 18 of his 27 starts this season, which is the 4th-most such starts in the American League...teammate **TREVOR BAUER** leads the Majors with 25 such outings.

» Tossed his first career complete-game shutout on April 21 at Baltimore on April 21...held the Orioles to two hits and two walks, with three strikeouts...his two hits allowed in the game marking the fewest such hits in a complete-game shutout by an Indians starting pitcher since **CARLOS CARRASCO** allowed one hit in a CGSO at Kansas City on September 25, 2015 (9.0IP, 2BB, 15K).

» Set a new career-high in innings pitched for the second time this season in the outing, after breaking his previous career best with 7.1IP on April 8 vs. Kansas City.

» Clevinger is in his fourth season in the Indians organization...was selected in the 4th round (135th overall) by Los Angeles-AL in the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Seminole State College (FL)...acquired by the Indians in exchange for reliever **Vinnie Pestano** on Aug. 7, 2014...added to Cleveland's 40-man roster on November 20, 2015.
